DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a pedestal showing our design,
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view,

FIG. 5 is a side elevation looking in the direction of arrow 5 of FIG. 3.

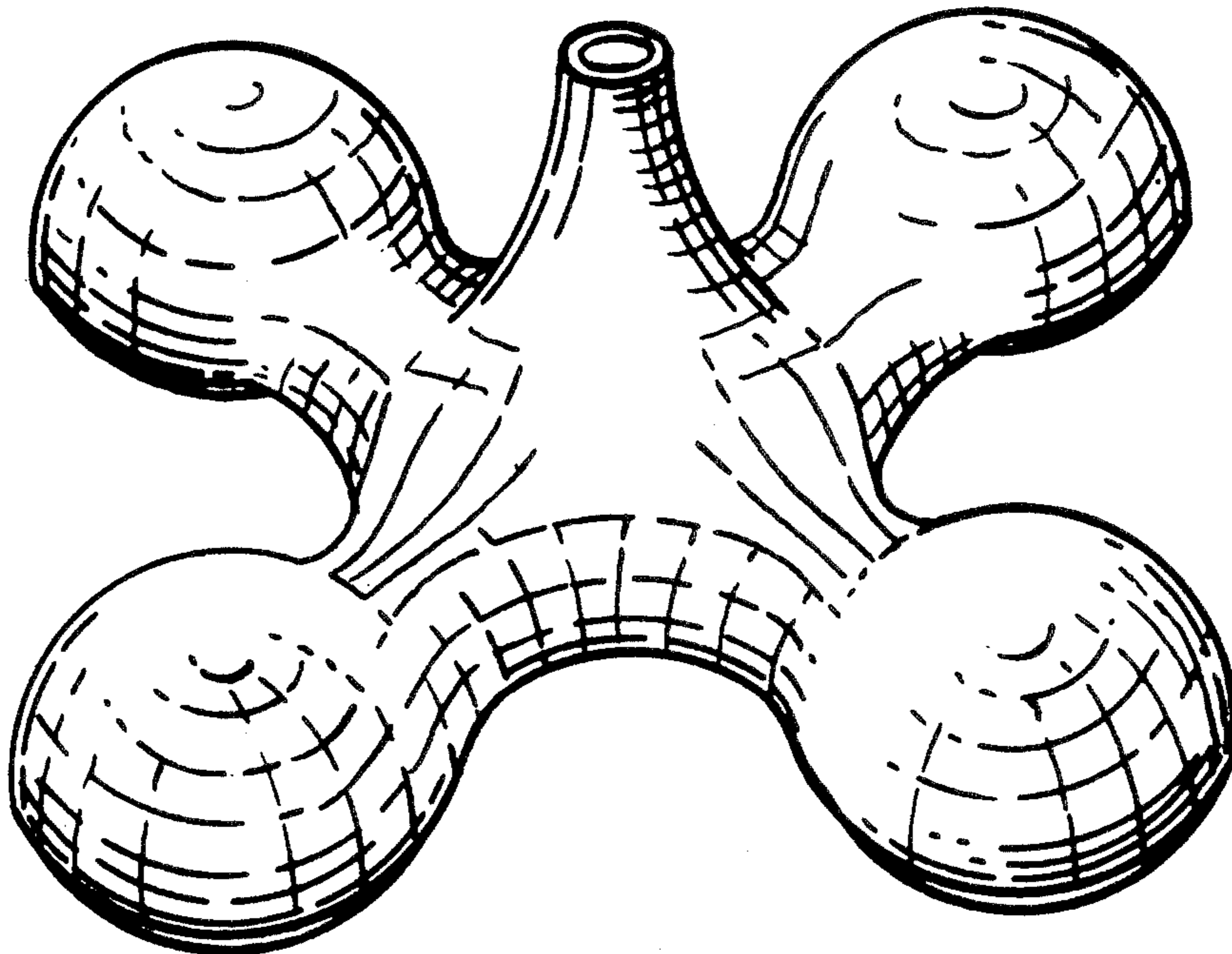

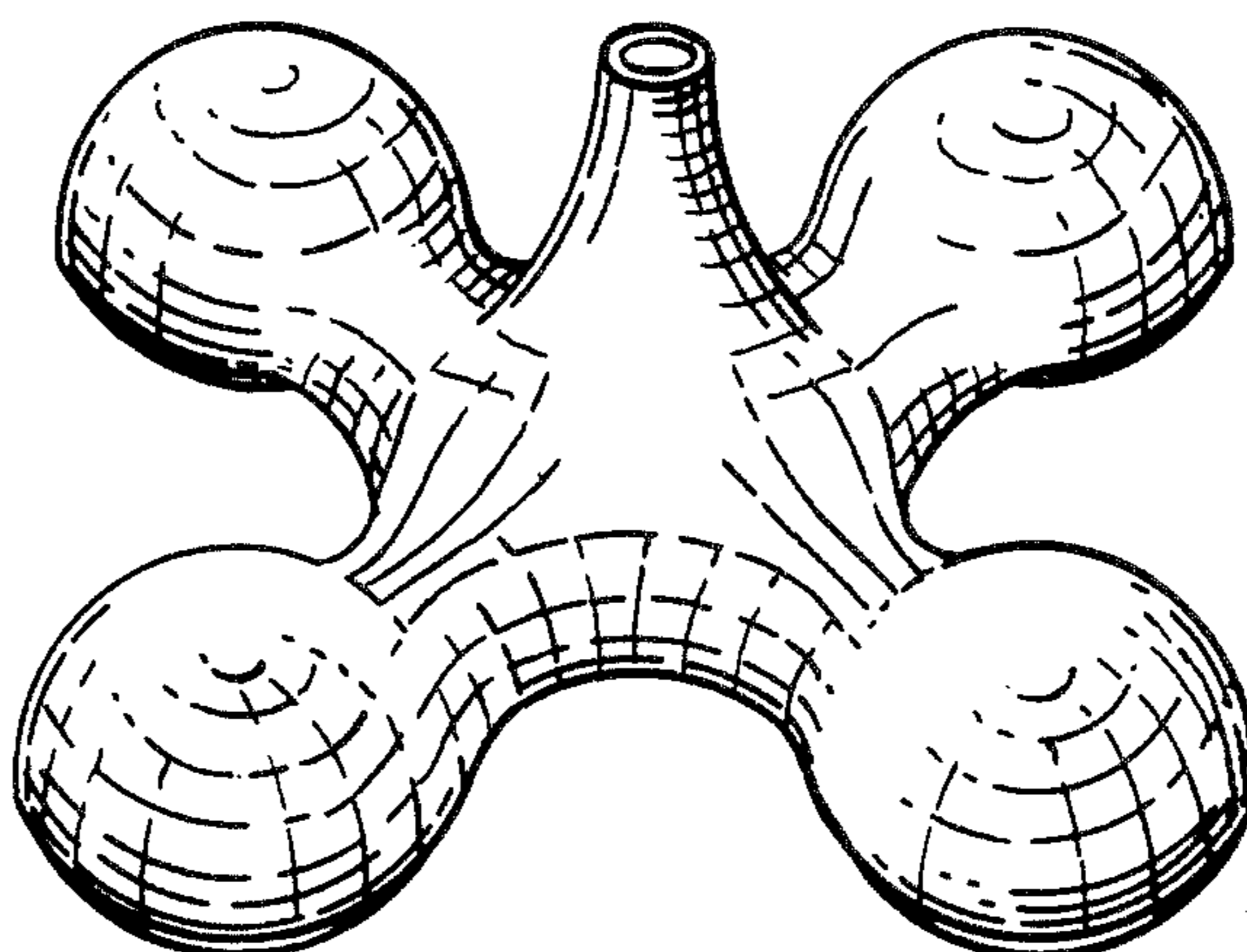

