FIG. 4 is a cross section of the same taken on the line 4-4 of FIG. 1.

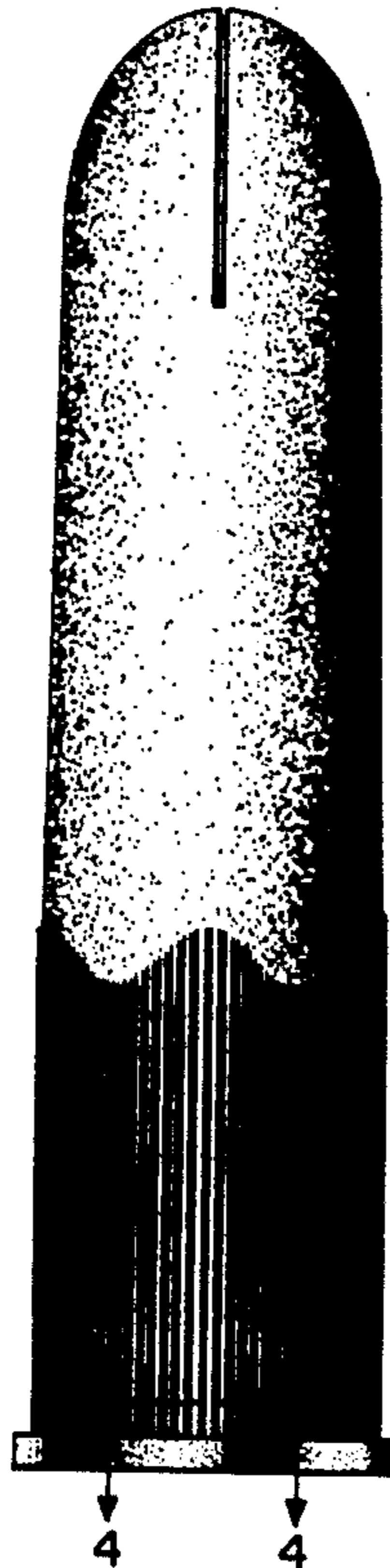
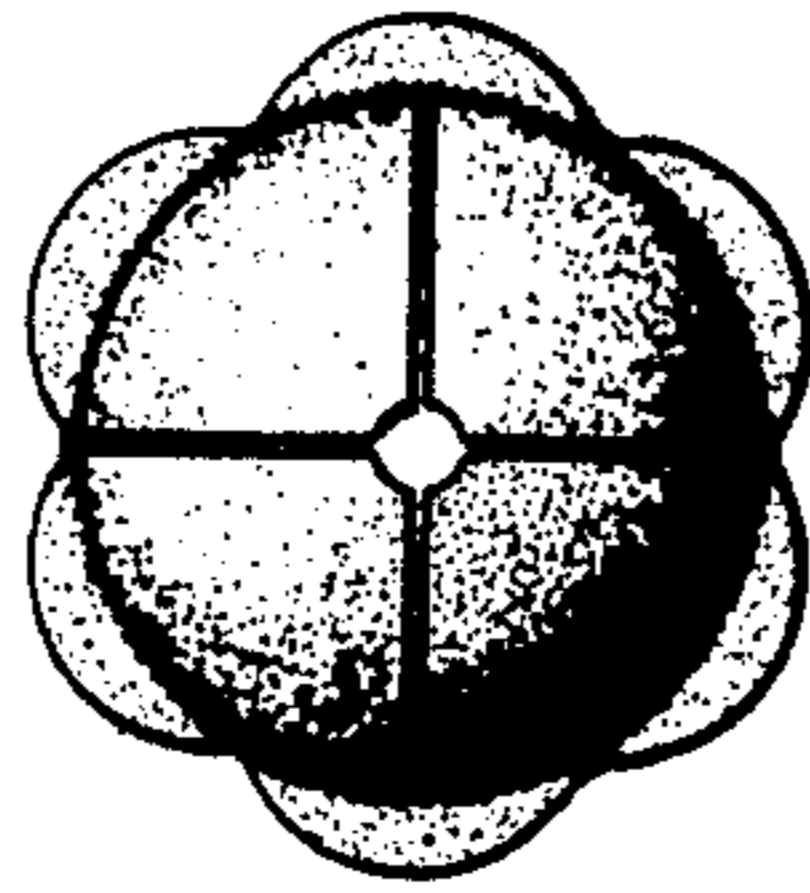

