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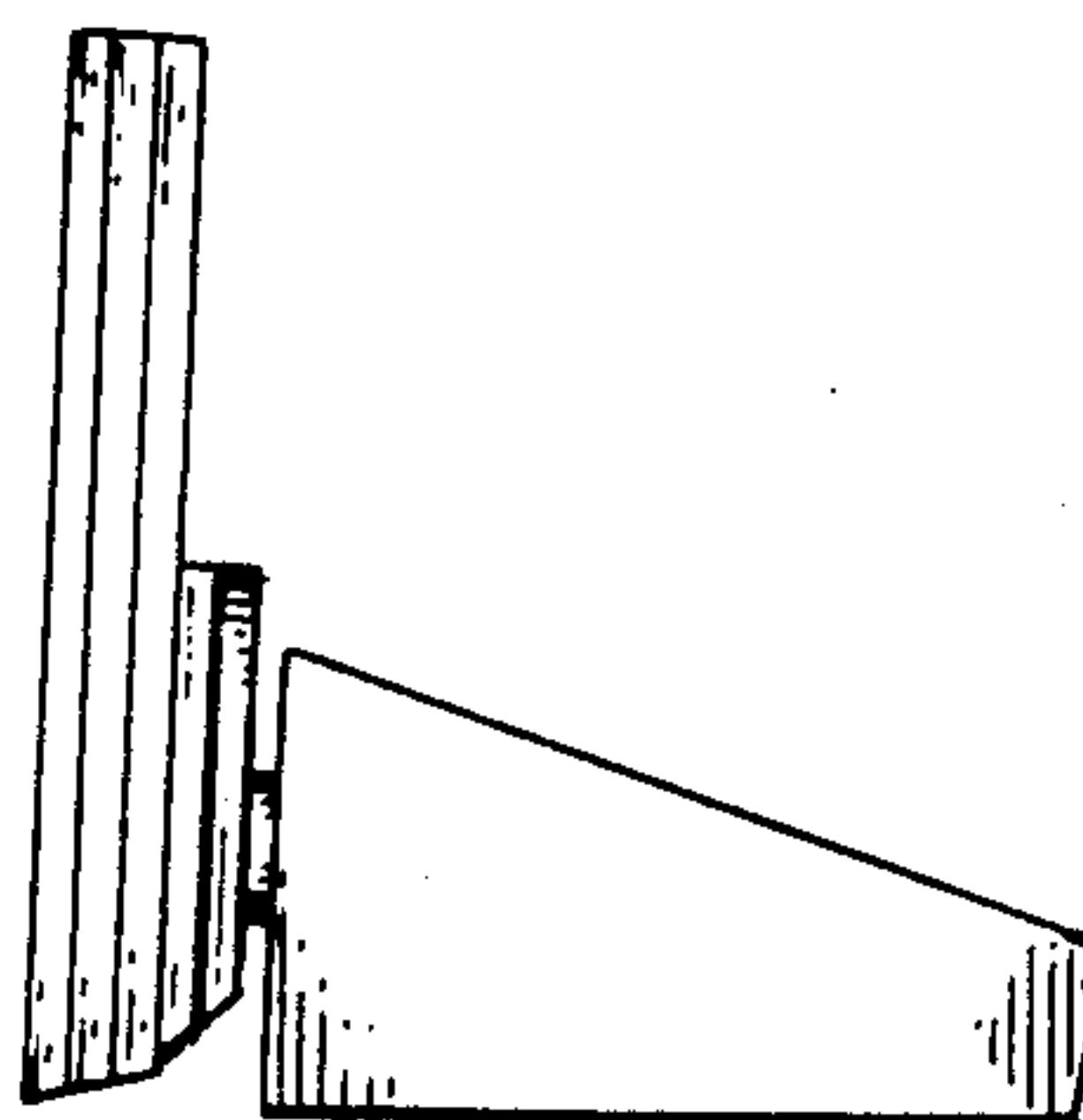
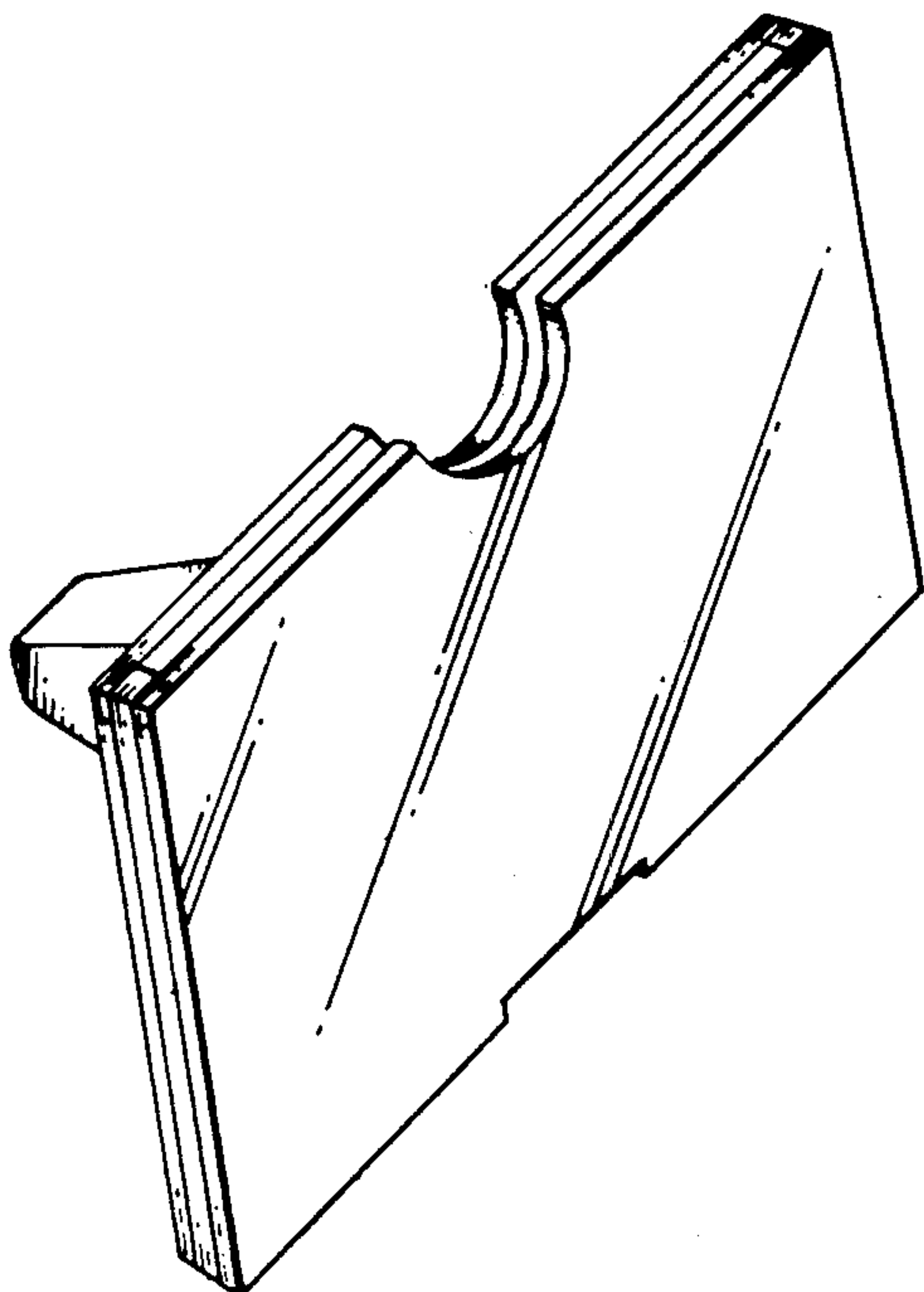

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an adjustable card holder showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view;

FIG. 8 is a side elevational view with the support member in a fourth position.



