[57] **CLAIM**

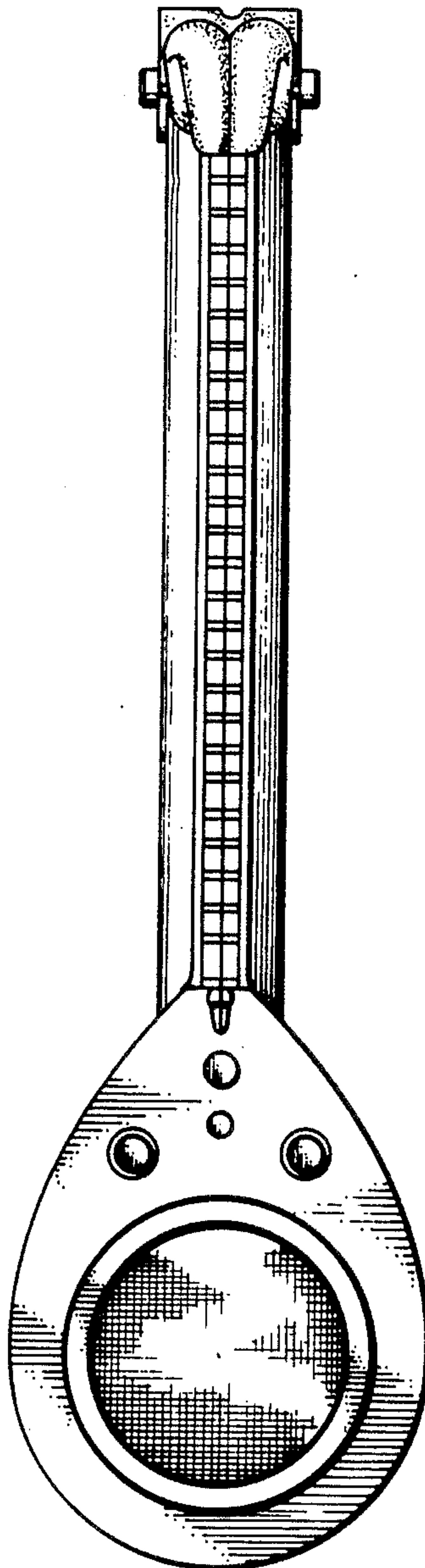
The ornamental design for a stringed musical instrument, substantially as shown.

FIG. 3 is a perspective view thereof.



