DESCRIPTION

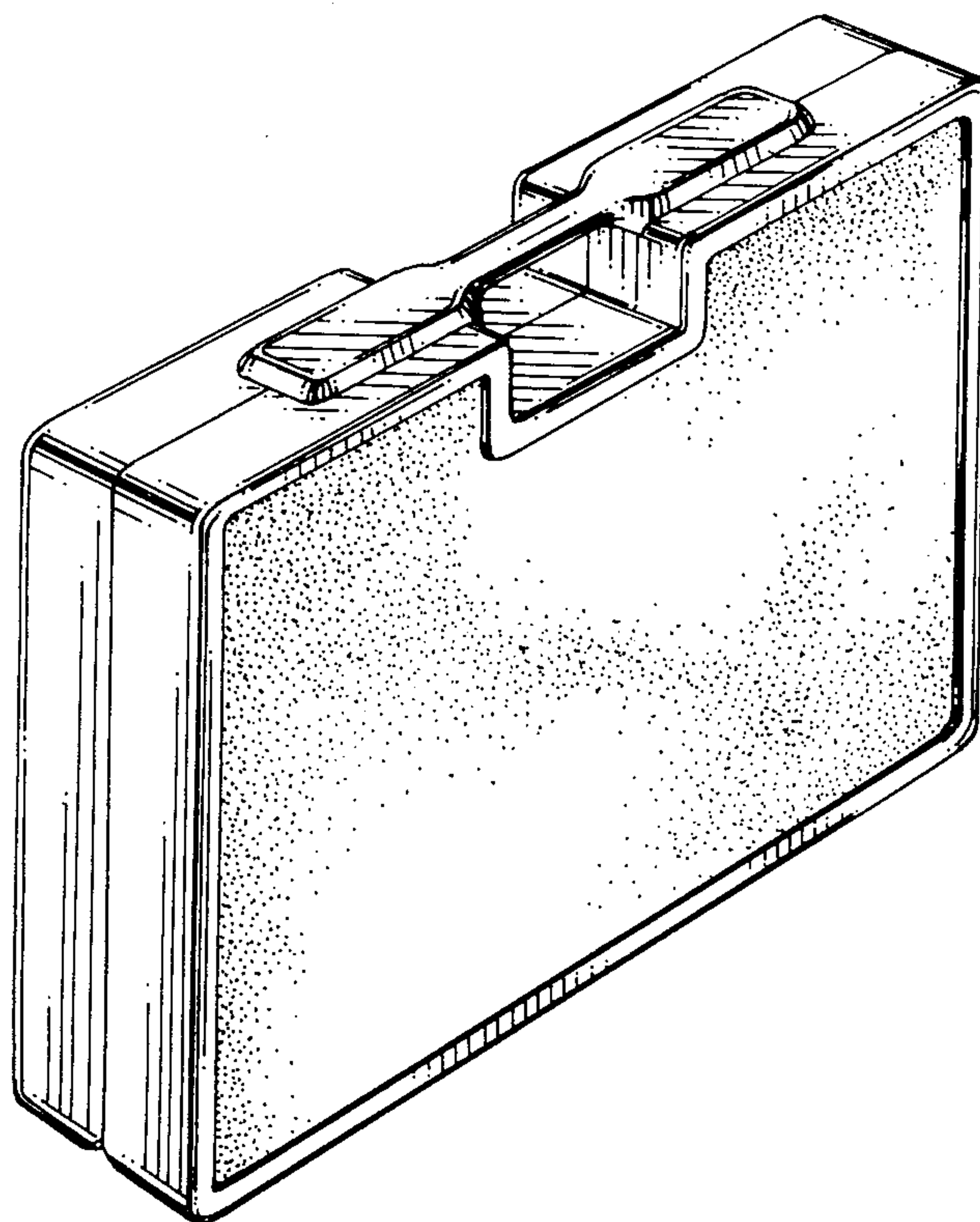
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a briefcase showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view.



