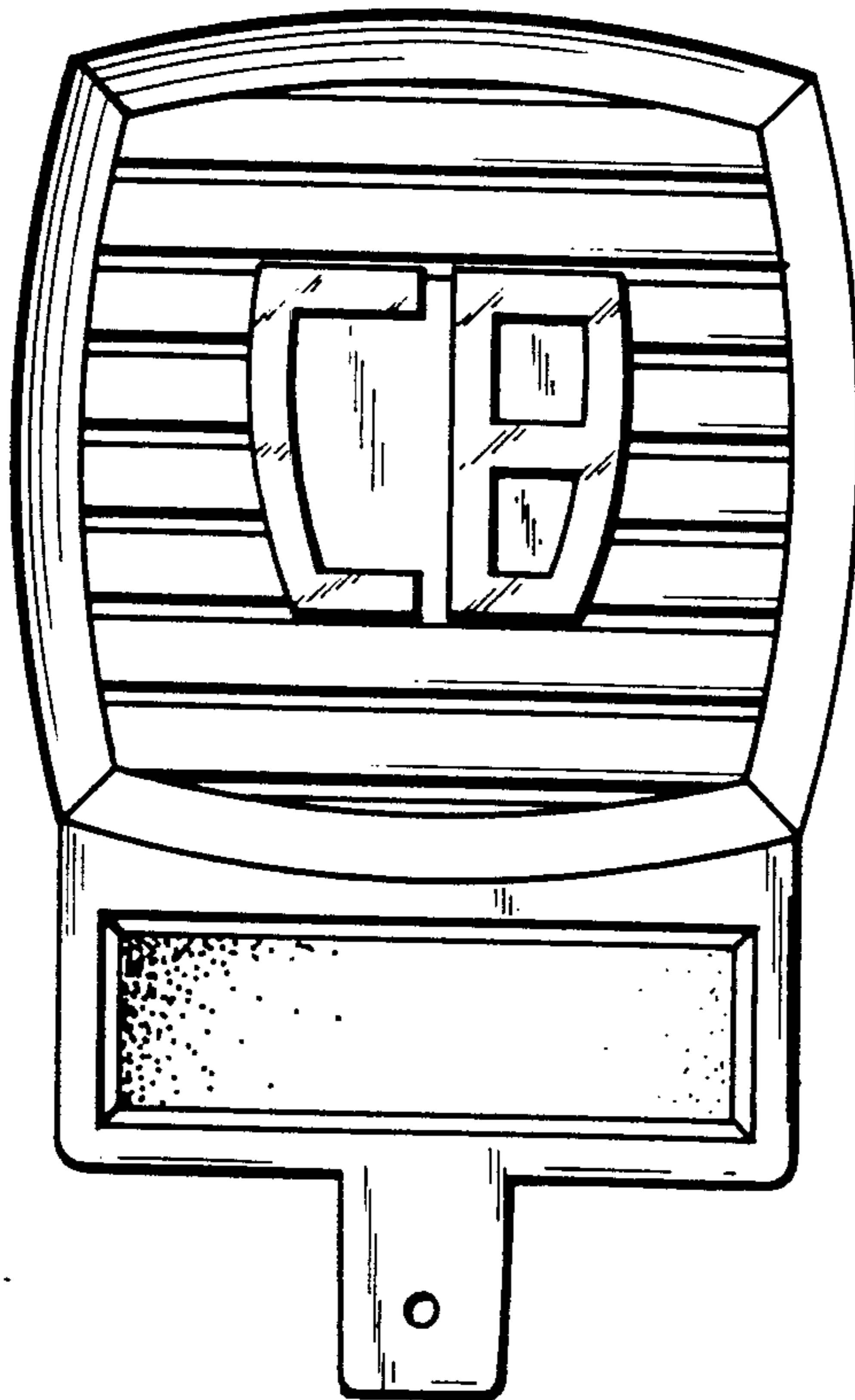

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a charm or the like, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a charm or the like showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view, the opposite side being the same in appearance as the side shown;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a front elevational view of a charm or the like showing a modified form of our new design; and
FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of a charm or the like showing another modified form of our new design.



