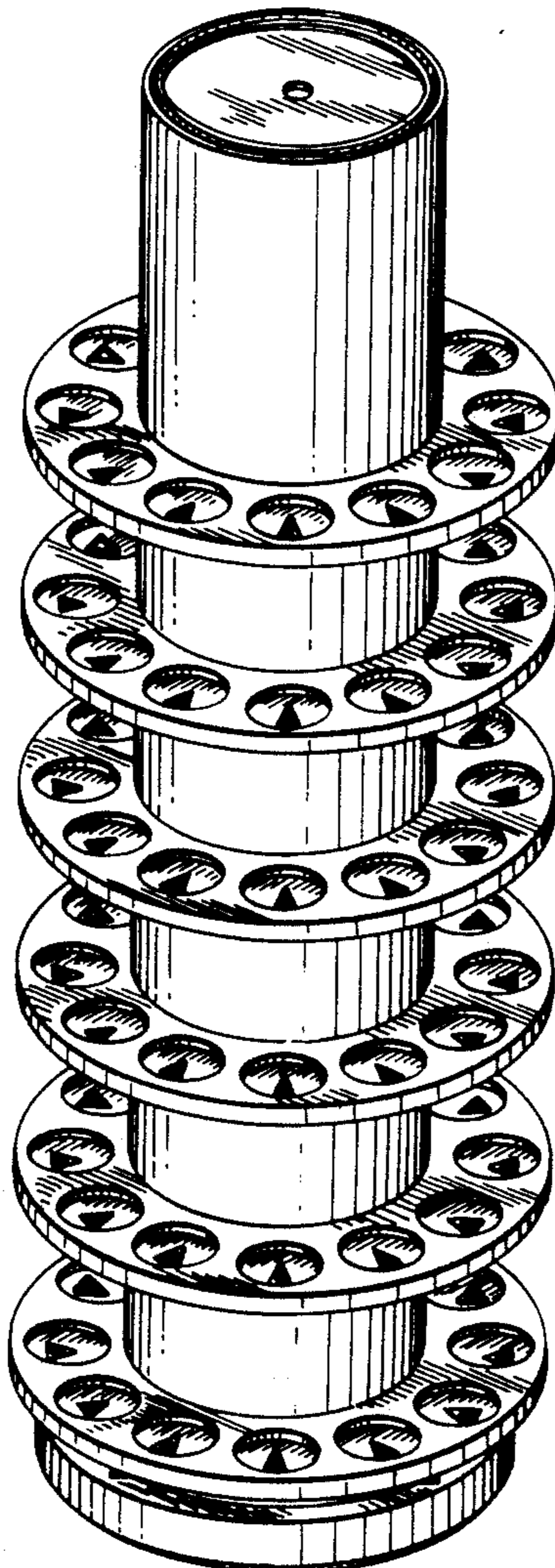

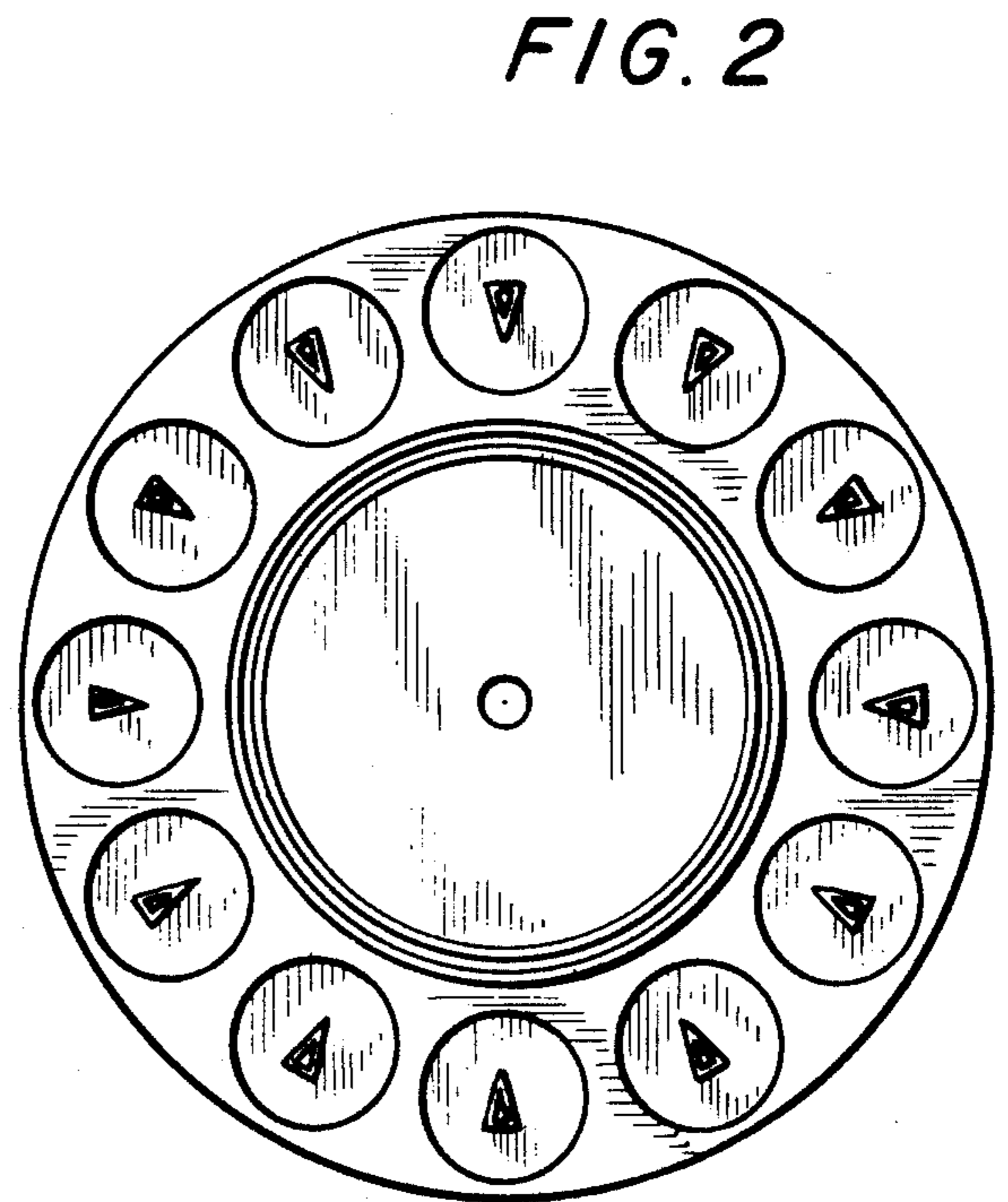
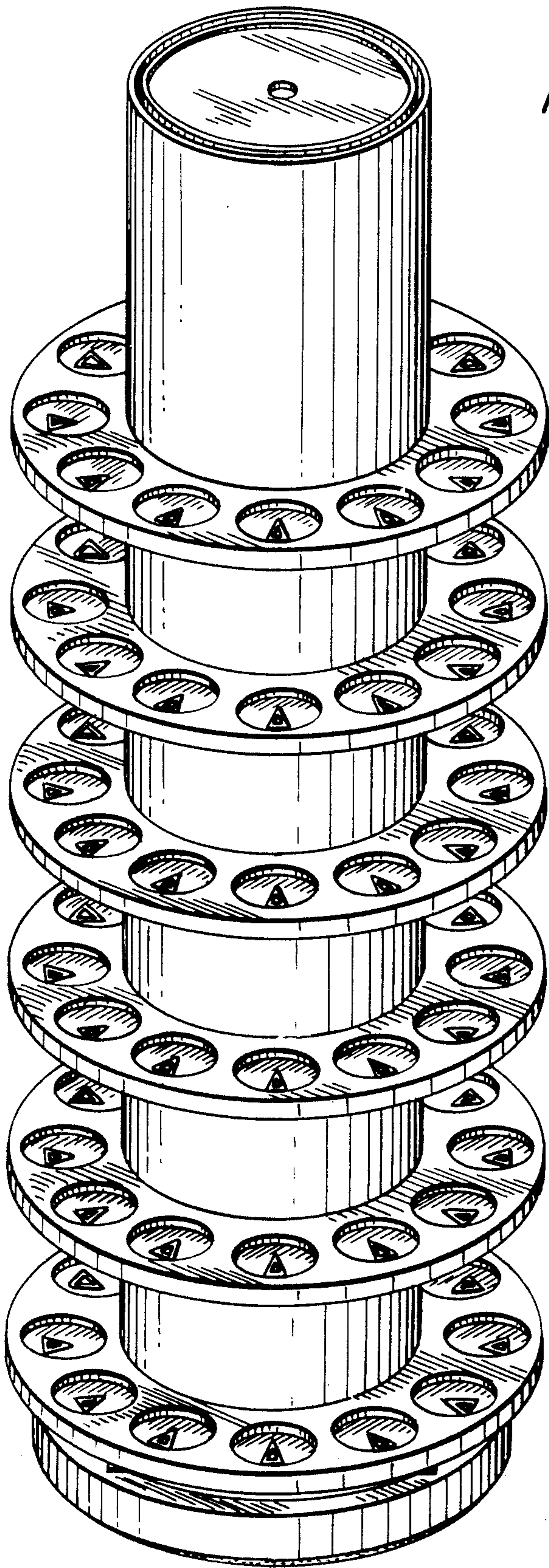
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a jewelry display support, or similar article, as shown.