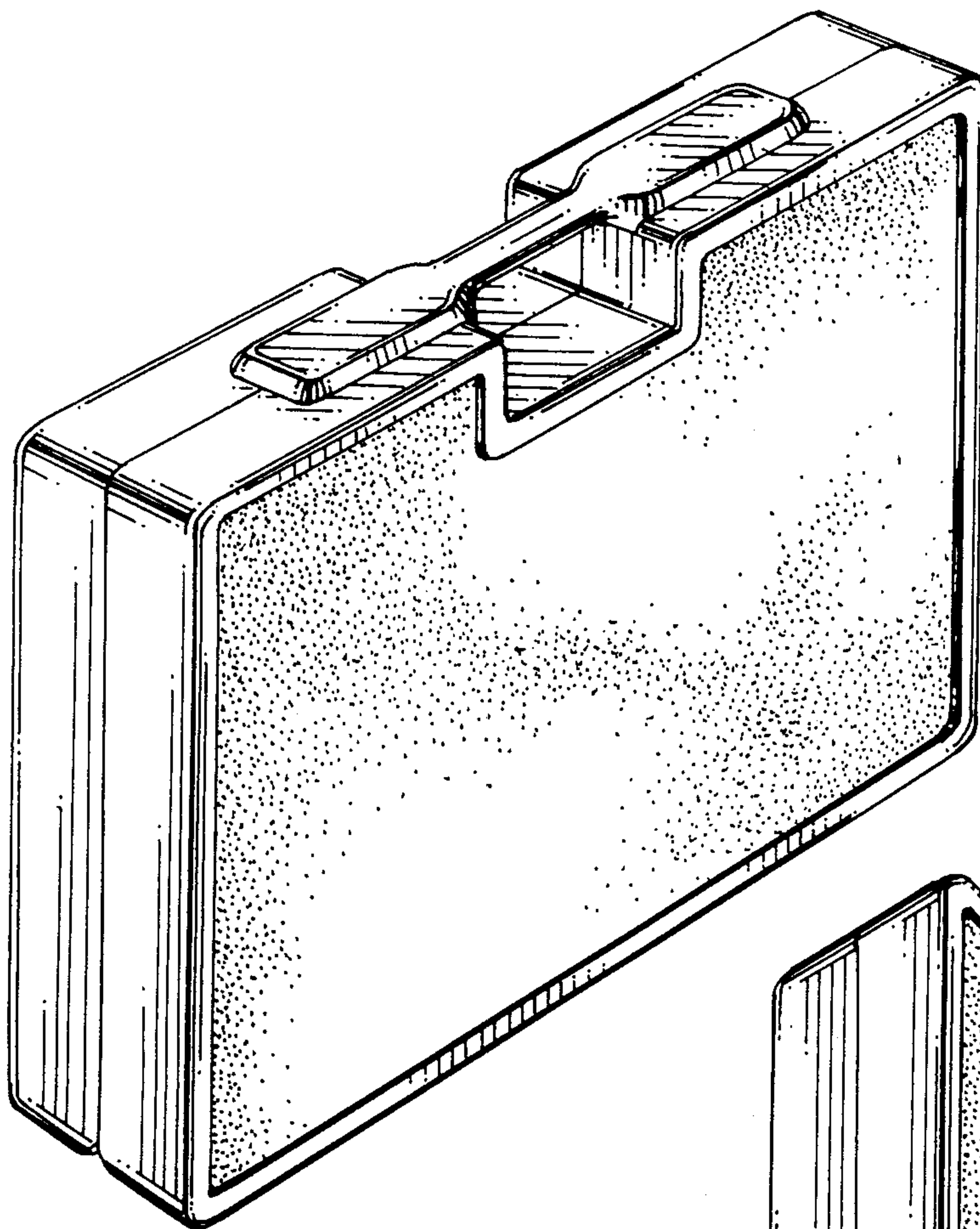

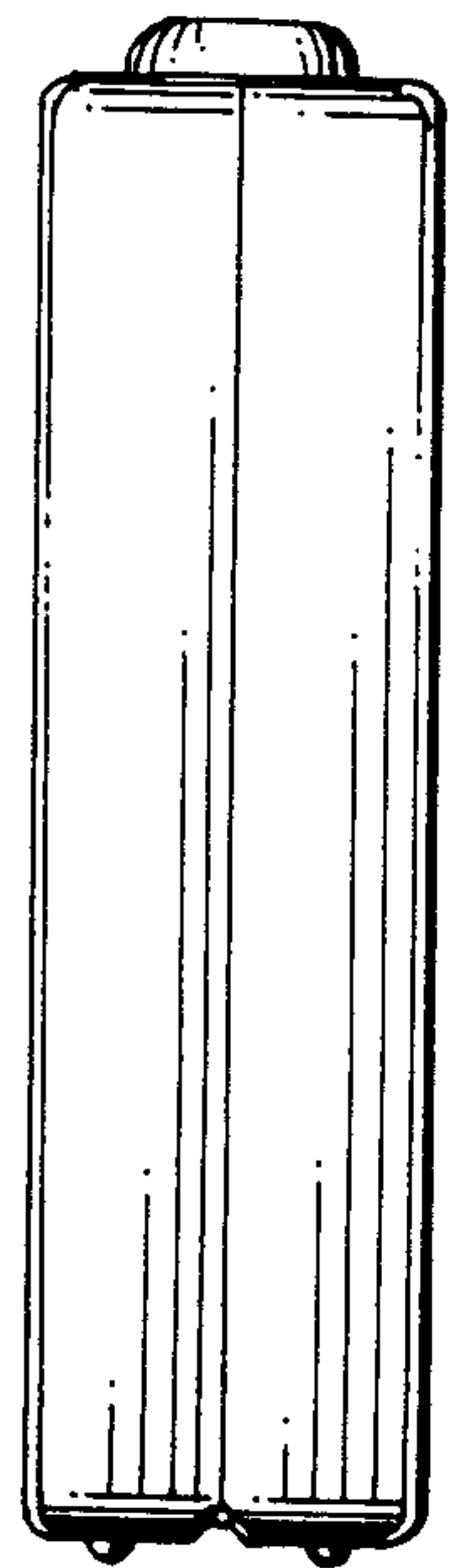

