DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a position indicator showing my new design;

 FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.

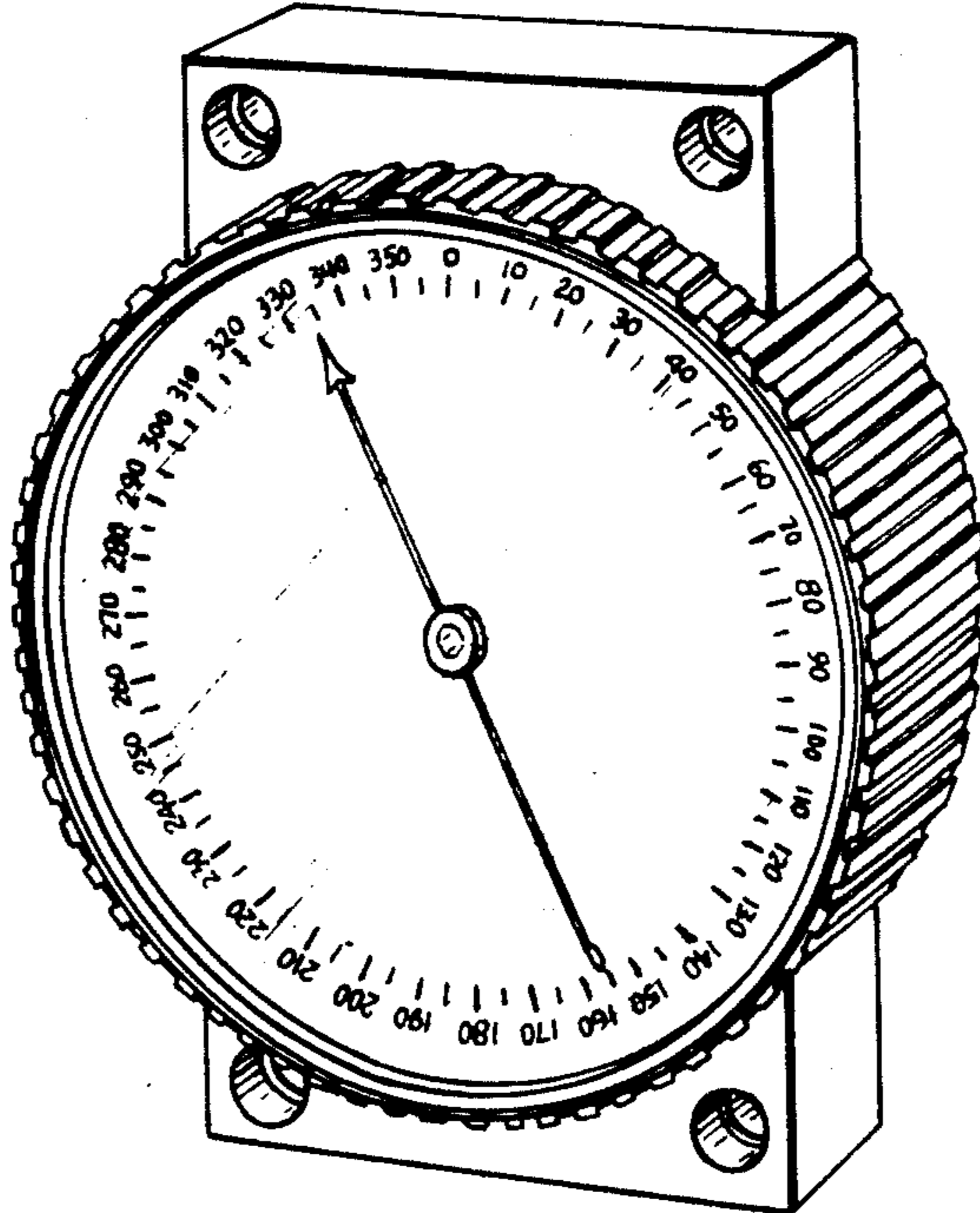

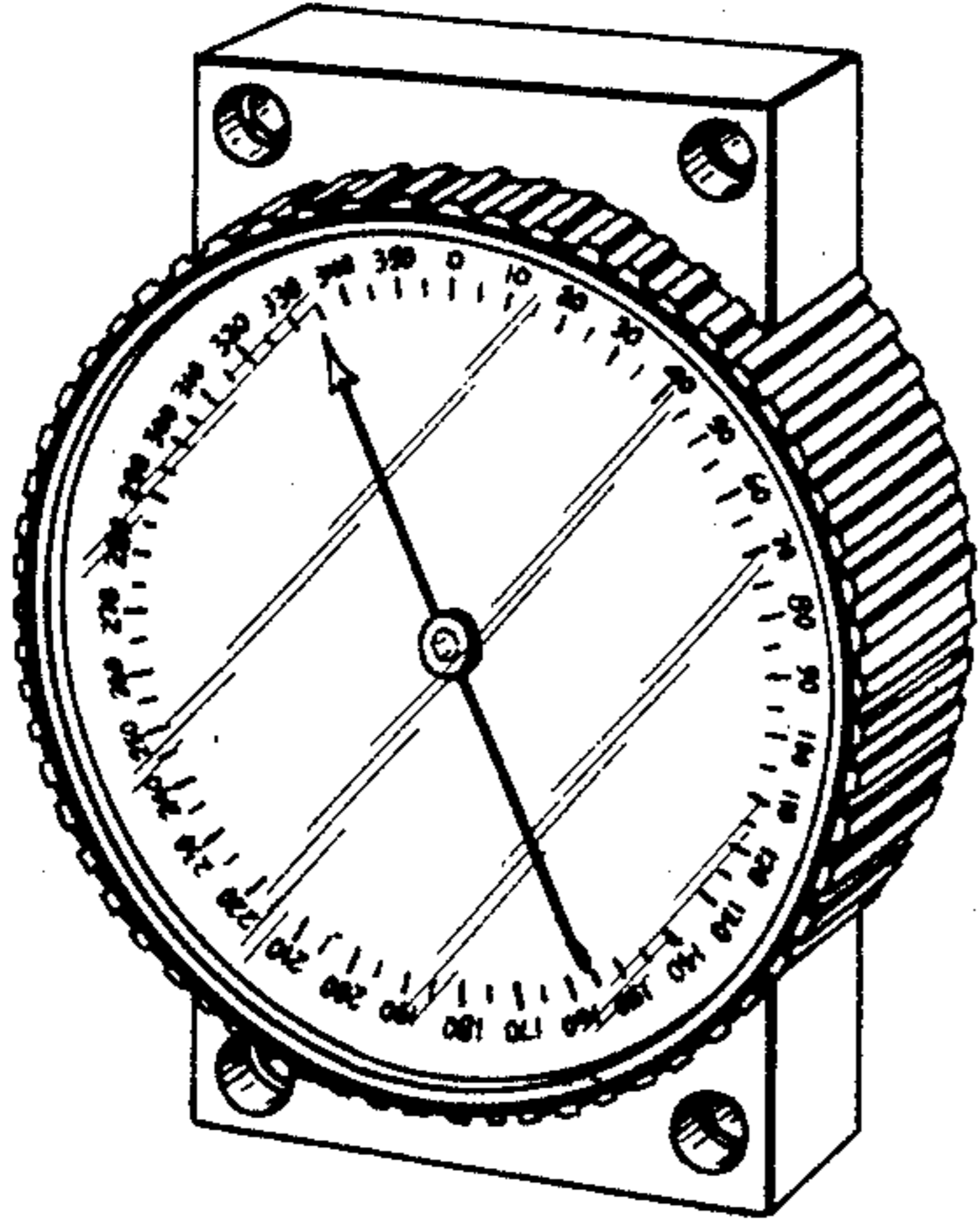

