FIG. 4 is a right front perspective view thereof.

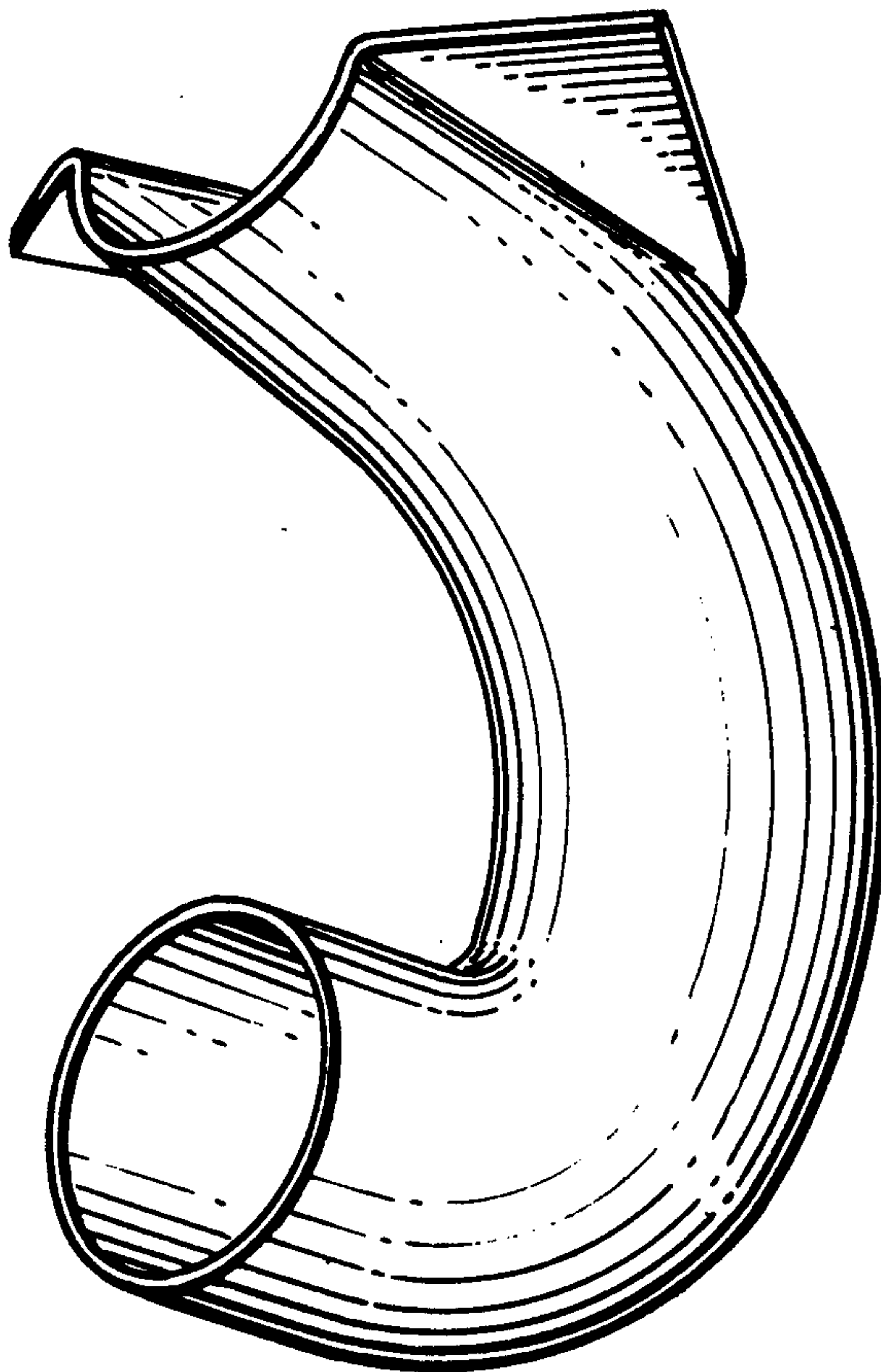

