FIG. 4 is a perspective view as seen from the side opposite FIG. 1.

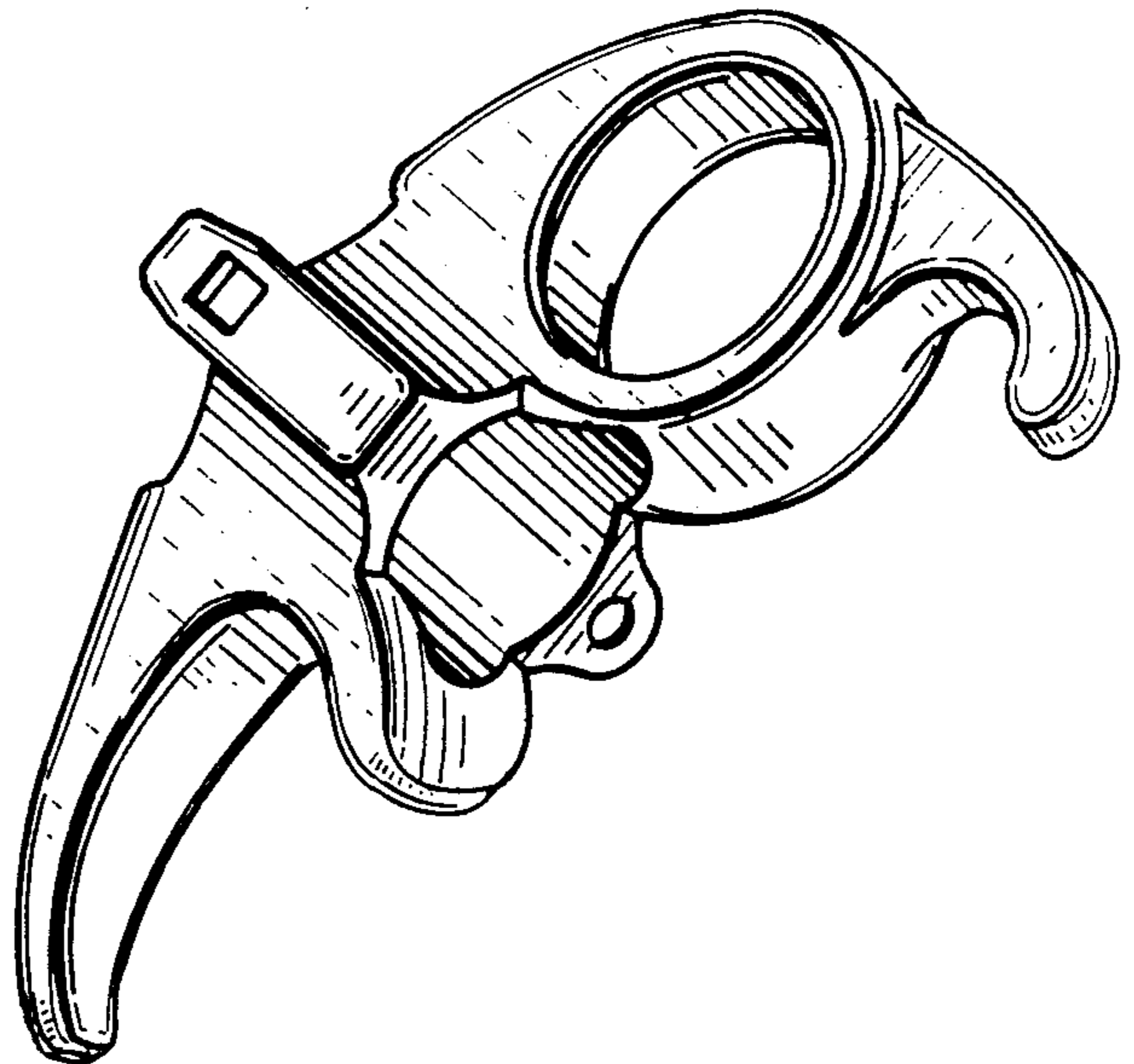
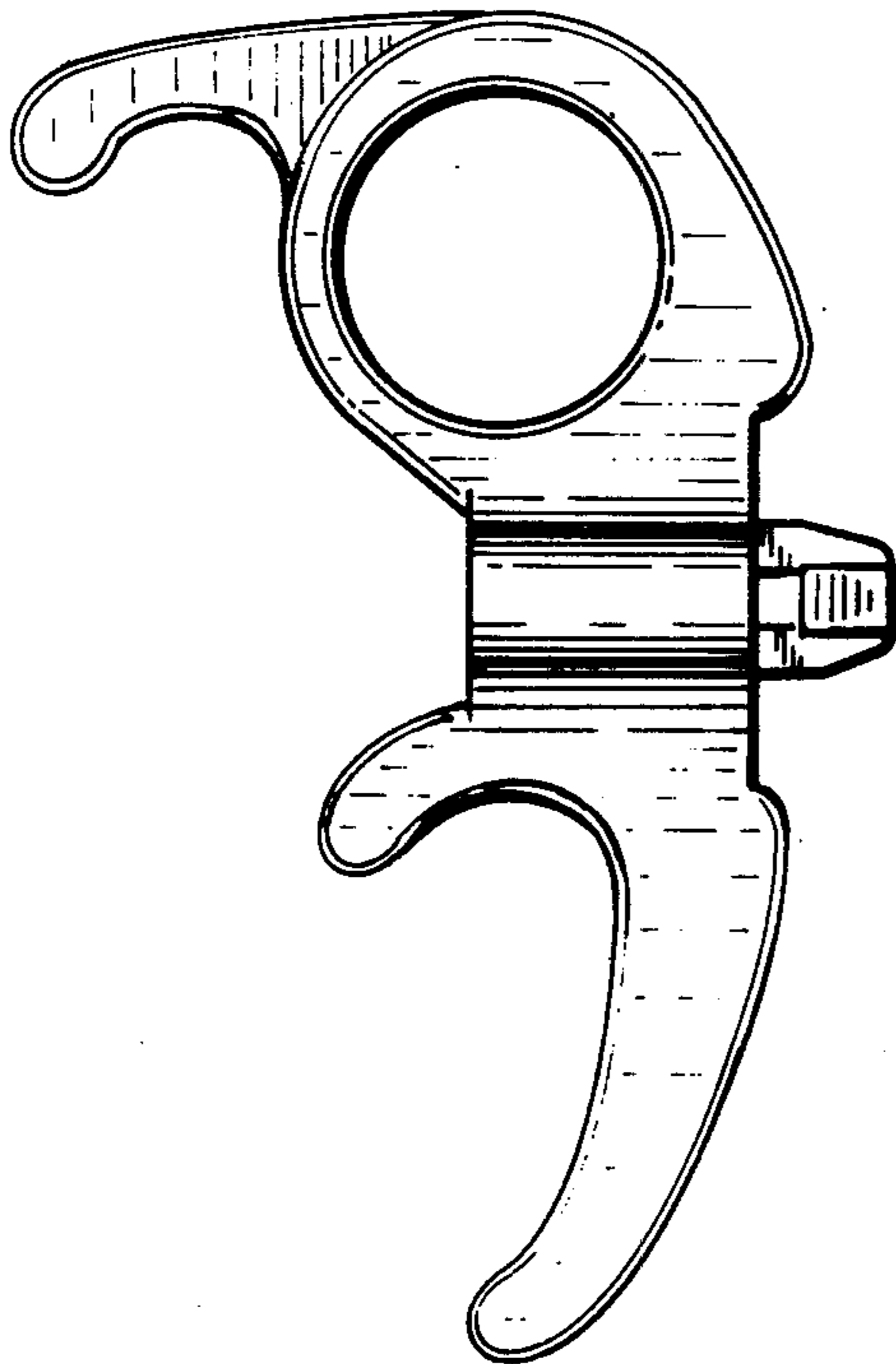

