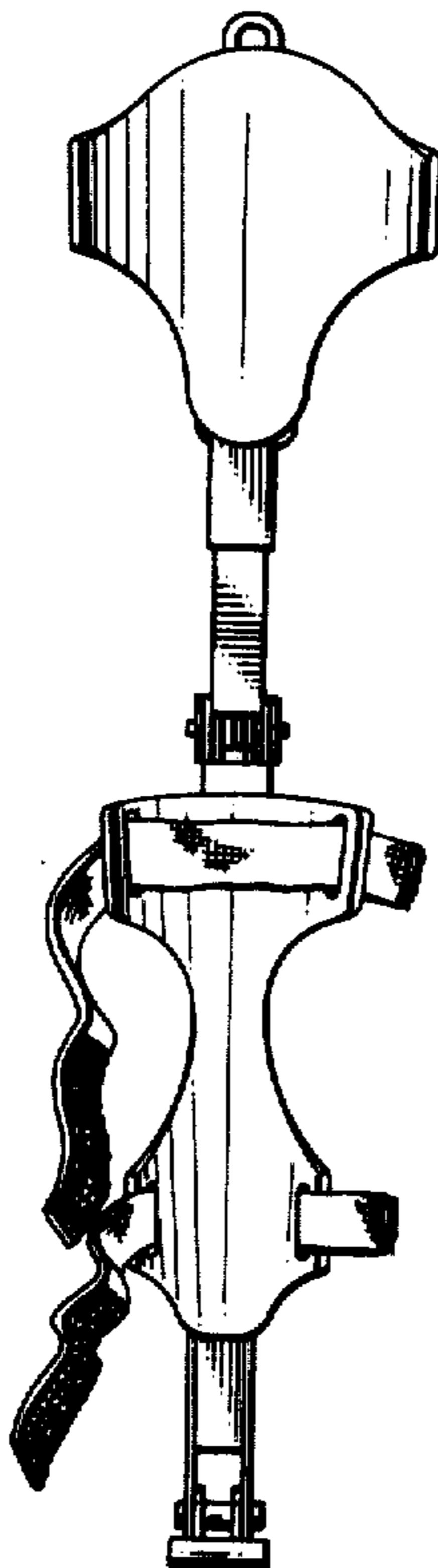

trated in FIGS. 1 through 4 in an