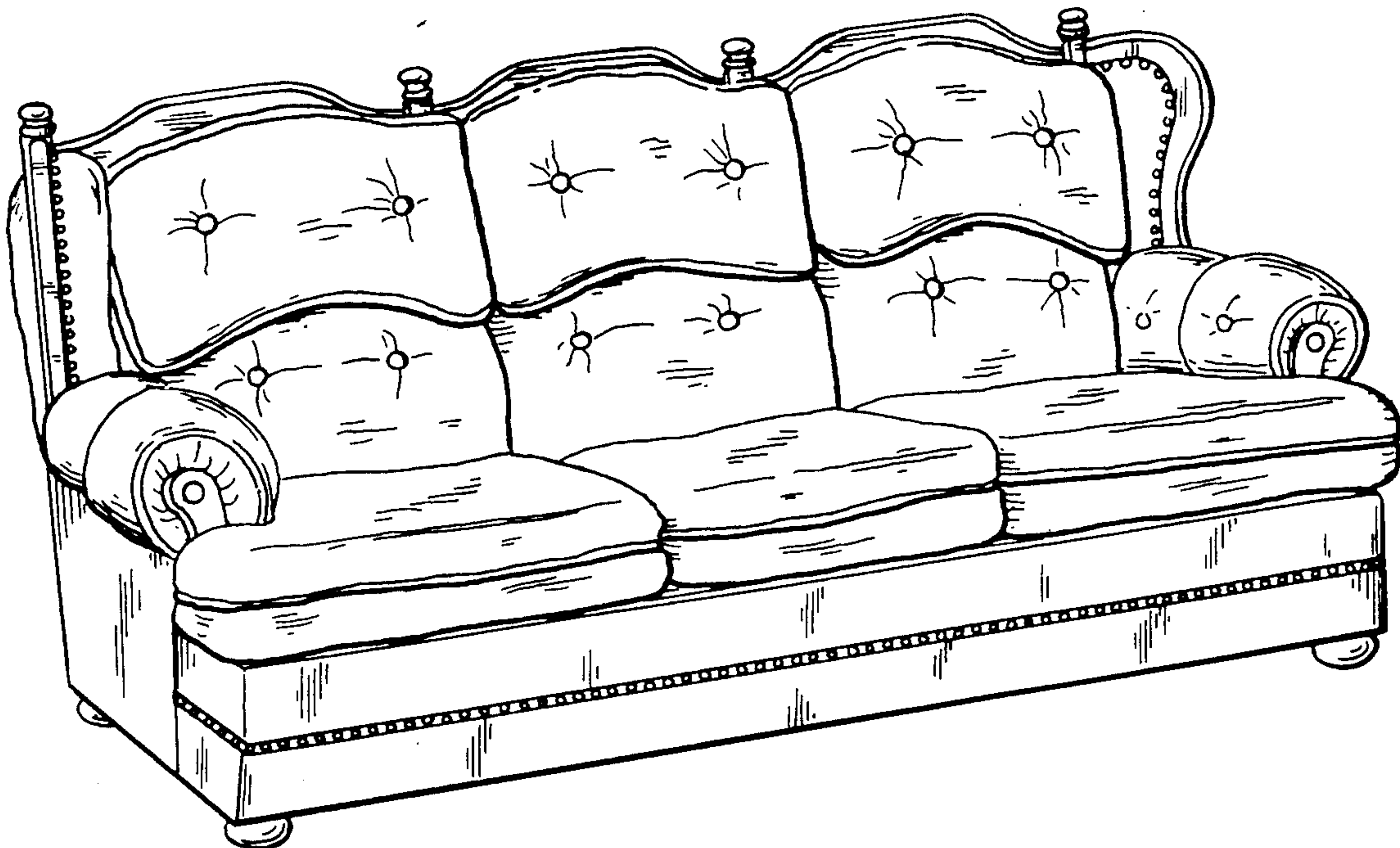

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a chair showing
the design in the form of a sofa;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;

form of an armchair.



