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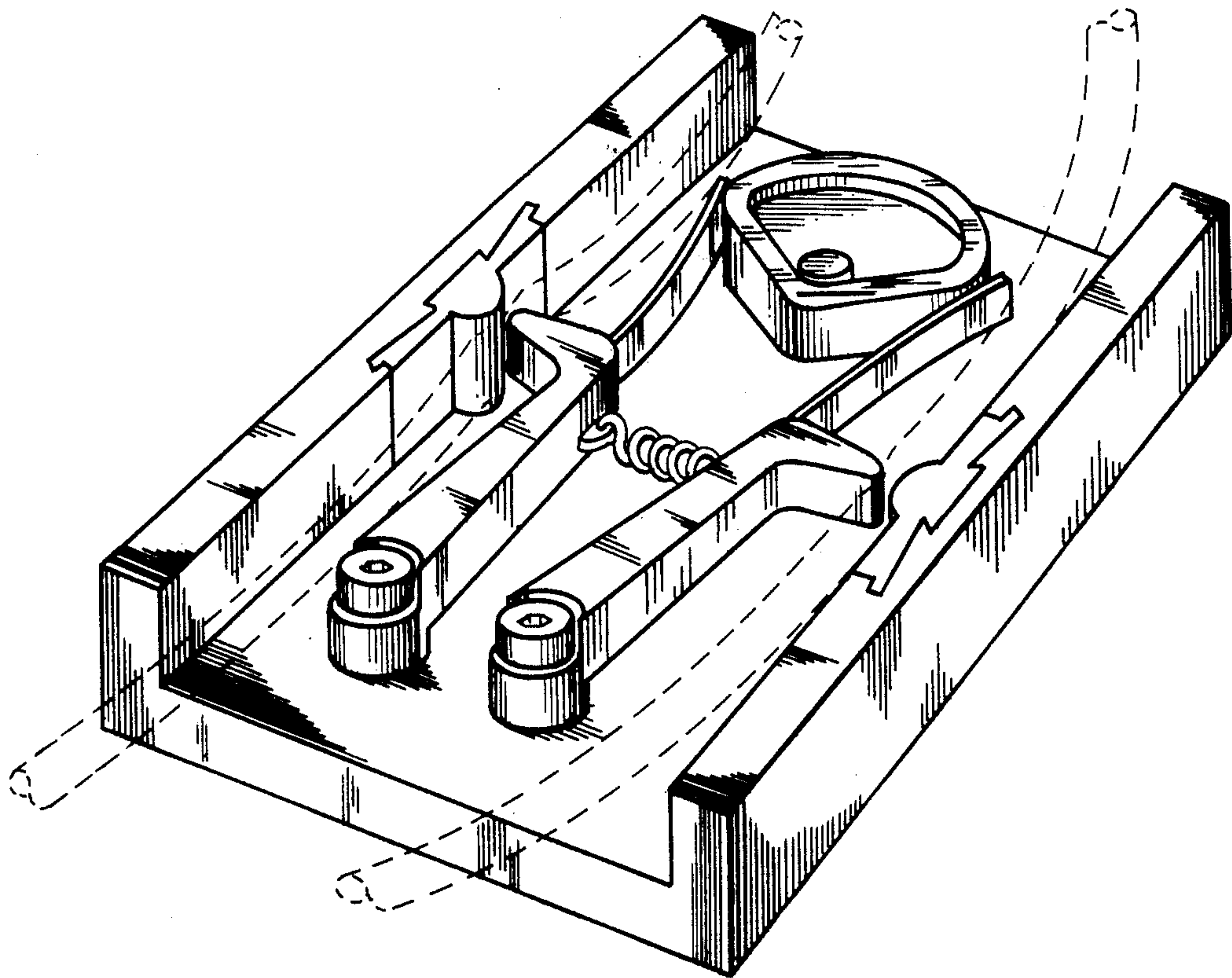

The broken lines are shown for illustrative purposes only.