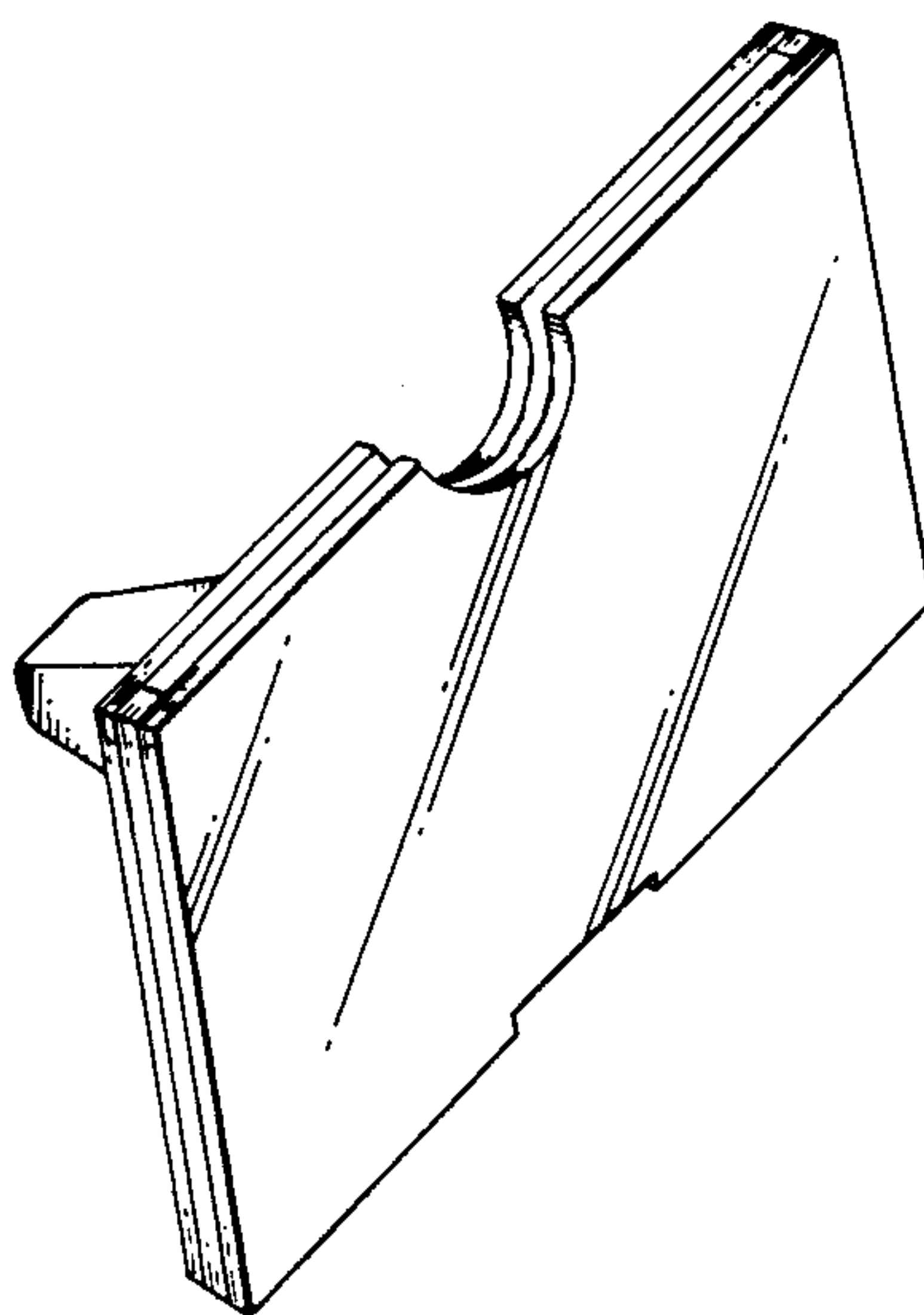