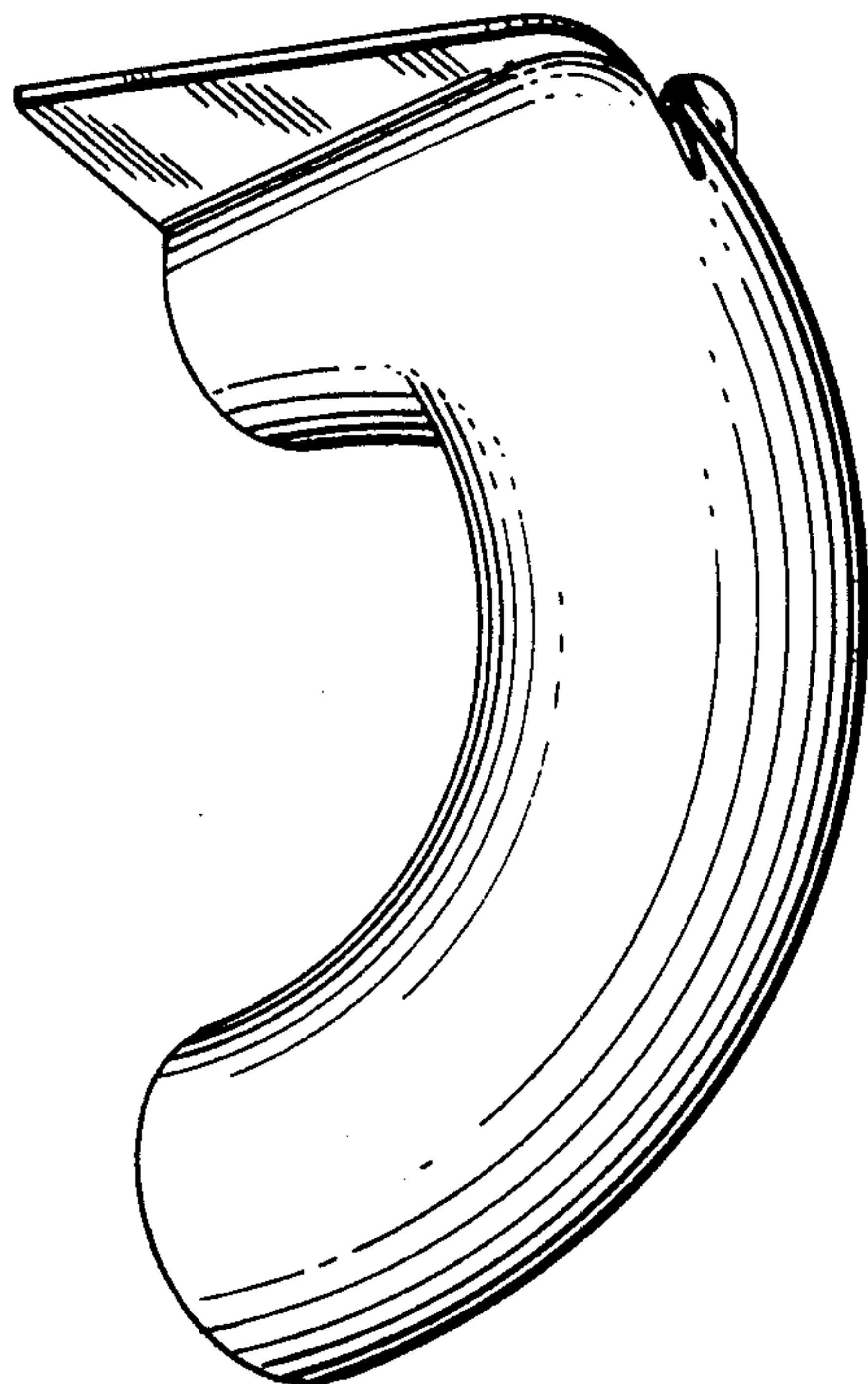

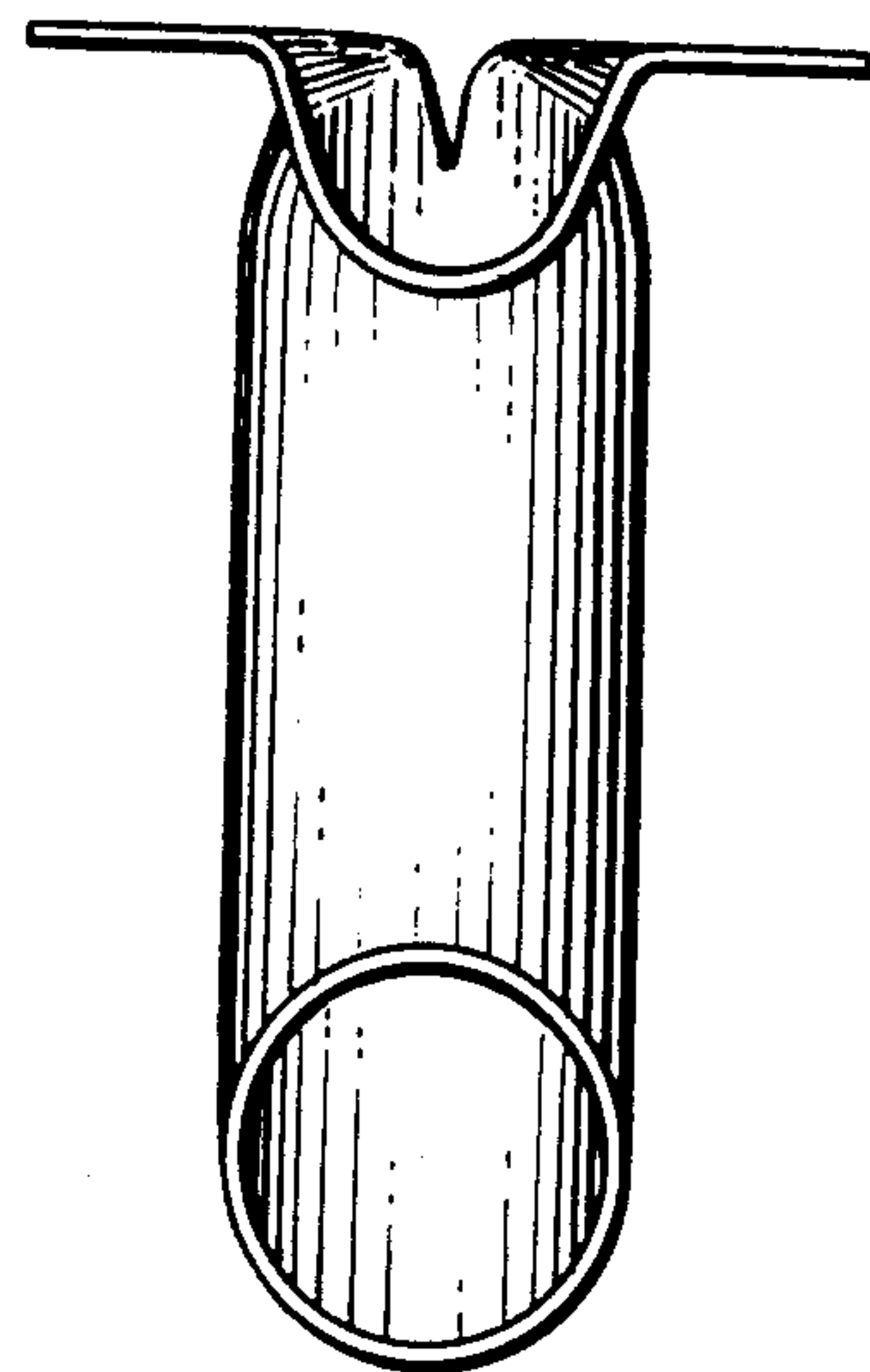