alternative position.



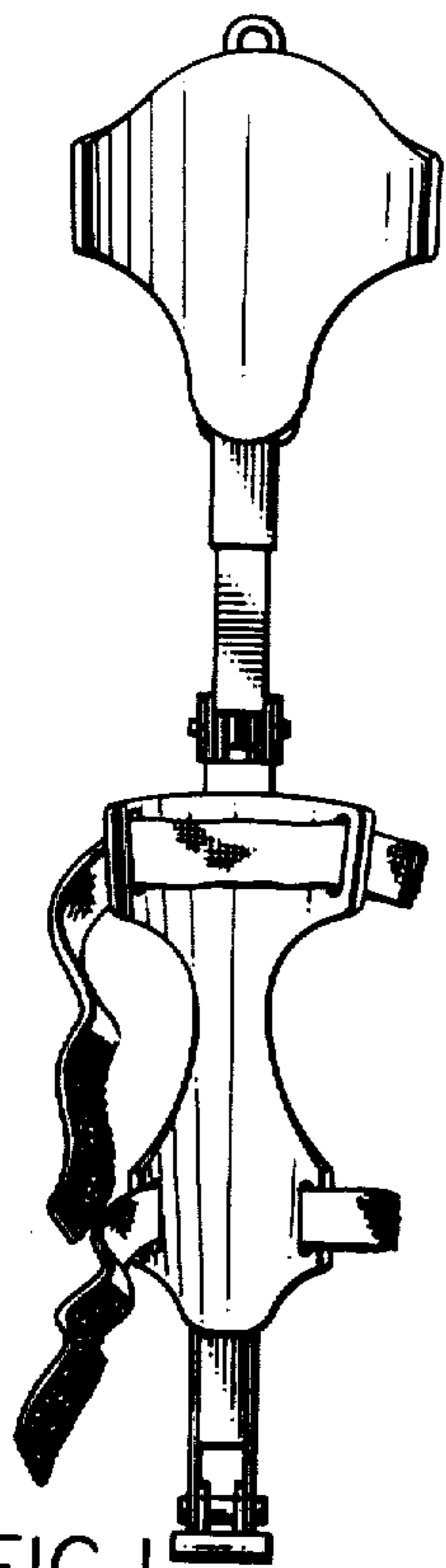

