FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the combined coin chest and coin showing my new design.

FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view of the coin chest of FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the coin chest with the cover in a closed position.

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of the coin chest with the cover in a closed position.
