The ornamental design for a transport container for dangerous liquids, as shown and described.

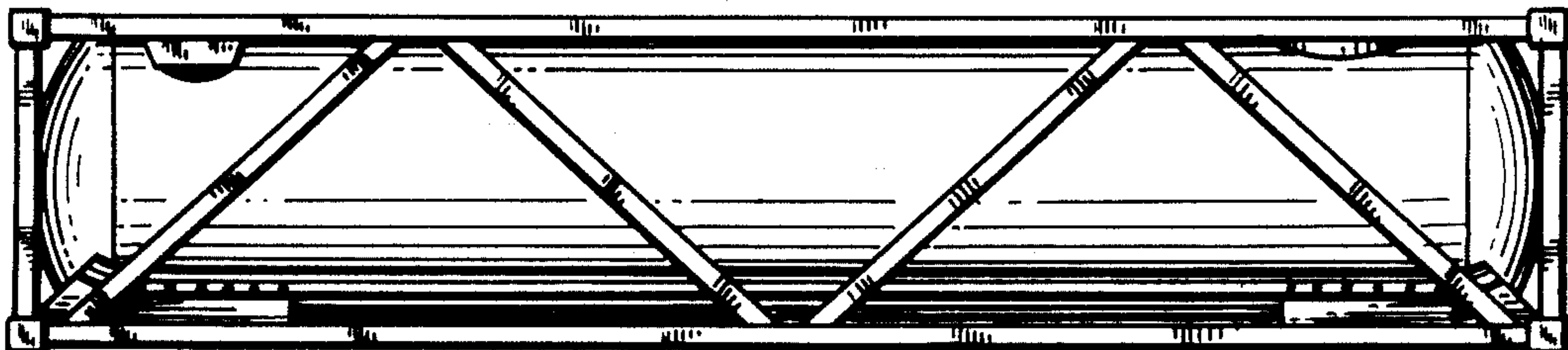
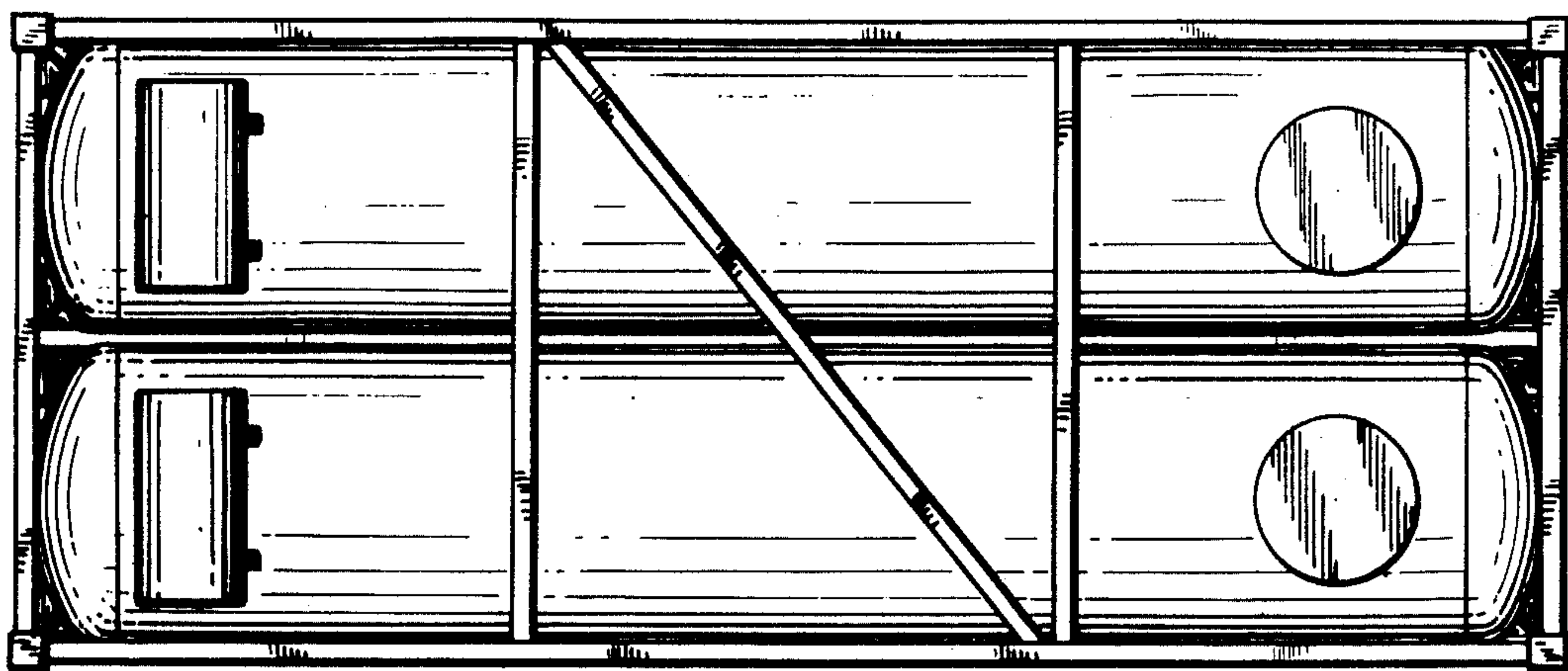
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of the transport container for dangerous liquids embodying my new design.