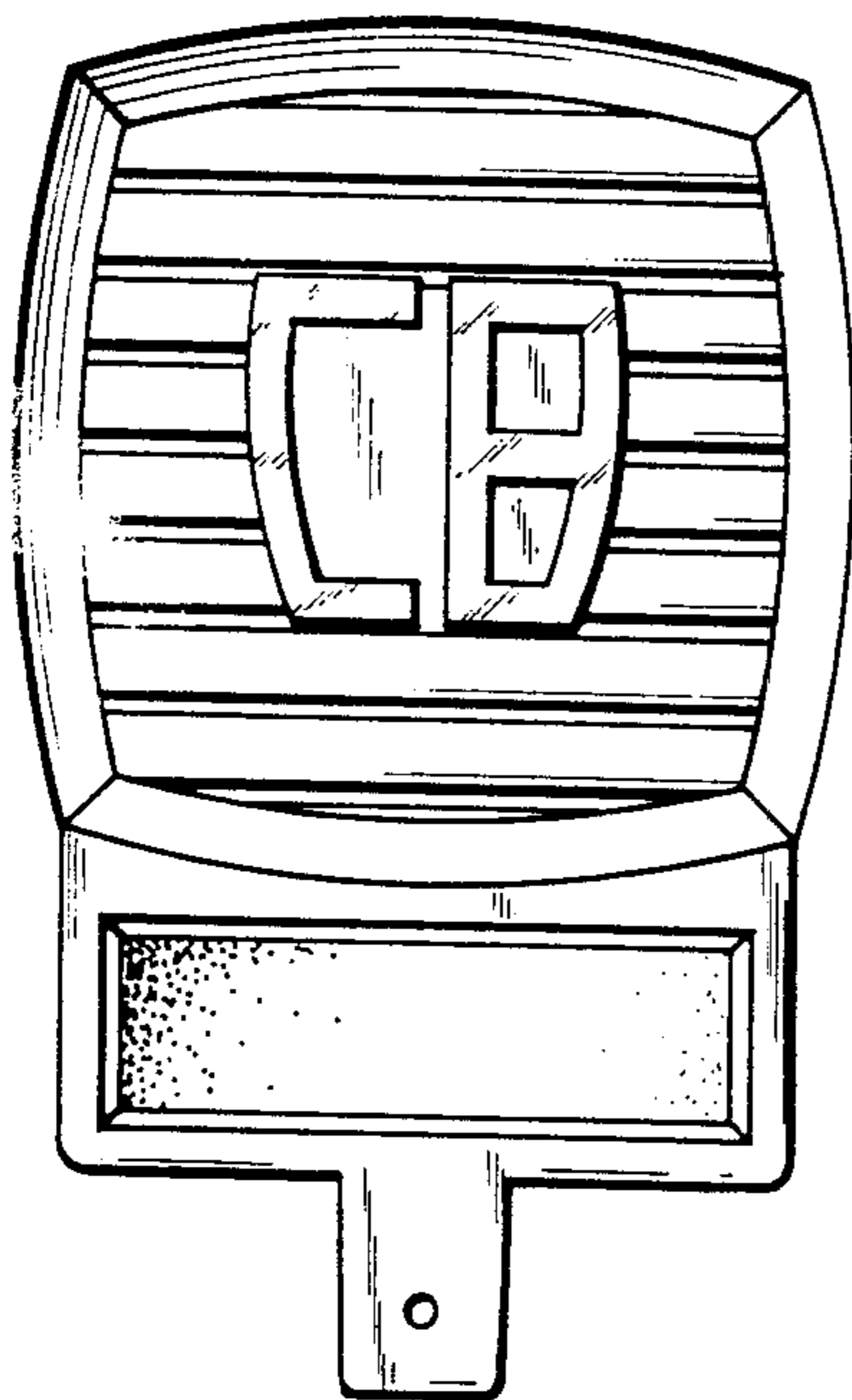