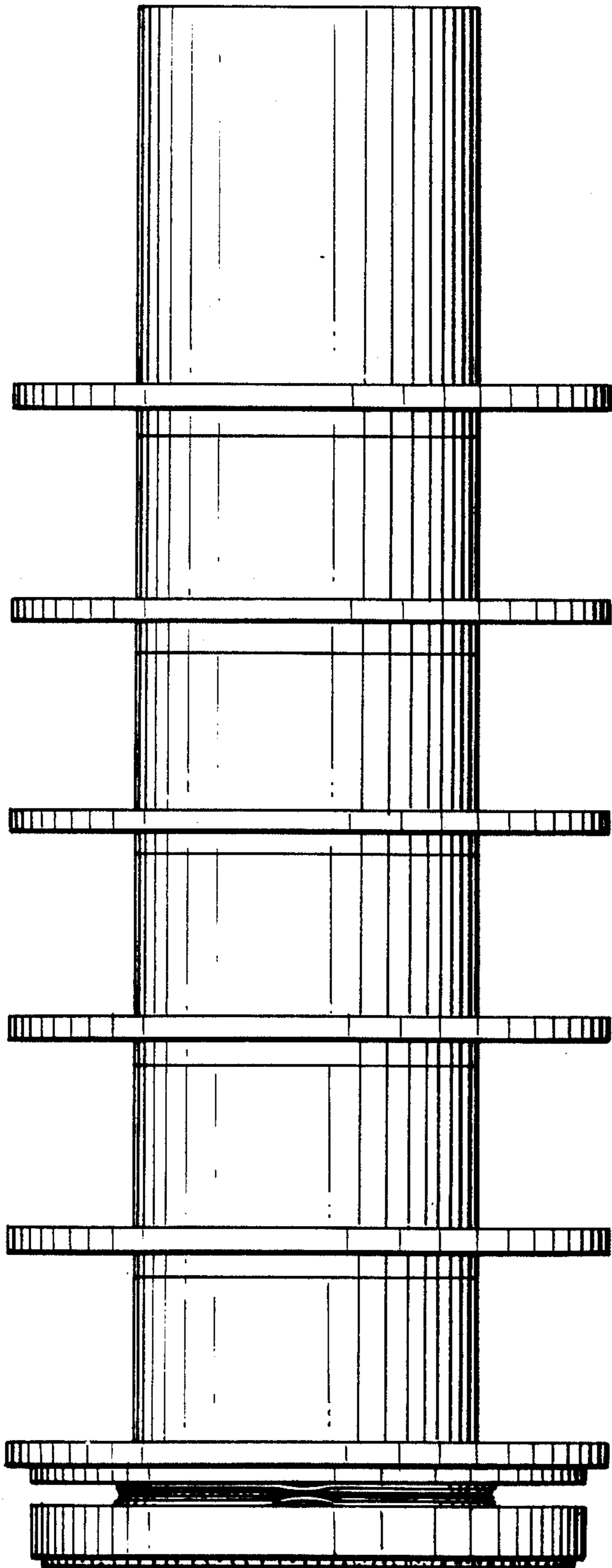
DESCRIPTION