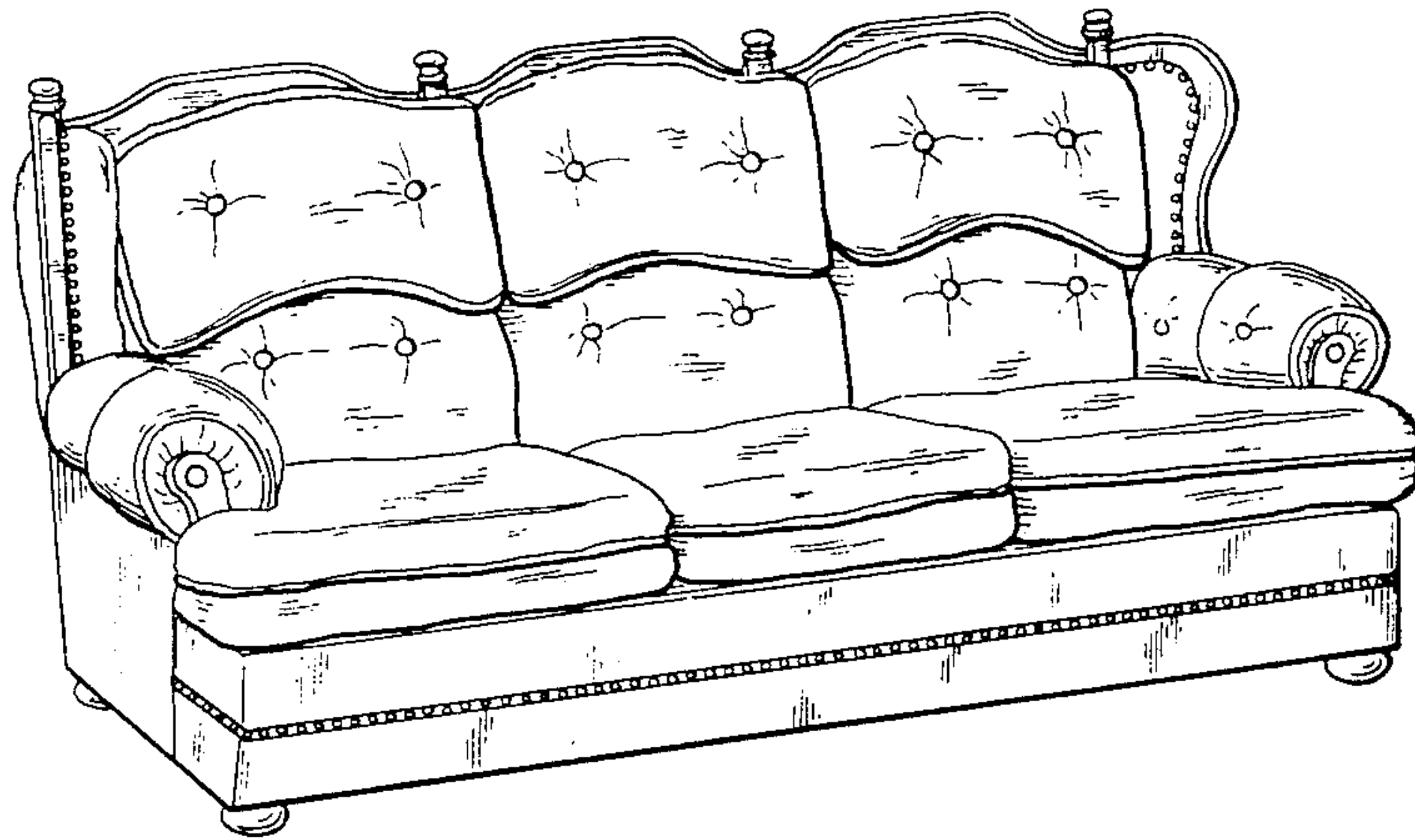