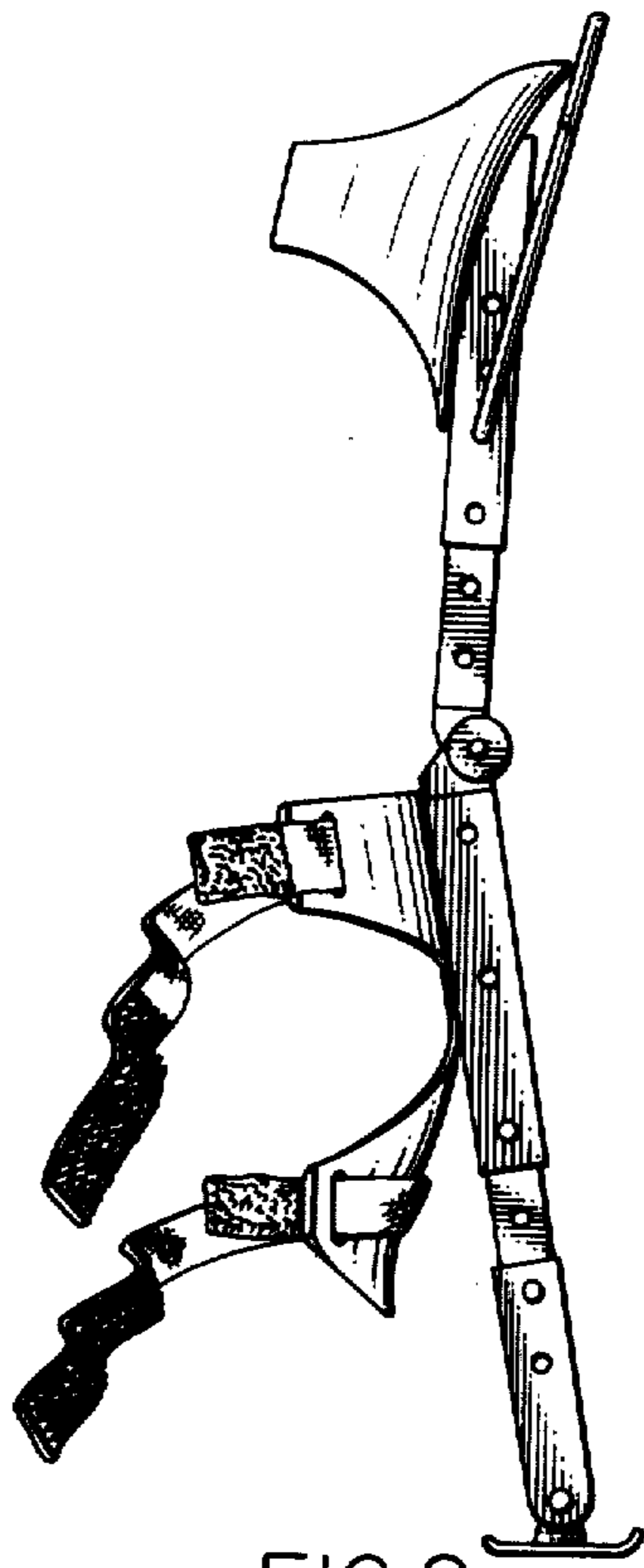

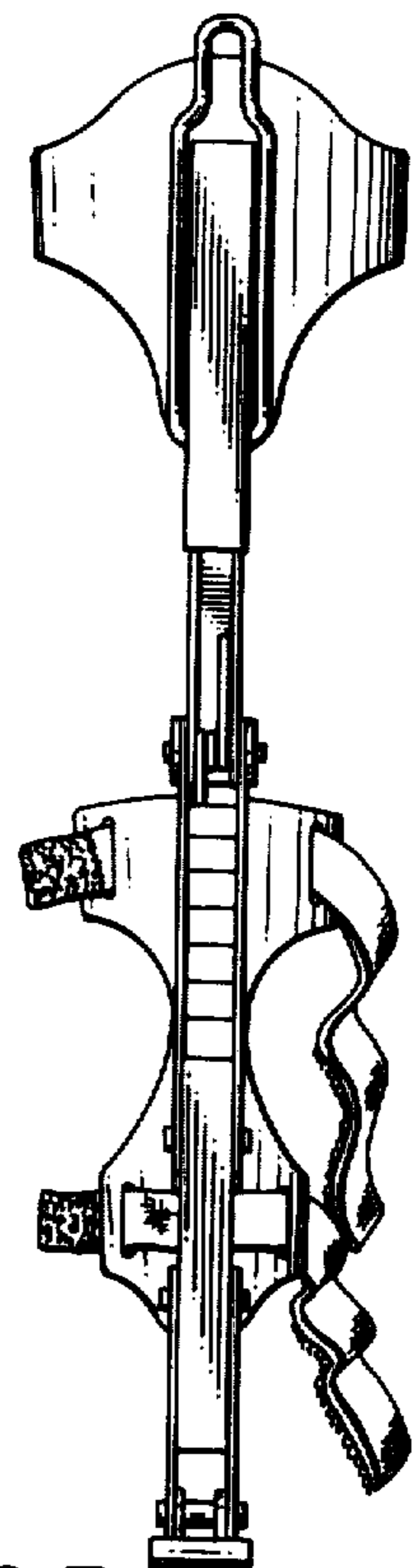

