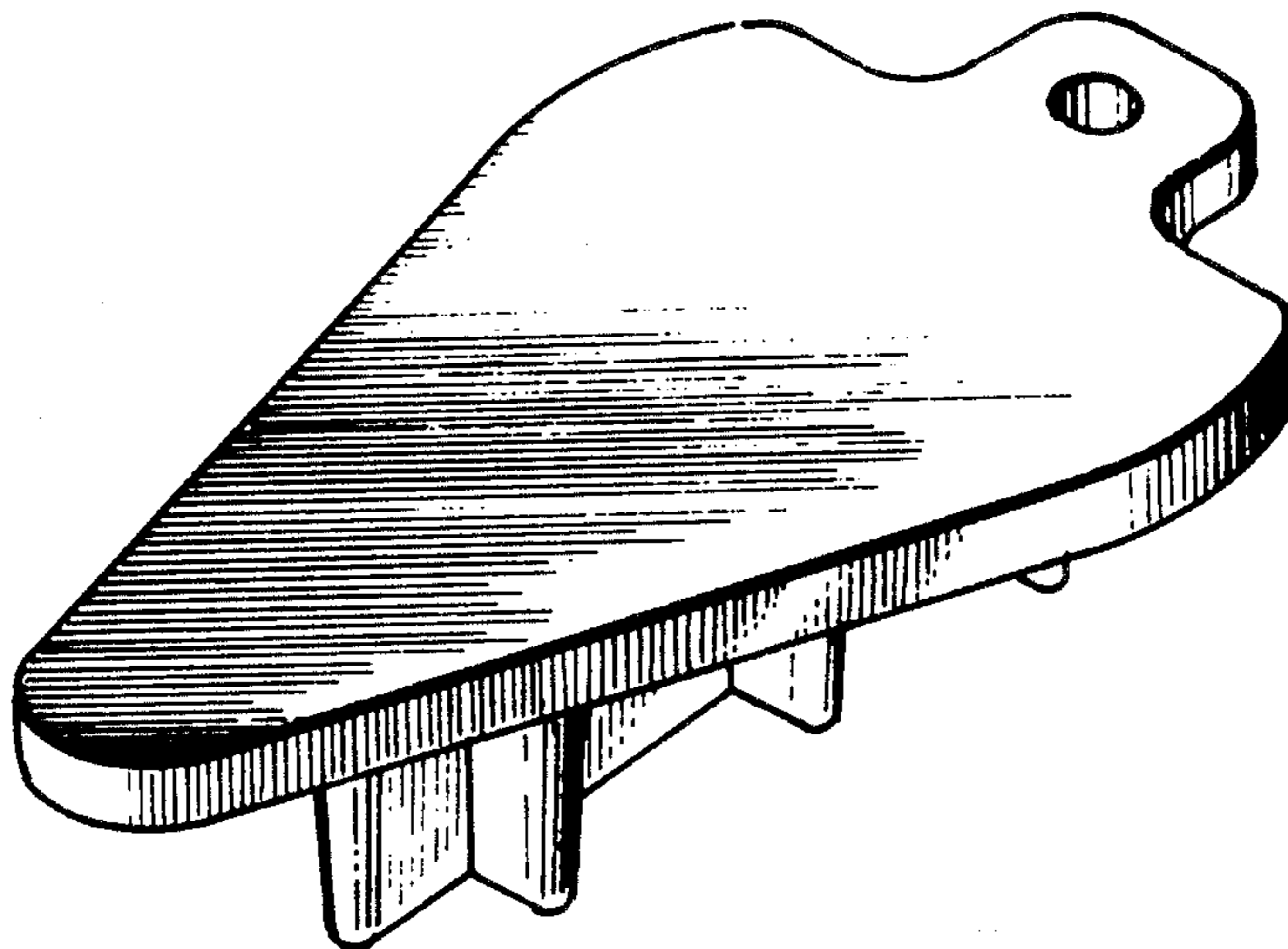

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a combined key chain fob and tab can opener showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a inverted bottom perspective view thereof; FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view; FIG. 5 is a front elevational view; FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view; and FIG. 7 is a right side elevational view.



