DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a shoe showing my new design, the opposite side being a mirror image thereto;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom being plain and unornamented;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof.

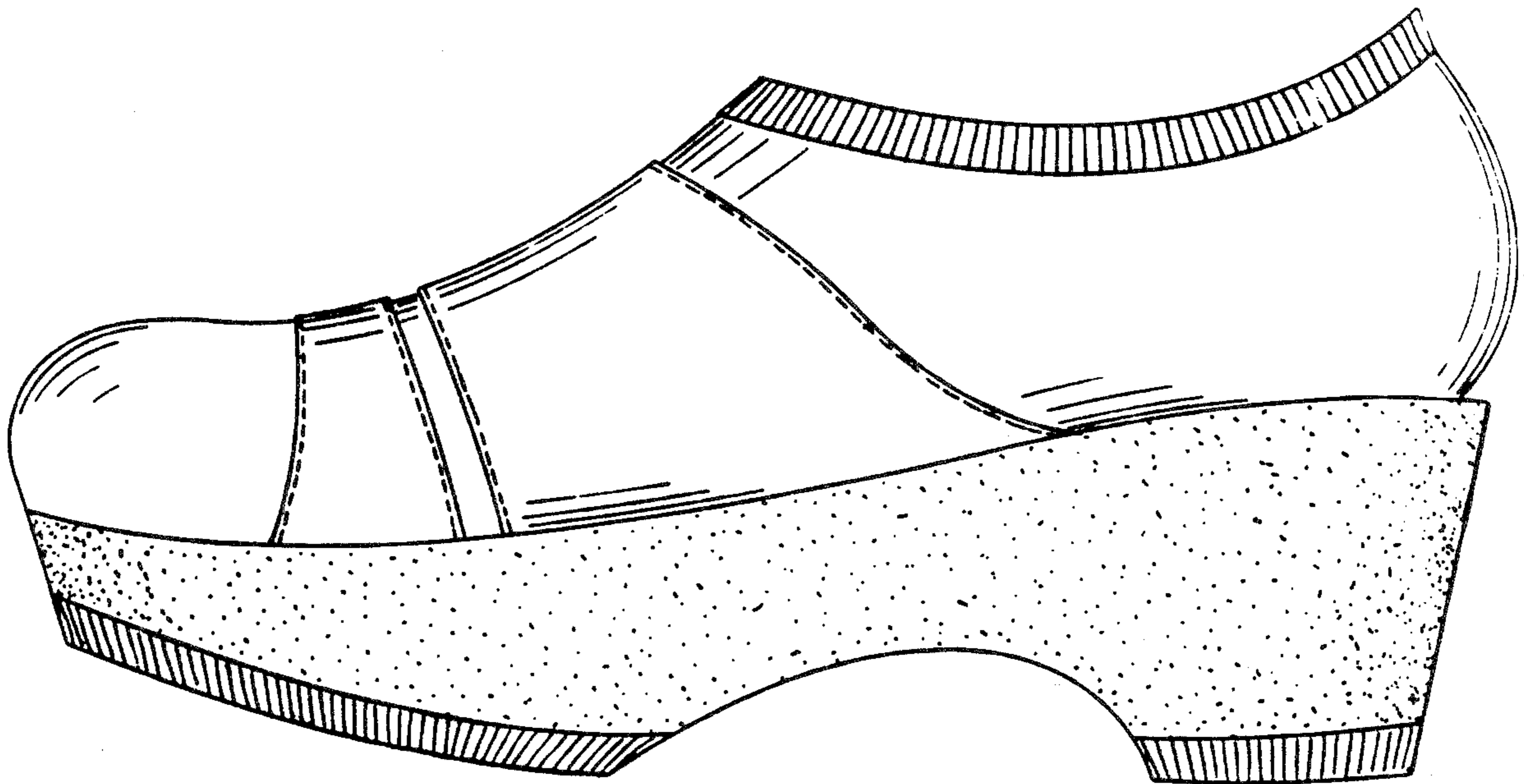

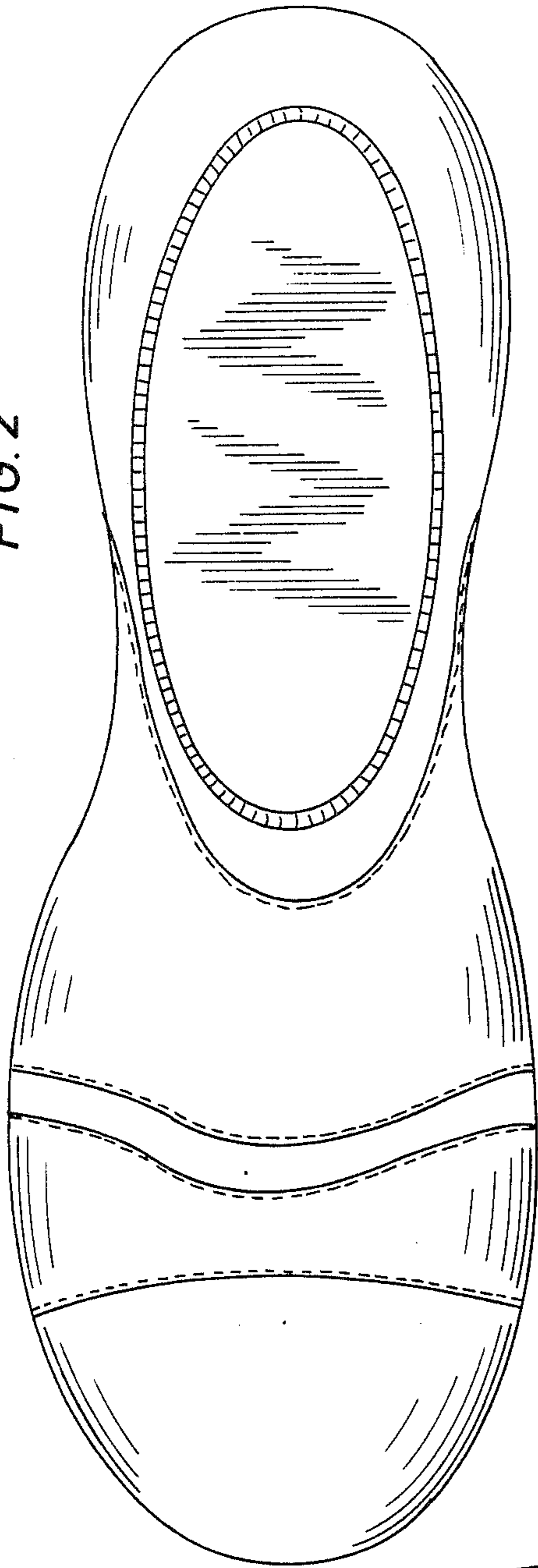

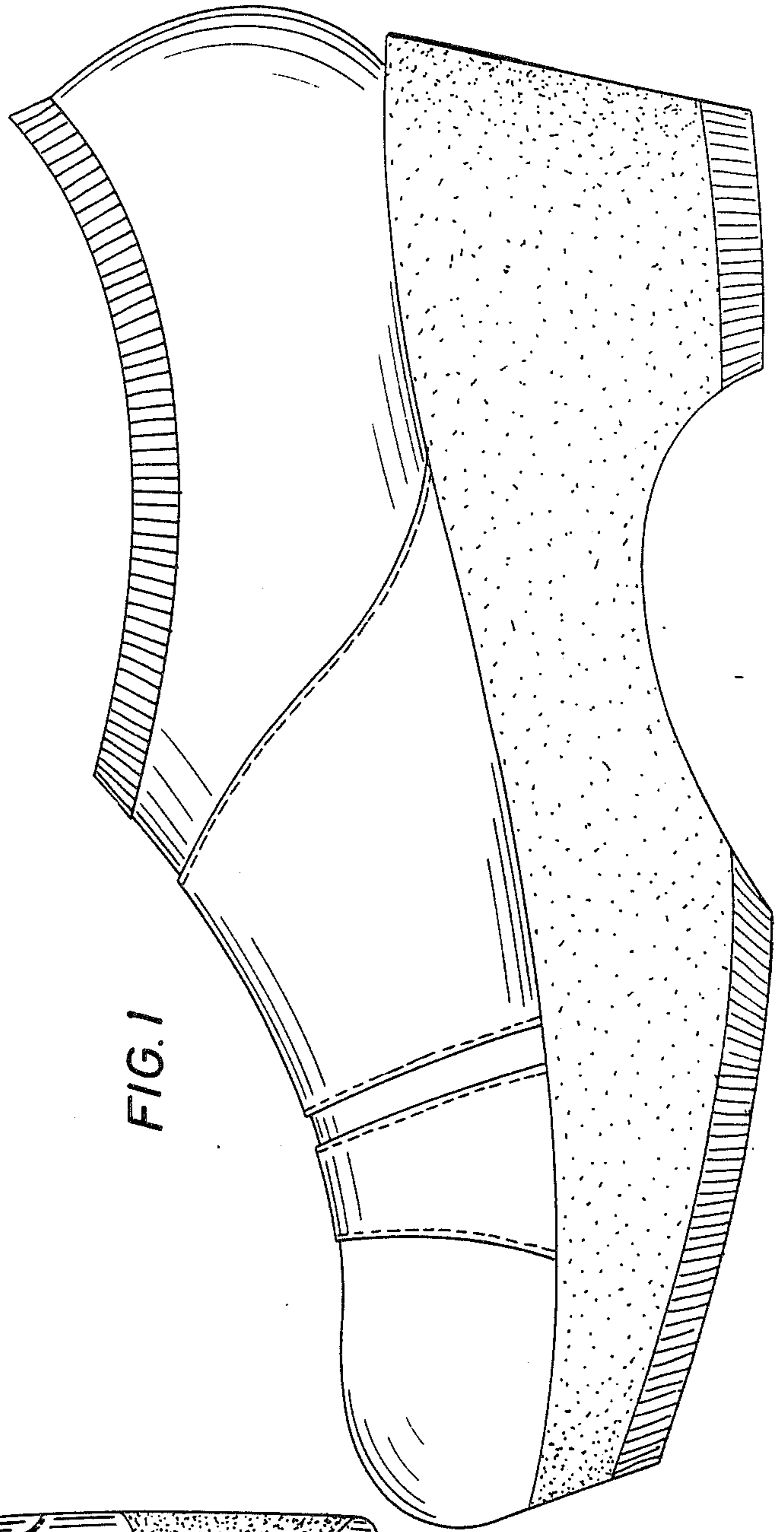
