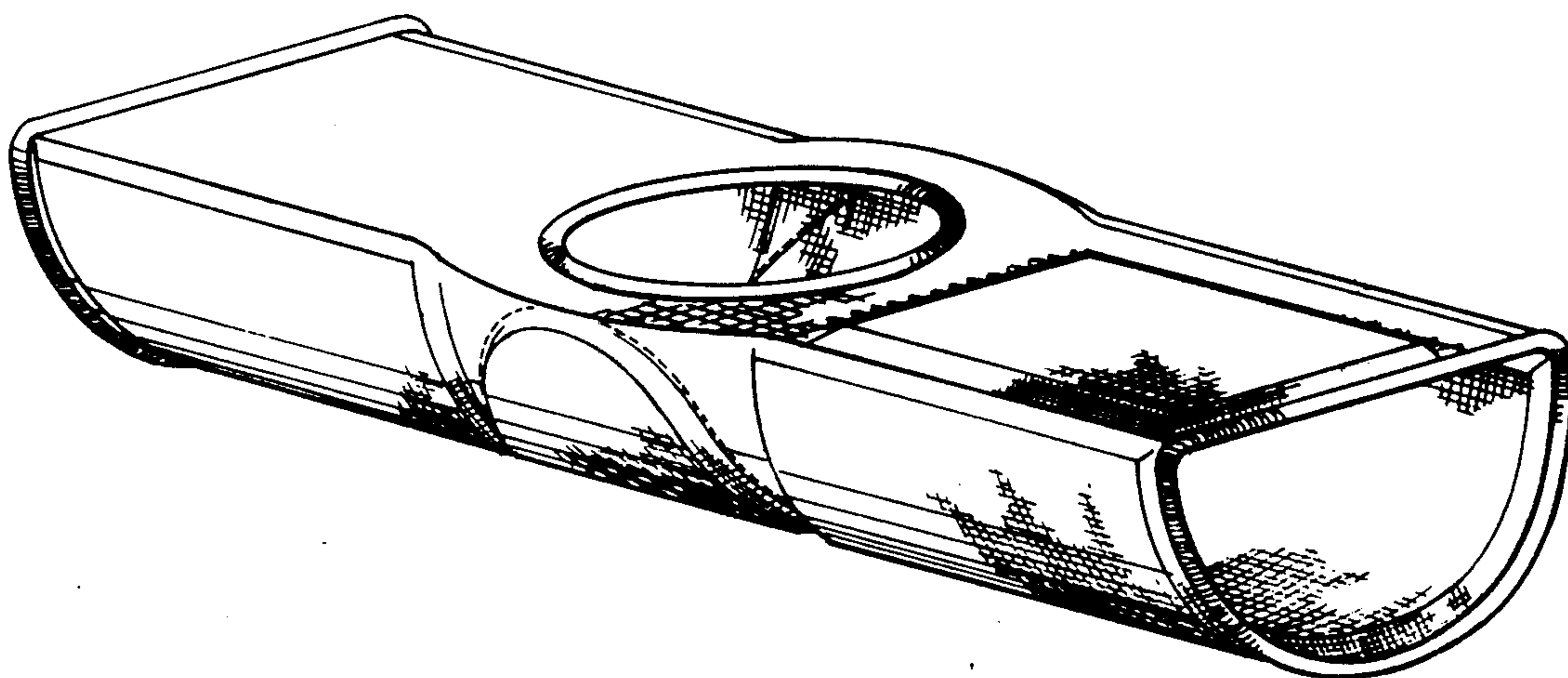

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top and left side perspective view of a lacrosse elbow guard showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view;
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view, the right side being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view; and
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view.



