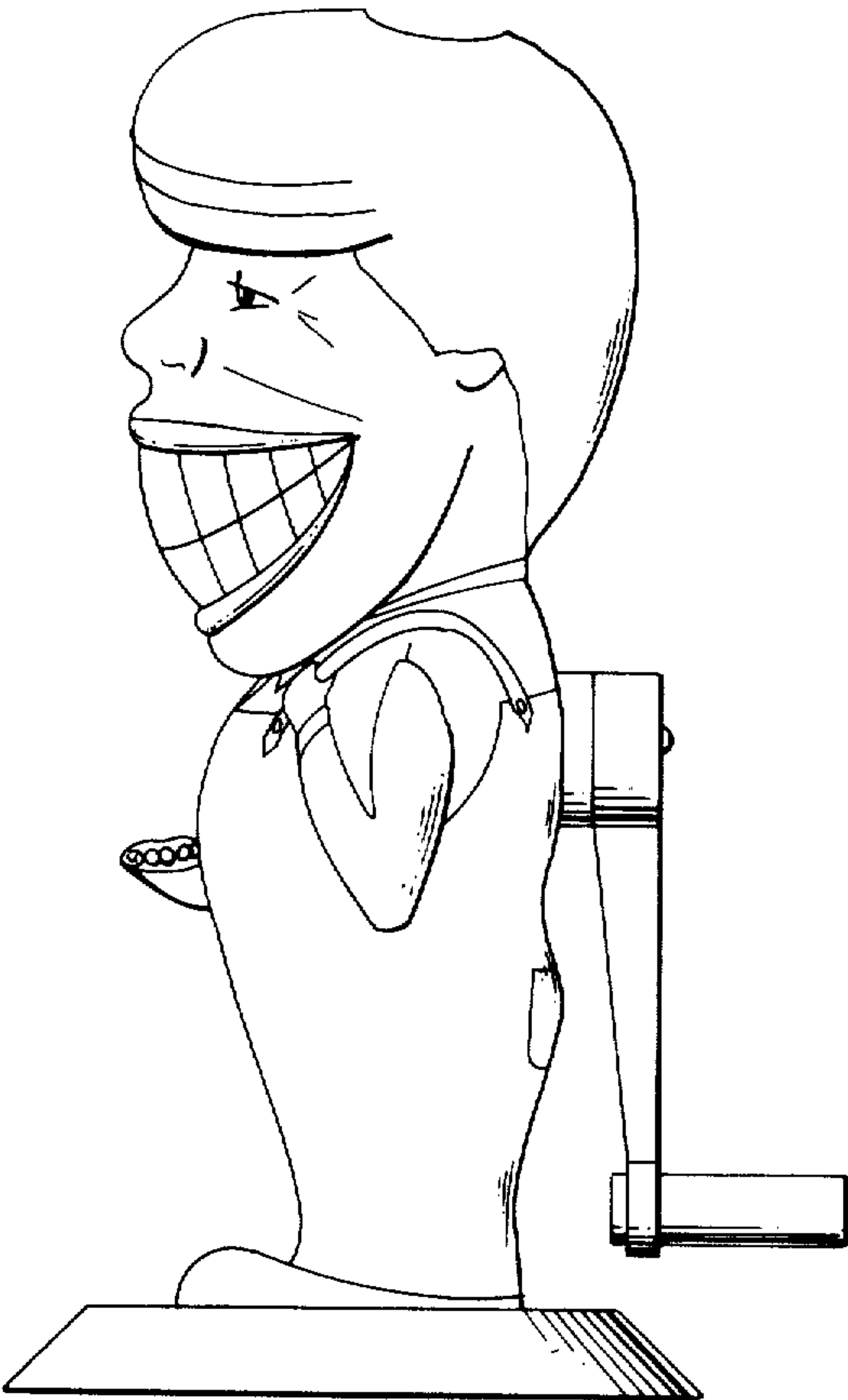

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a food grinder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of a food grinder showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevation view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevation view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevation view thereof; and
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof.