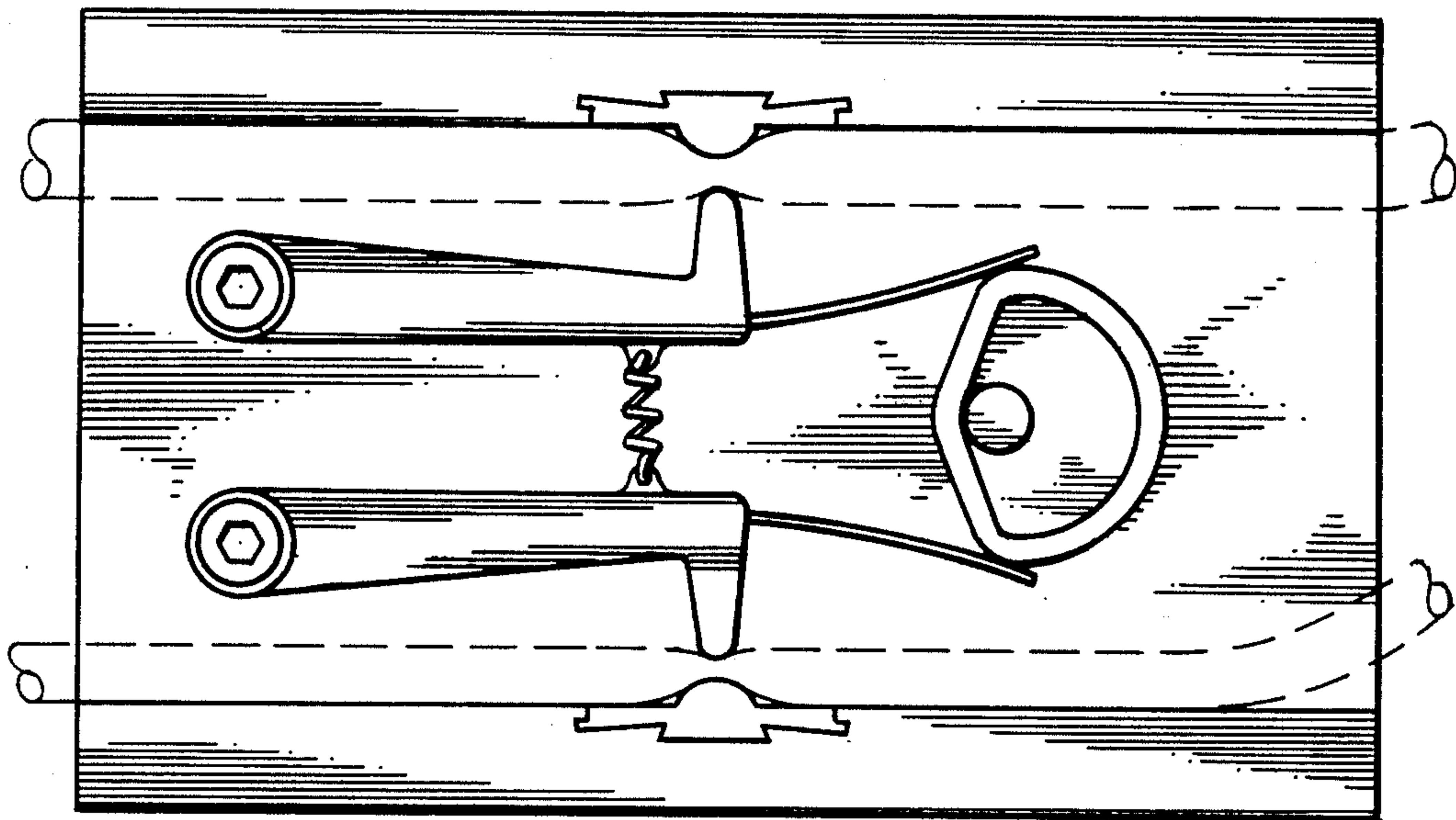