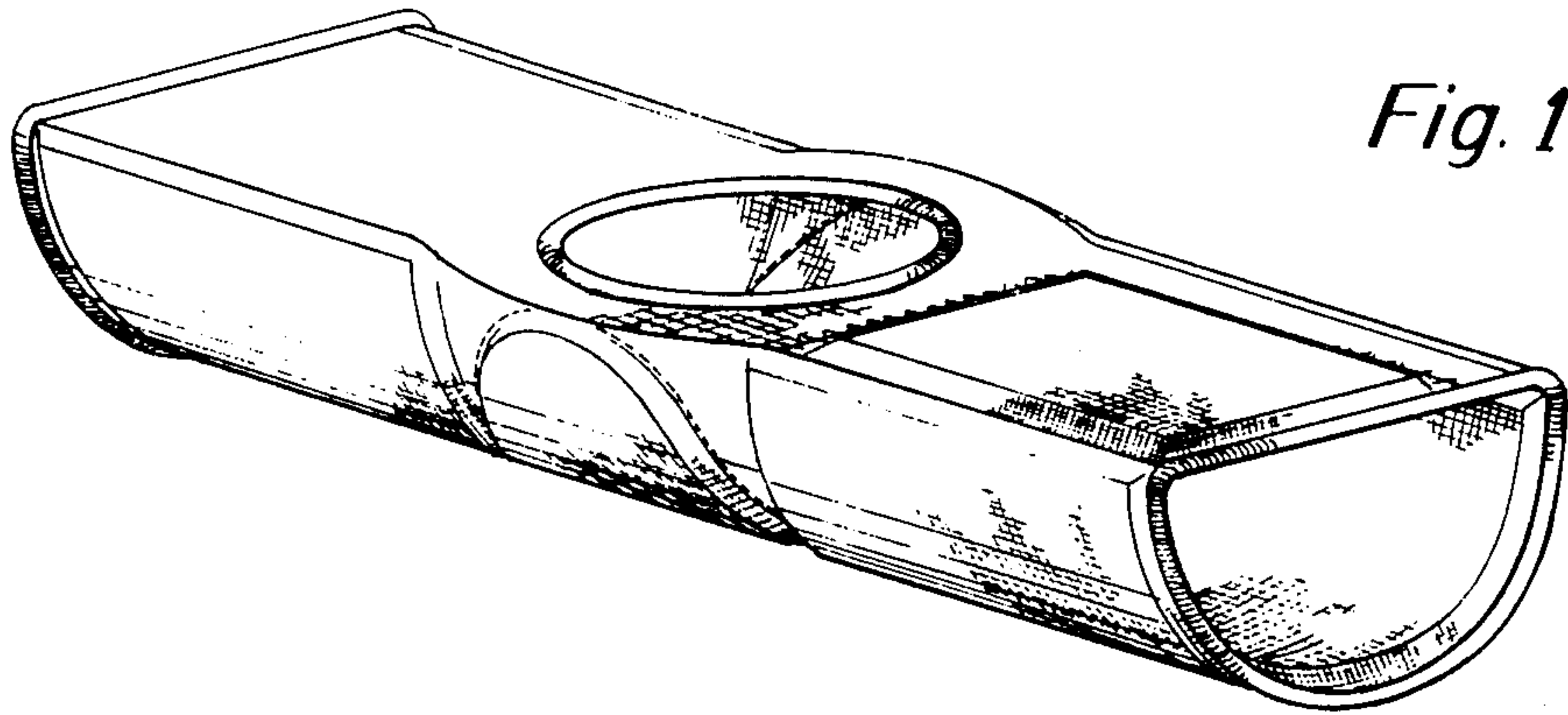

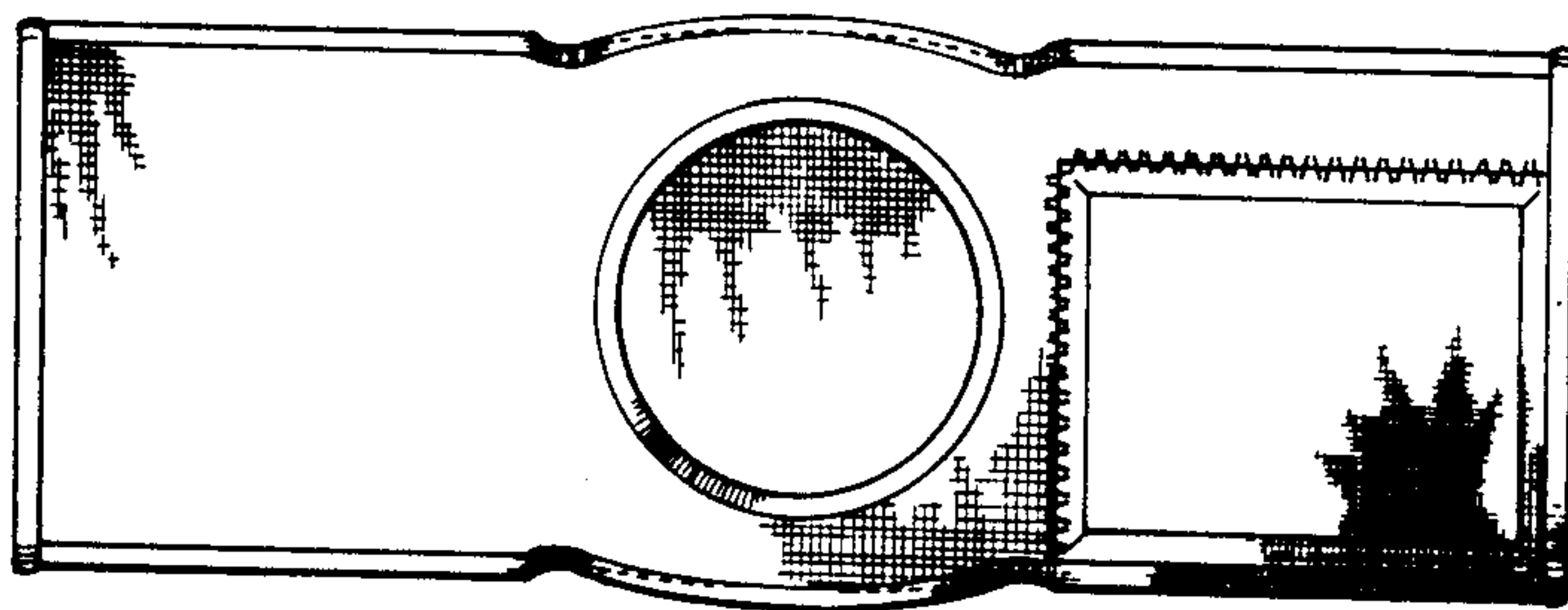