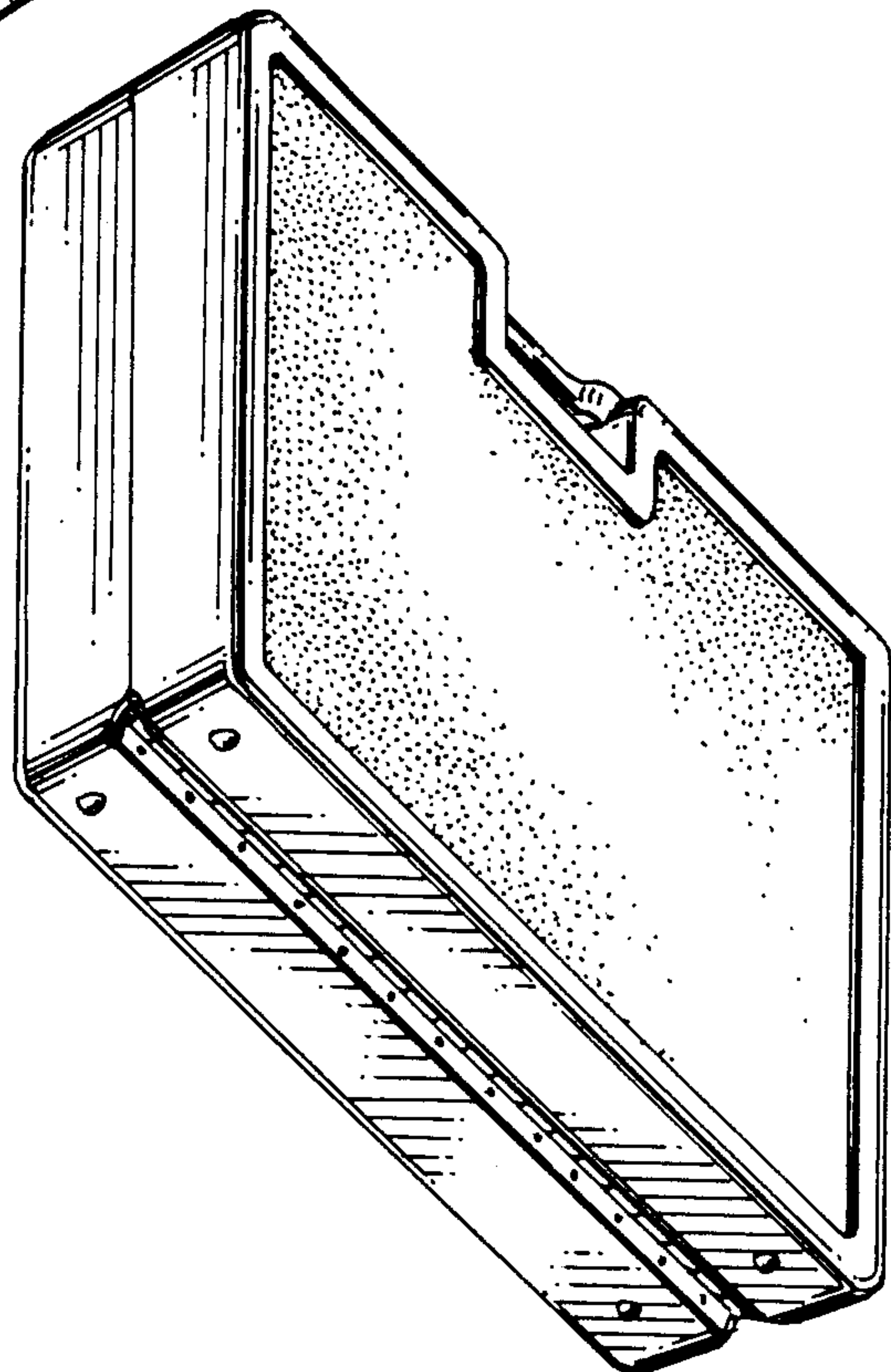