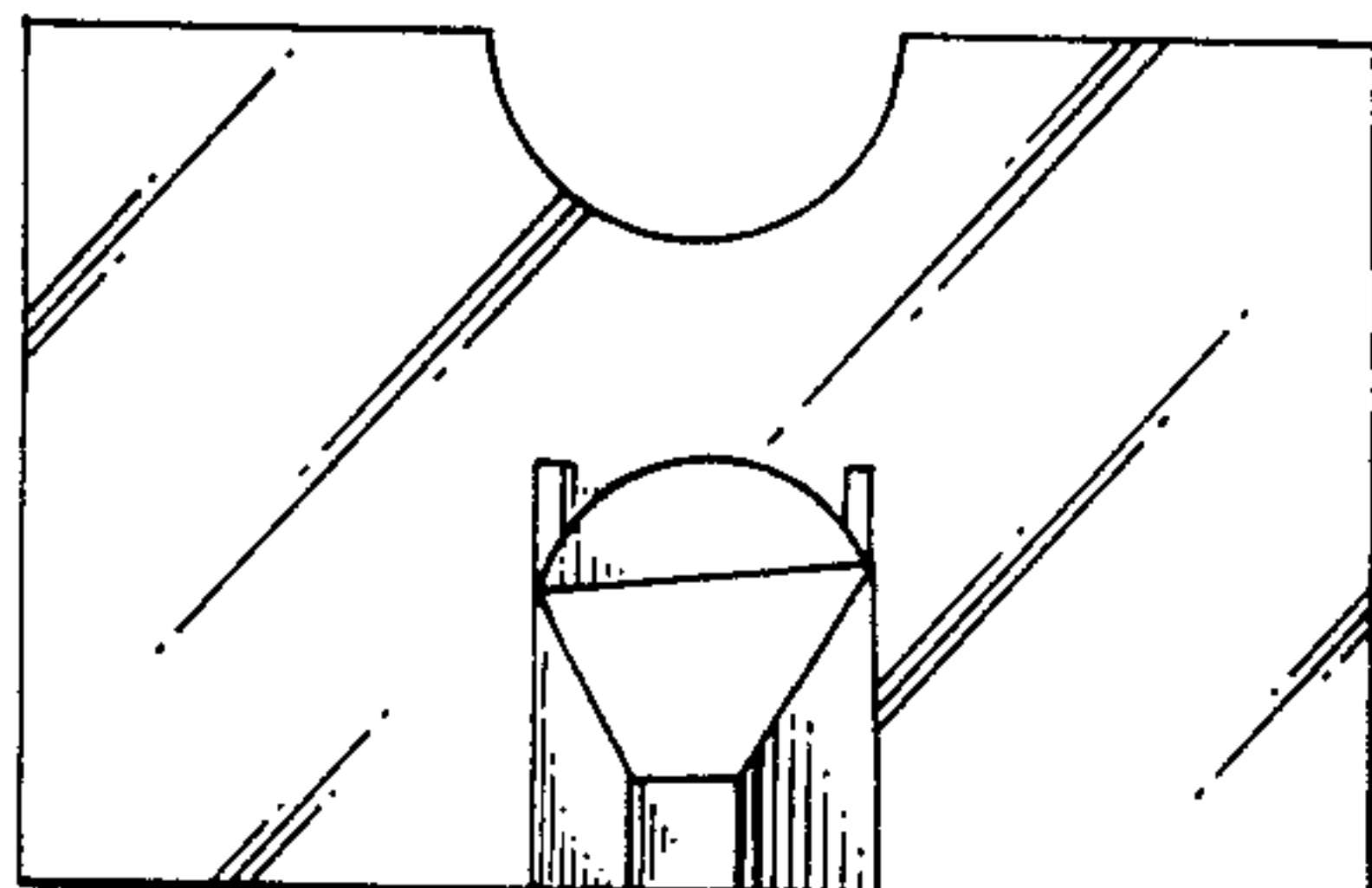

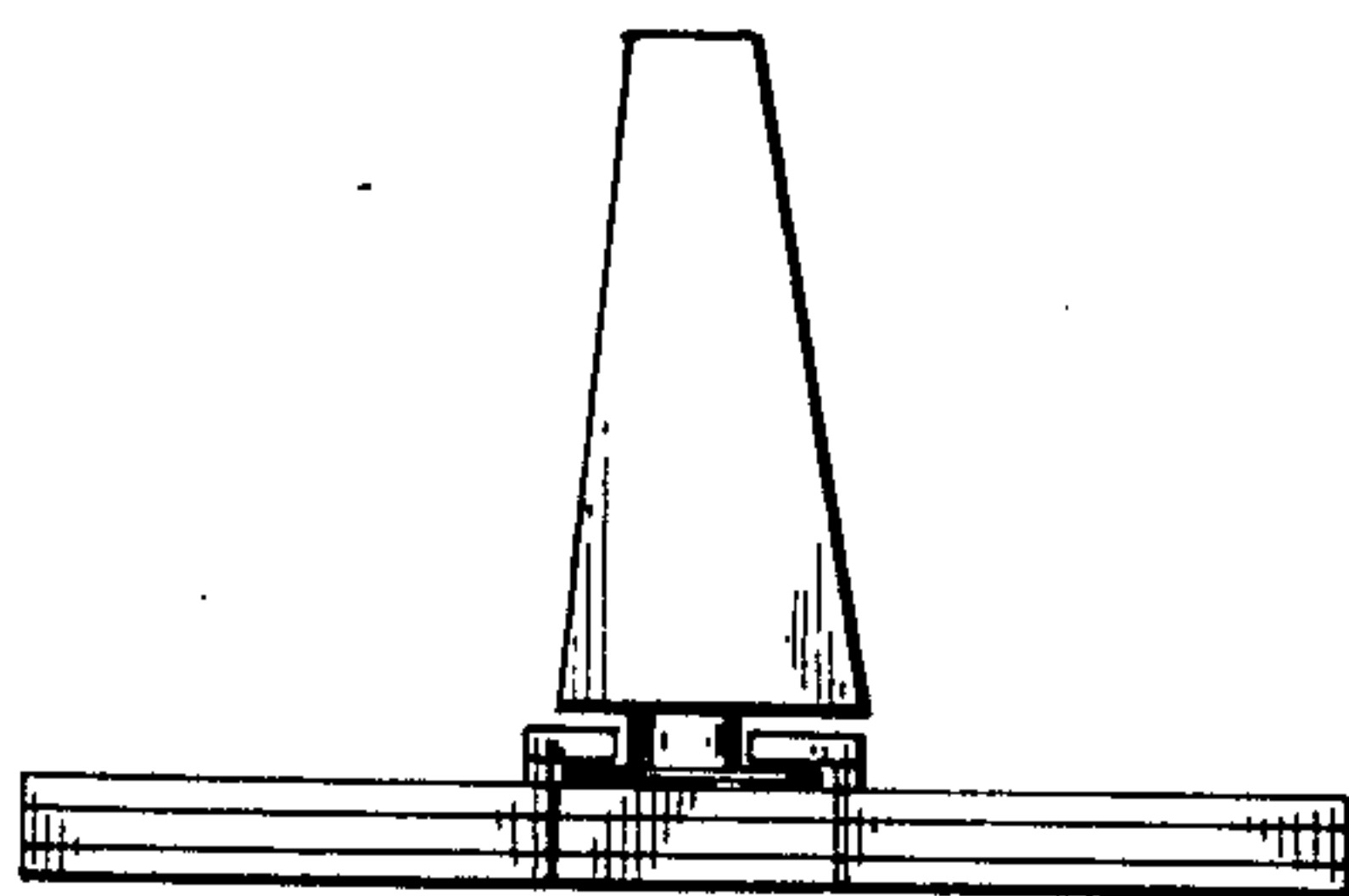