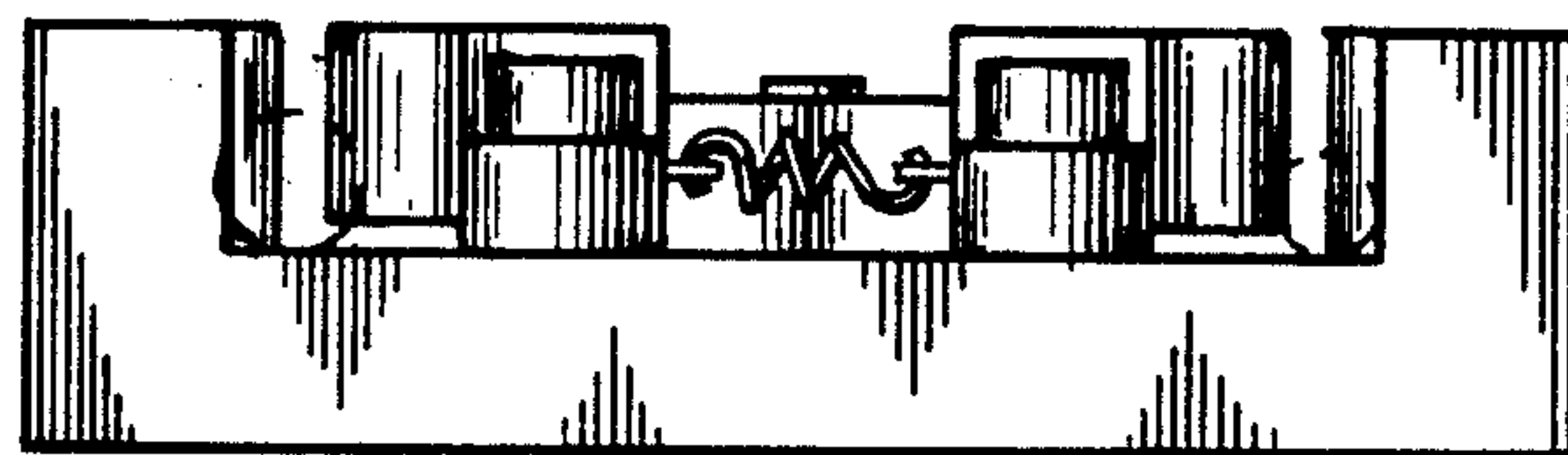

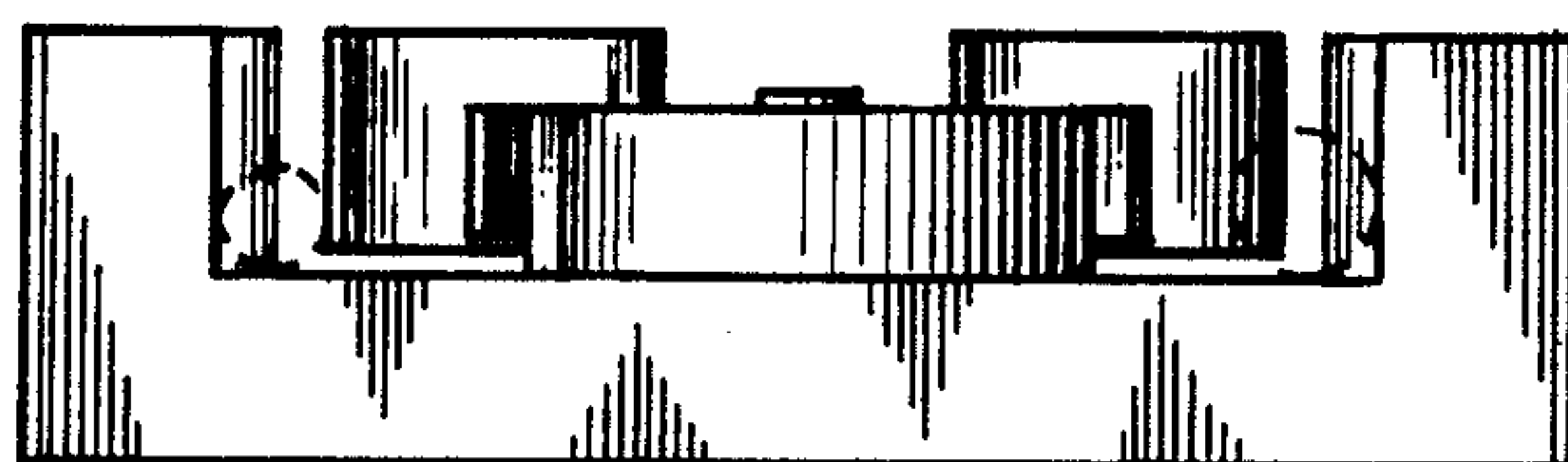

