DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view looking from the front of a chair embodying the present design;
FIG. 2 is a perspective view looking from the side of said chair;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view of said chair.

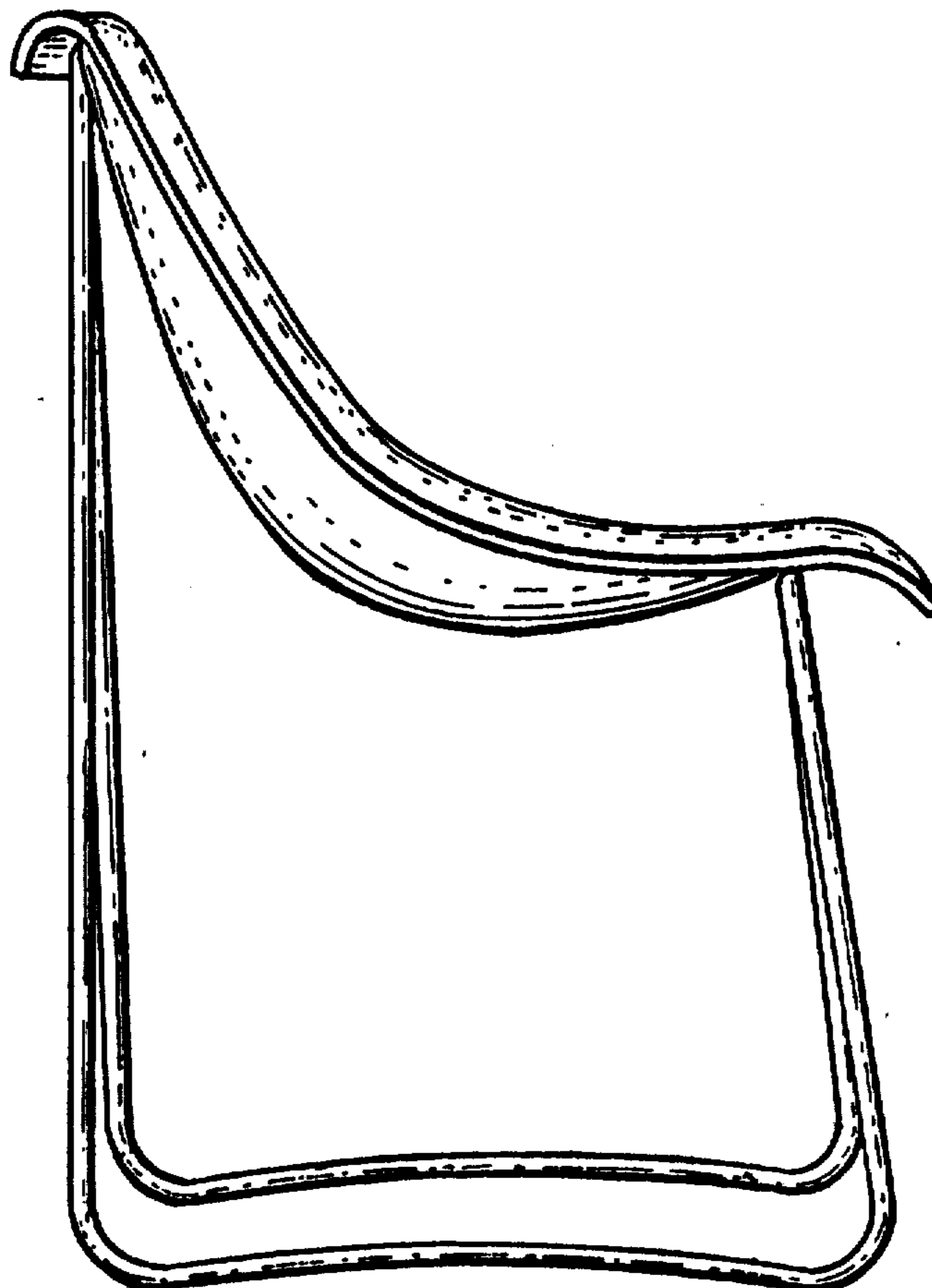