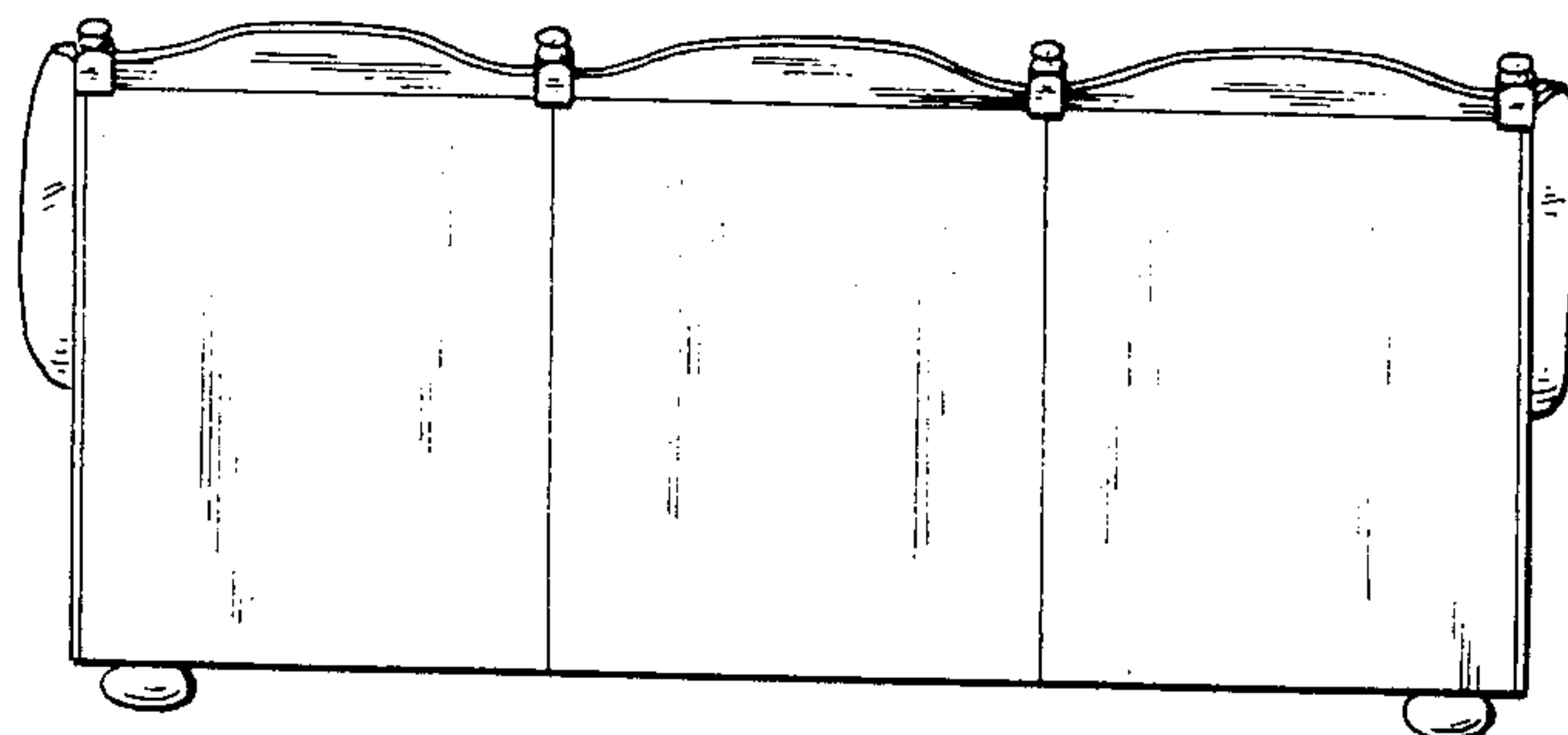

