[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a toothbrush, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a toothbrush showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
FIG. 4 is a sectional view of the head of the toothbrush taken along line 4-4 of FIG. 2.
The side of the toothbrush not shown is a mirror image of the side shown in FIG. 2.

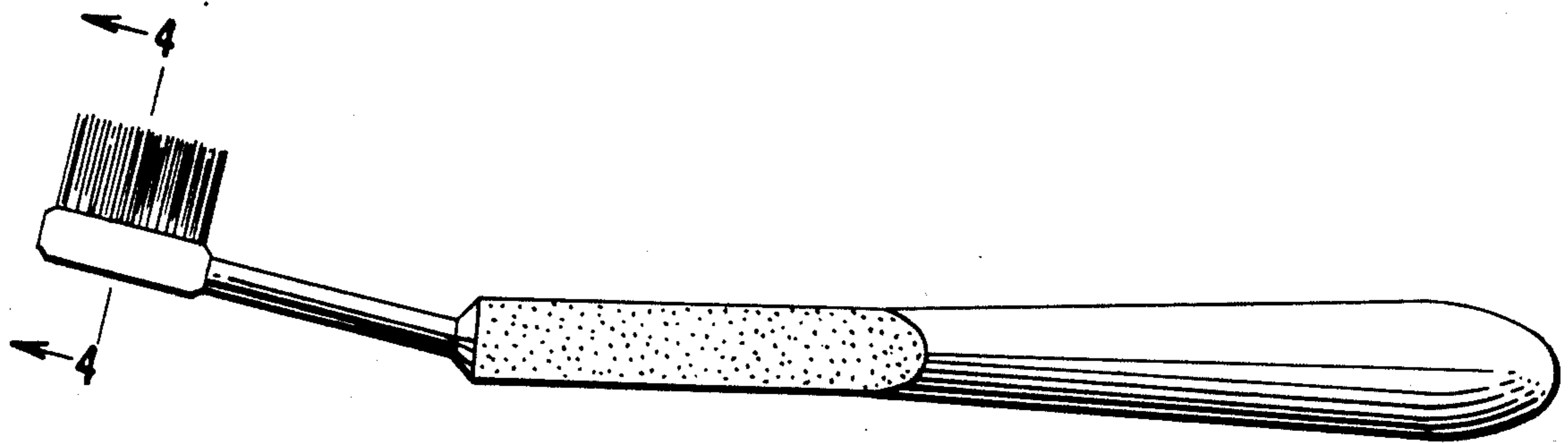

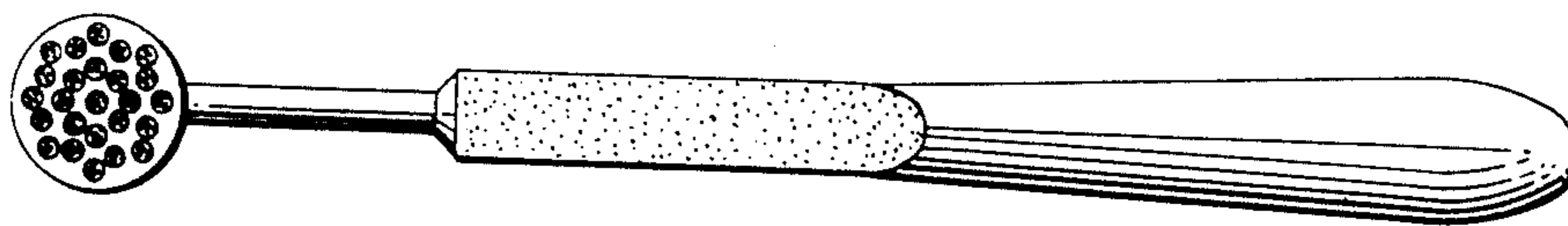

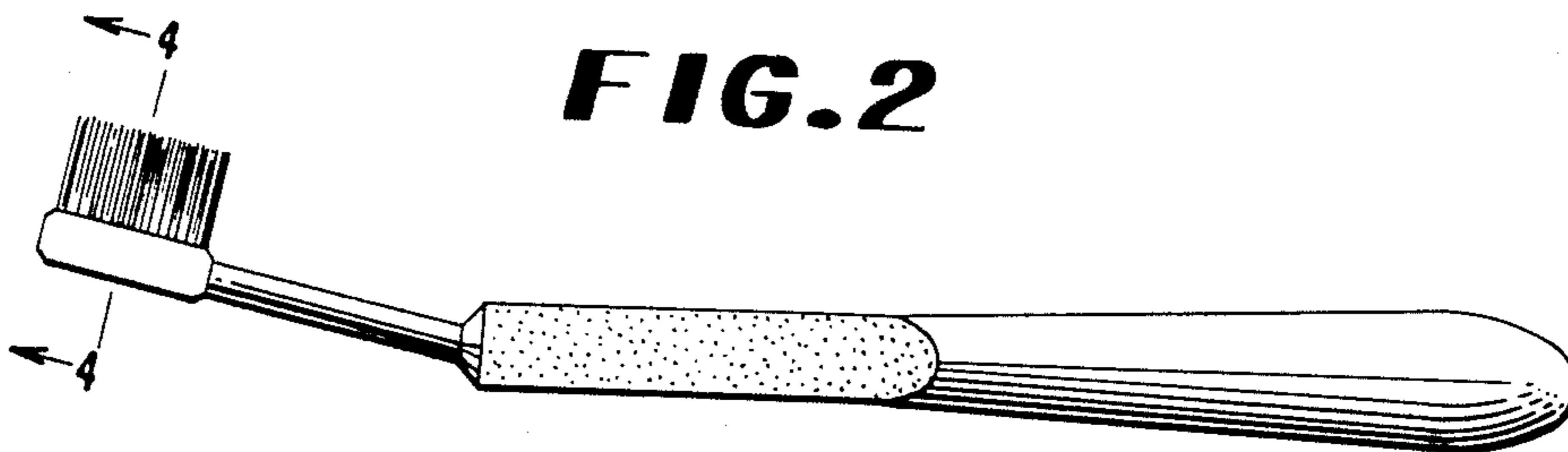

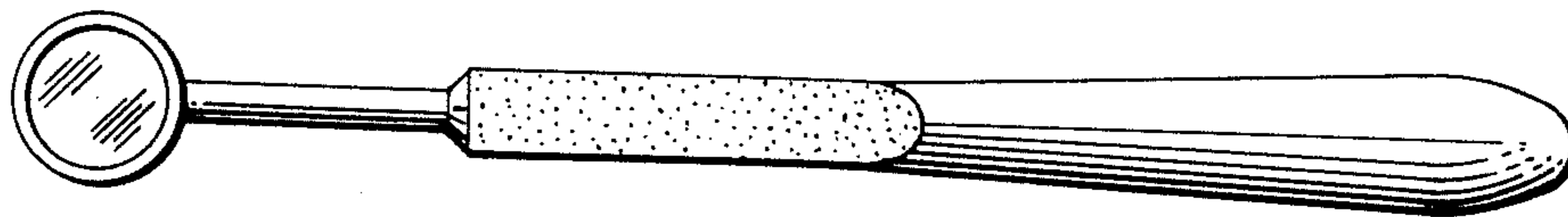
