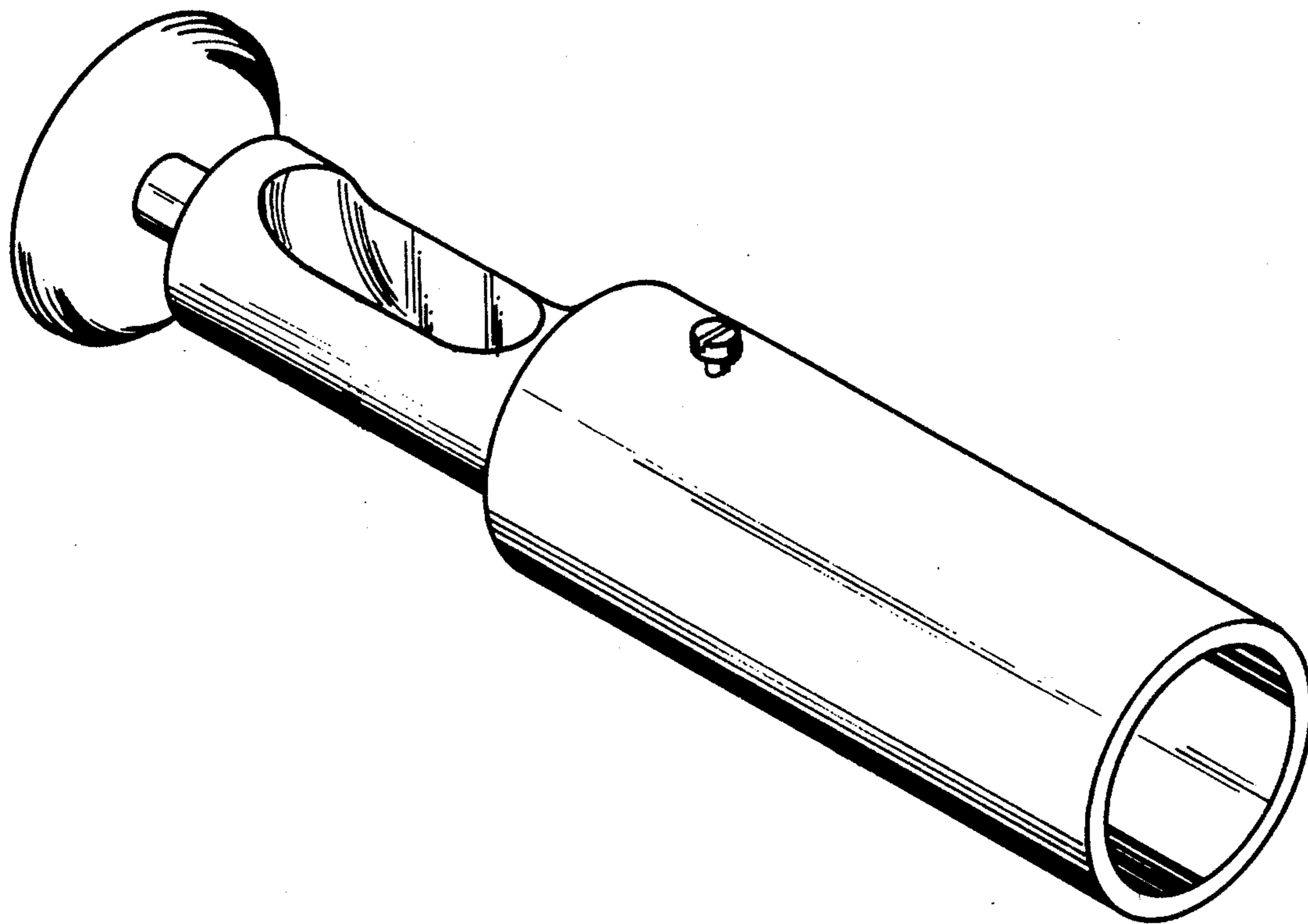
The ornamental design for a shotgun shell cutter, substantially as shown and described.

FIG. 3 is a perspective view of the shotgun shell cutter of the instant design.