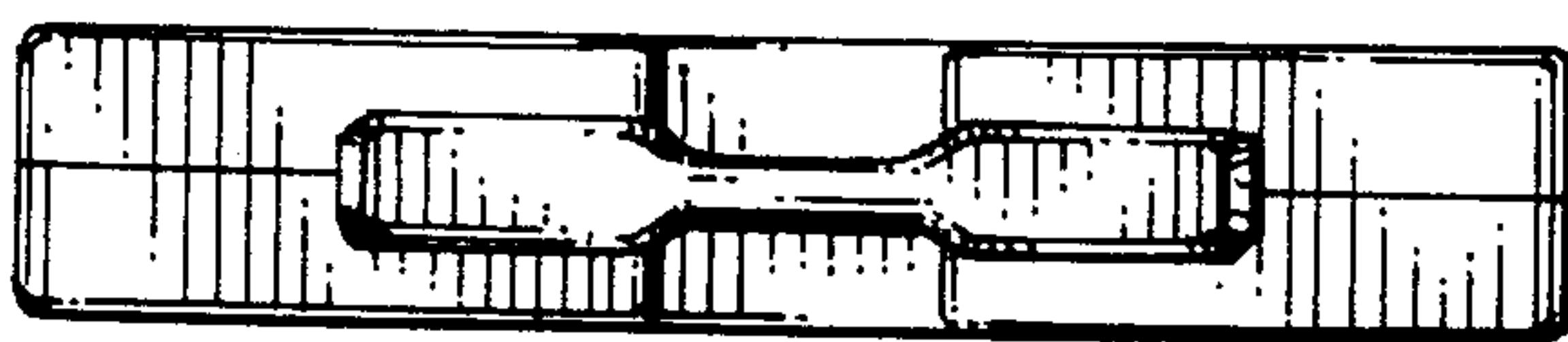

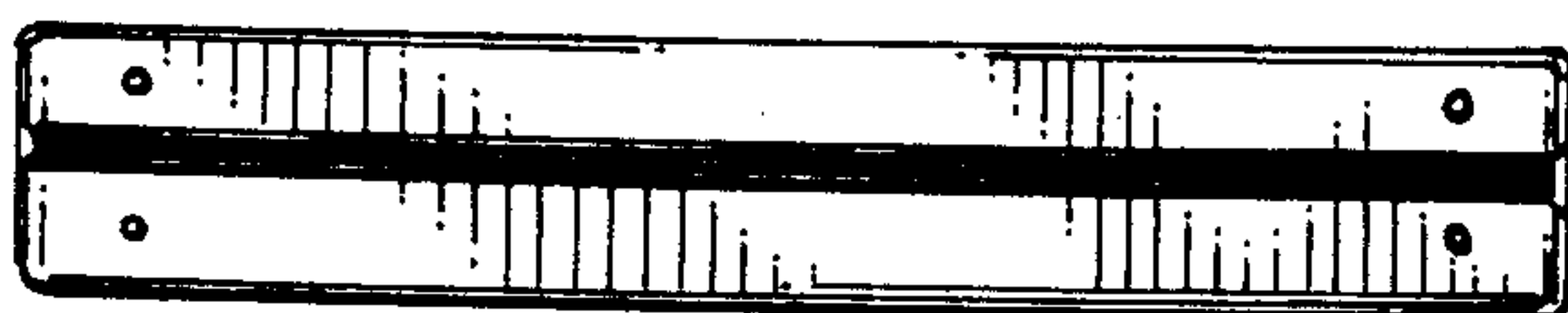