The bottom of the food grinder is flat and unornamented.



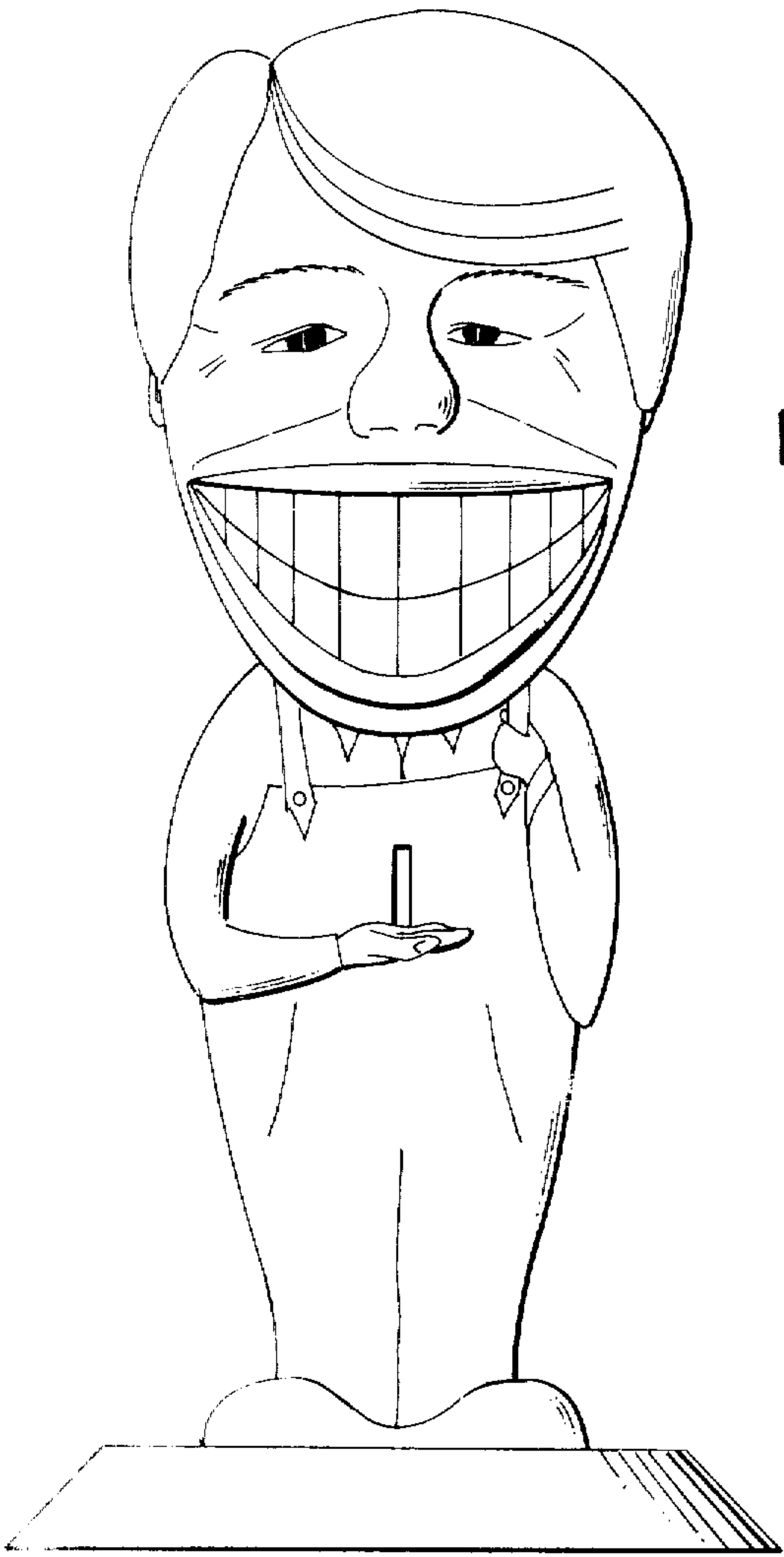