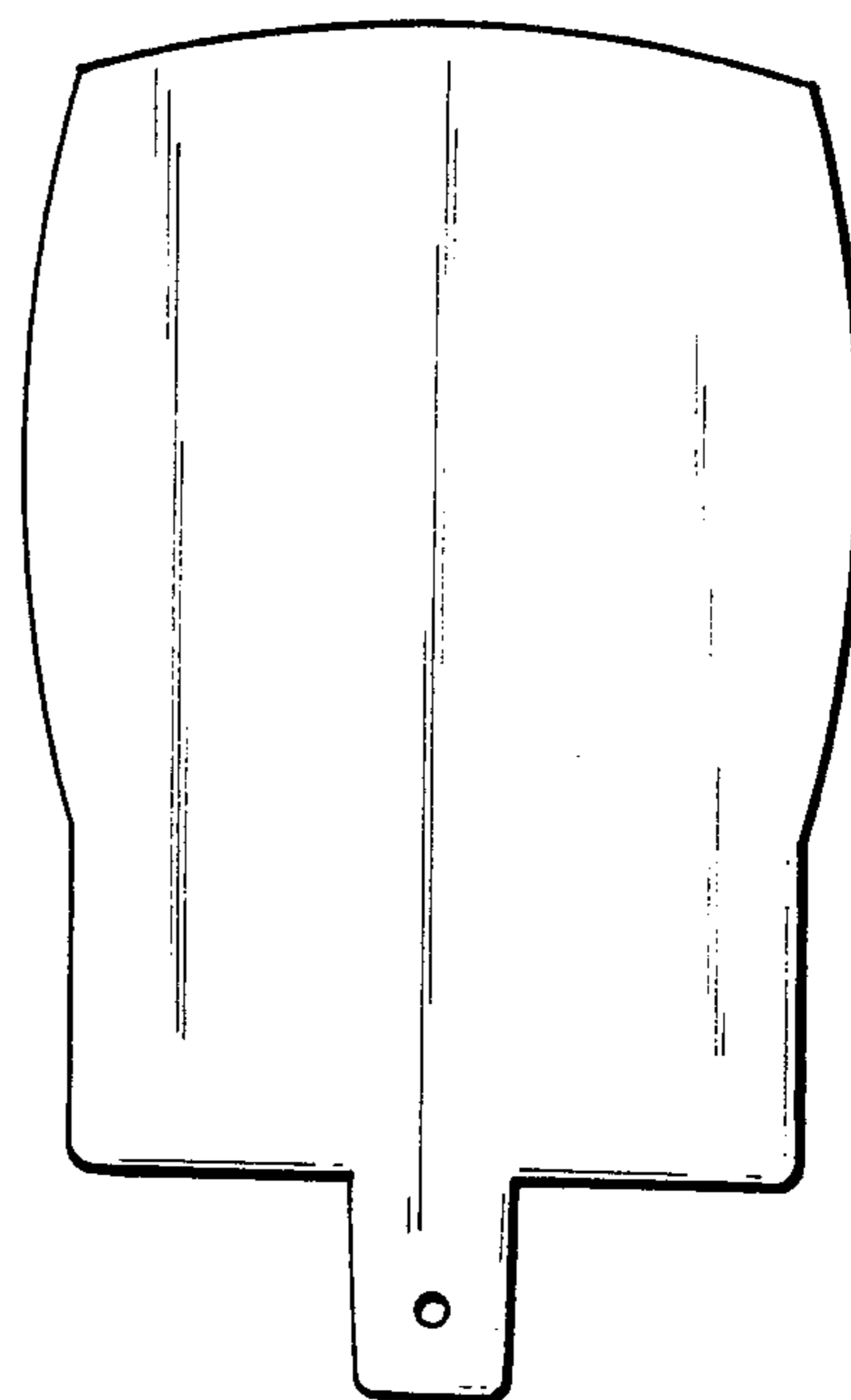