FIG. 2 is an elevational view taken from one side thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image of the side shown.

FIG. 3 is an elevational view taken from one end thereof, the opposite end being the same as the end shown.

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.



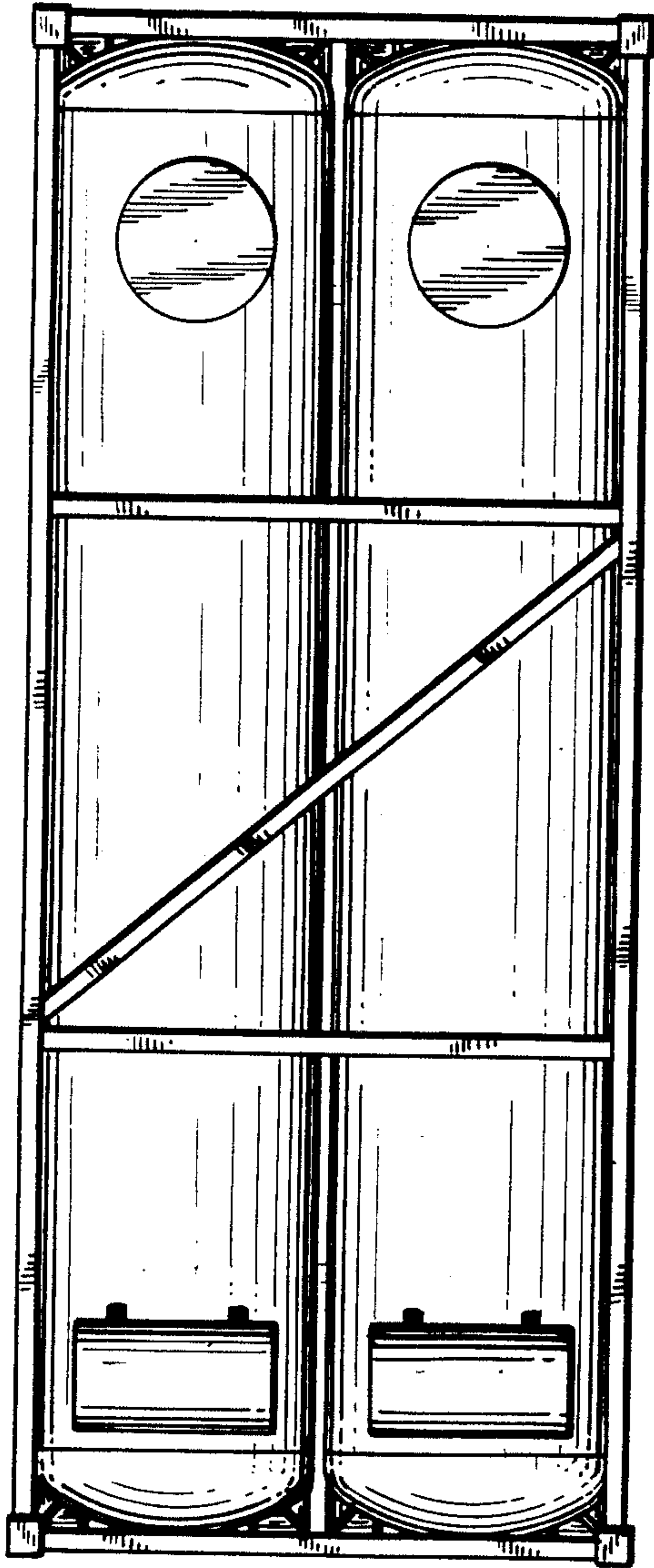

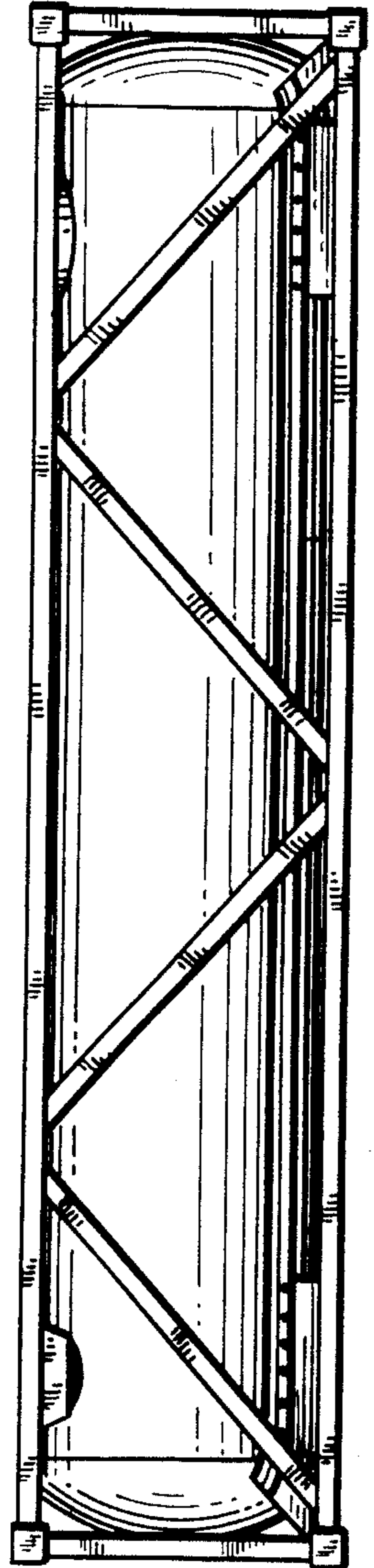

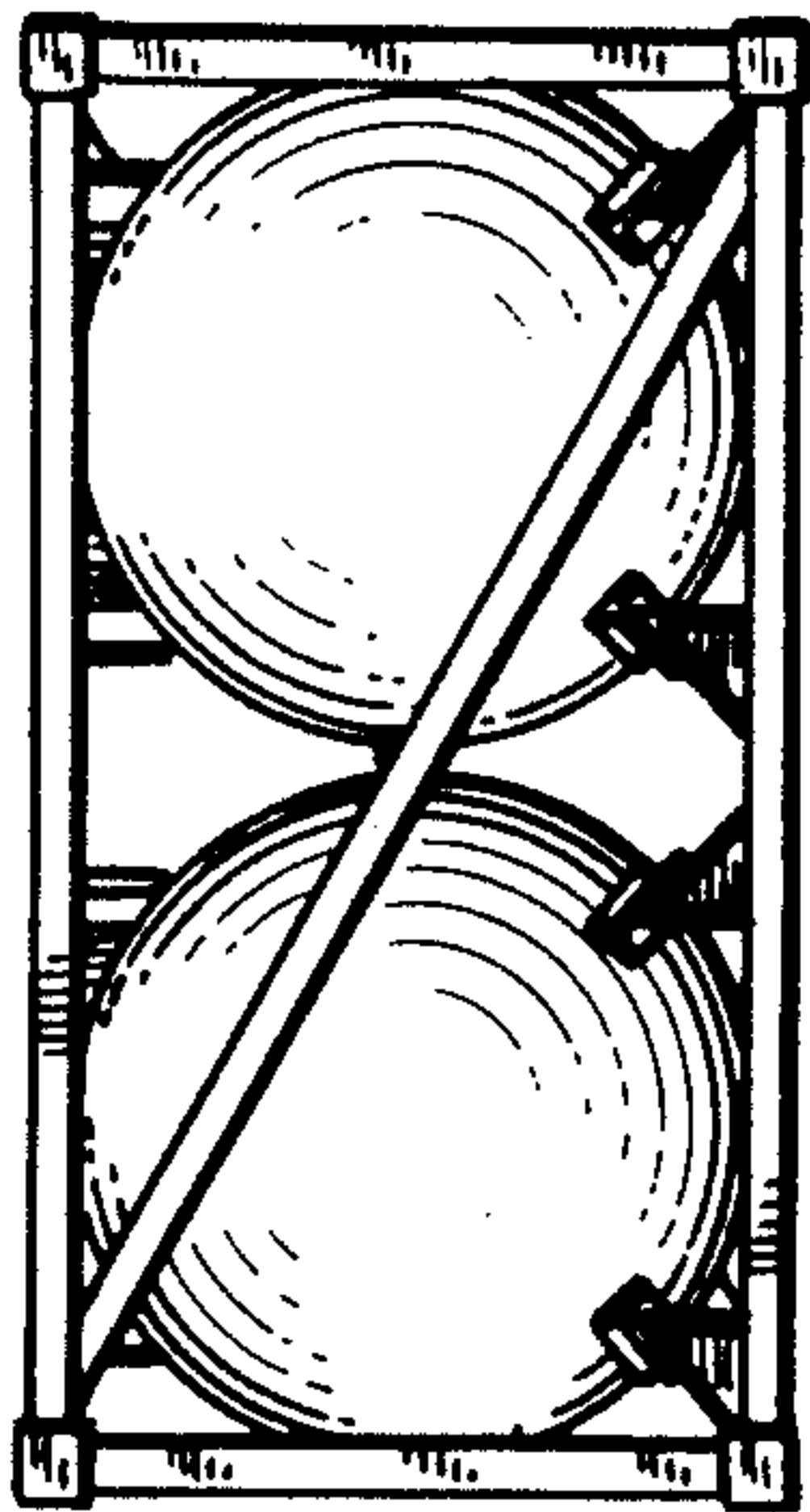

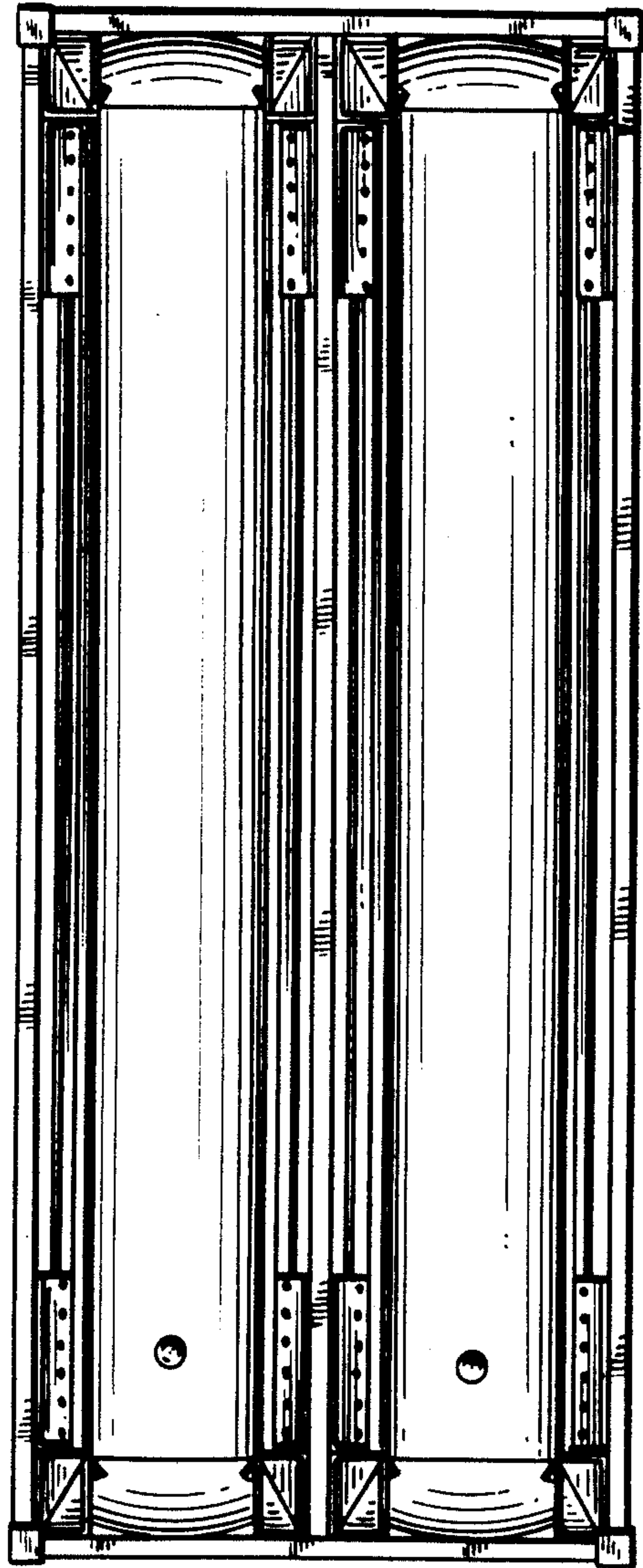