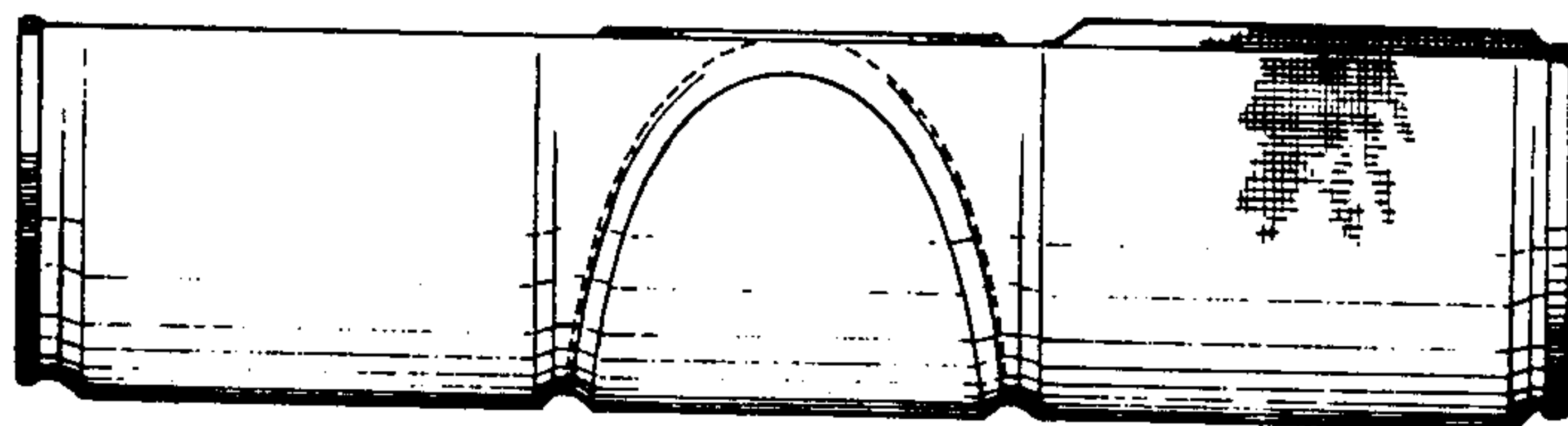