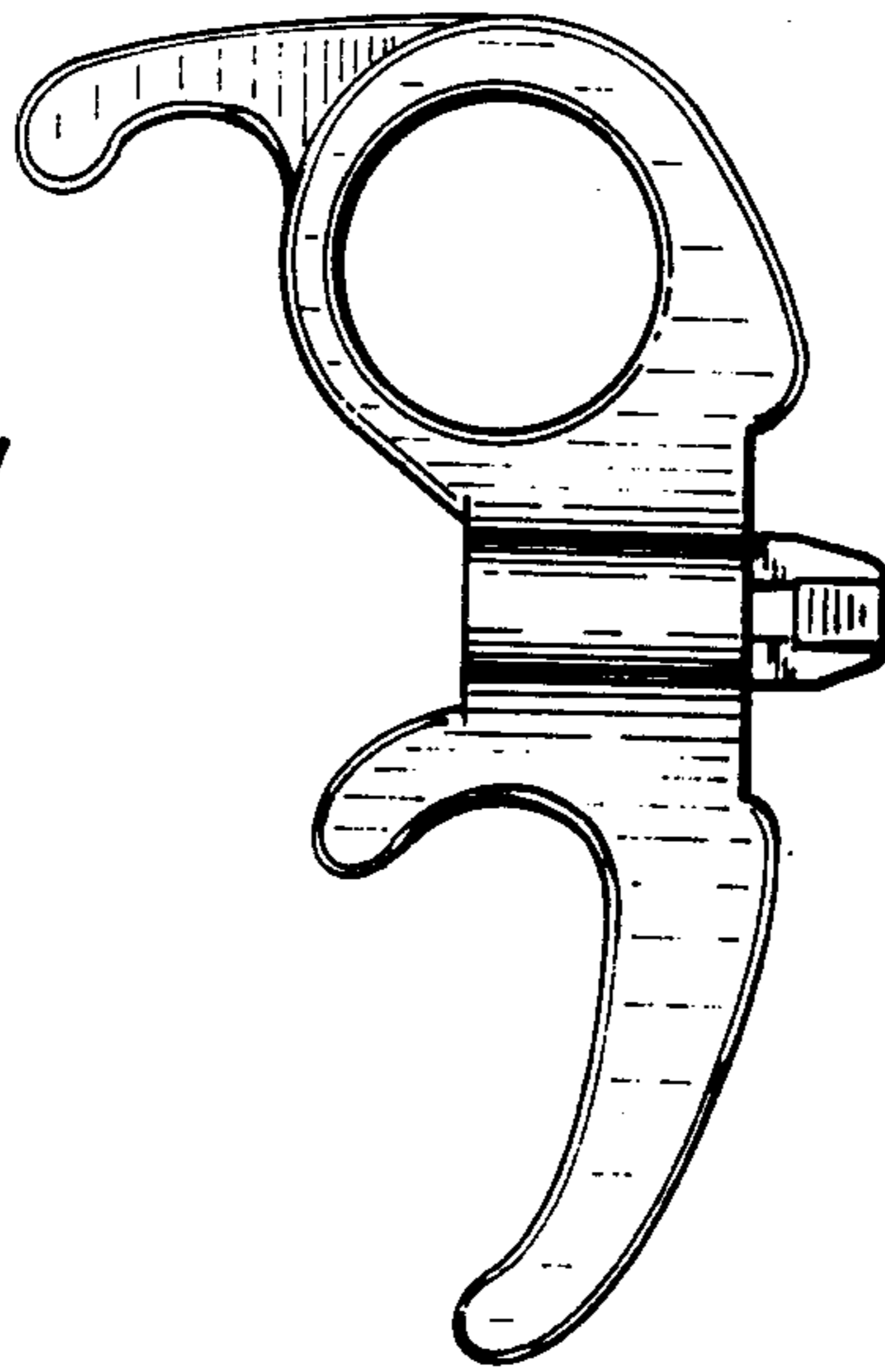

