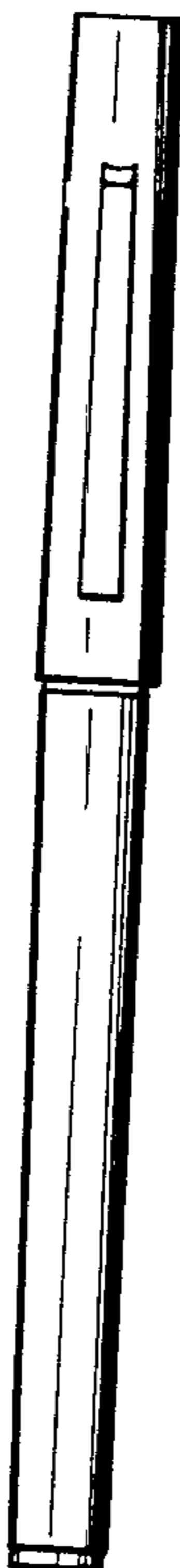

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a writing instrument, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right side elevational view of a writing instrument showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view; FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view; FIG. 5 is a top plan view; and FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view of the writing instrument with the cap deposed on the end remote from the writing point.