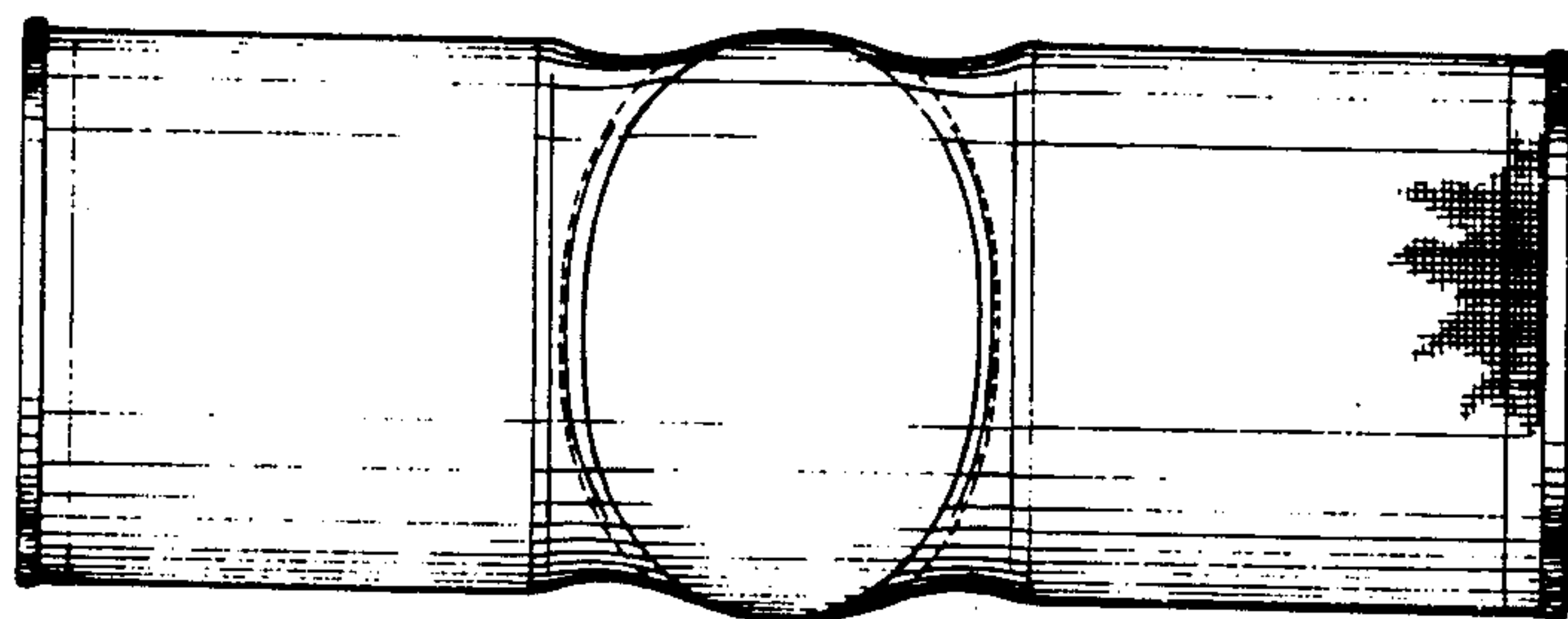

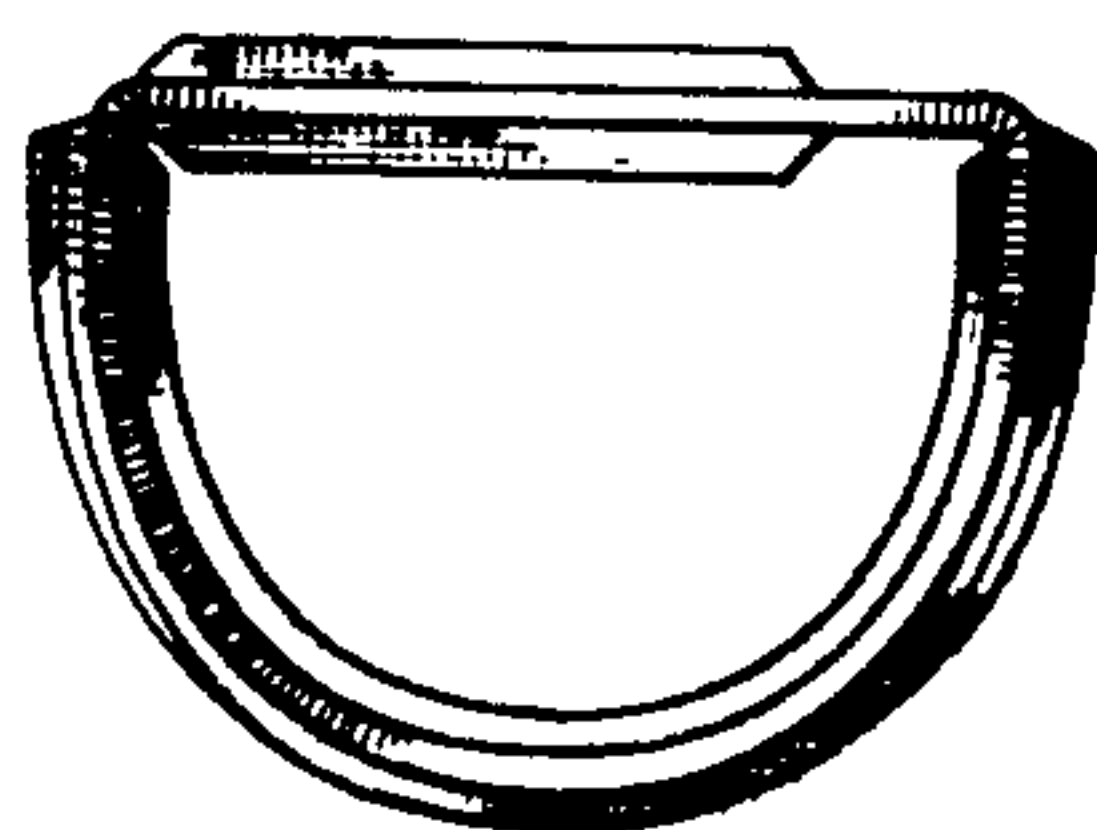