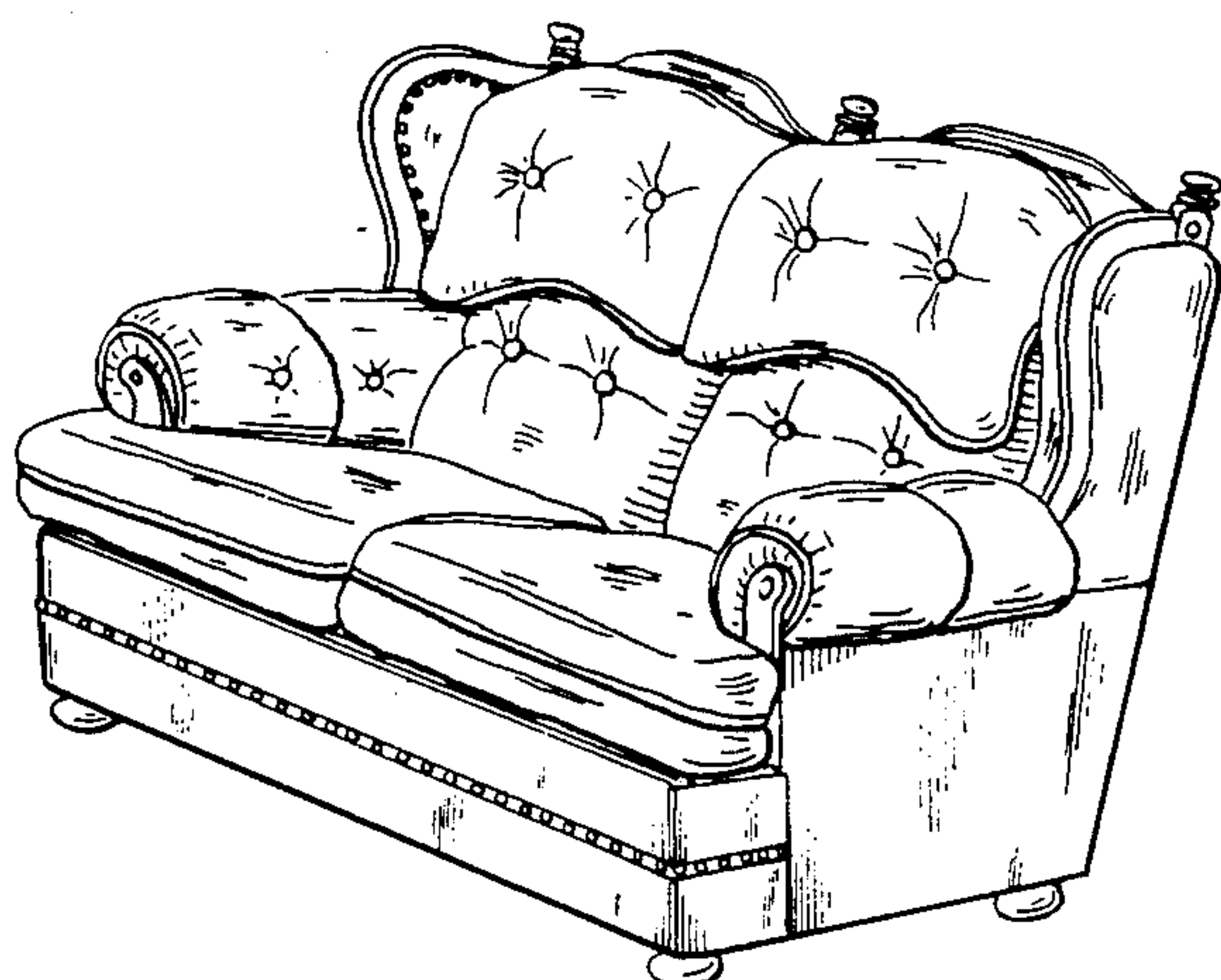