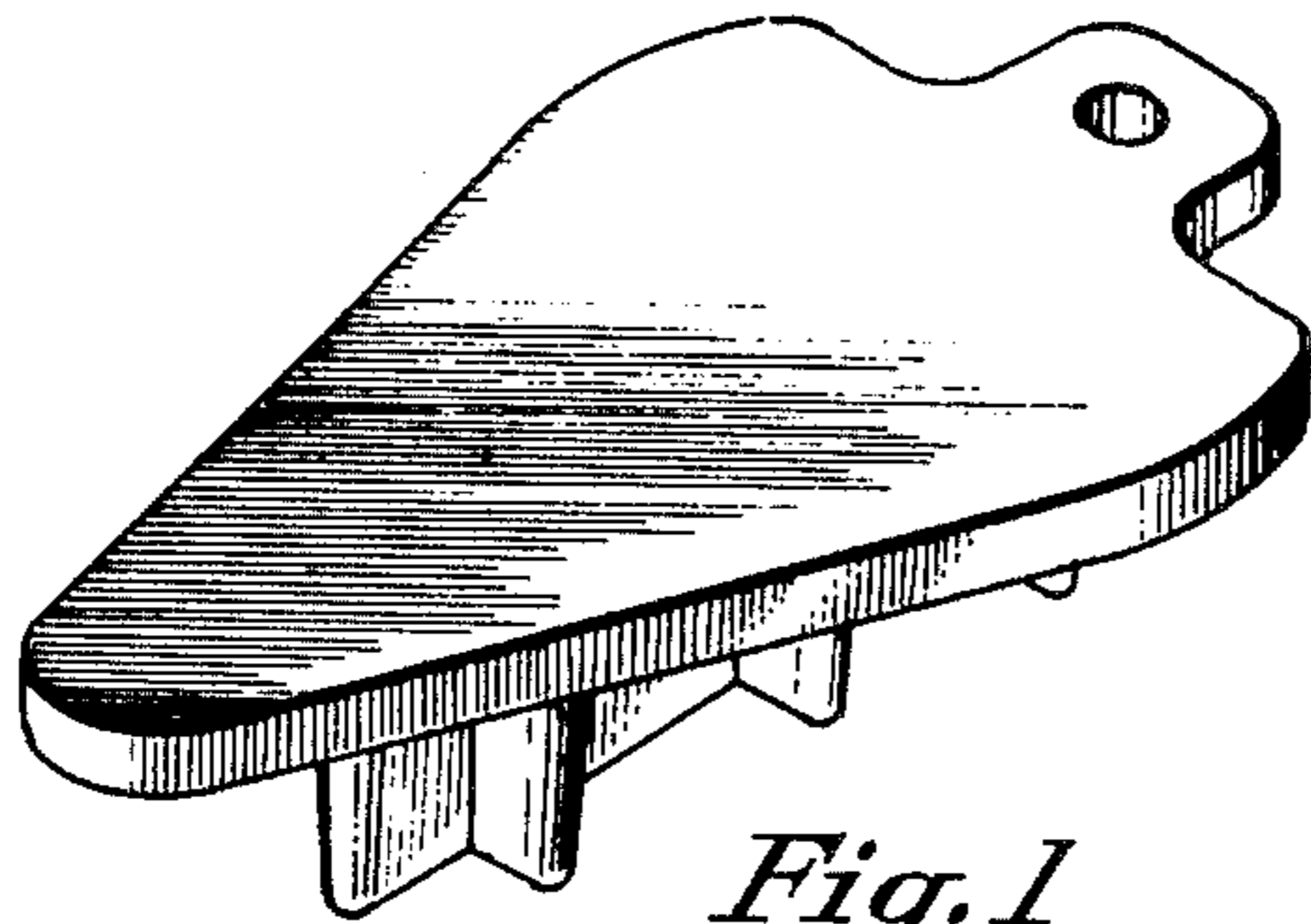

