DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a pendant showing
my new design; and
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view.
The left side of the pendant is a mirror image of the
right side, shown in FIG. 2. The back, bottom, and top
sides of the pendant are plain.

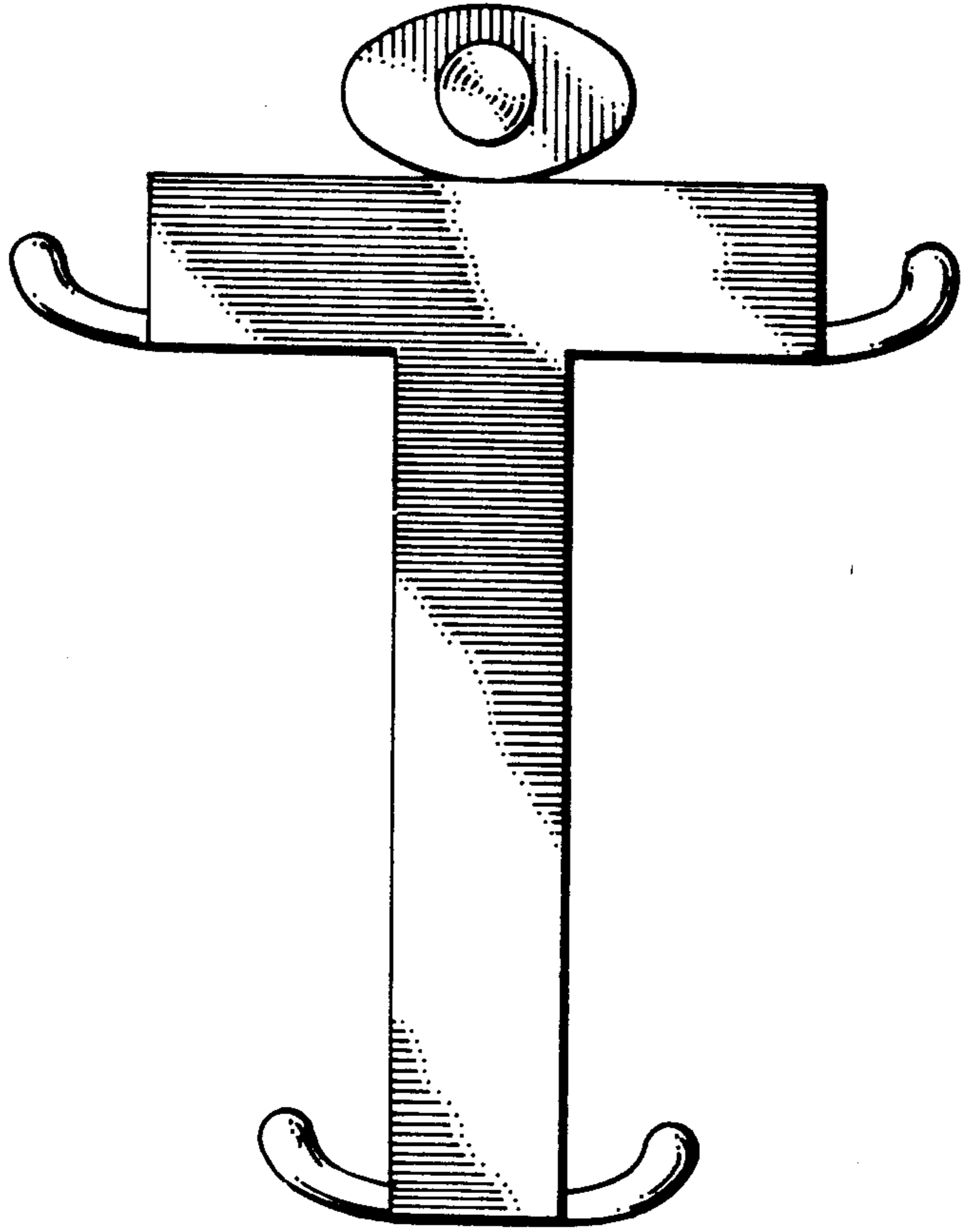

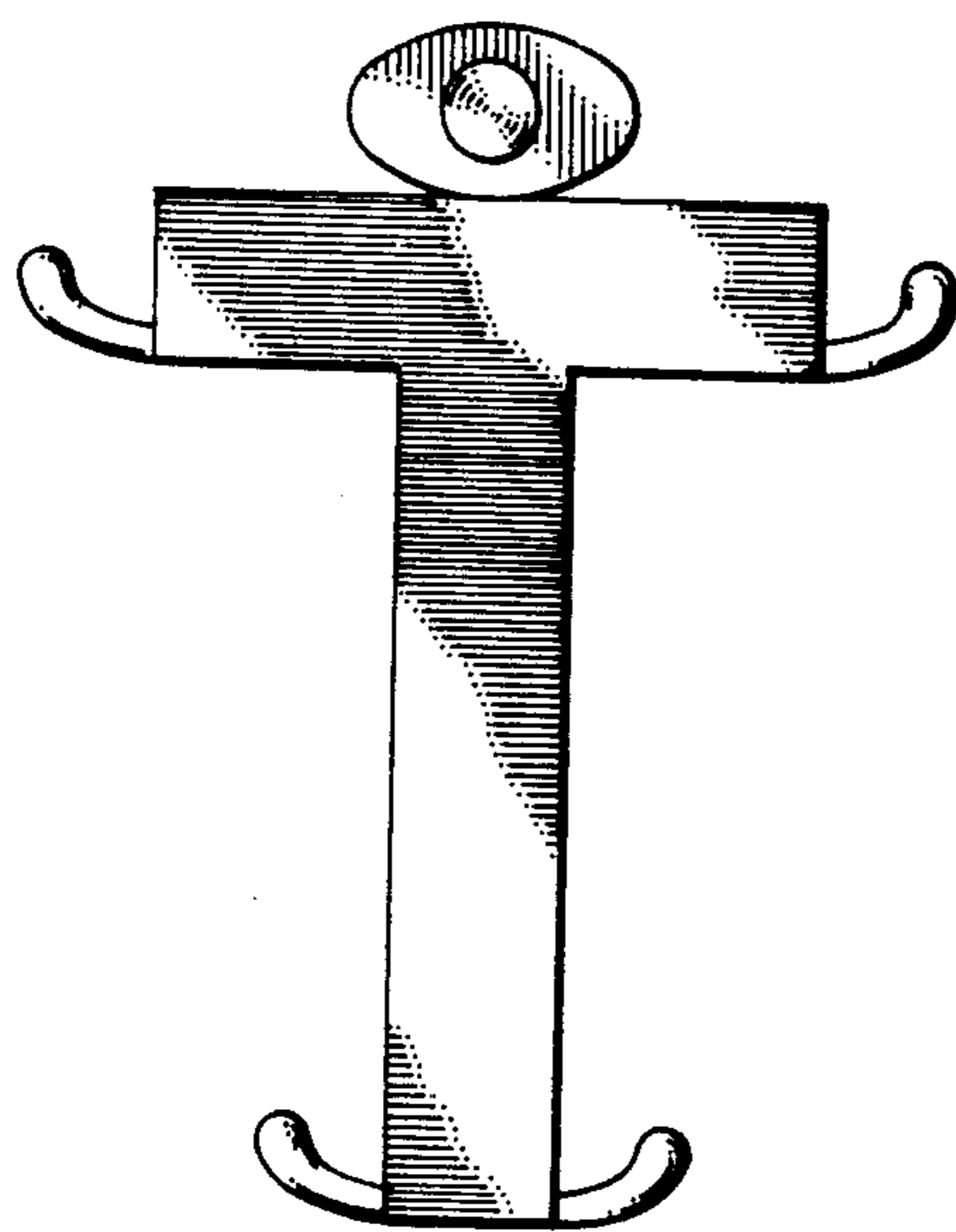