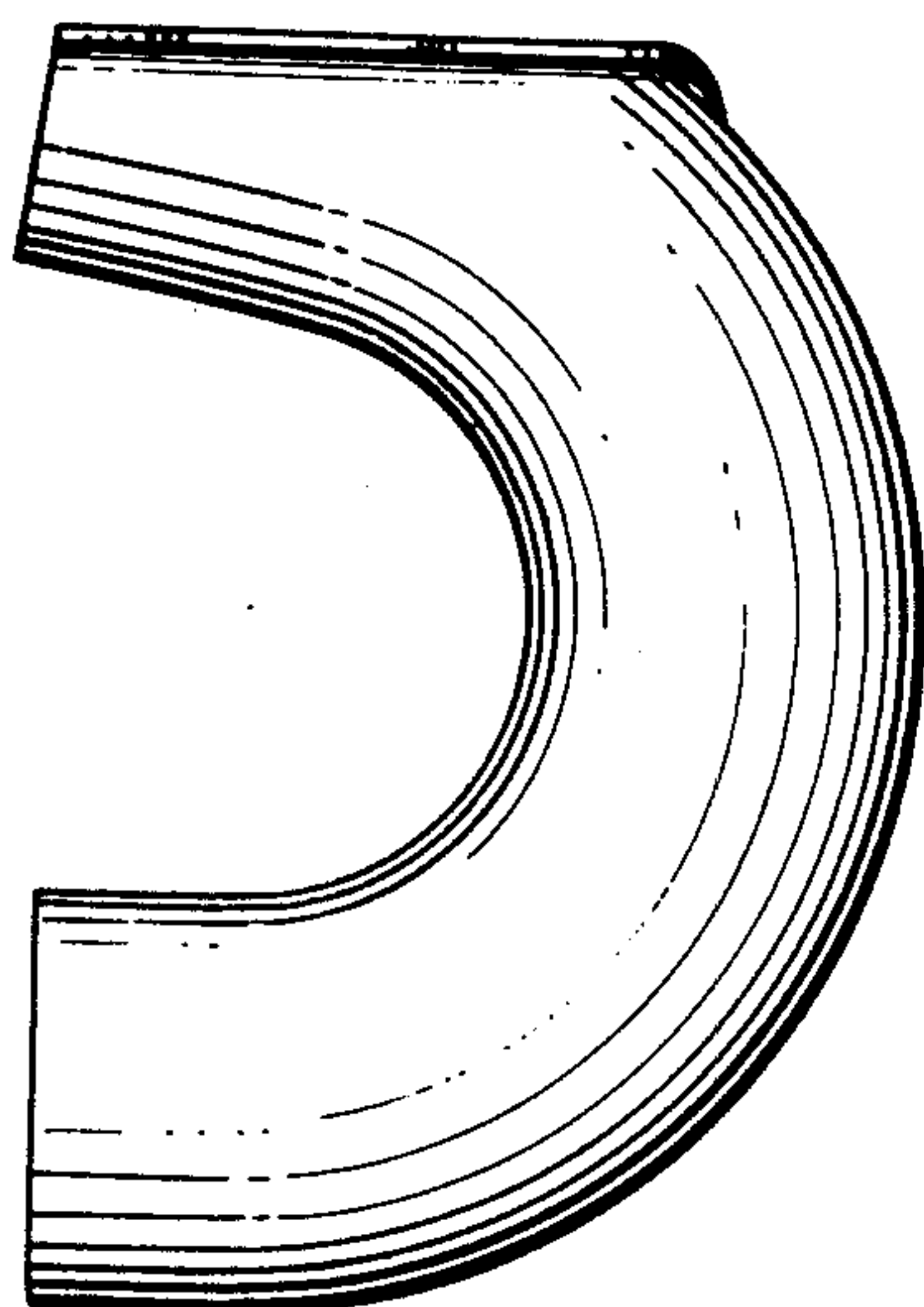