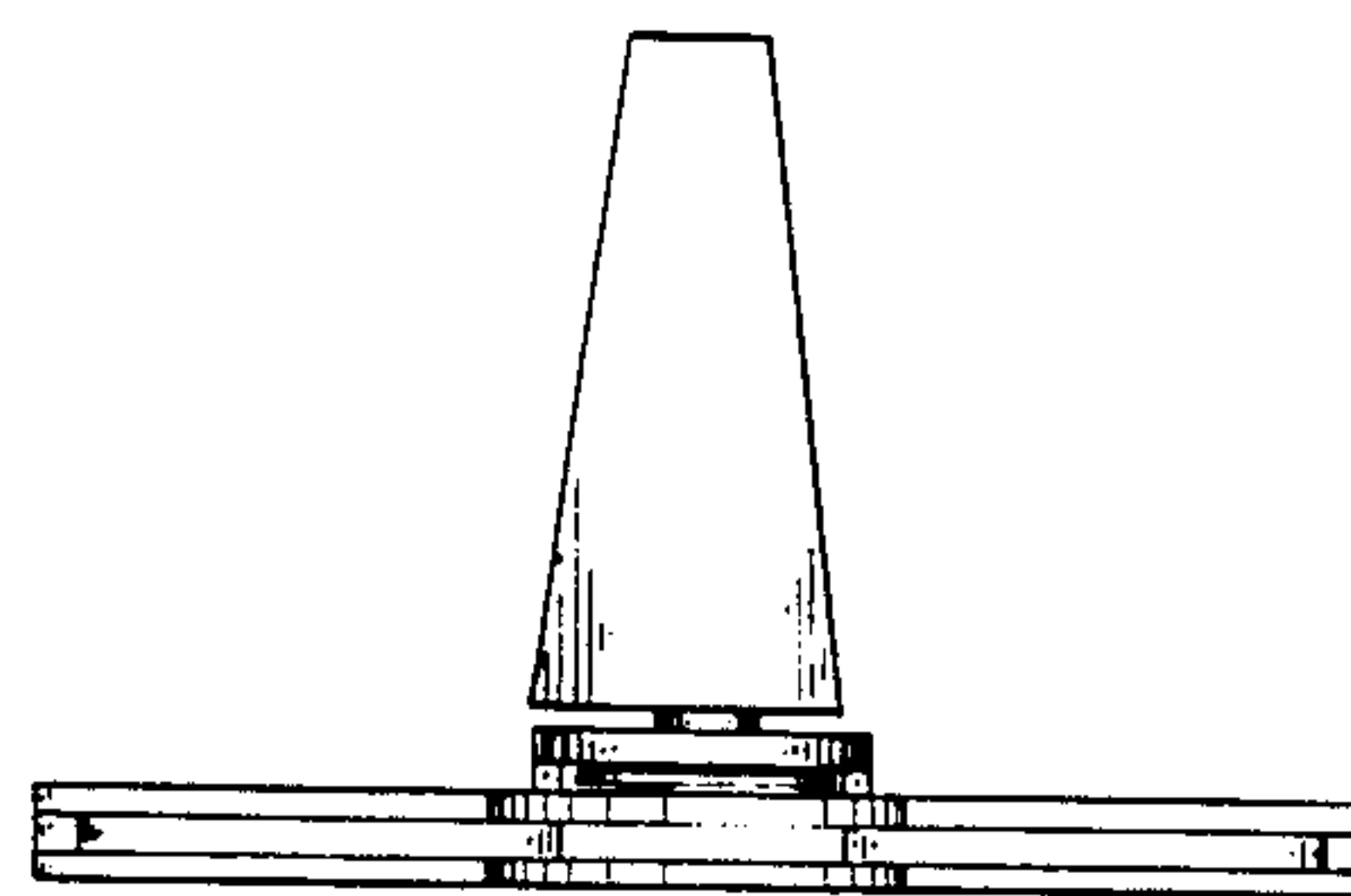