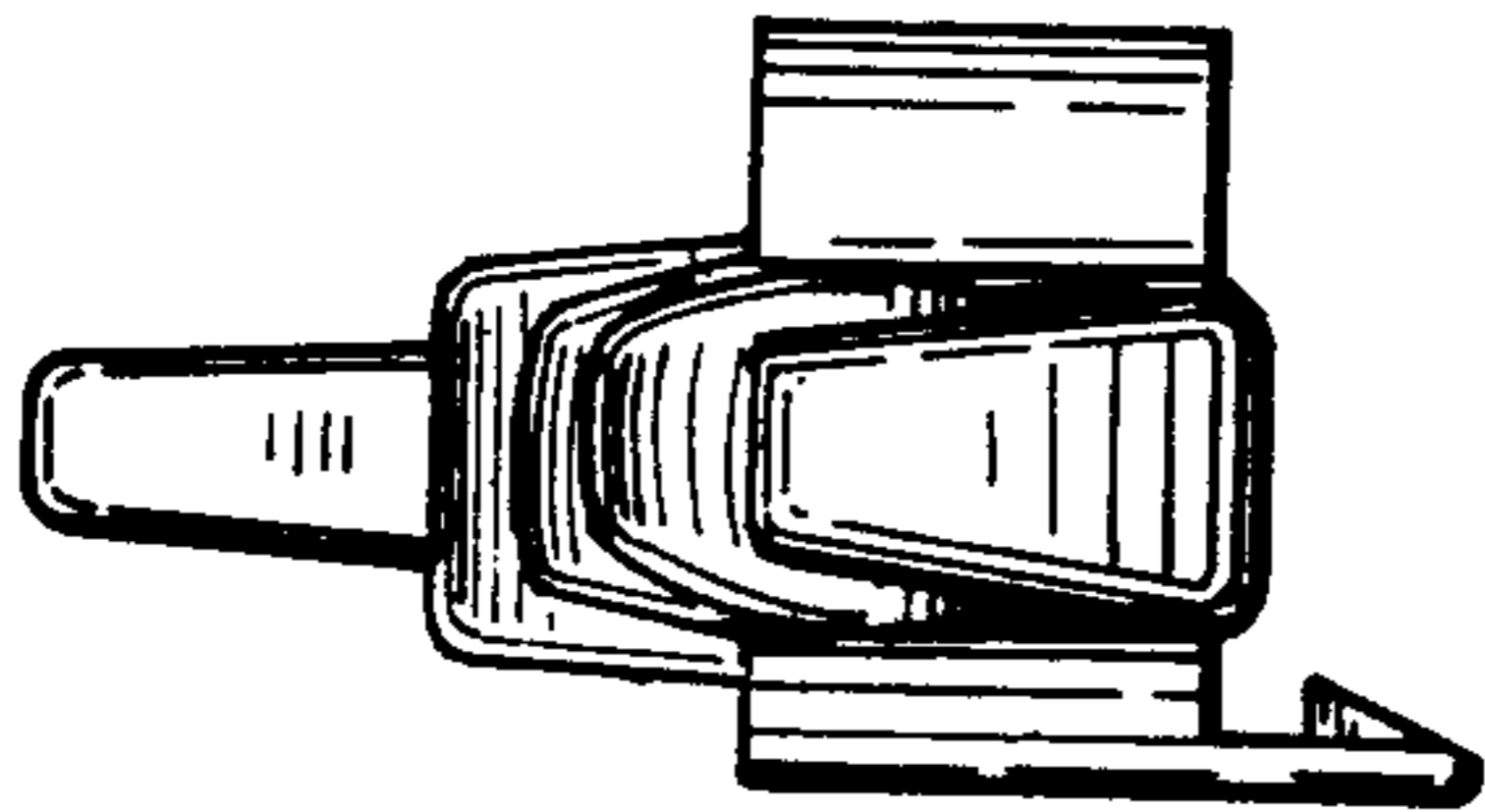

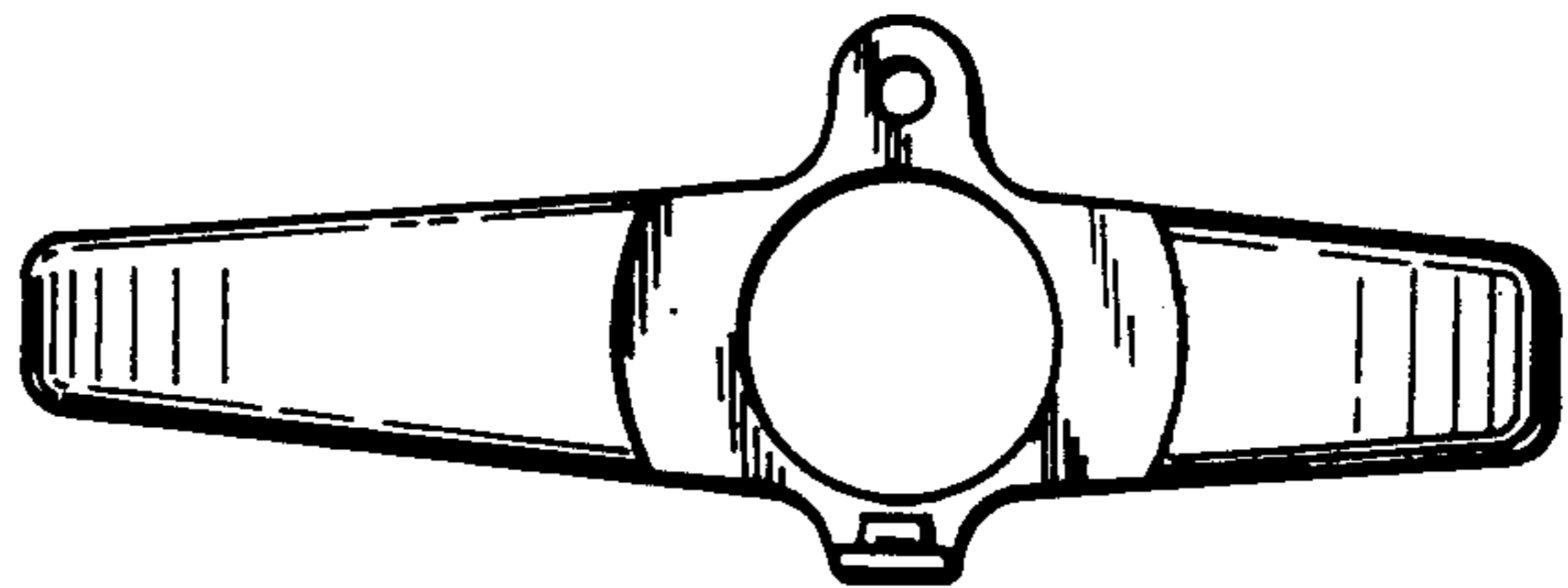