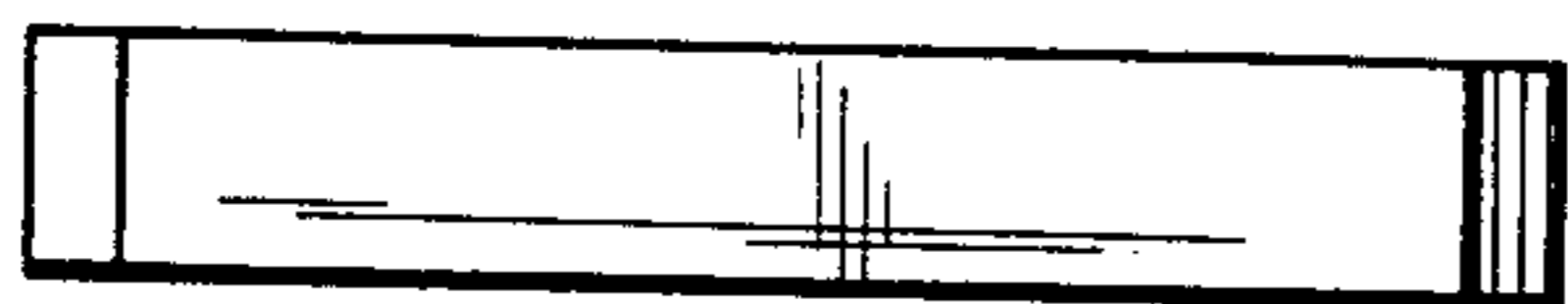

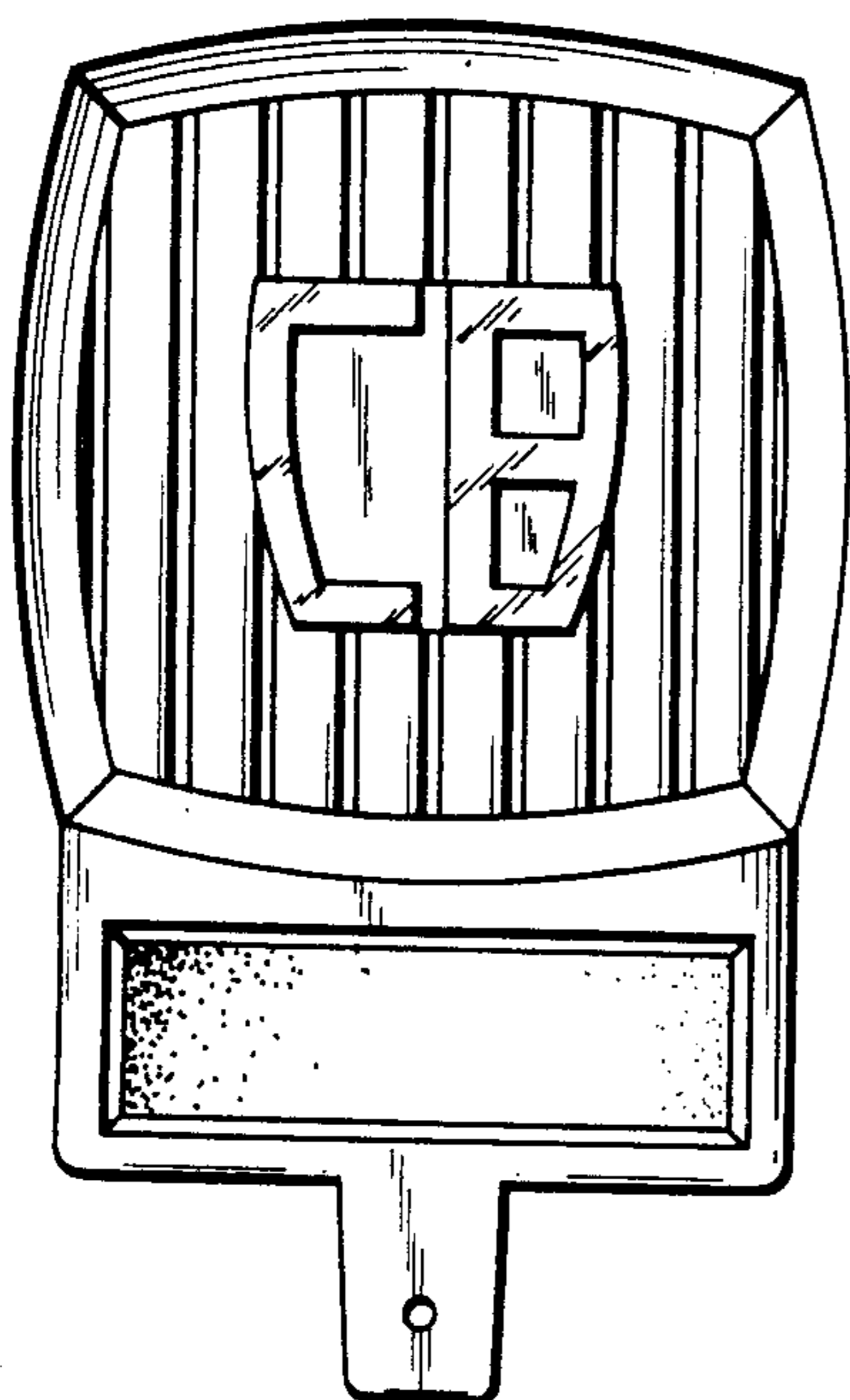