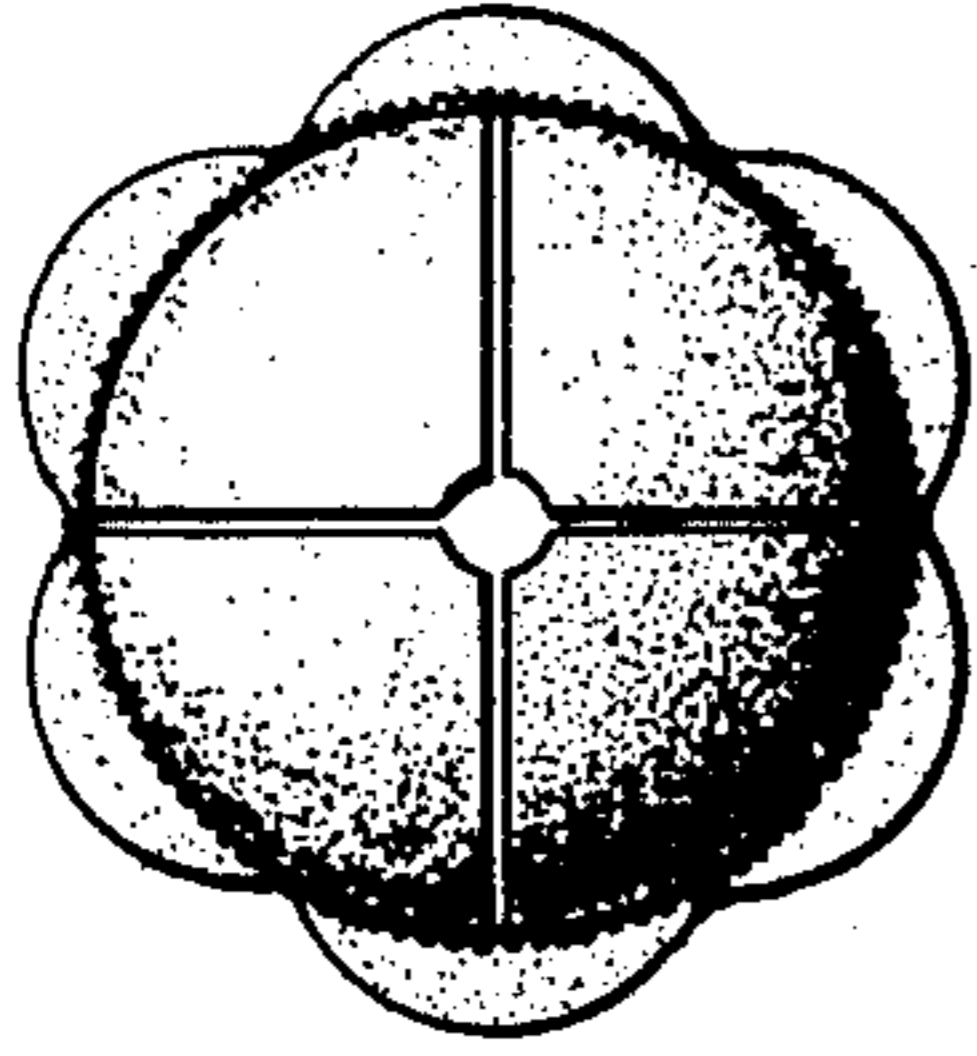

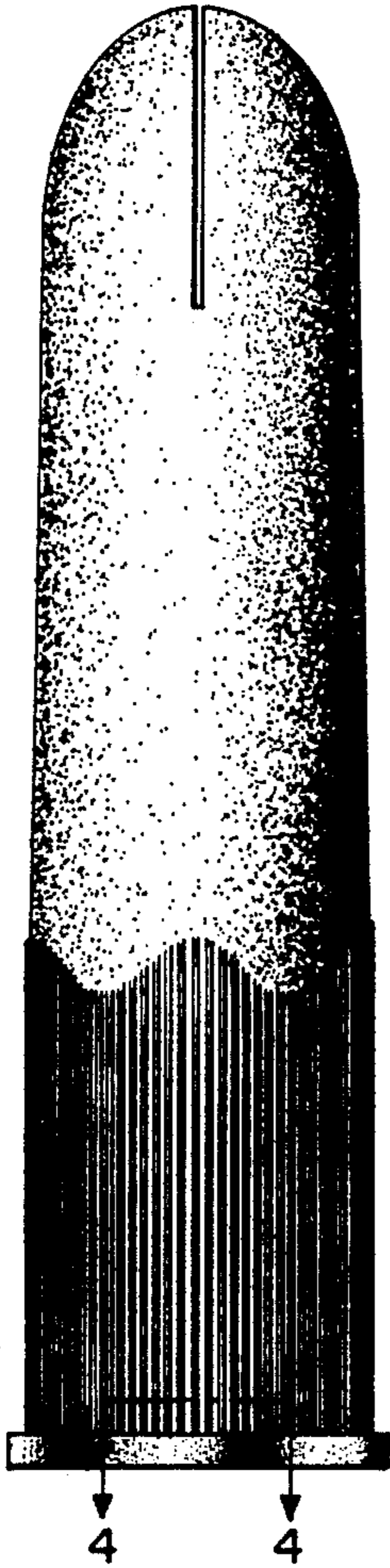