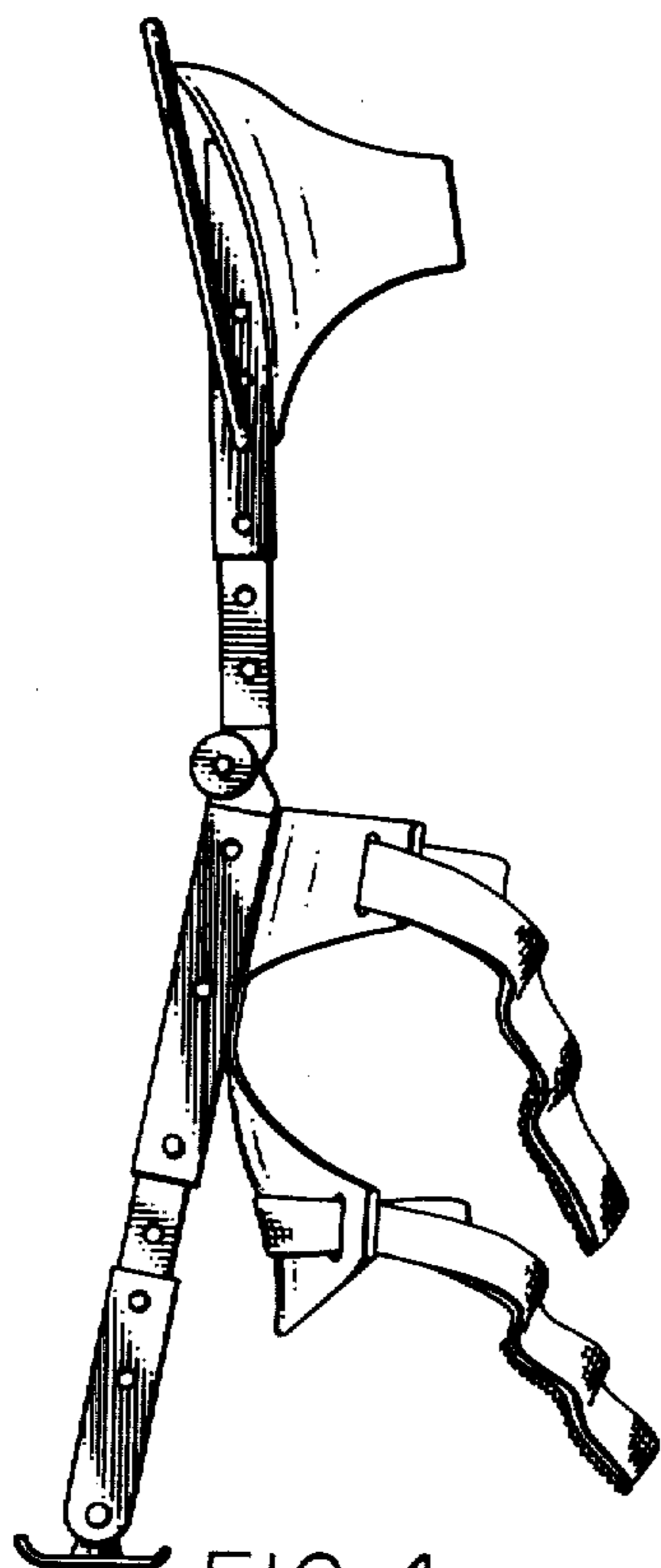

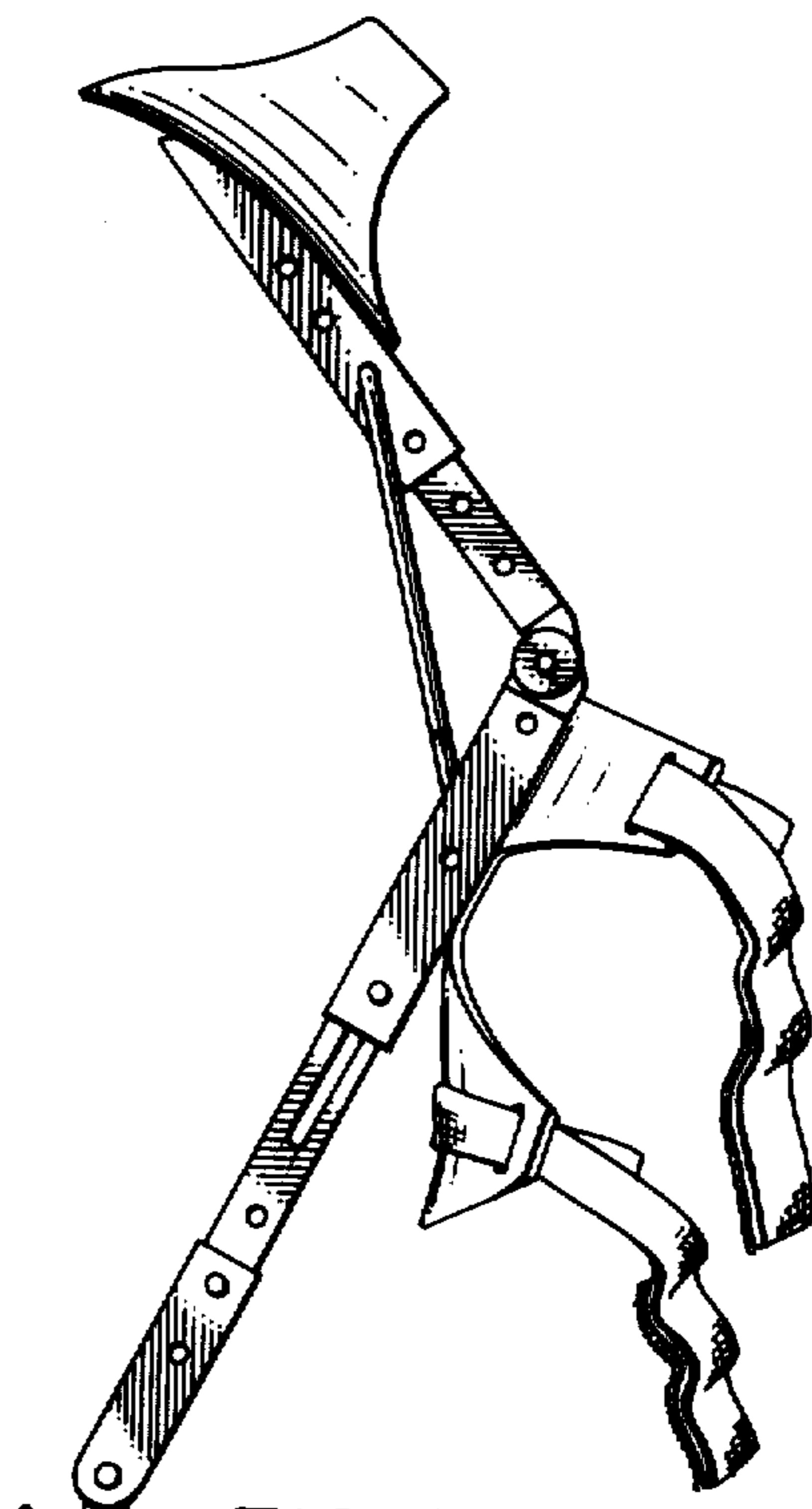