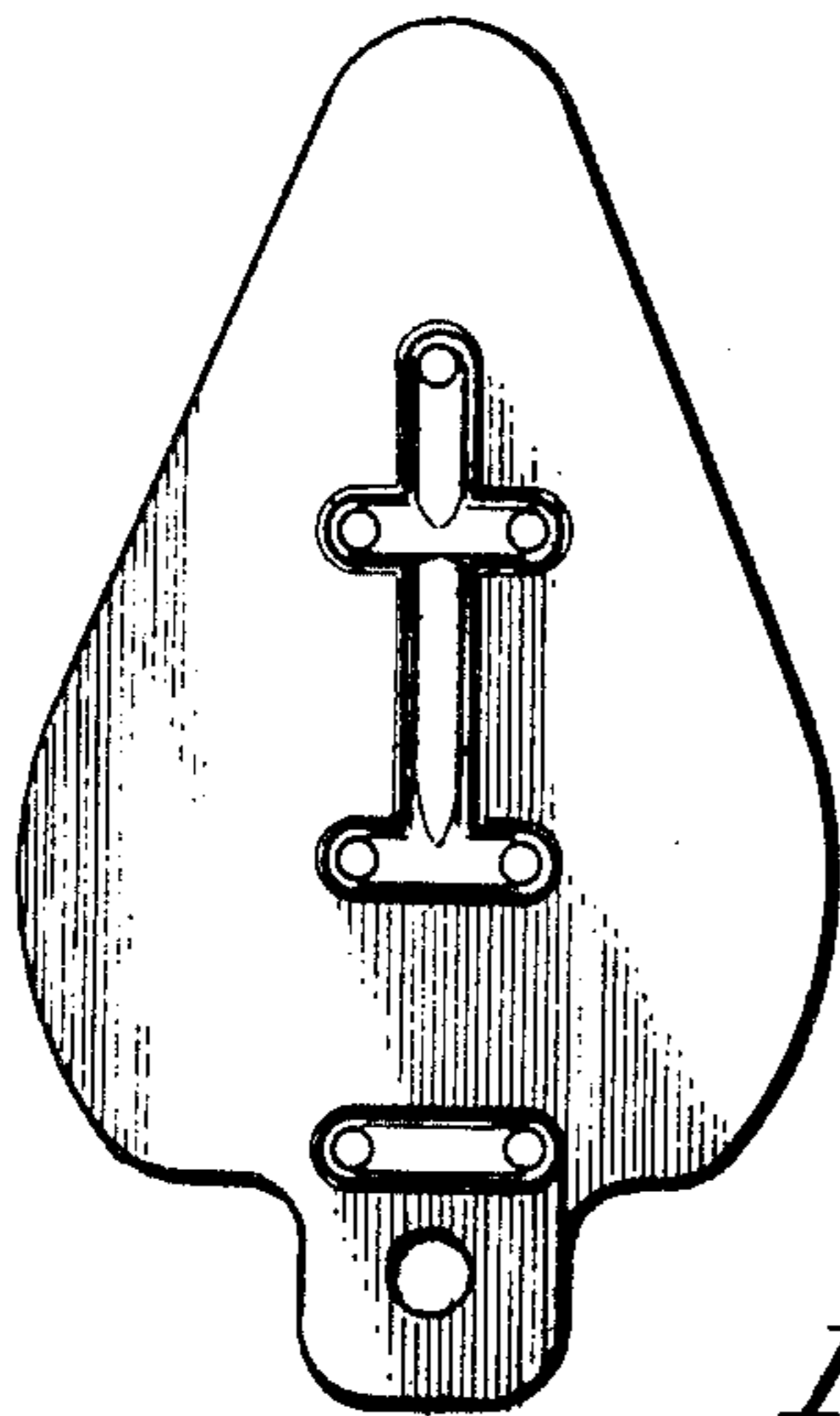
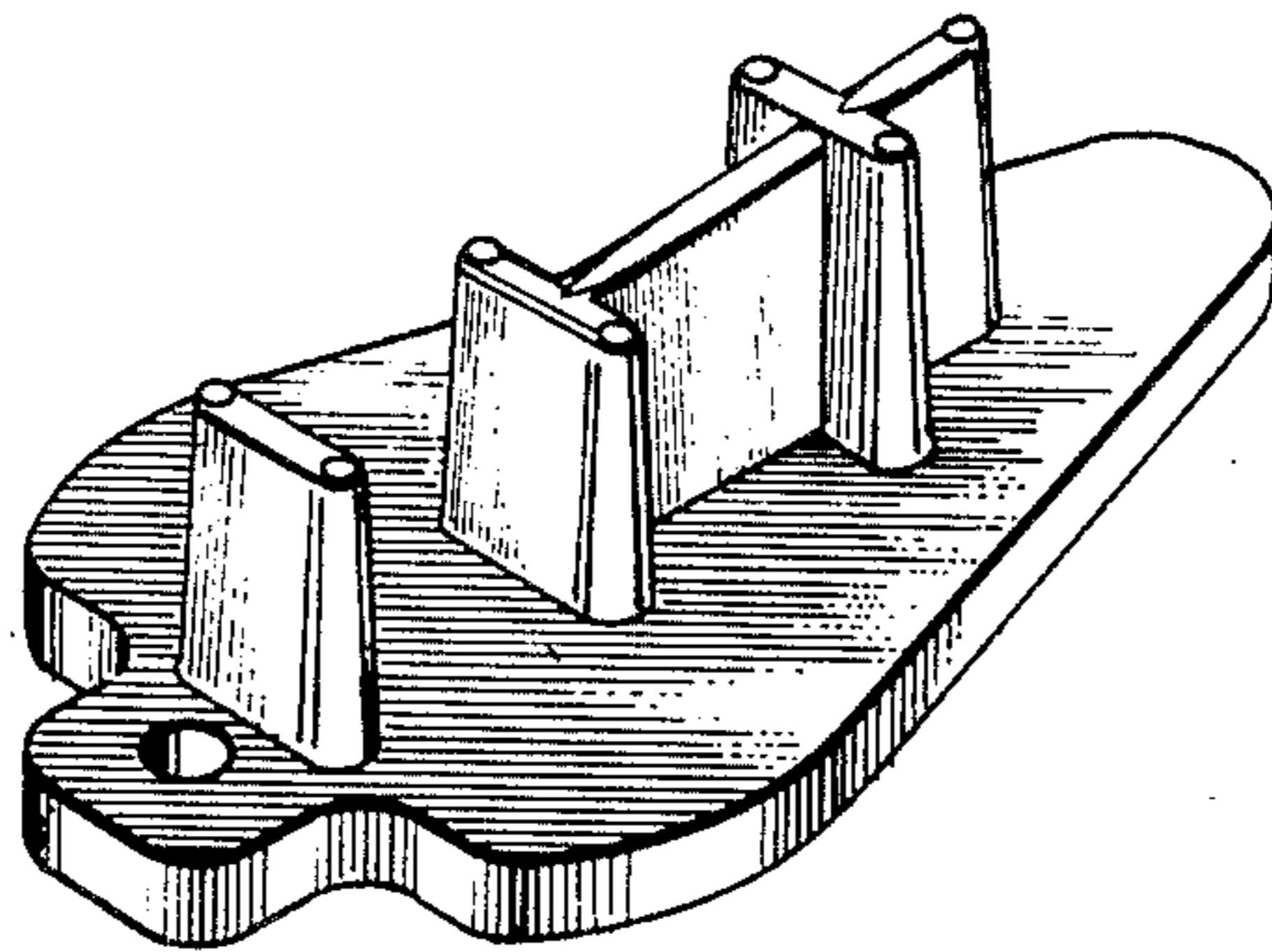

