CLAIM

The ornamental design for a fishing lure, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a fishing lure embodying my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the fishing lure;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view of the fishing lure;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the fishing lure;

FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of the fishing lure;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view of the fishing lure;

FIG. 7 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of my new design for a fishing lure; the second embodiment illustrates the fishing lure of FIG. 1 equipped with a spinner harness and a flexible skirt;

FIG. 8 is a perspective view of a third embodiment of my new design for a fishing lure; the third embodiment illustrates the fishing lure of FIG. 1 equipped with a flexible skirt; and

FIG. 9 is a perspective view of a fourth embodiment of my new design for a fishing lure; the fourth embodiment illustrates the fishing lure of FIG. 1 equipped with a flexible tail.