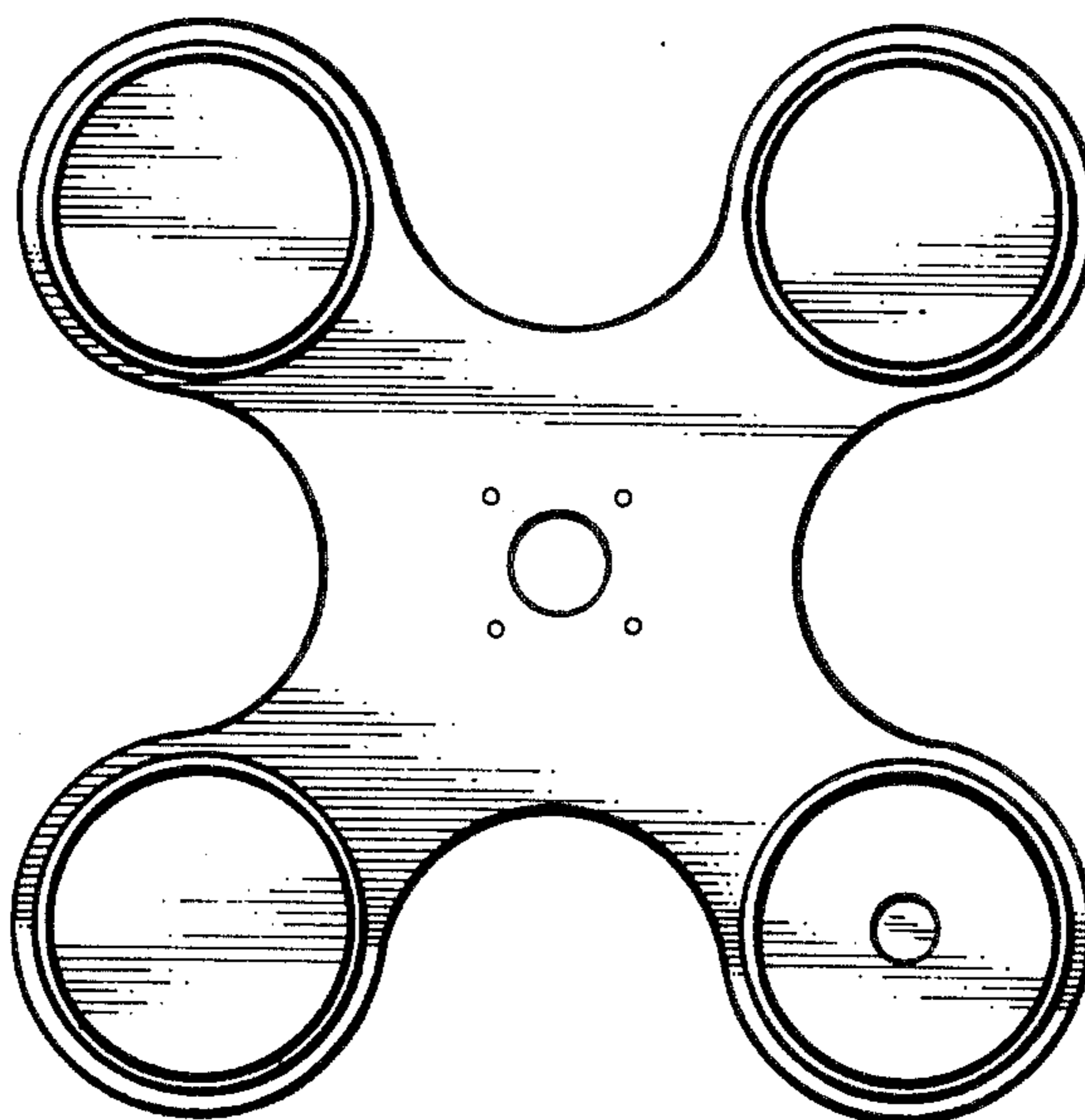

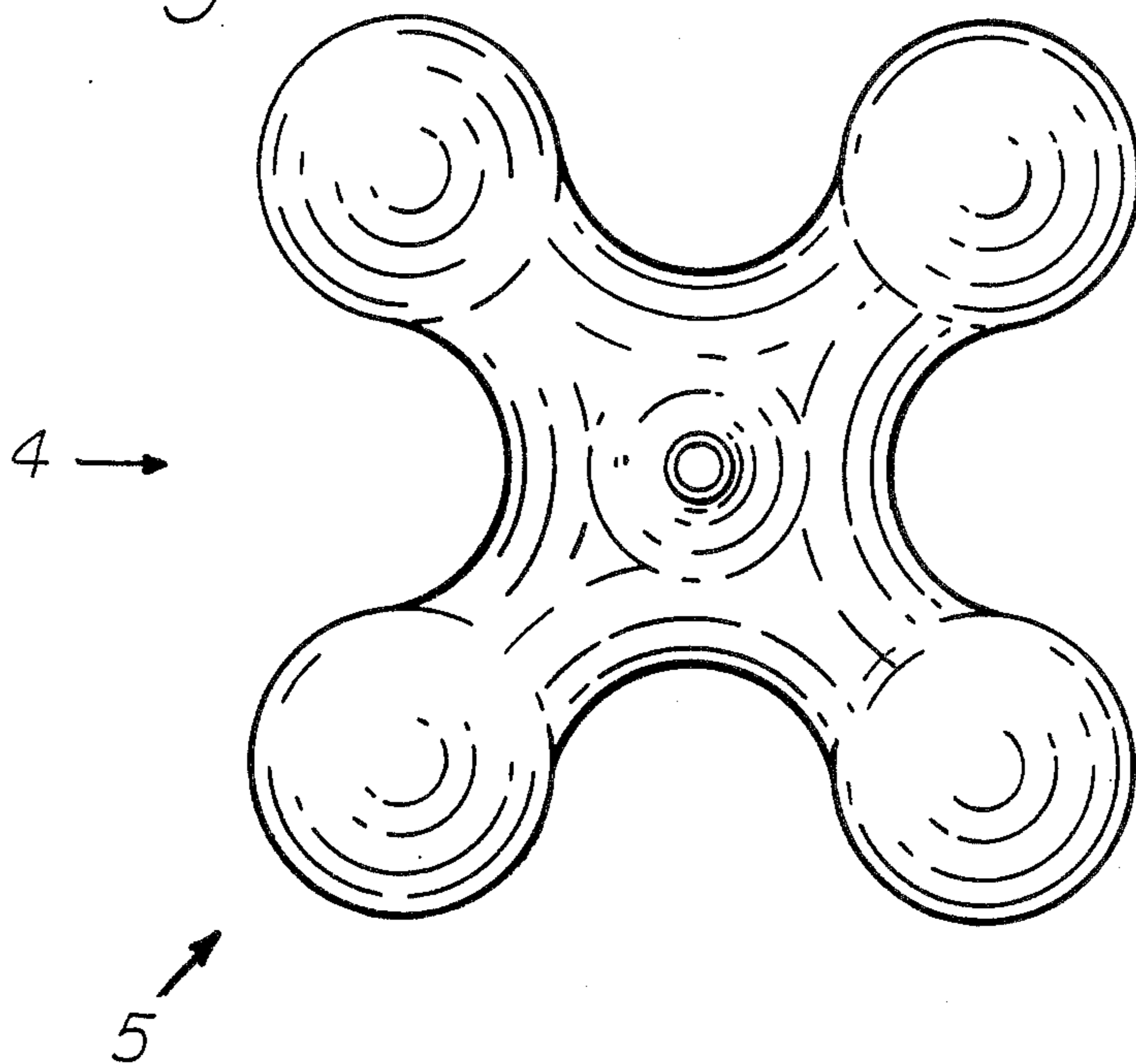

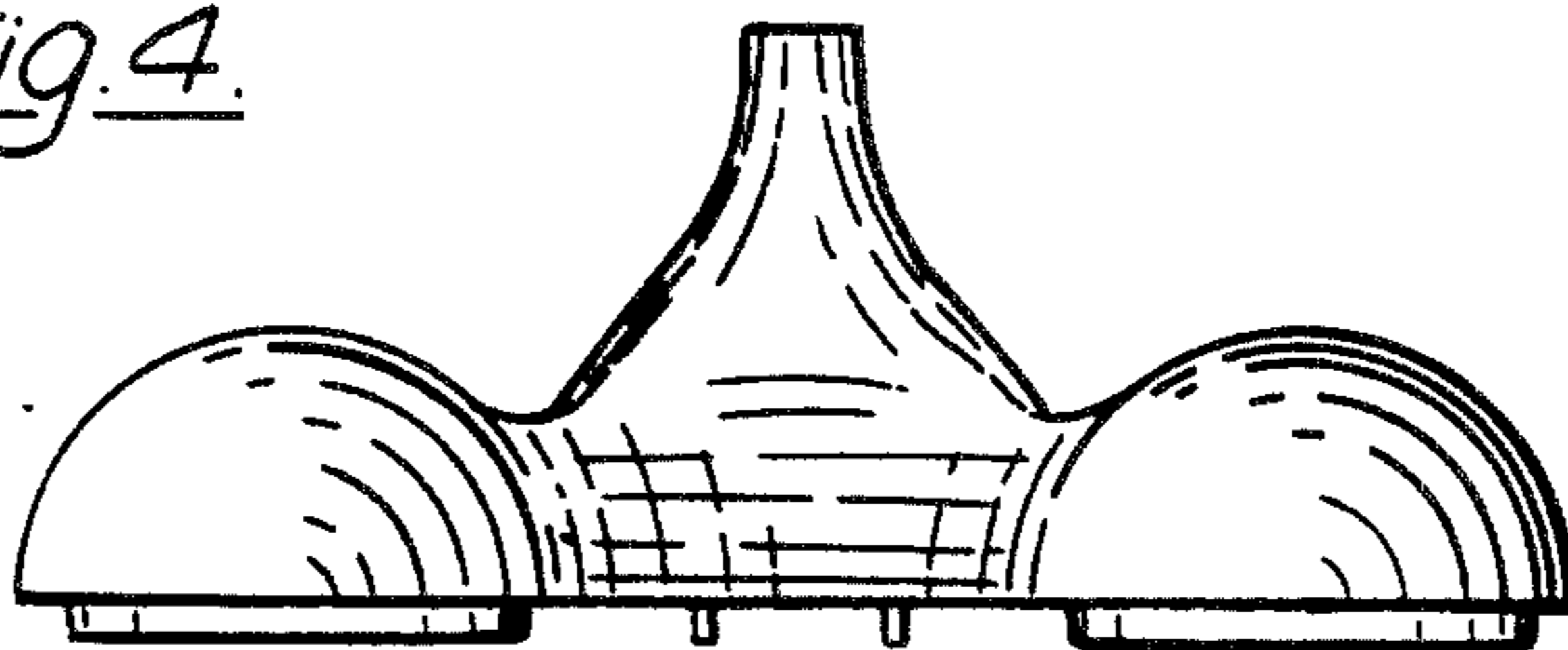
