#### **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a chair, as shown and described.

### **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of a chair showing my new design, the recessed areas are shaded for color contrast;

FIG. 2 is a side elevation view thereof, the undisclosed side being substantially identical to the side shown, the recessed area is shaded for color contrast;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view thereof, the recessed areas are shaded for color contrast;

FIG. 4 is a top view thereof, the recessed areas are shaded for color contrast;

FIG. 5 is a cross-section taken on line 5—5 of FIG. 1, the recessed areas are shaded for color contrast;

FIG. 6 is a cross-section taken on line 6—6 of FIG. 2, the recessed areas are shaded for color contrast;


FIG. 7 is a cross-section taken on line 7—7 of FIG. 3;


FIG. 8 is a second embodiment of FIG. 3;


FIG. 9 is a second embodiment of FIG. 2;


FIG. 10 is a third embodiment of FIG. 3;


