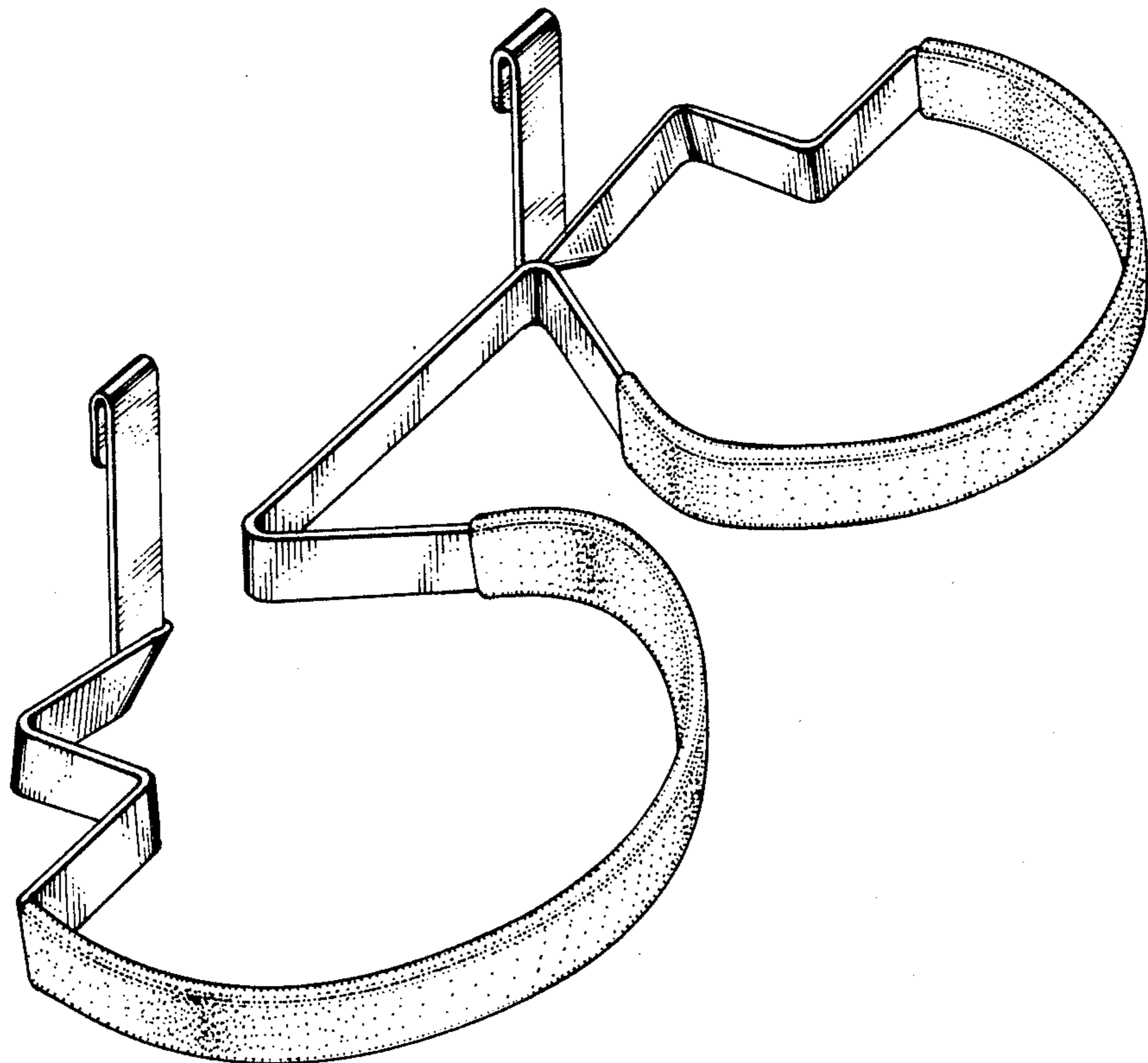

FIG. 1 is a top front perspective view of a shoe rack for locker doors or the like showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a bottom rear perspective view thereof.



