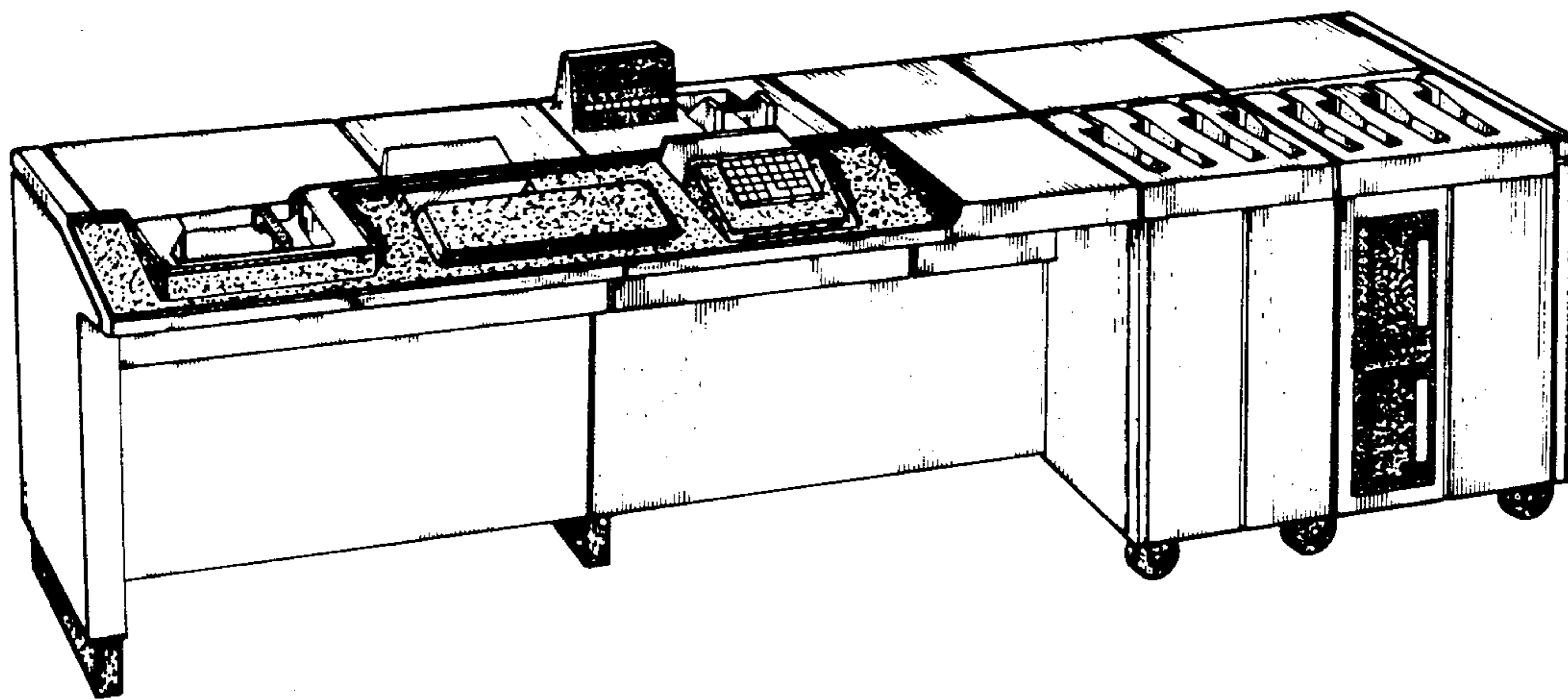

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a modular document processing encoder showing our new design; and FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof.



