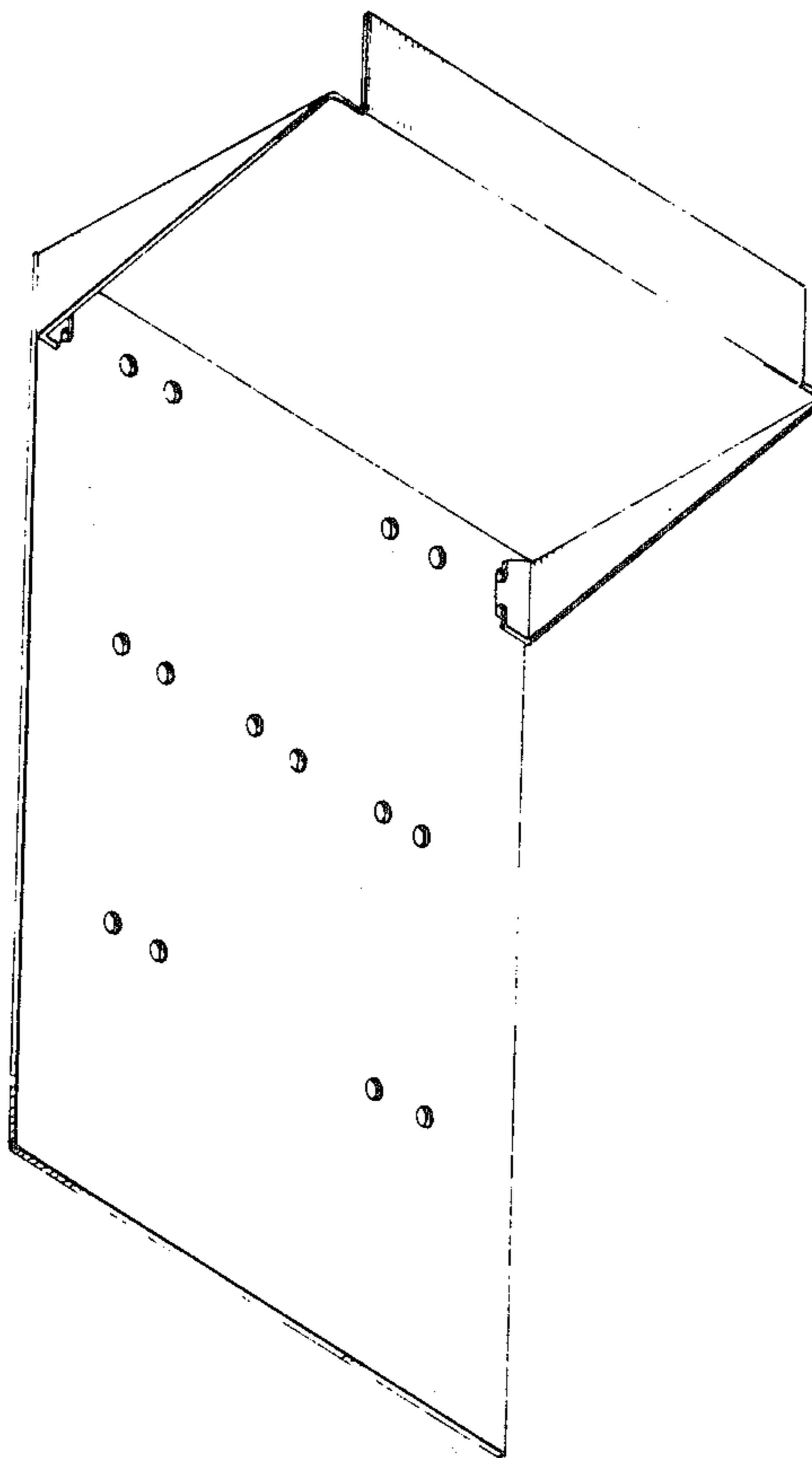

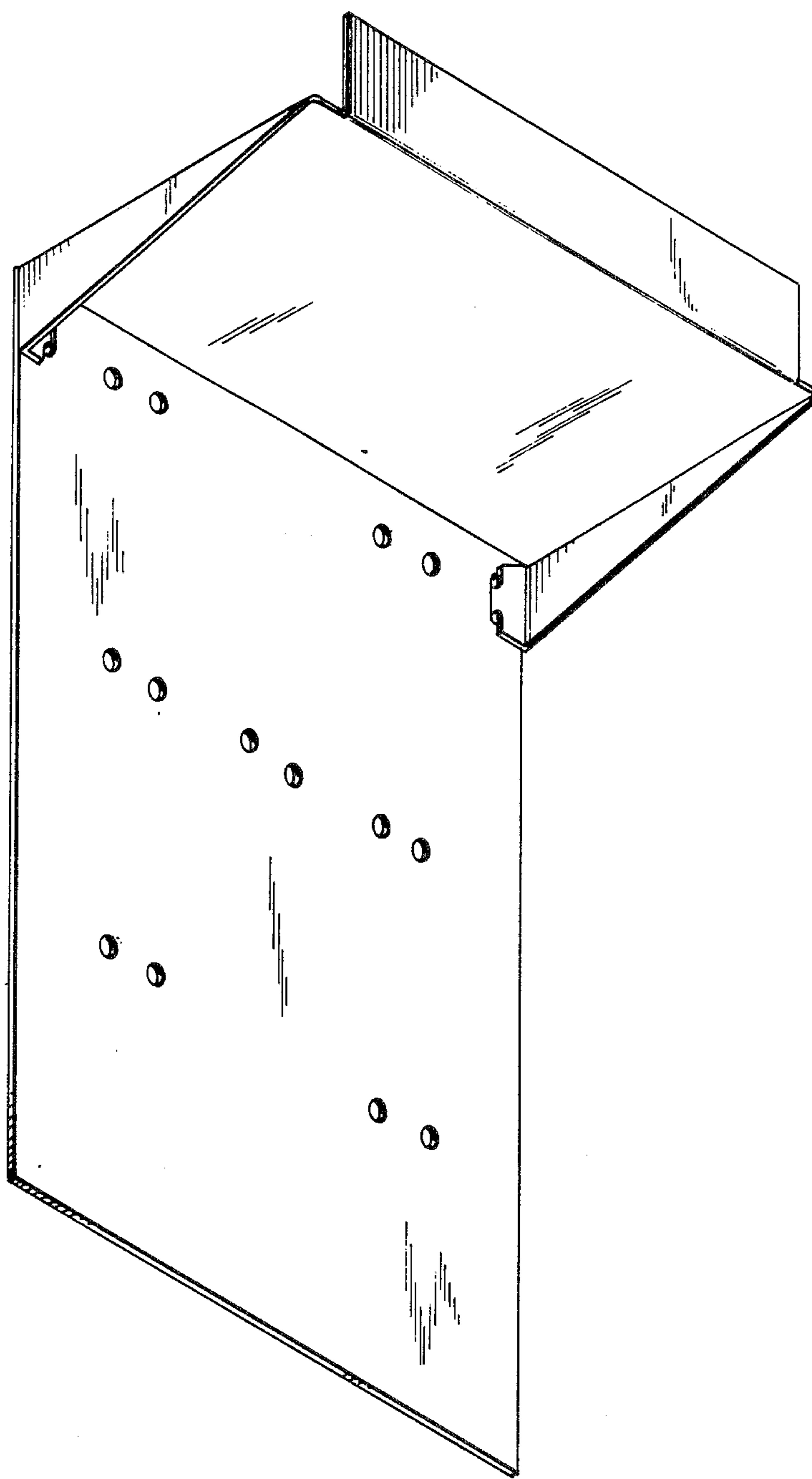
The ornamental design for a sign holder for