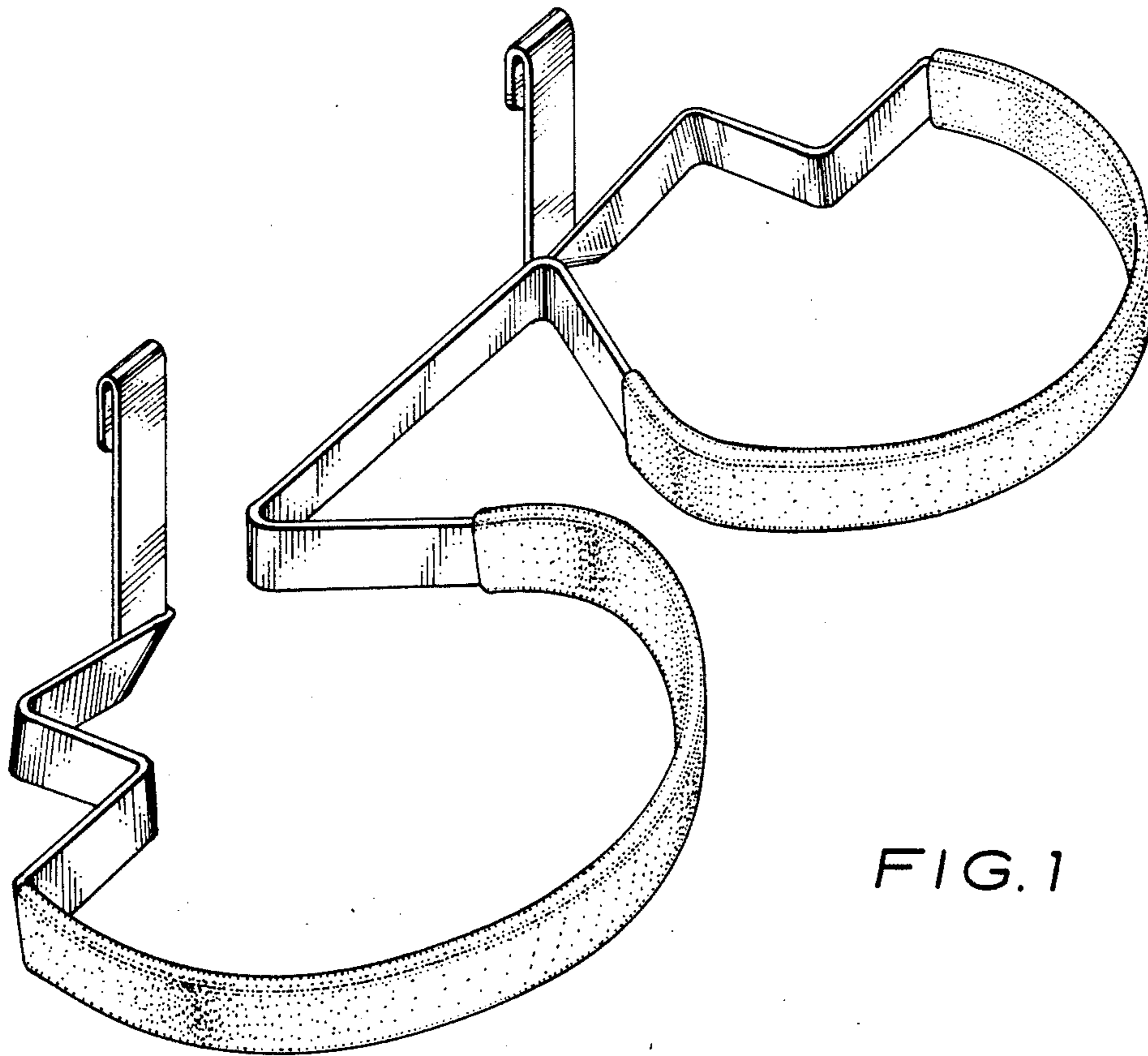

