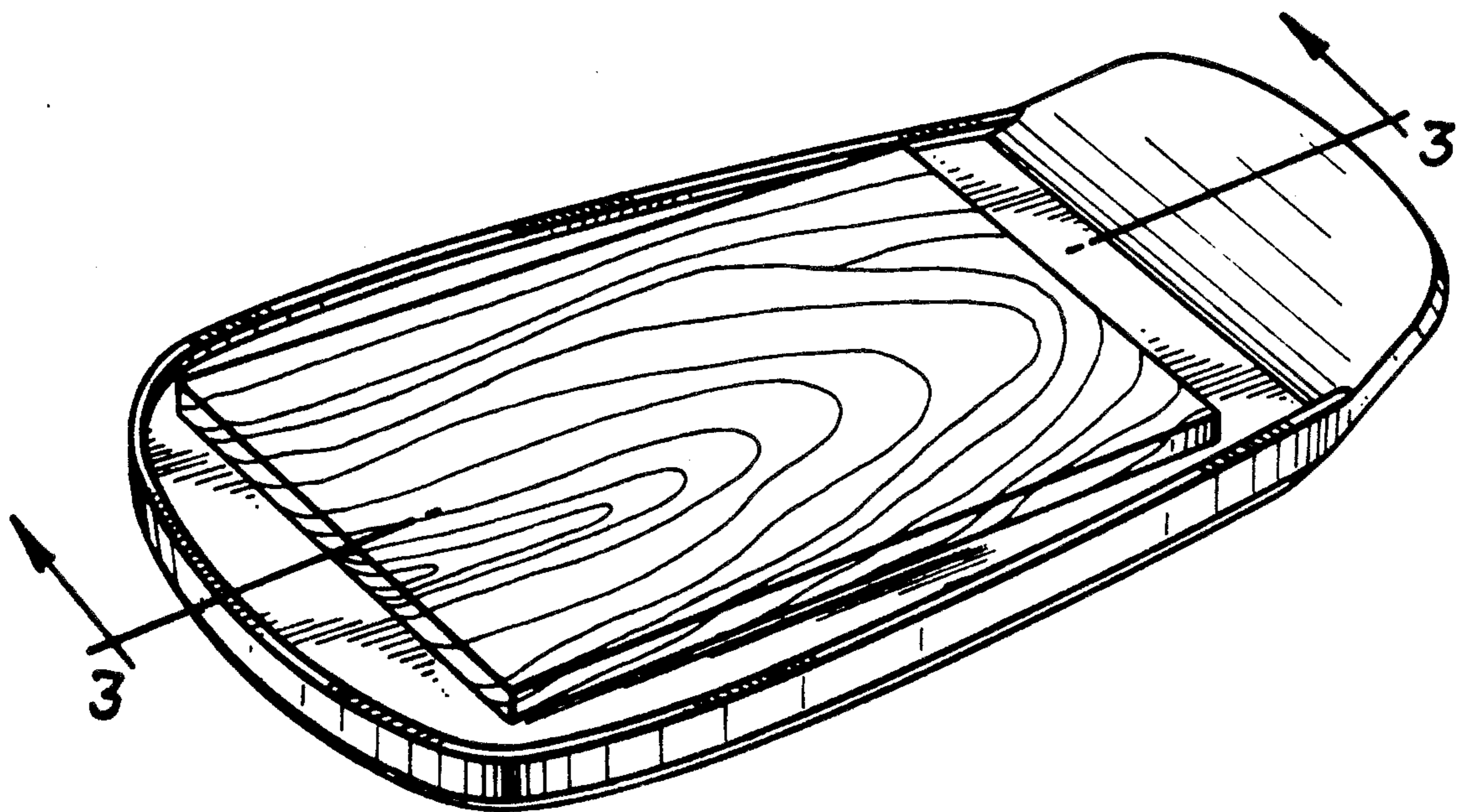

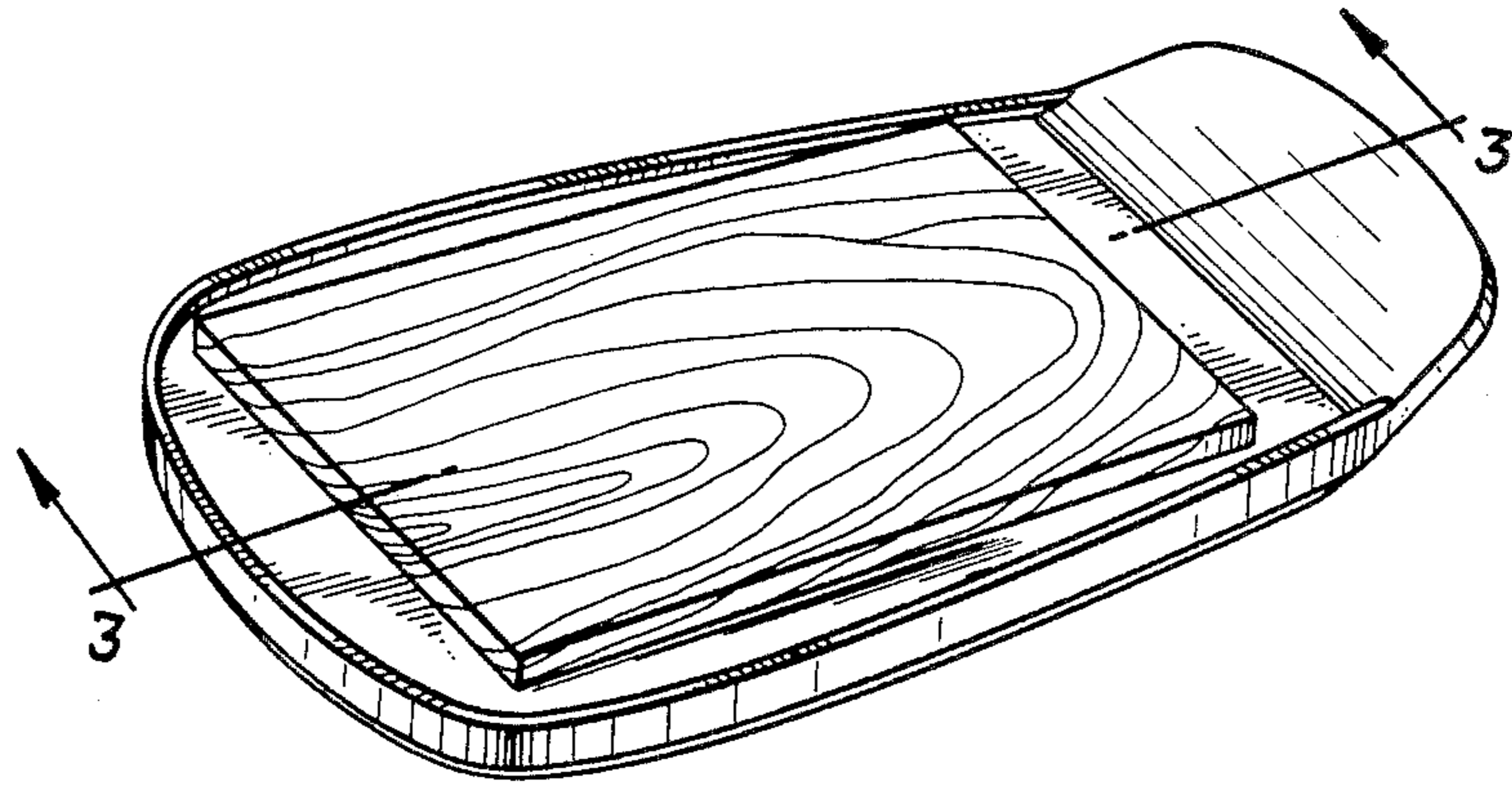
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a serving board, as shown.