use with perforated display board, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

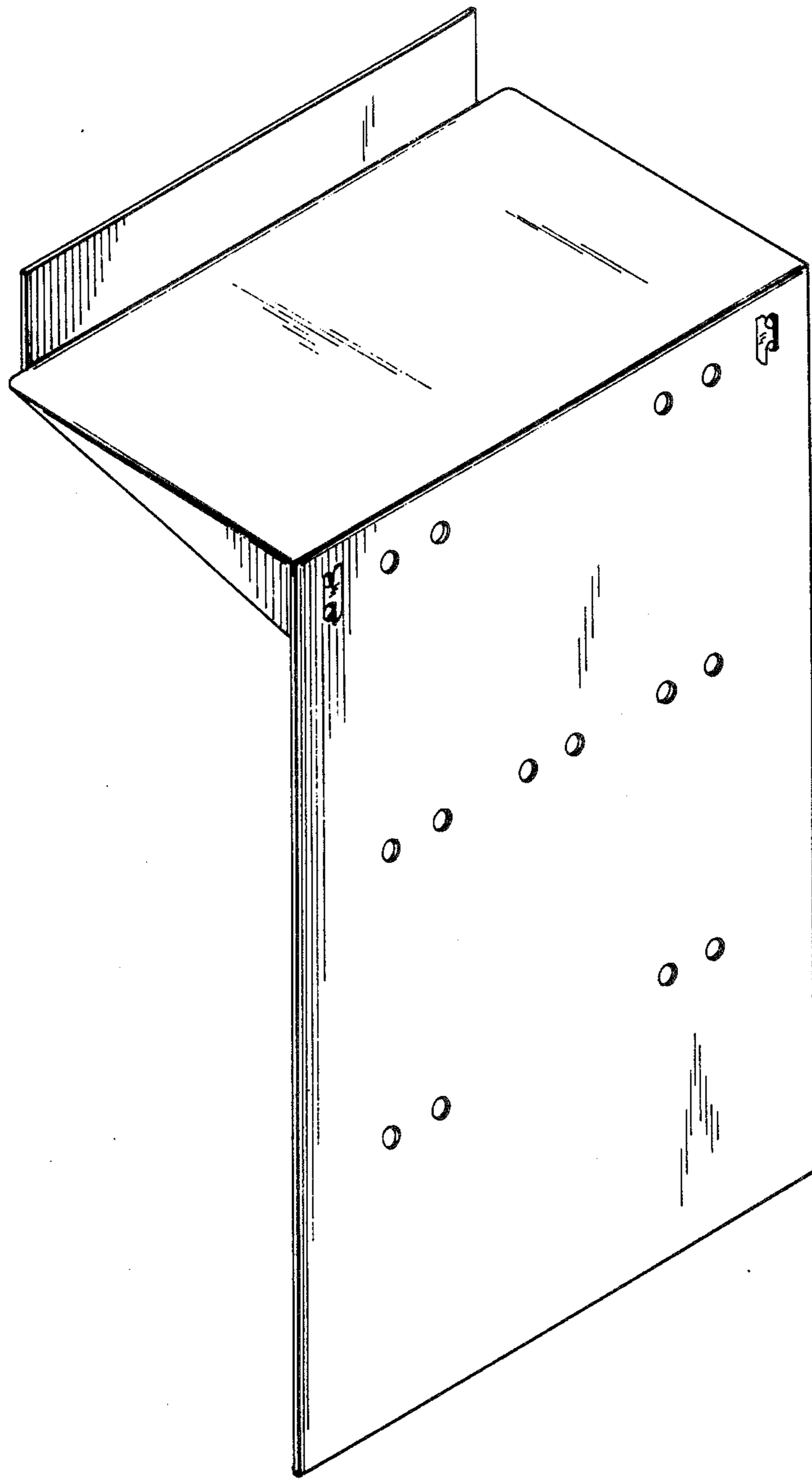
FIG. 1 is a front bottom perspective view of a sign holder for use with perforated display board showing my new design;