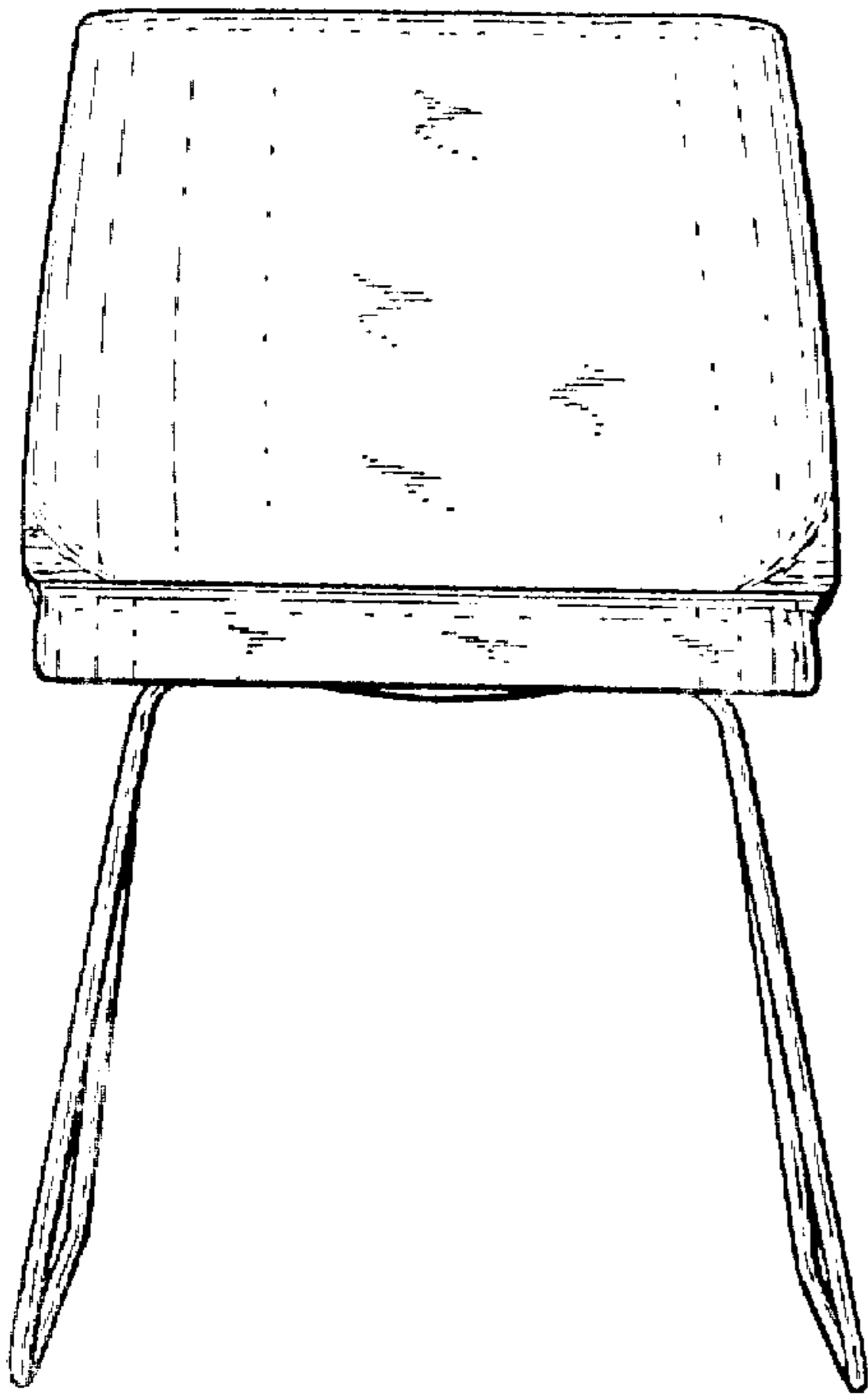

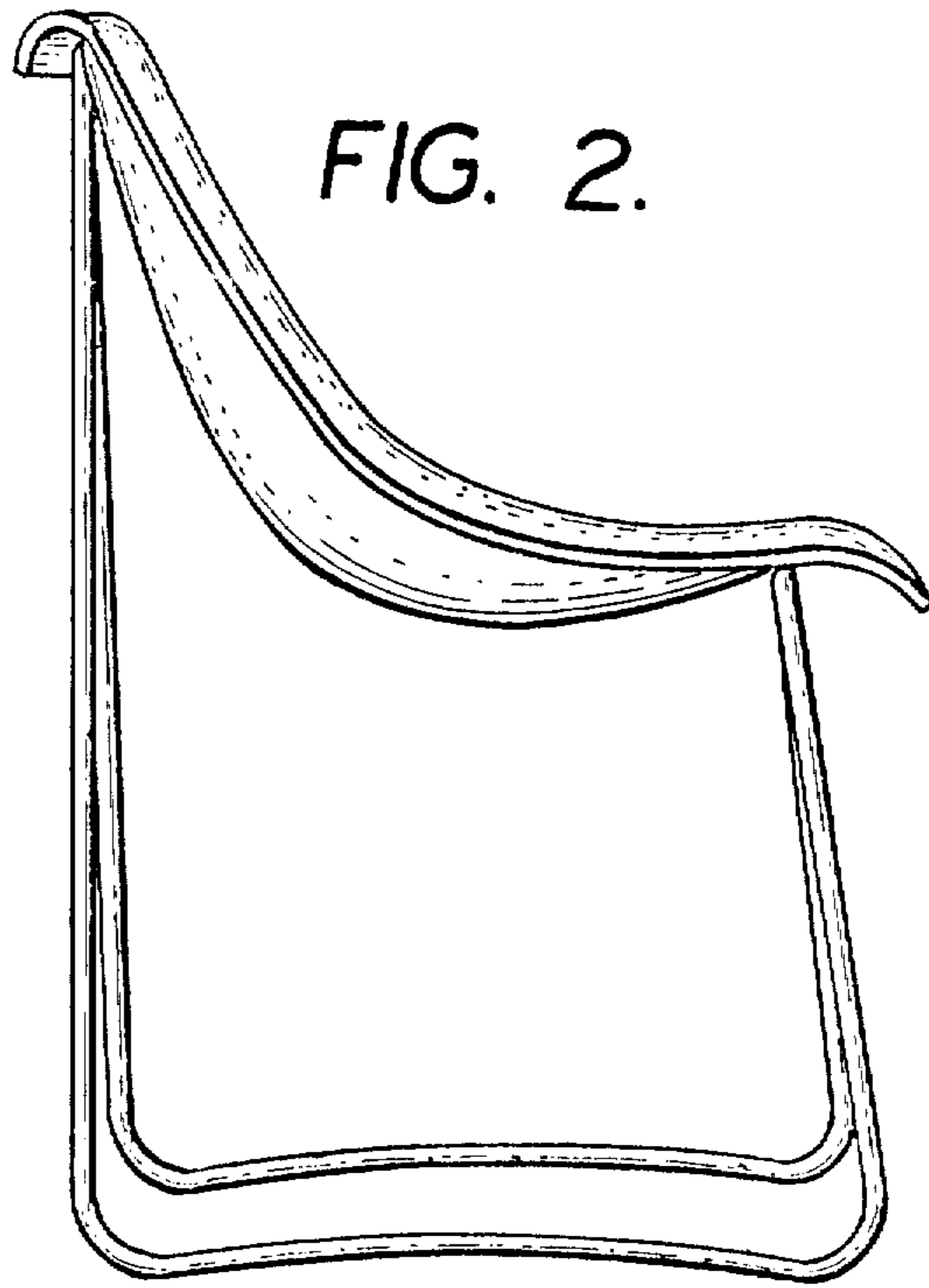

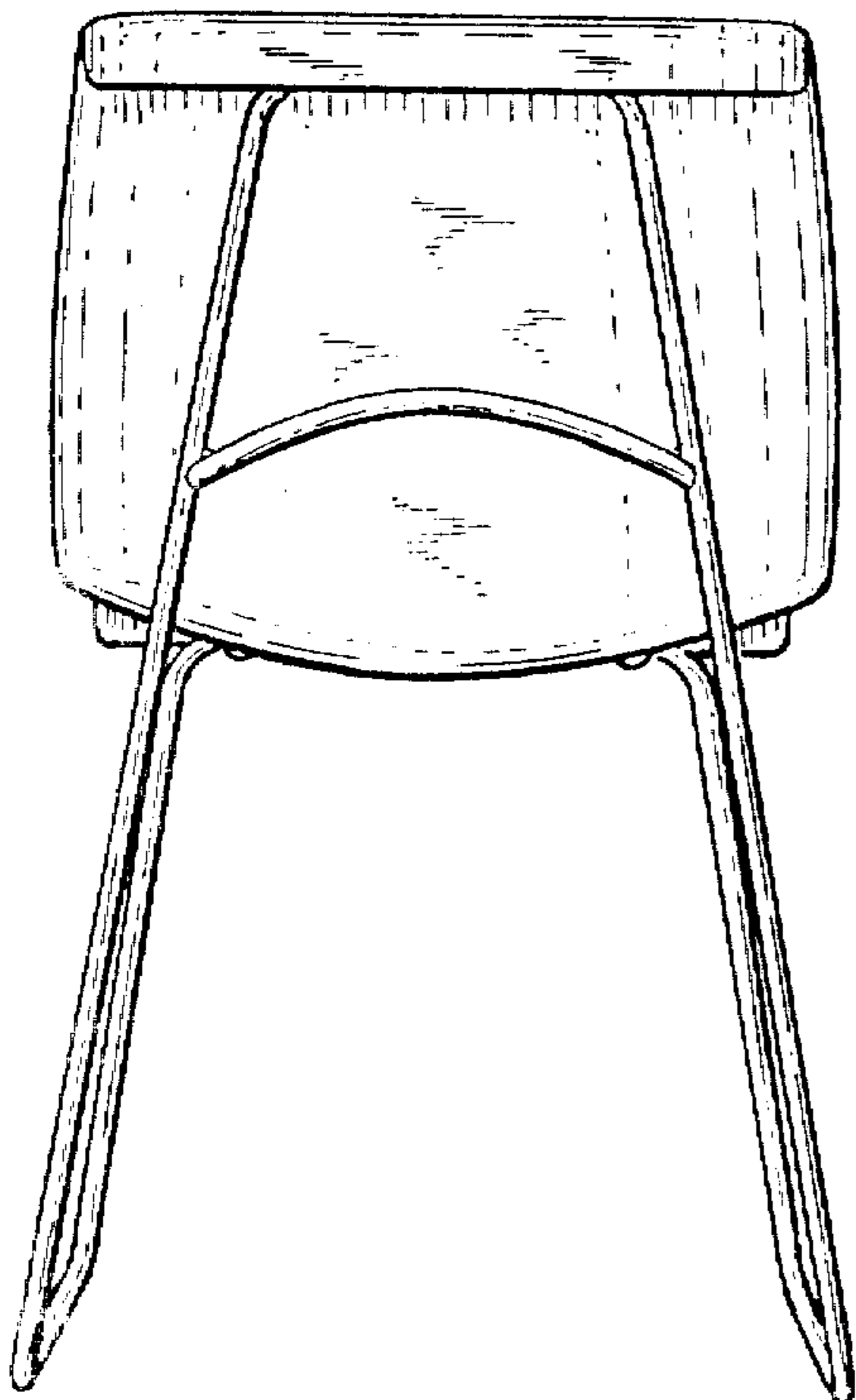
