FIG. 2 is an isometric view from below of the display stand shown in FIG. 1, but rotated 45° on its base.

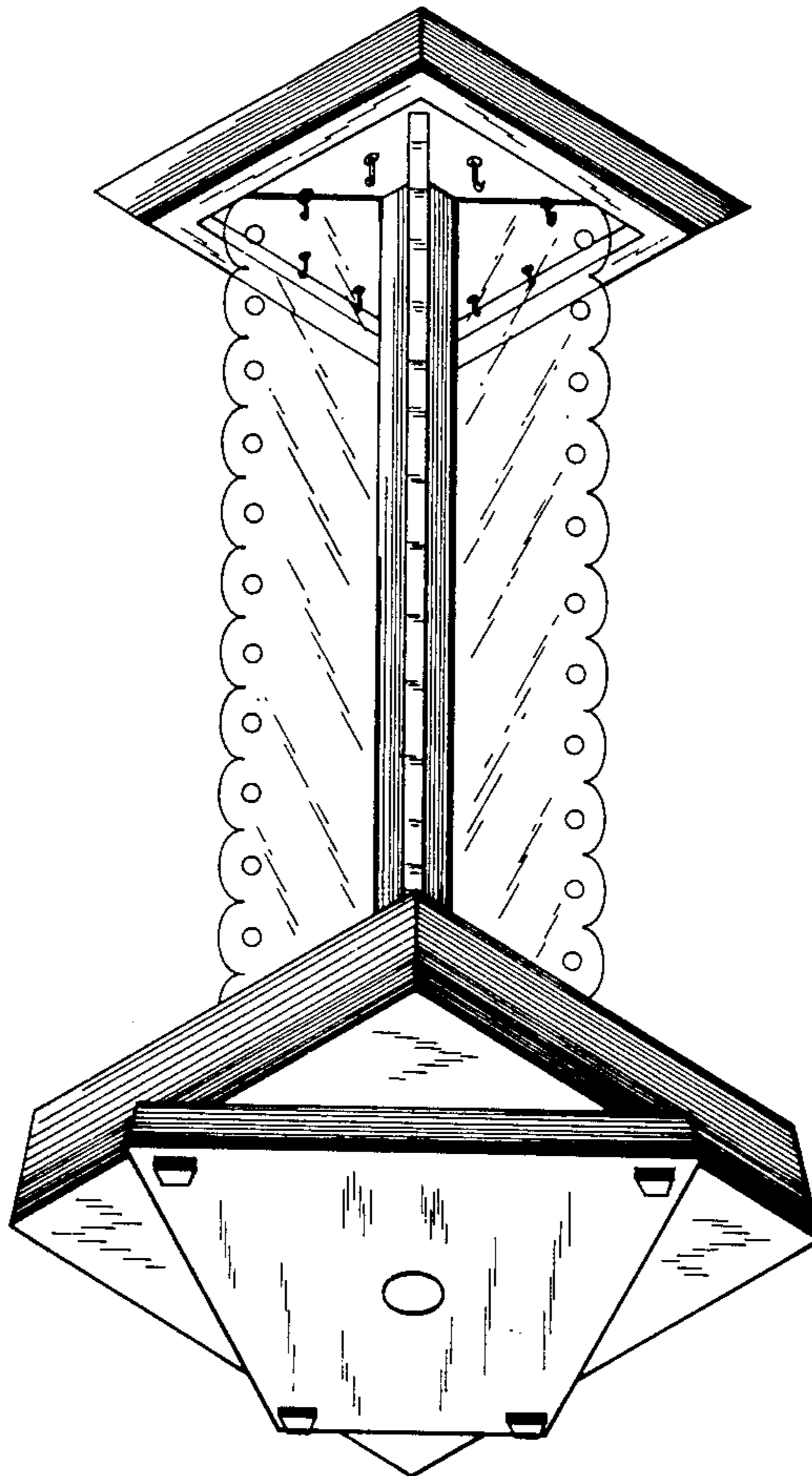

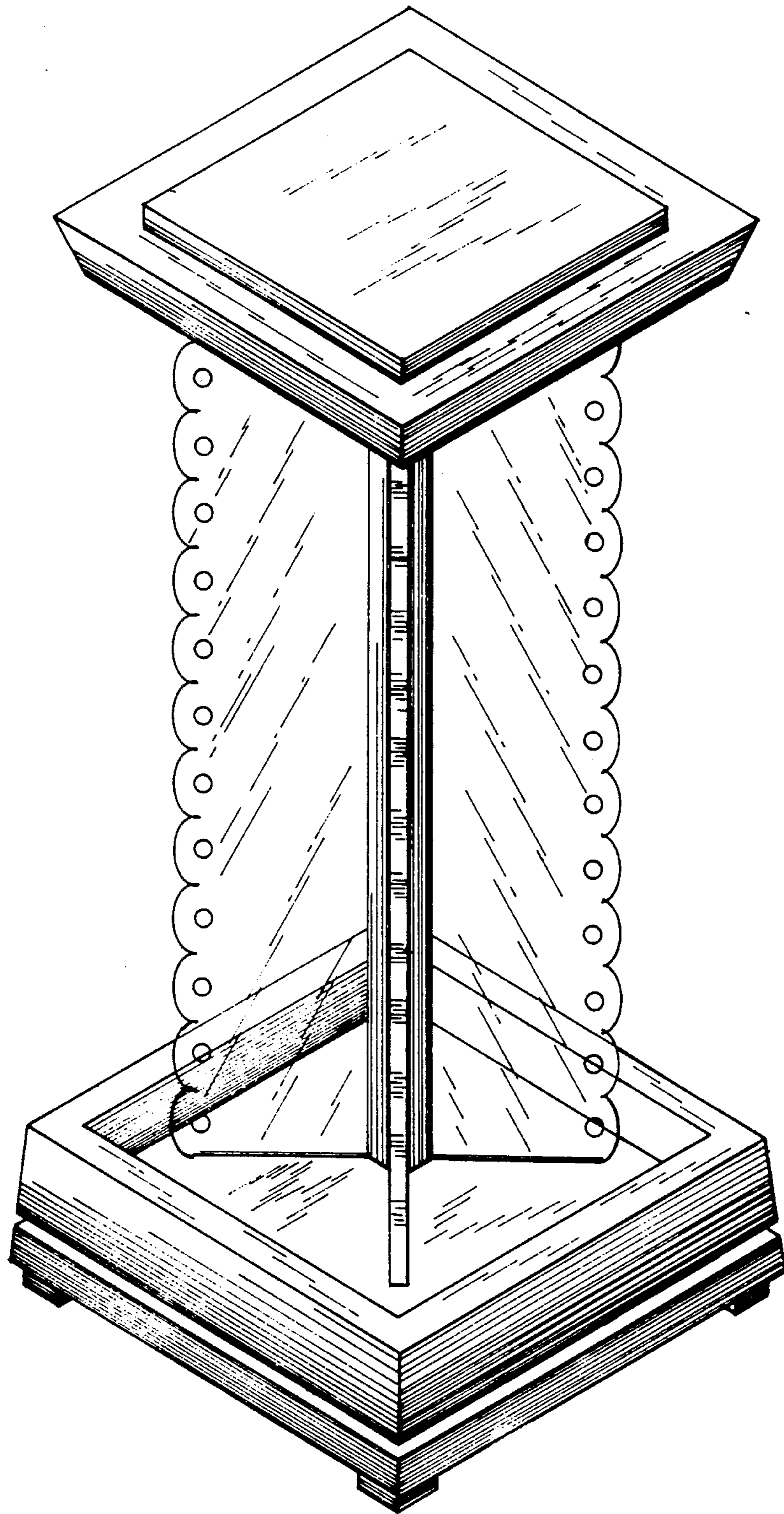