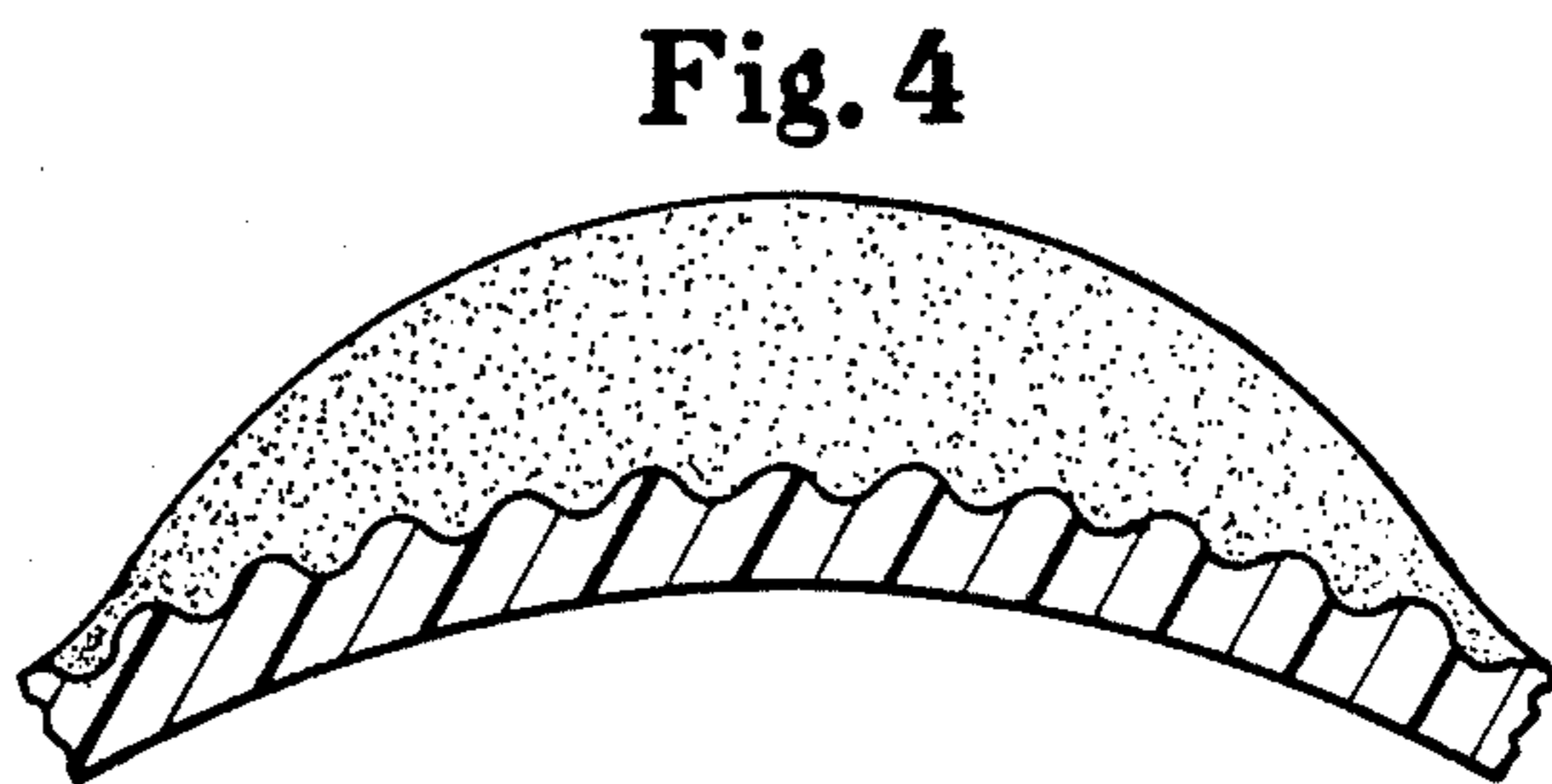

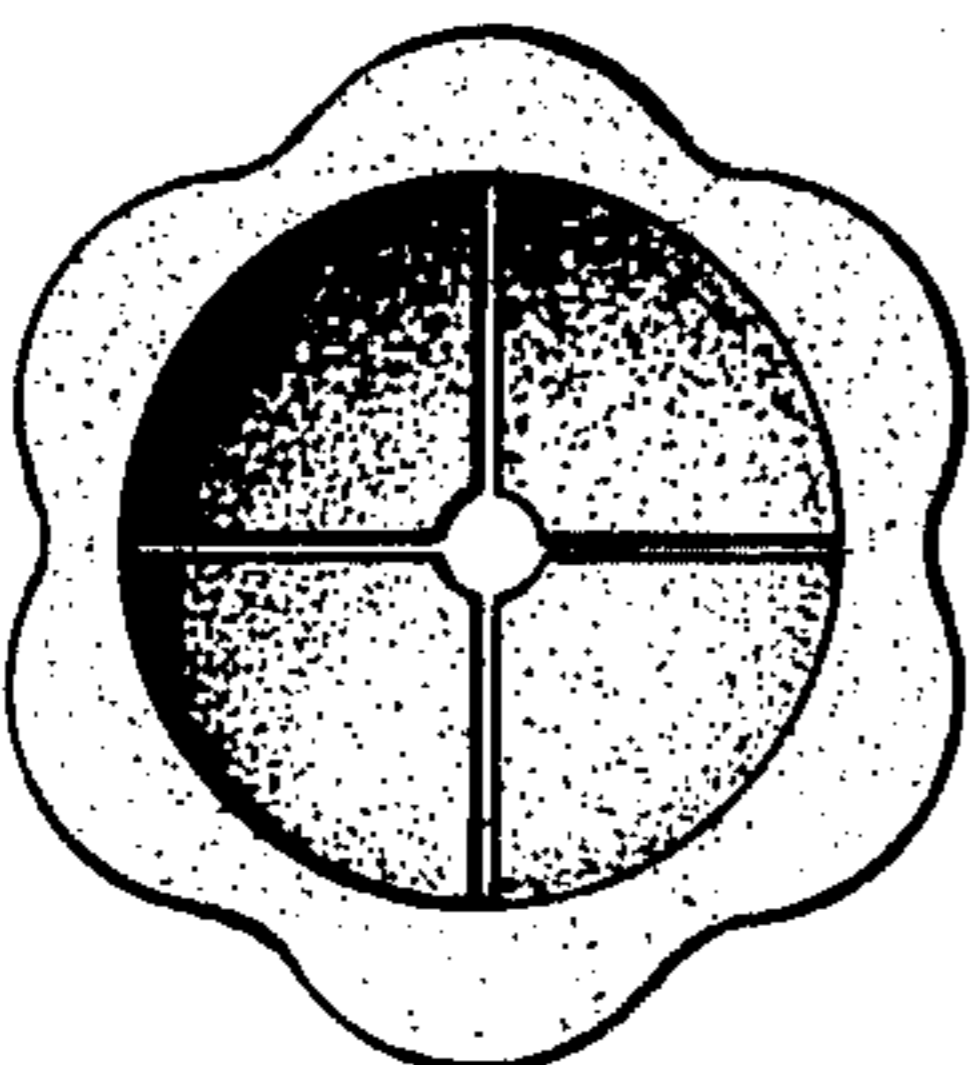