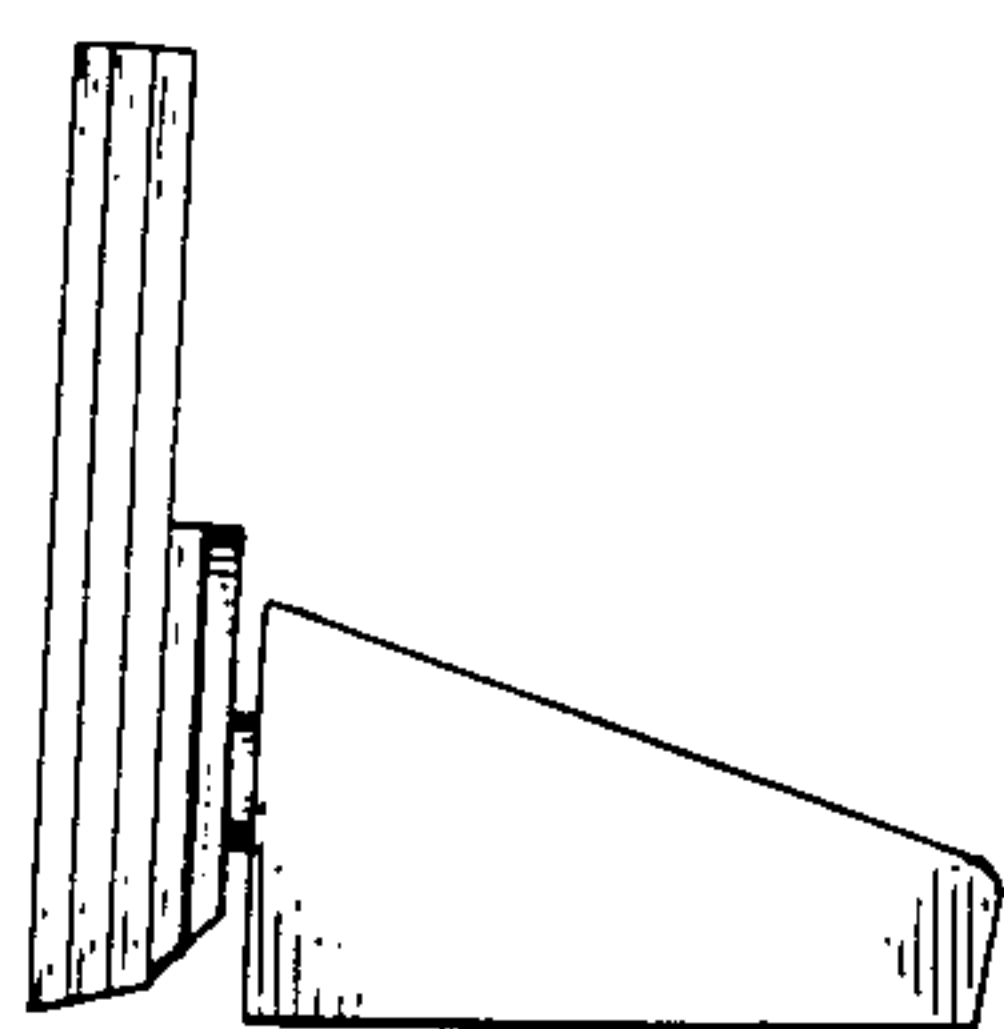

