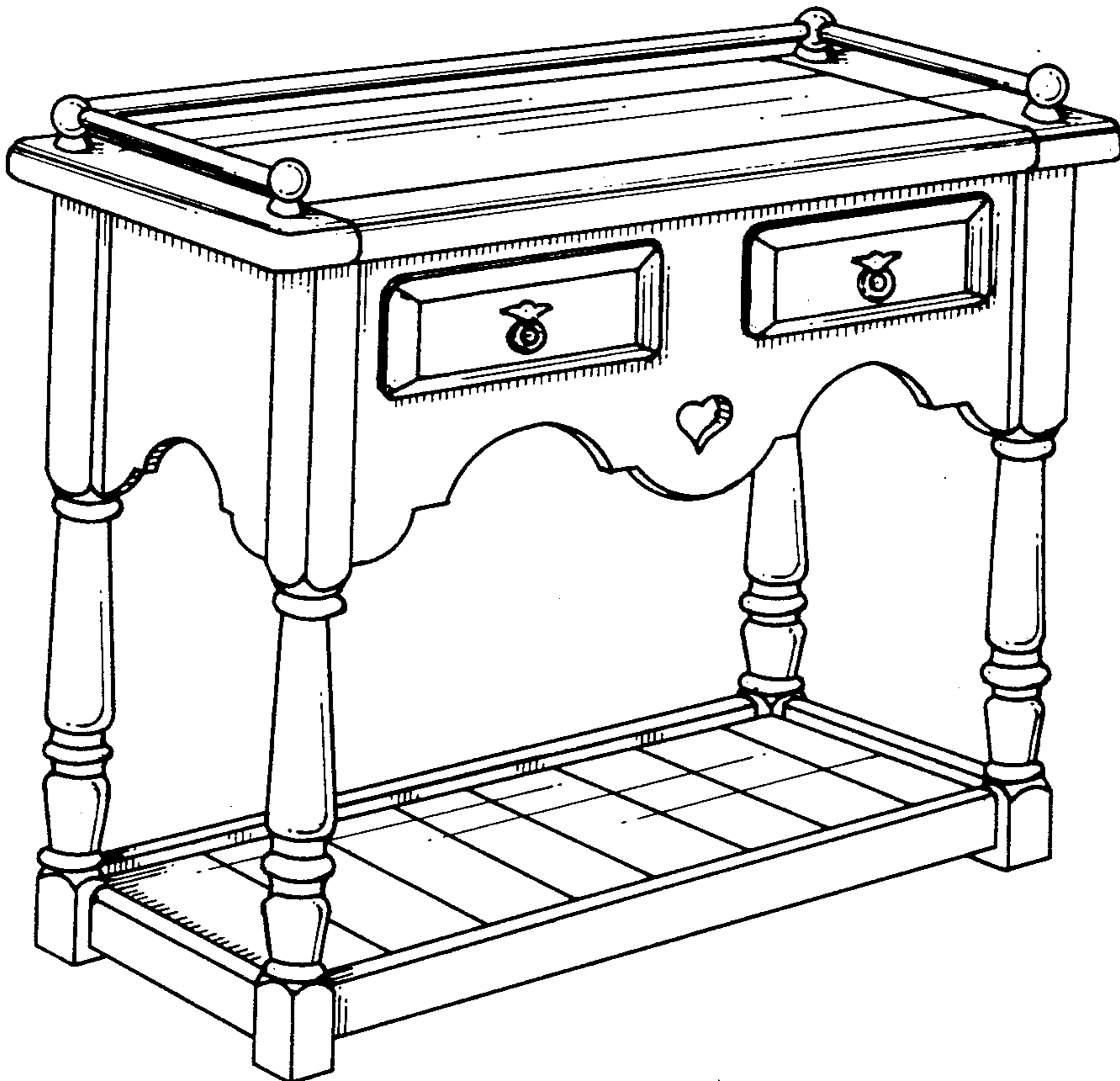
CLAIM