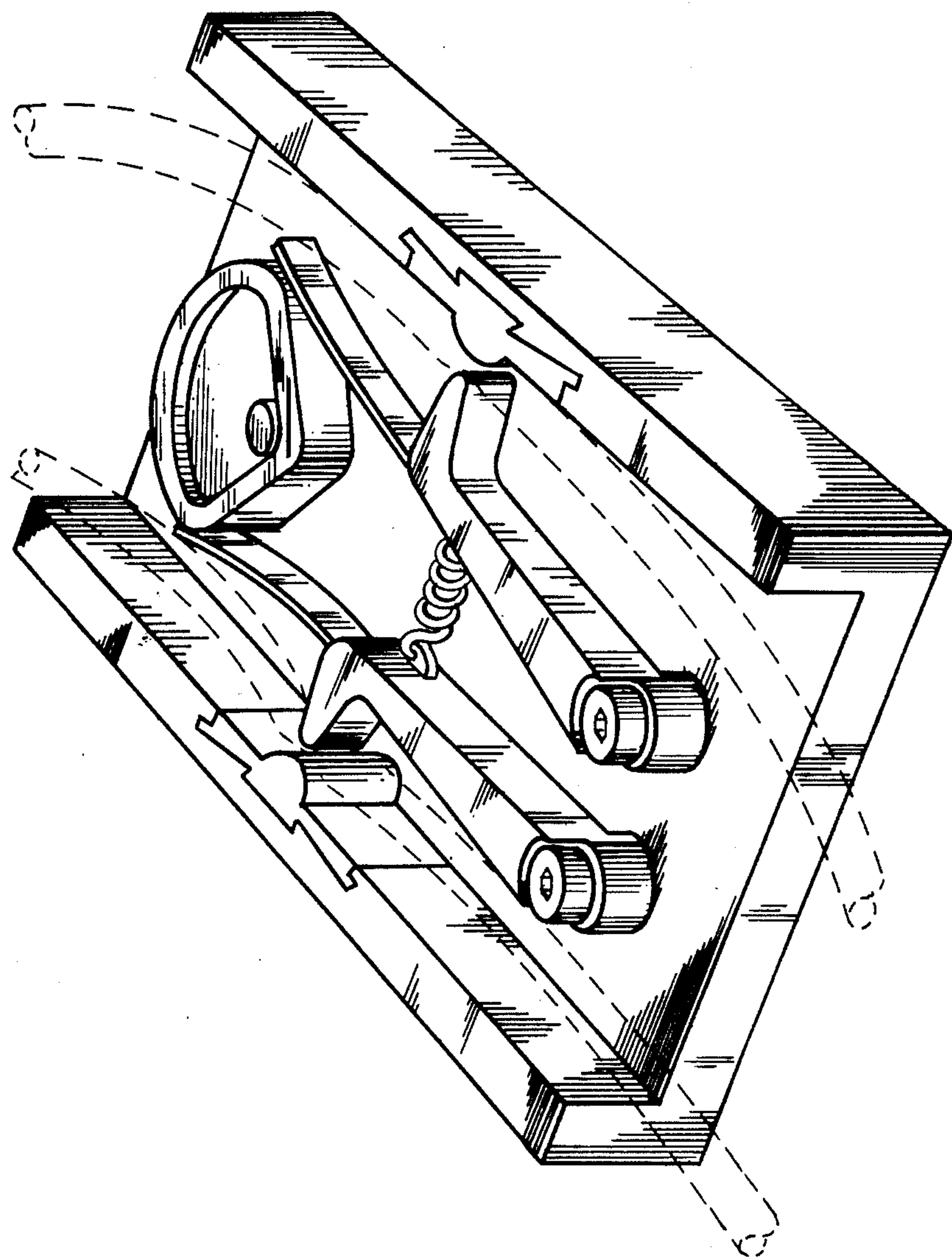
