The ornamental design for a precious, semiprecious or synthetic cut stone, as shown and described.

#### DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a precious, semiprecious, or synthetic cut stone showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof; and

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof.