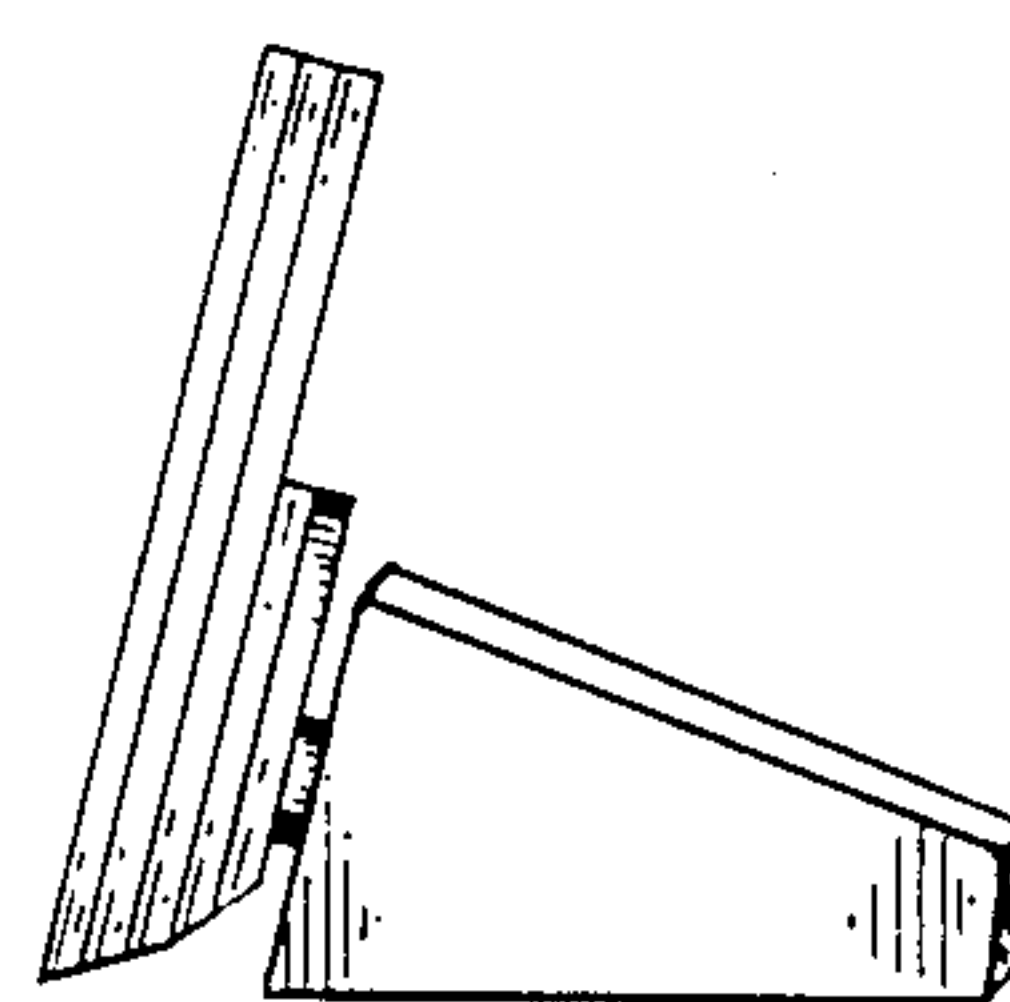

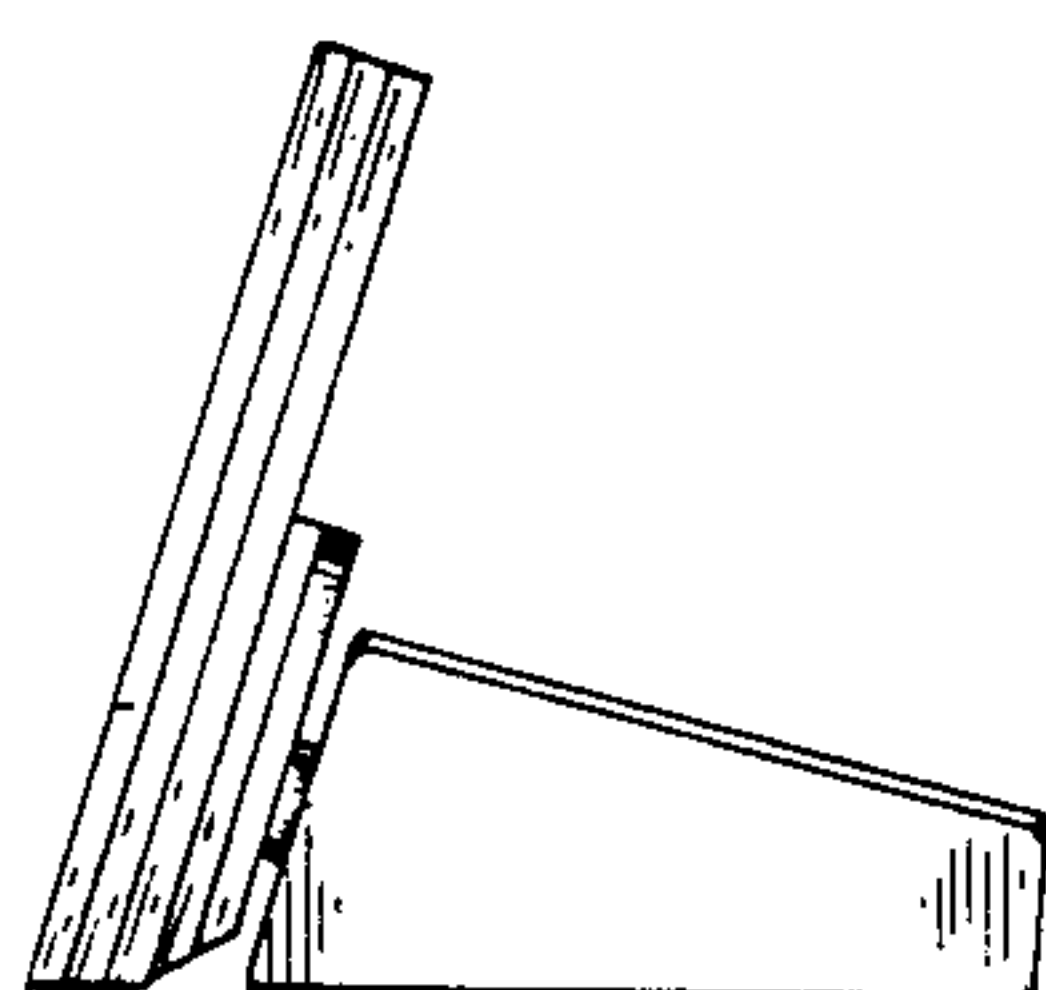

