[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined insulated food service tray and cover therefor, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a combined insulated food service tray and cover therefor showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view on an enlarged scale; FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is an end elevational view thereof; and FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

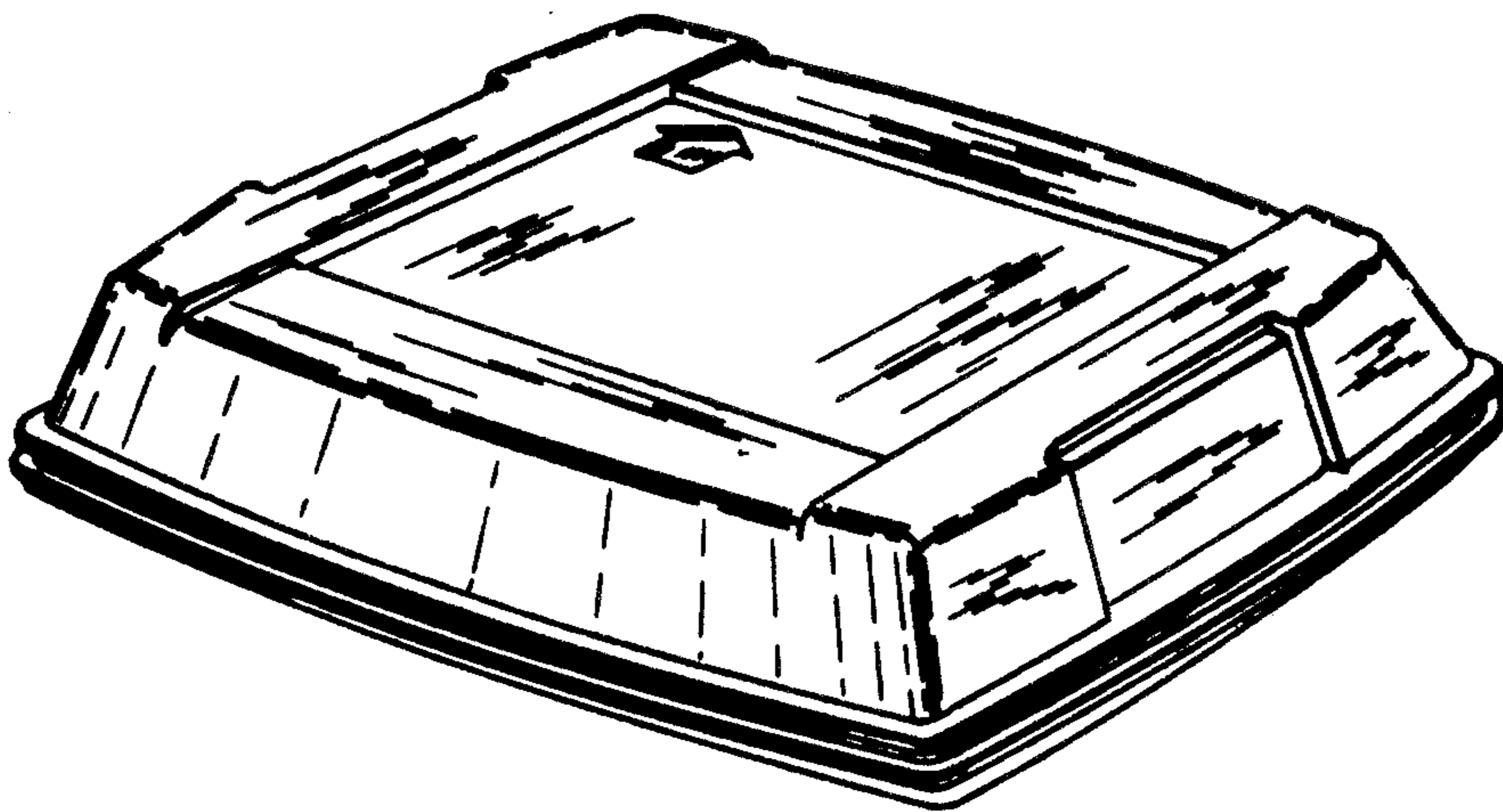

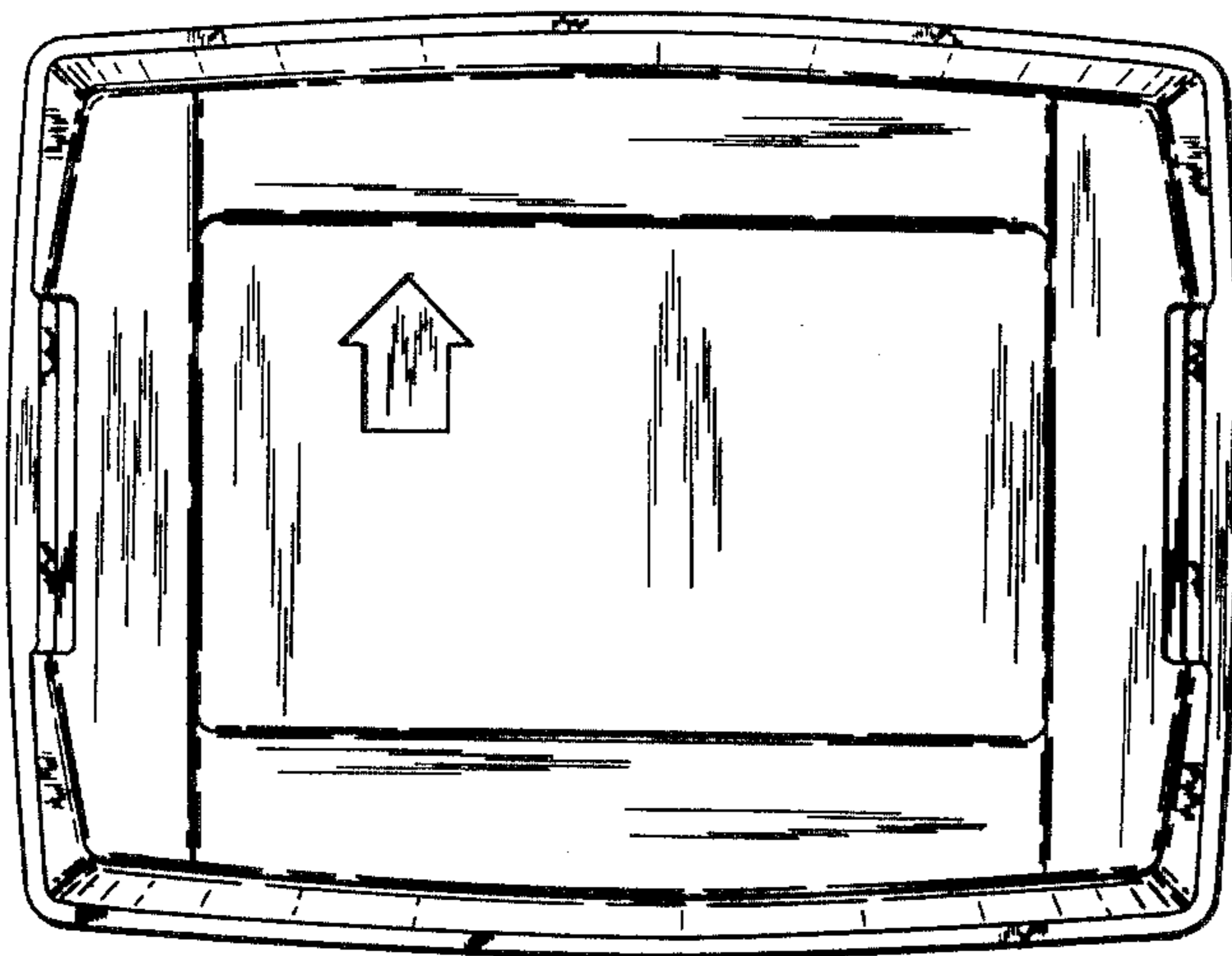
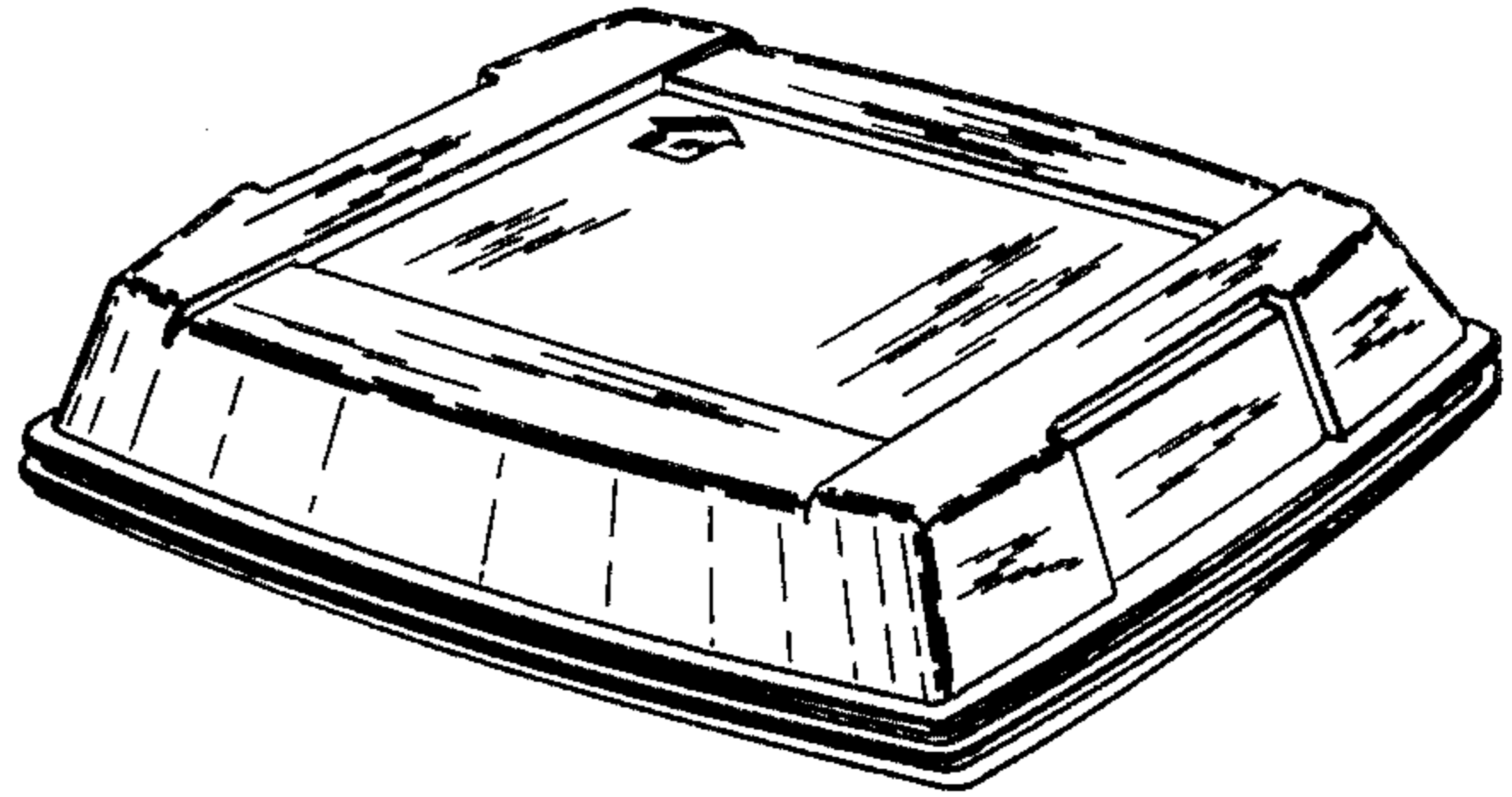