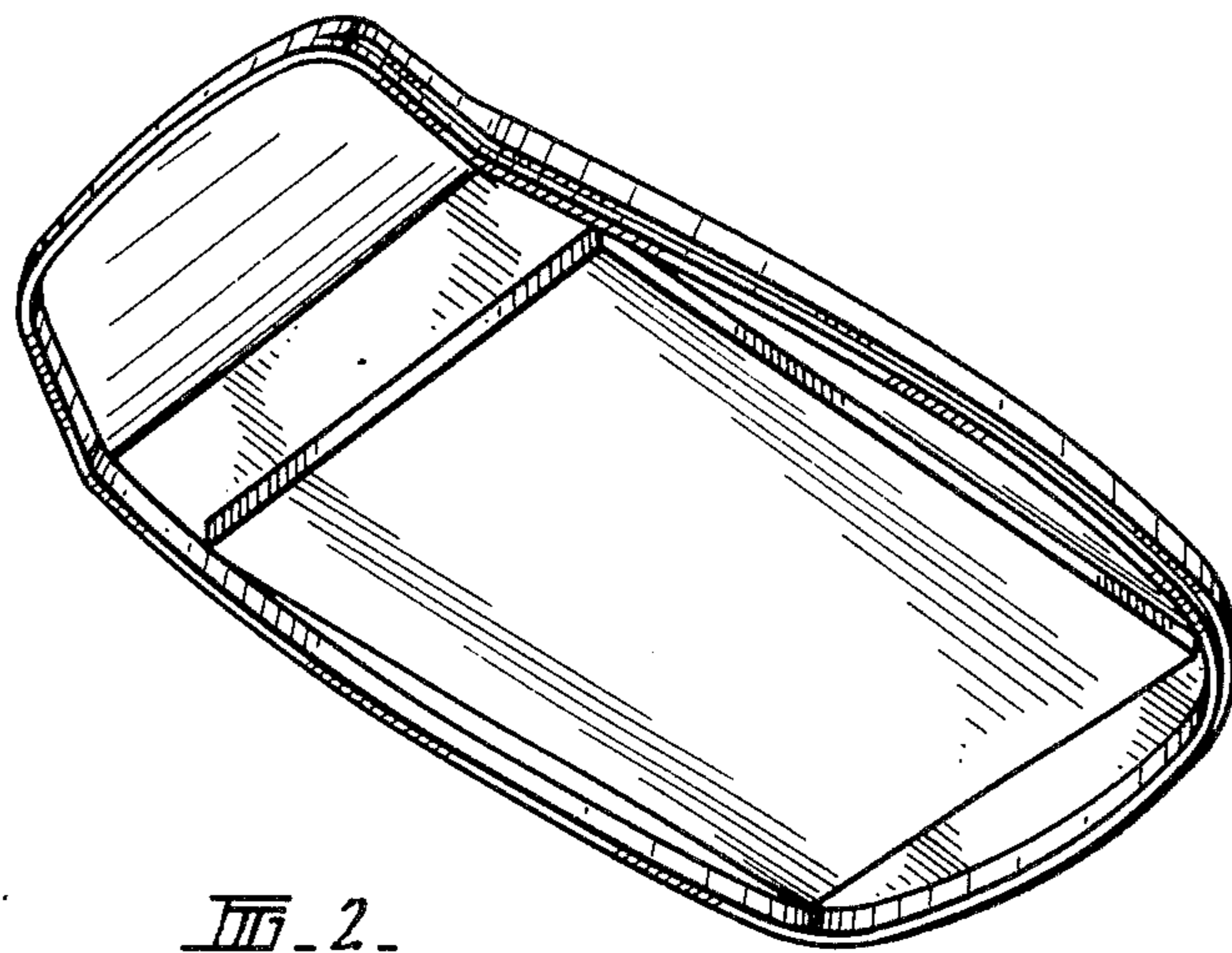
DESCRIPTION