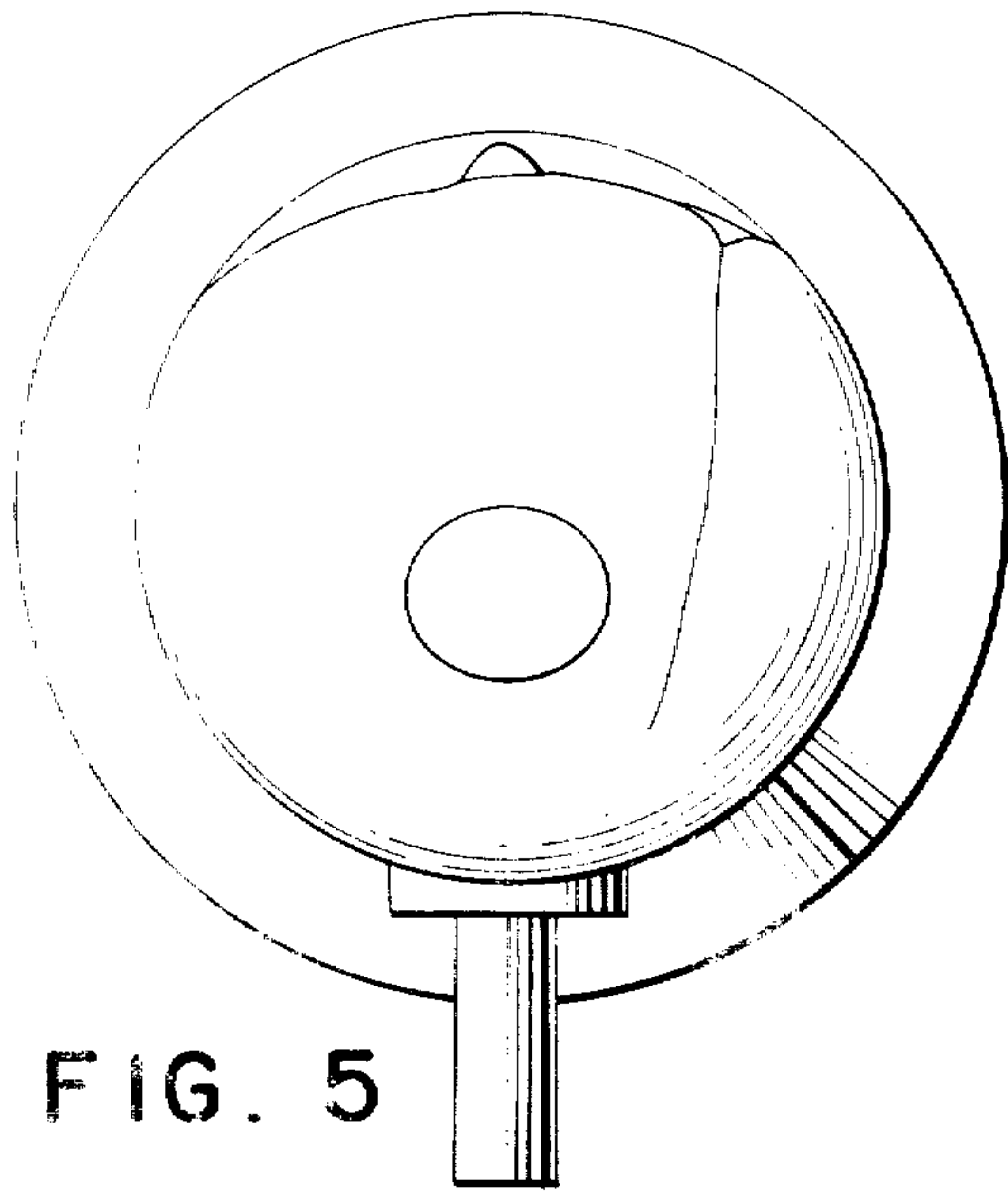
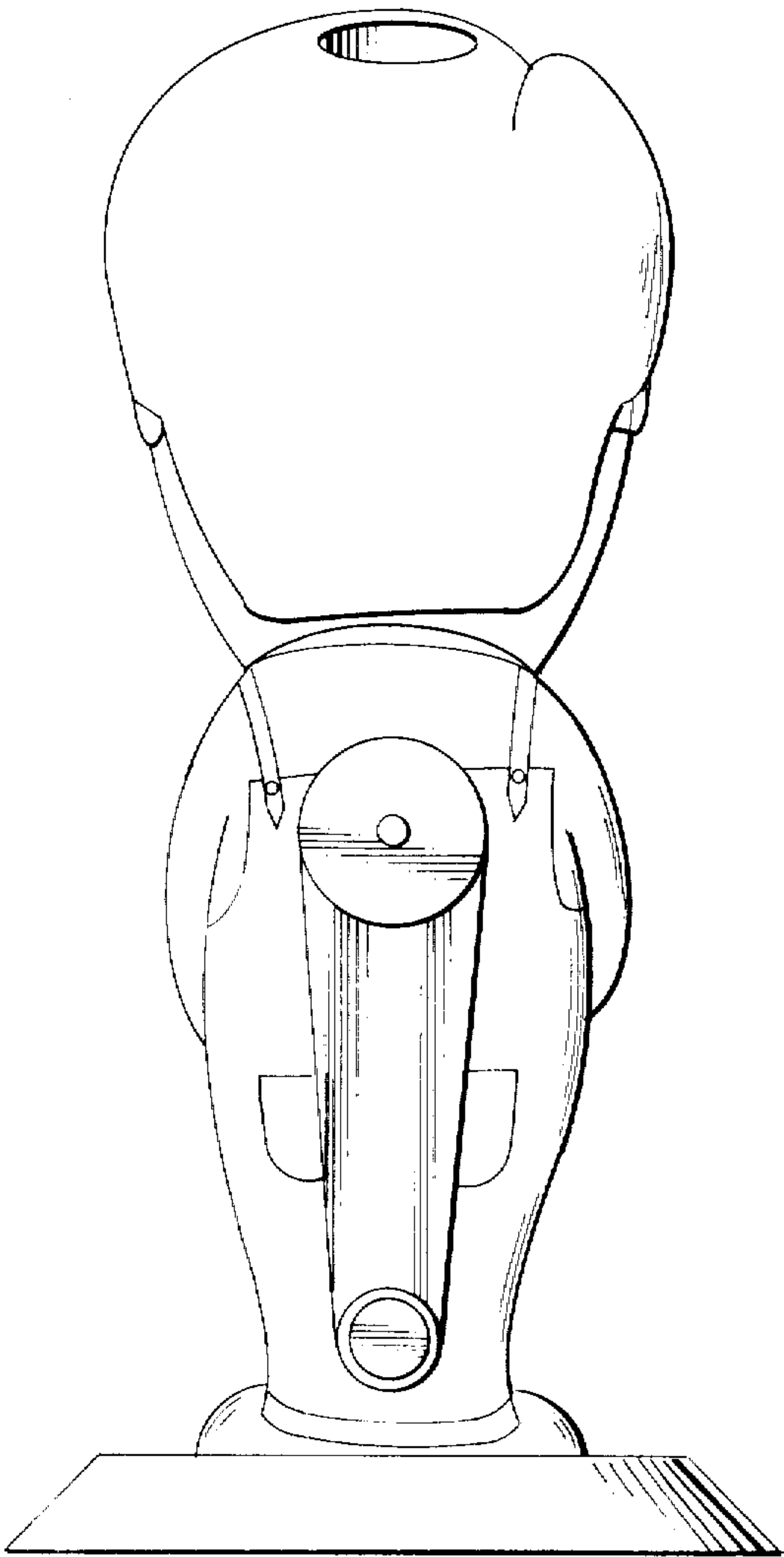