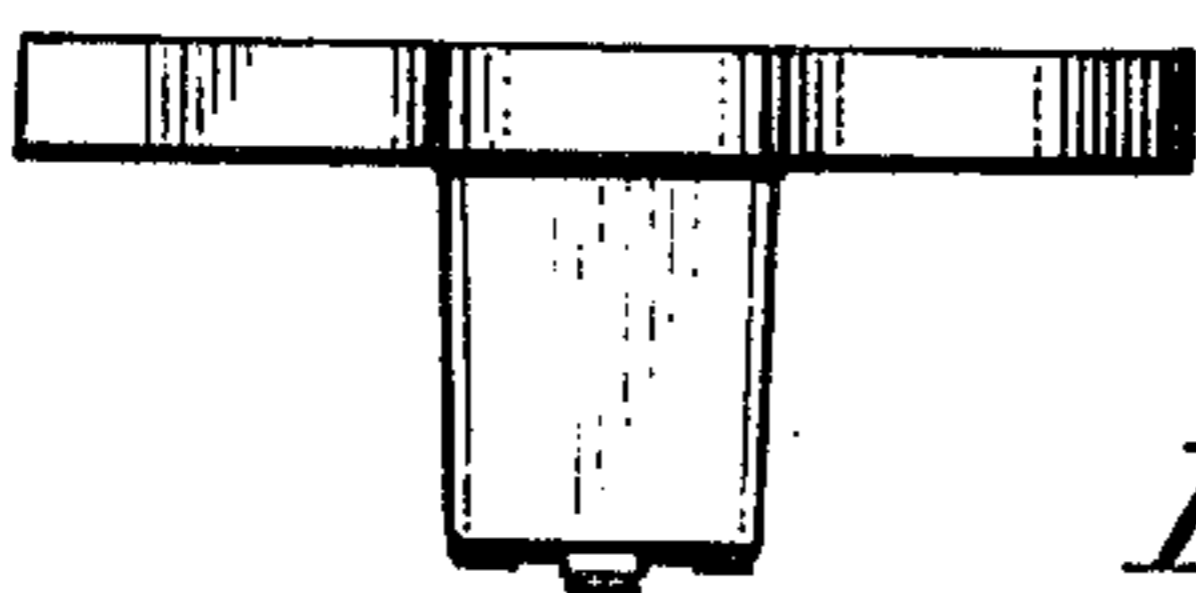