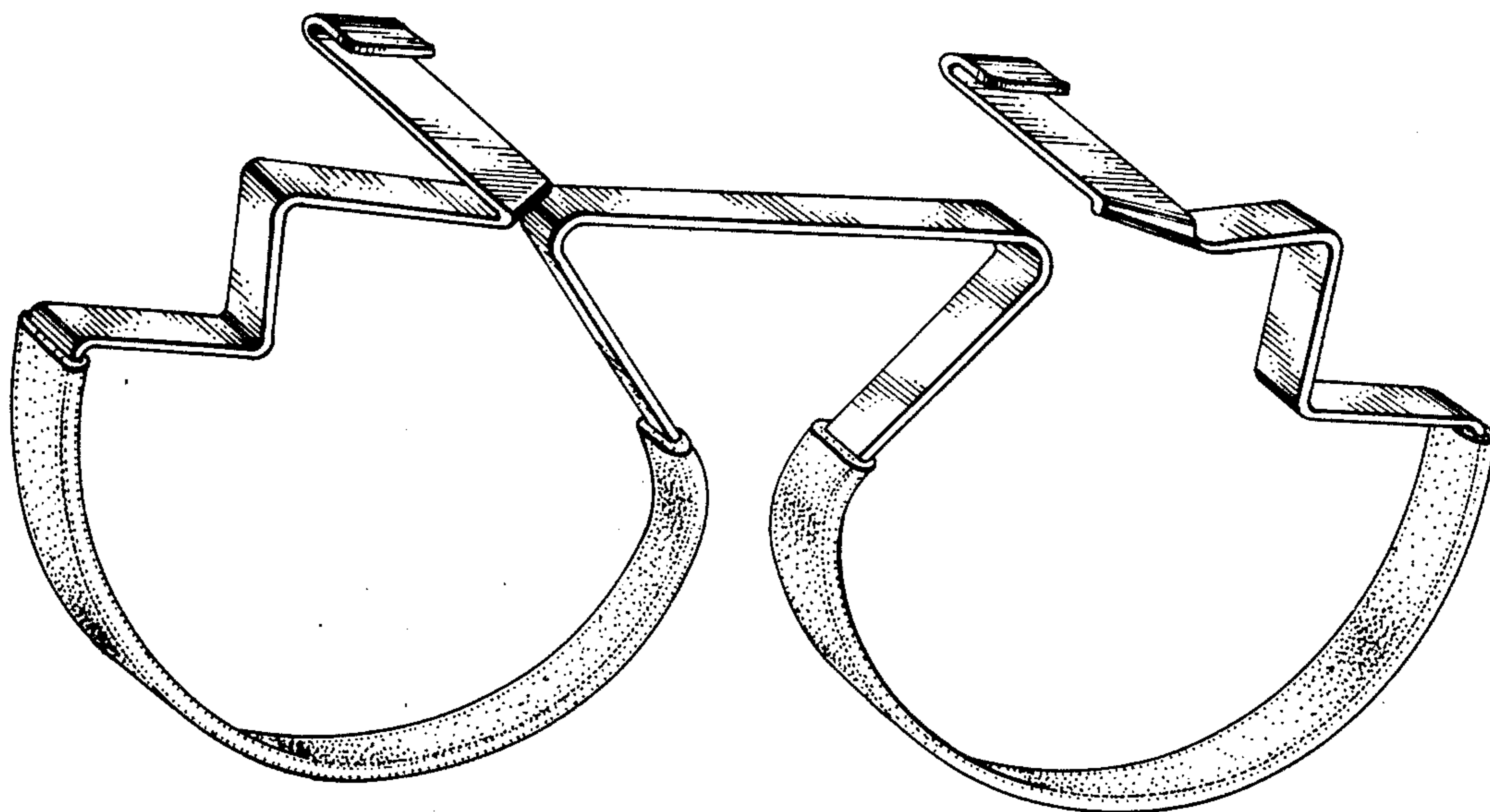