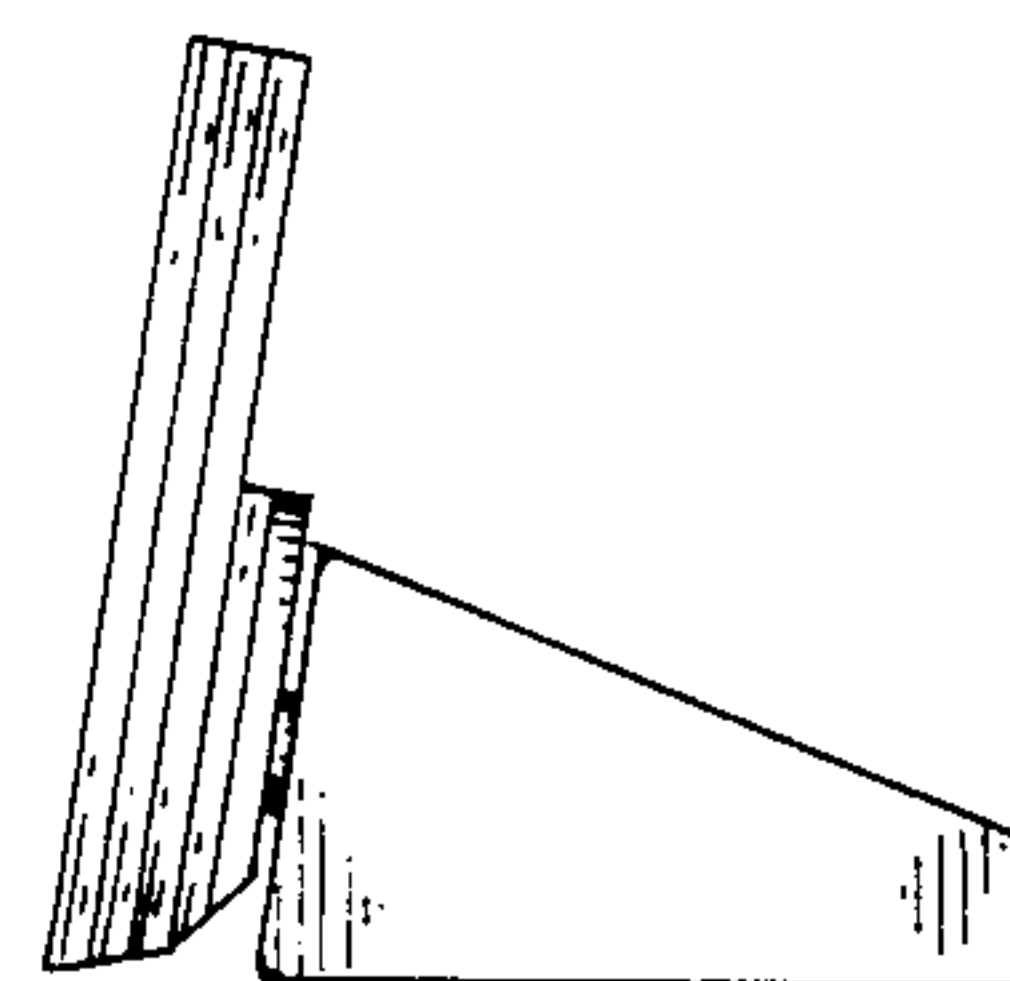