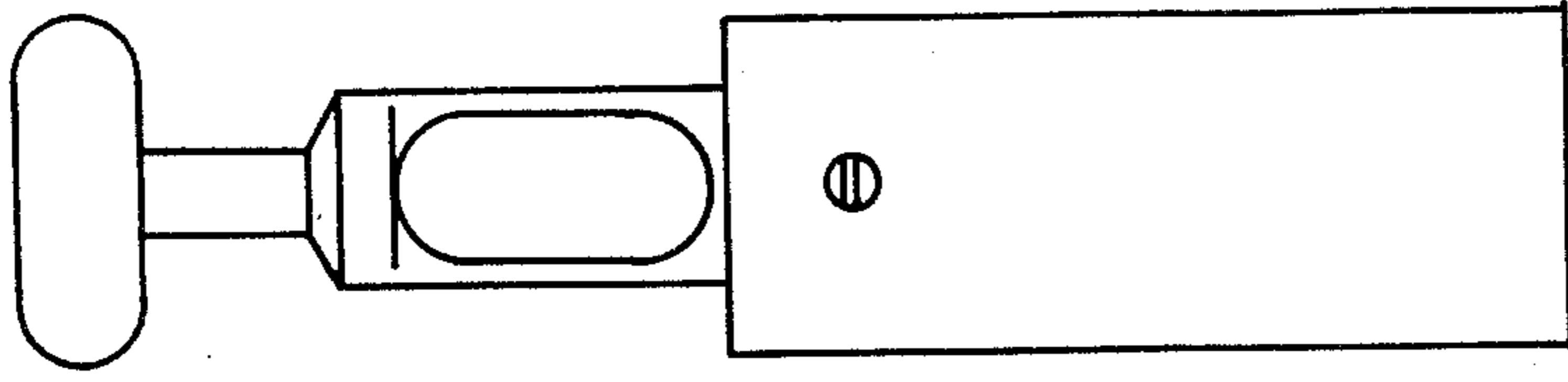

