CLAIM

[57]

The ornamental design for a storage jar or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a storage jar showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is an exploded rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a fragmentary developed plan view of the surface decoration shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of a storage jar showing my new design in a different size and proportion to that shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a fragmentary developed plan view of the surface decoration shown in FIG. 5;

FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of a storage jar showing my new design in a still different size and proportion to that shown in FIG. 1; and

FIG. 8 is a fragmentary developed plan view on an enlarged scale of the surface decoration shown in FIG.