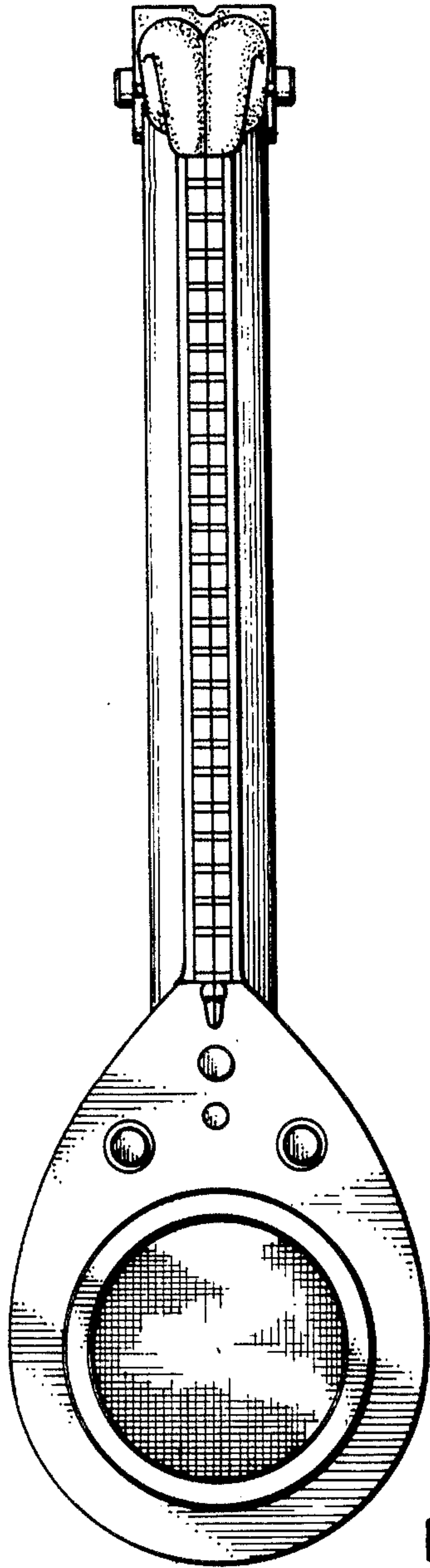

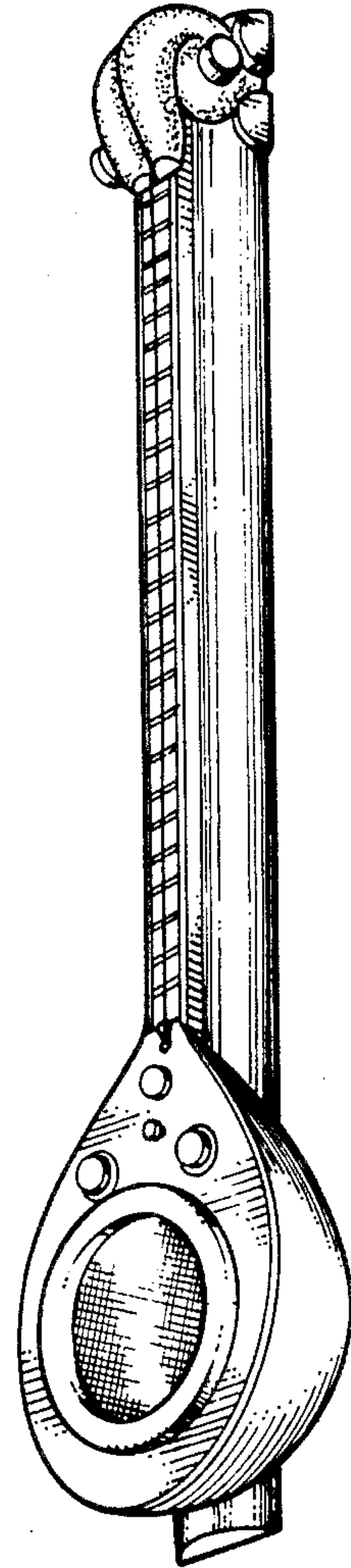

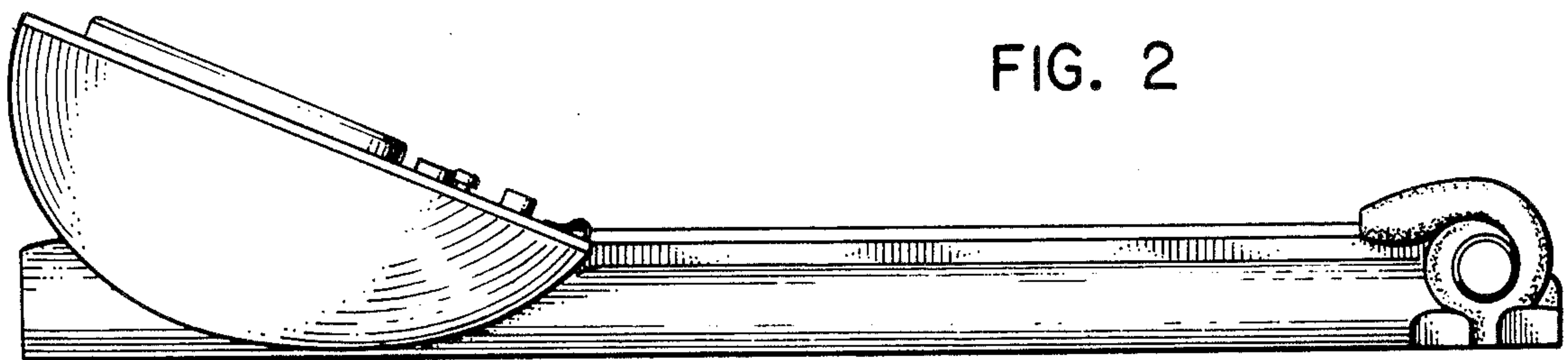