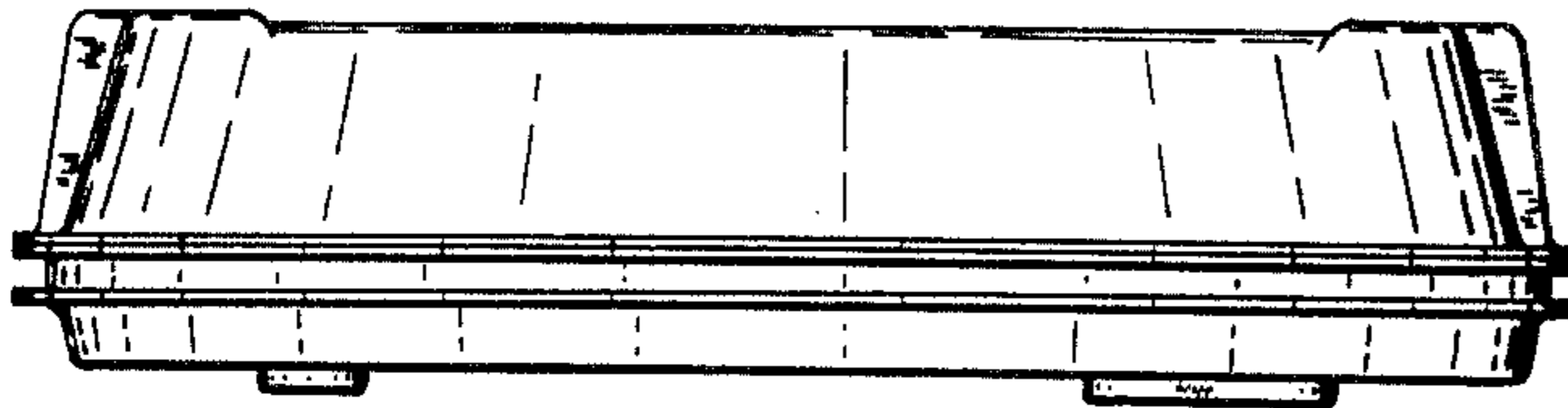

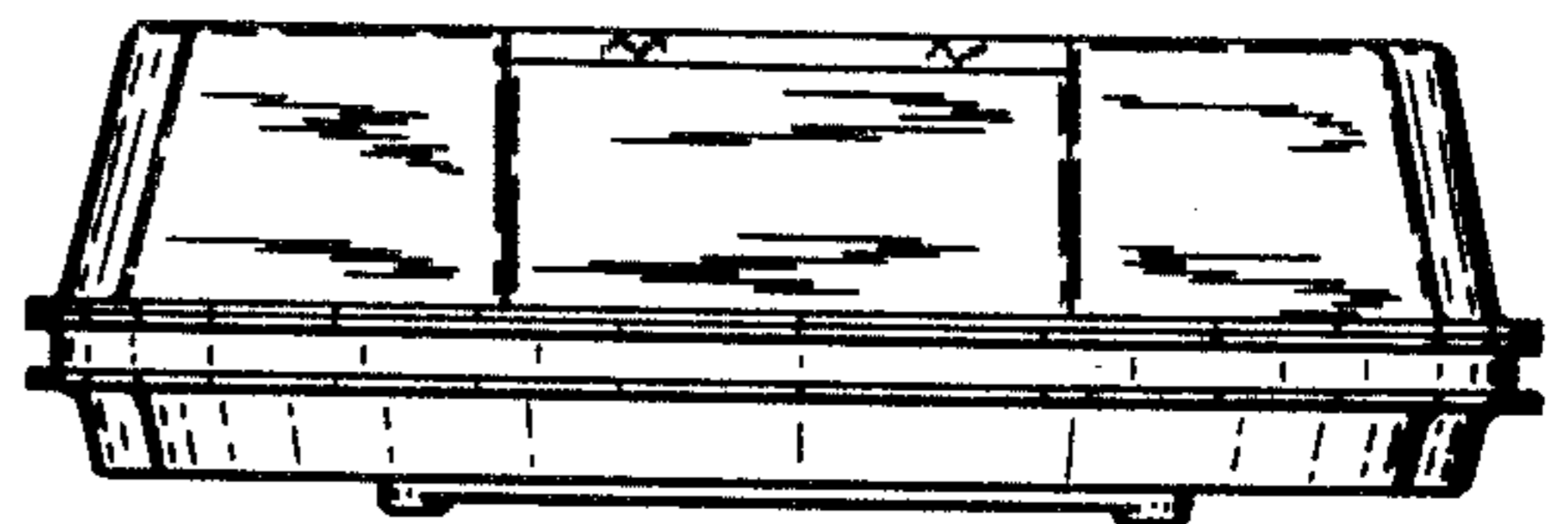

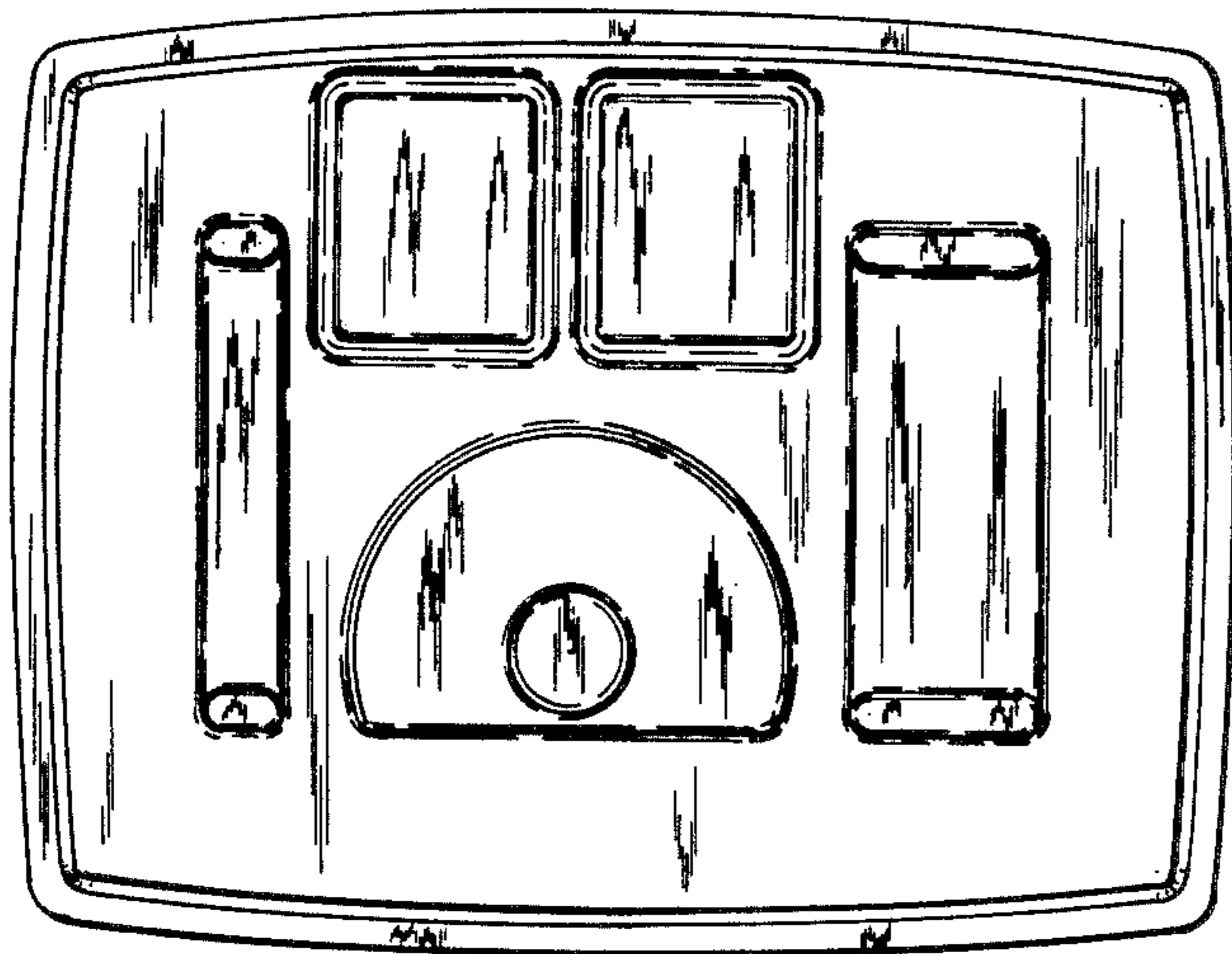