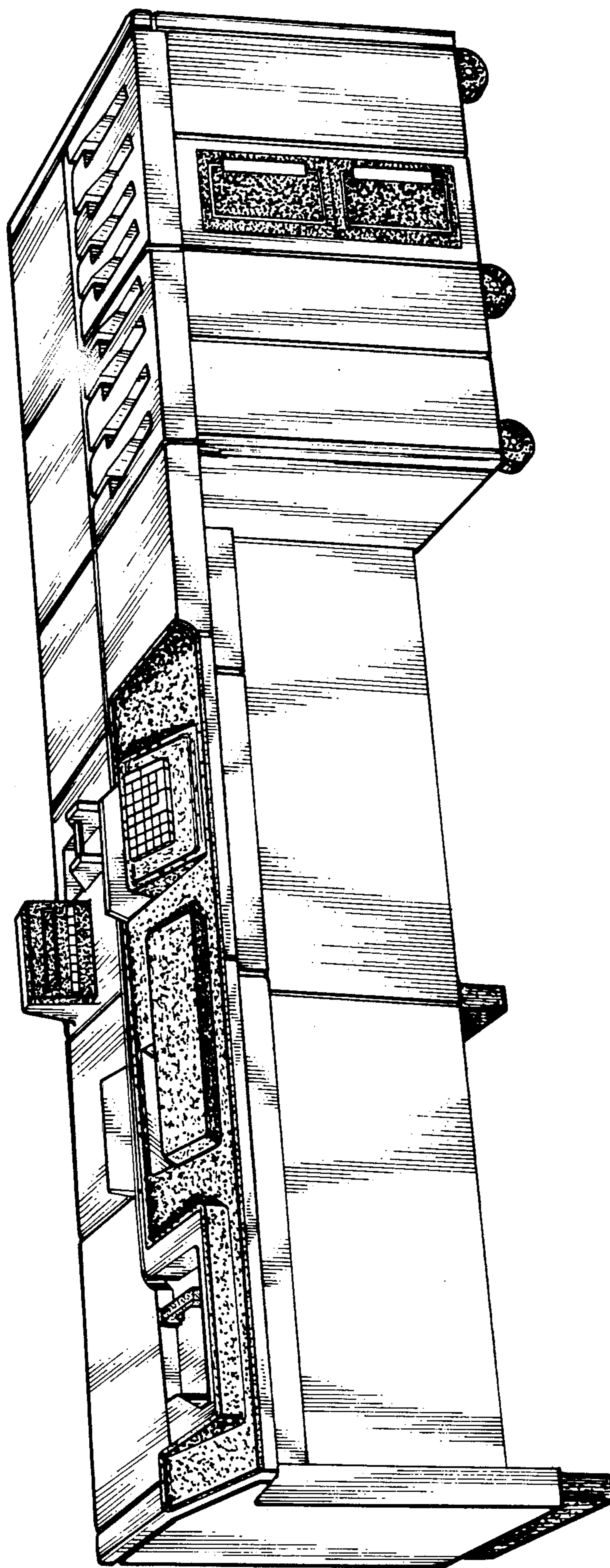

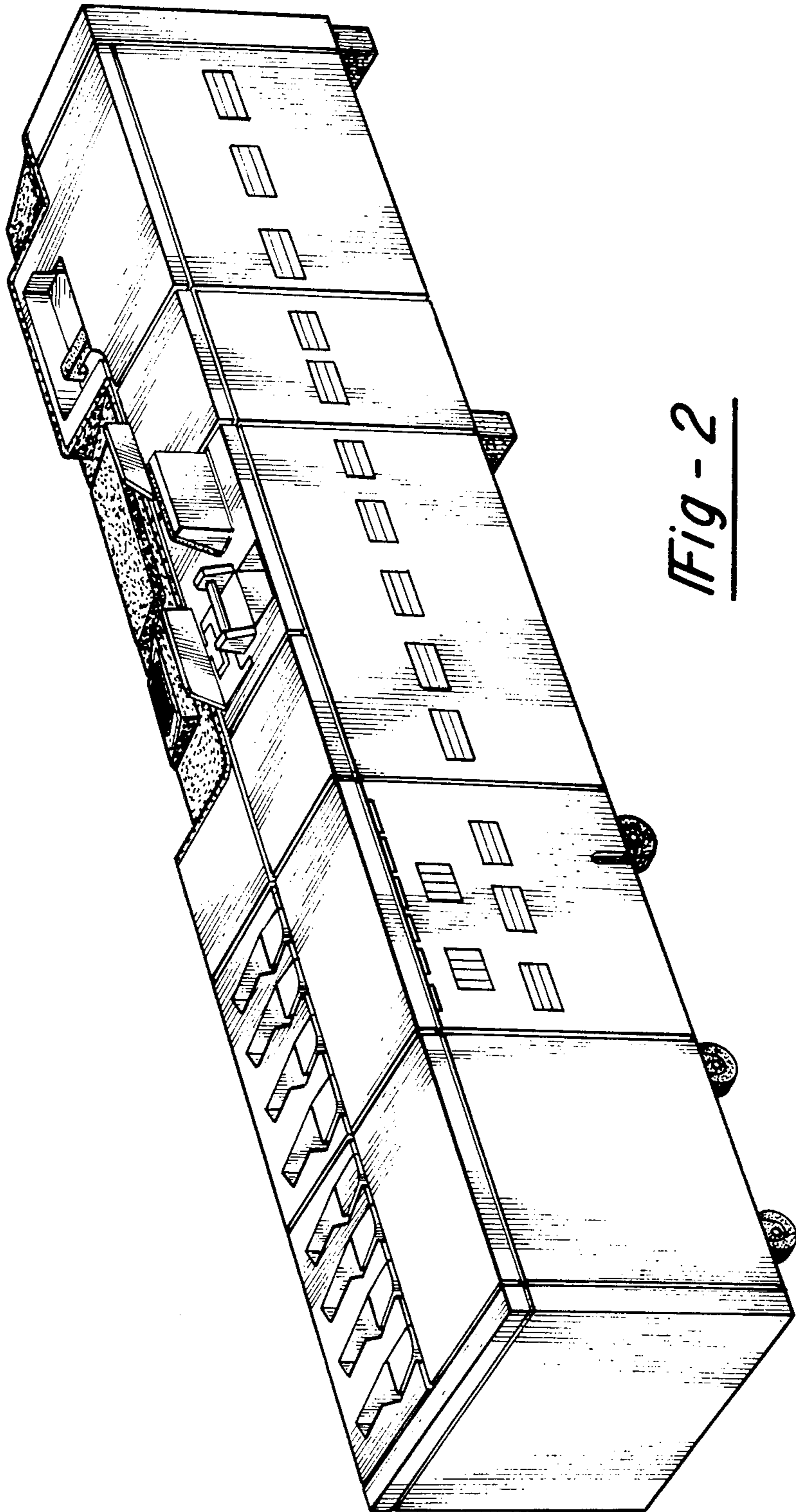