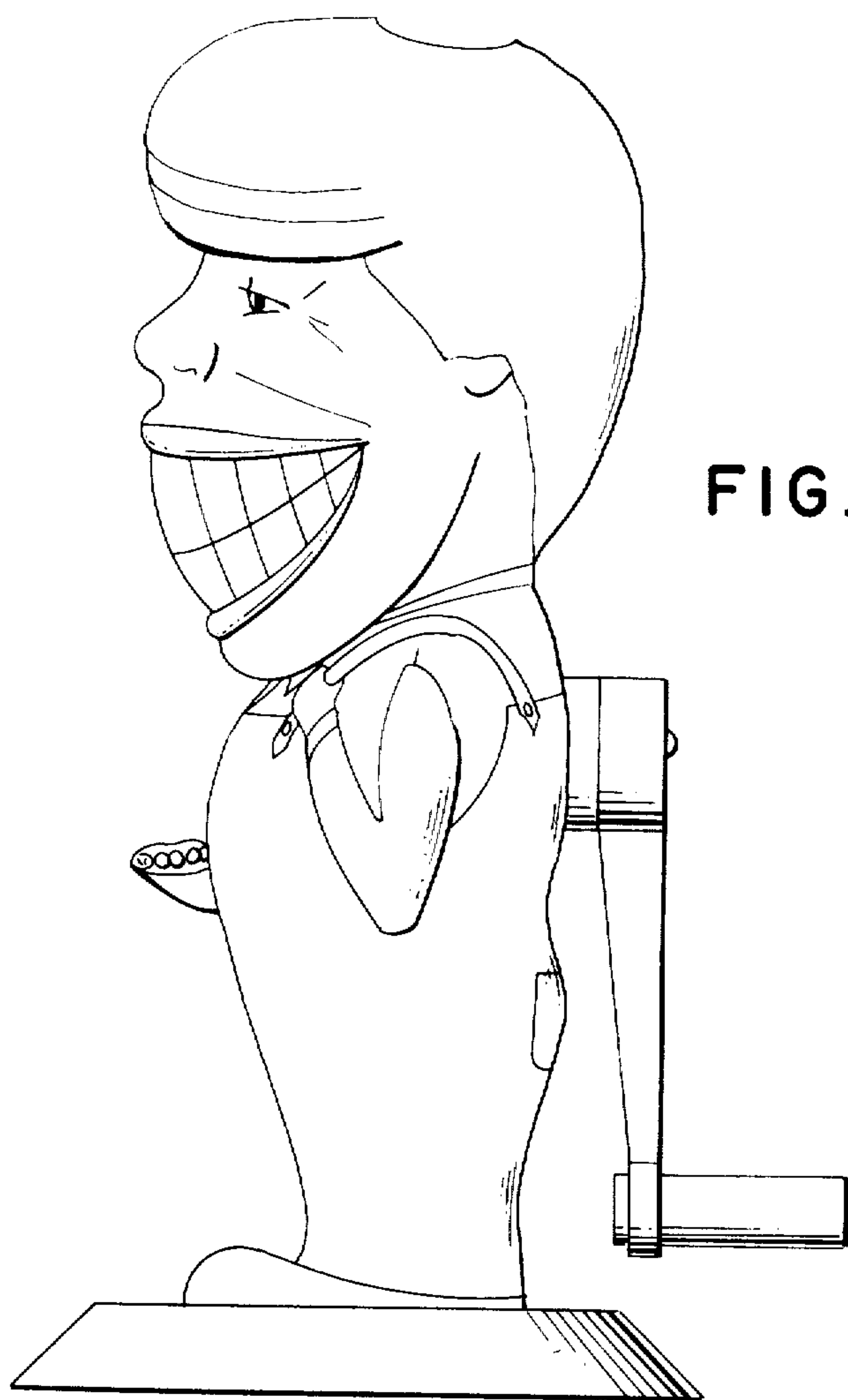