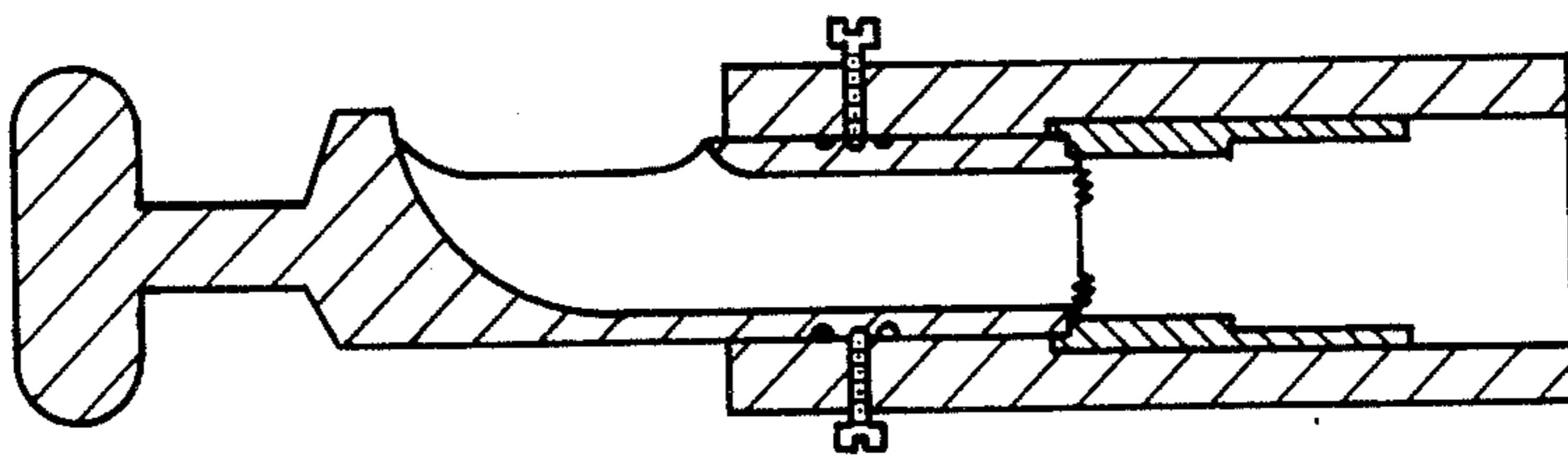

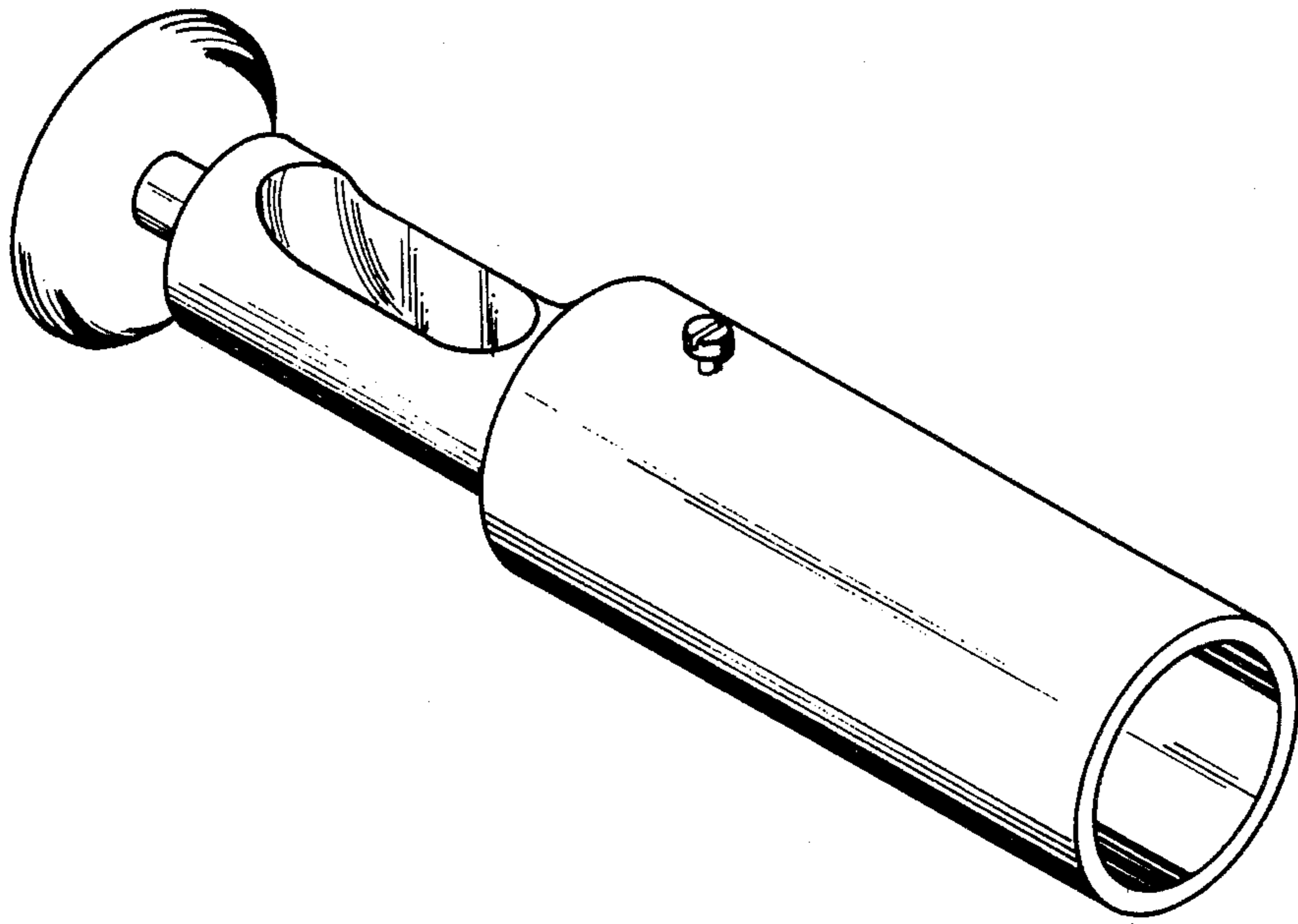