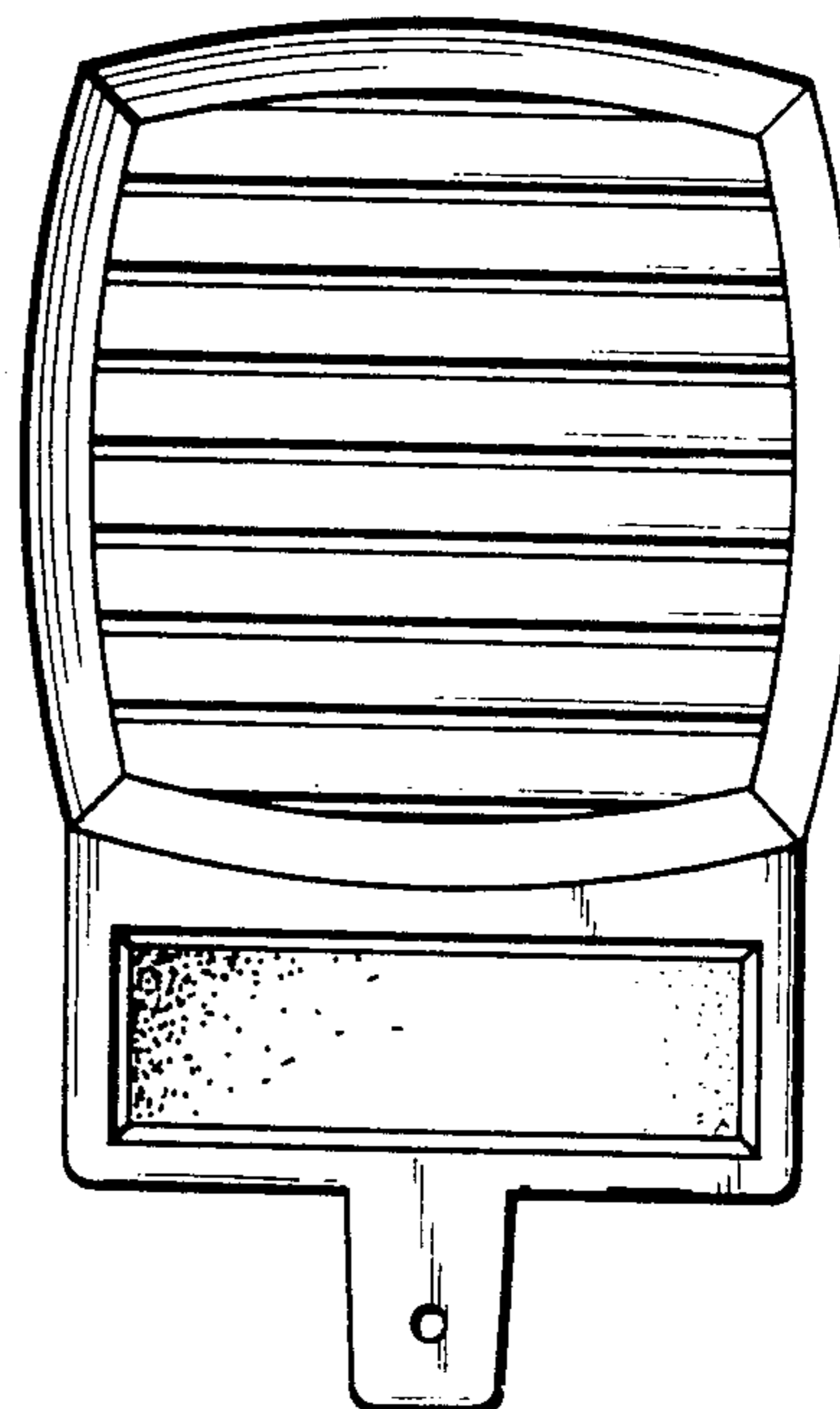