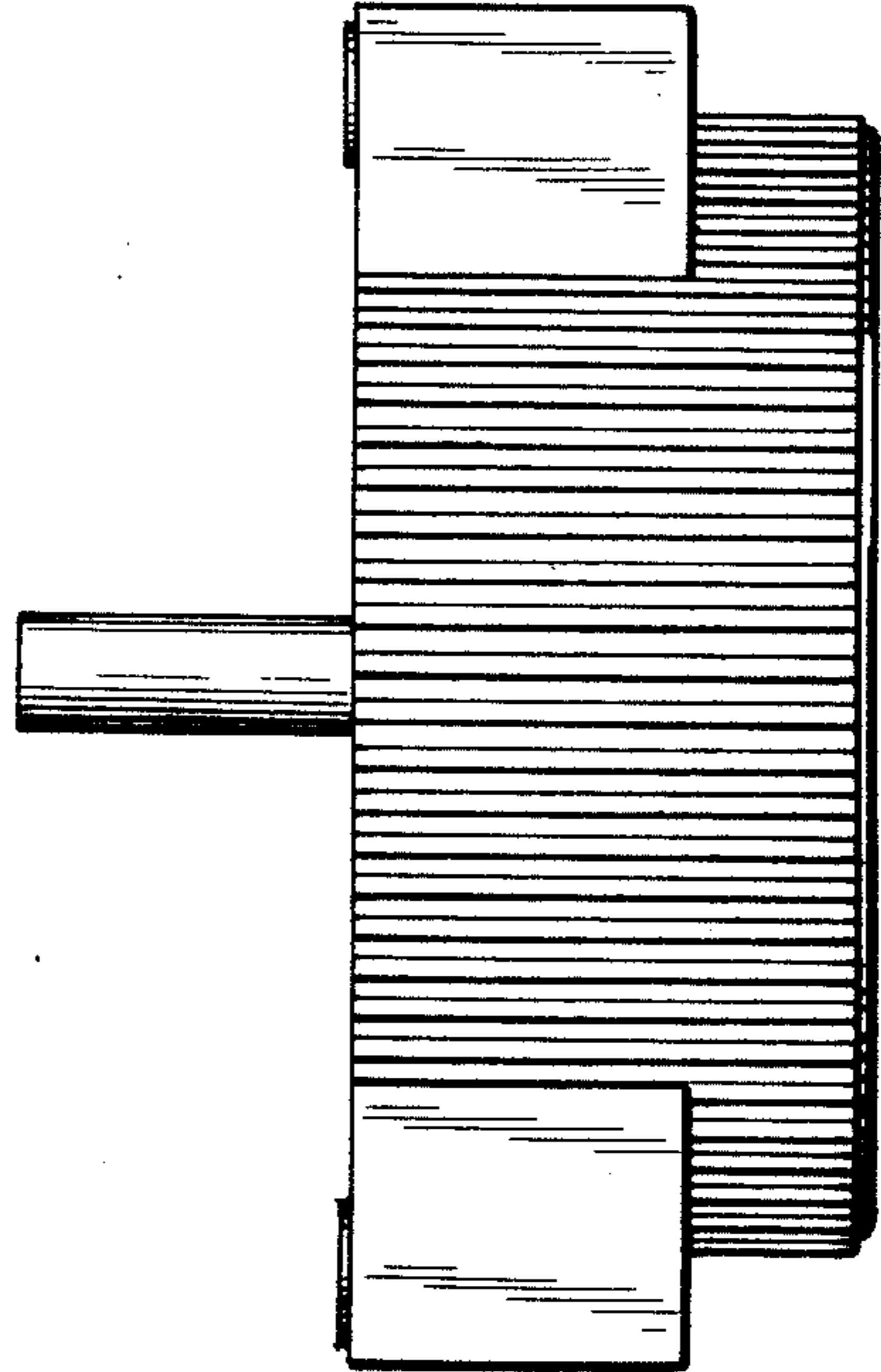