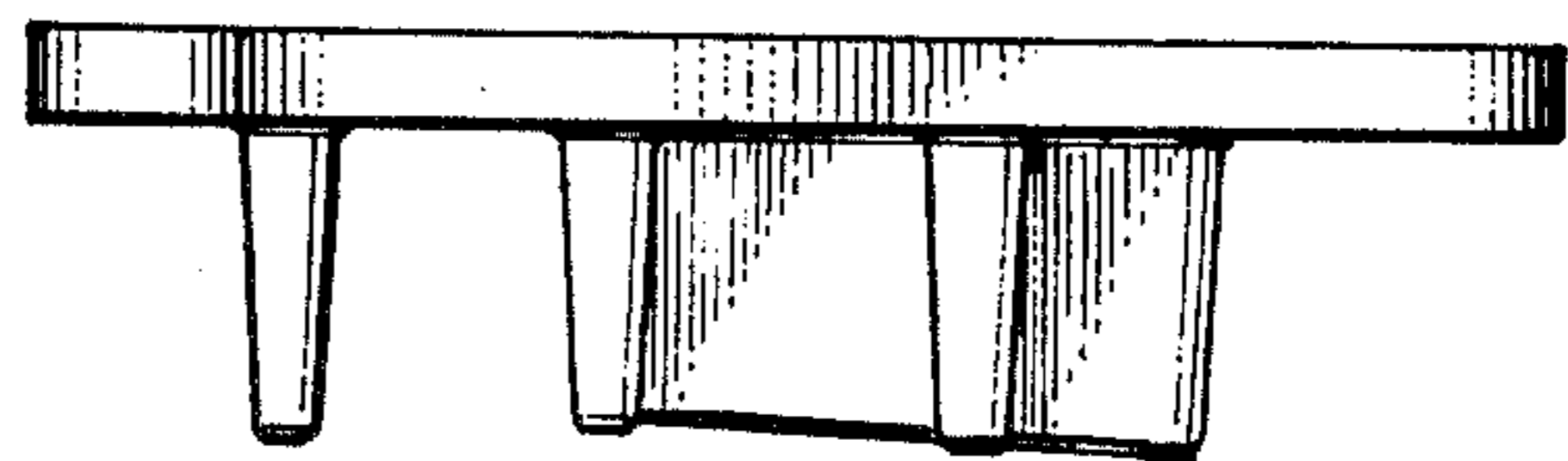

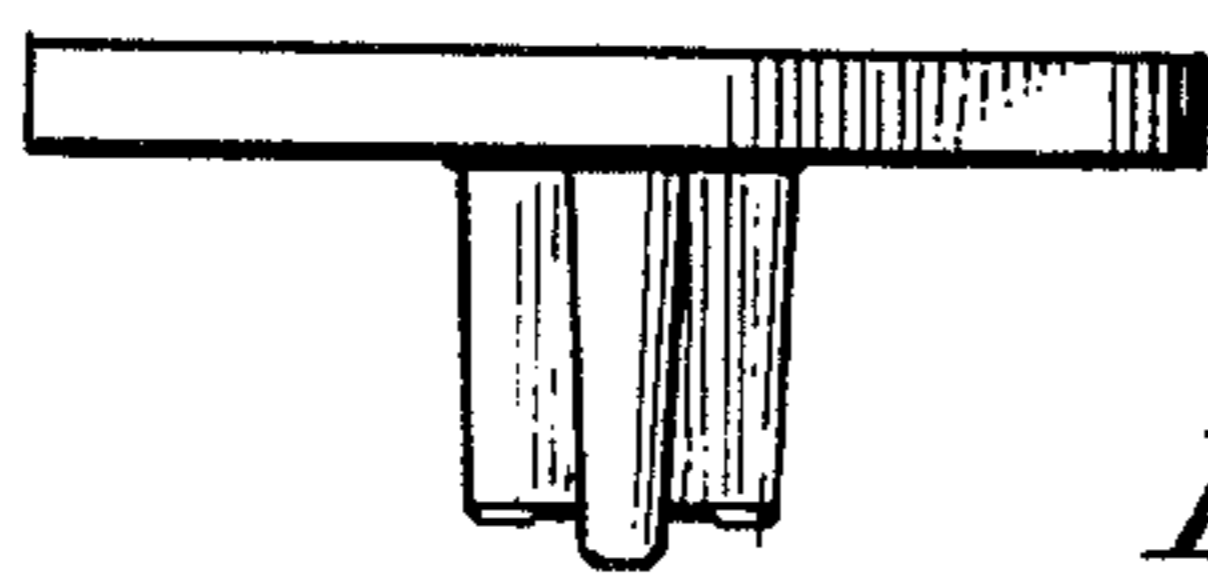
