[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a modular track assembly for a 300-unit biological sample changer, substantially as shown.

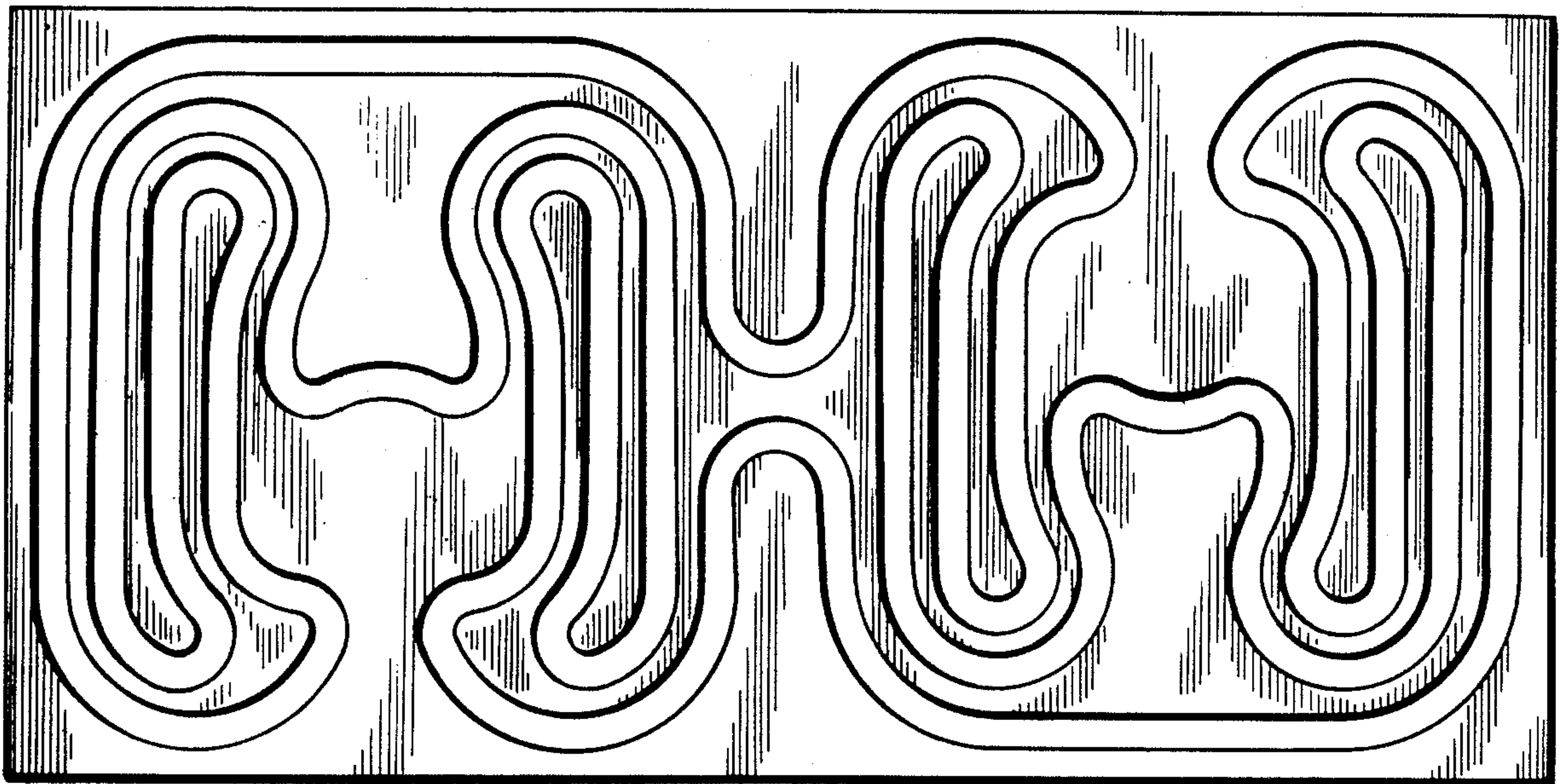

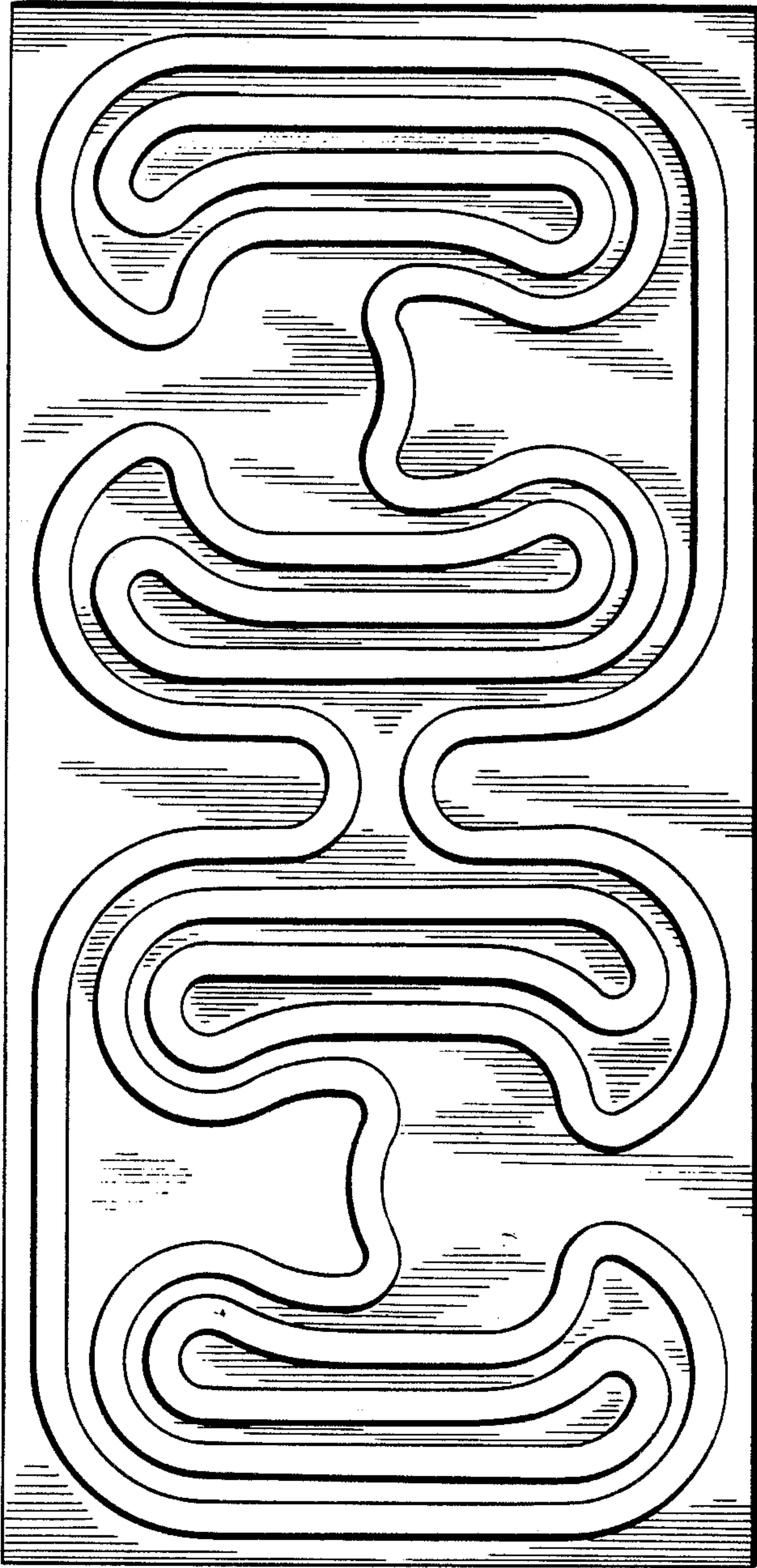