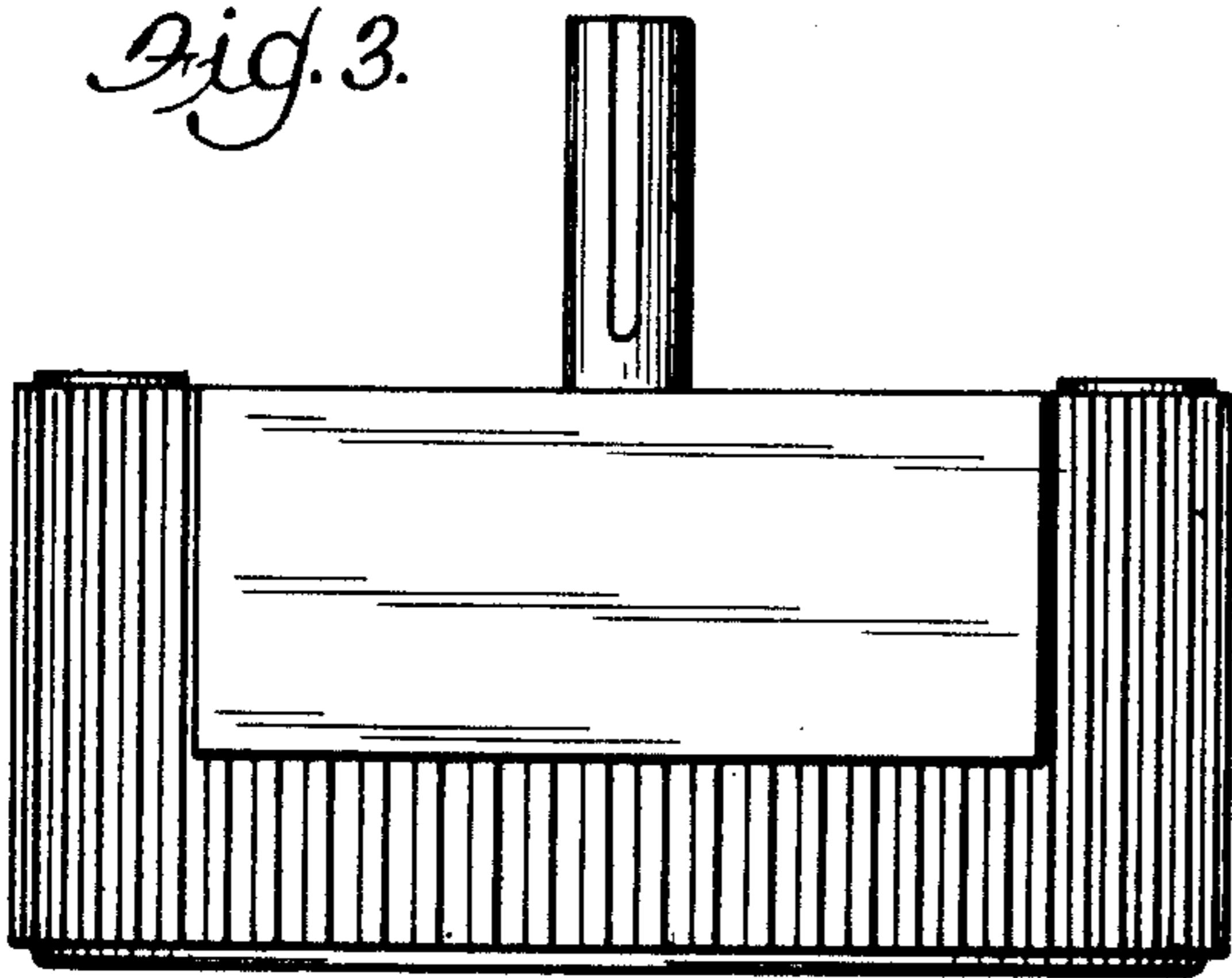

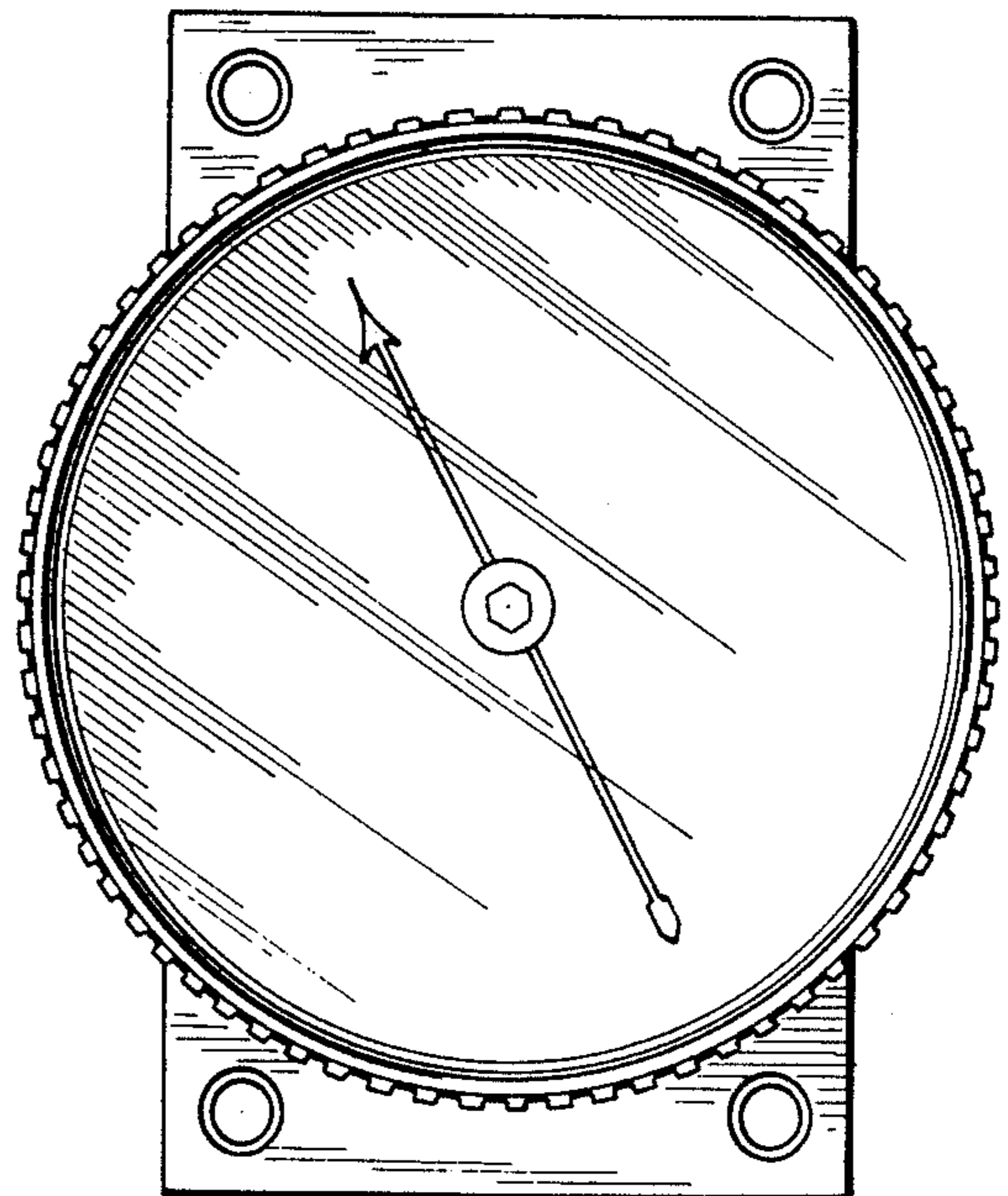