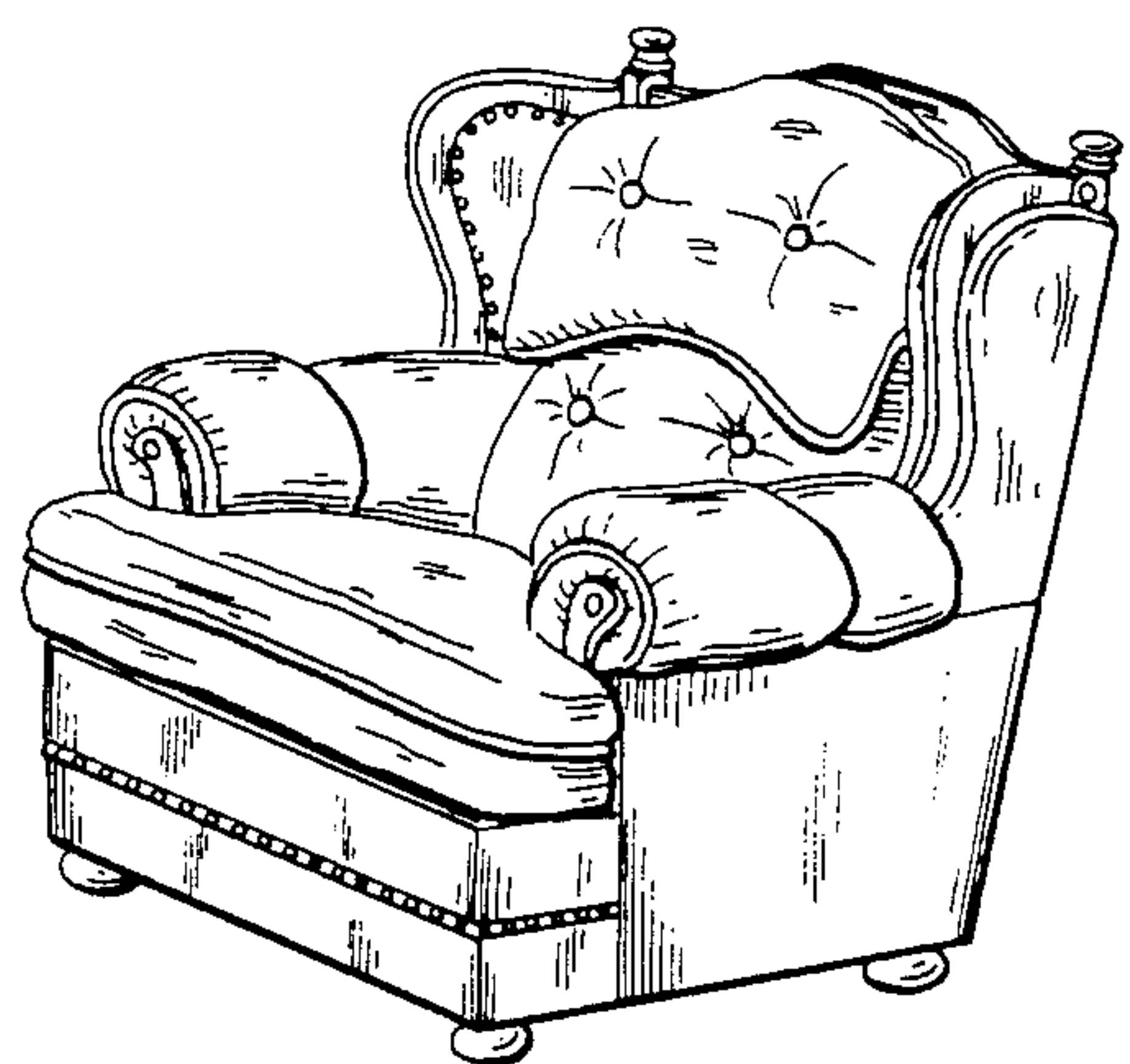
