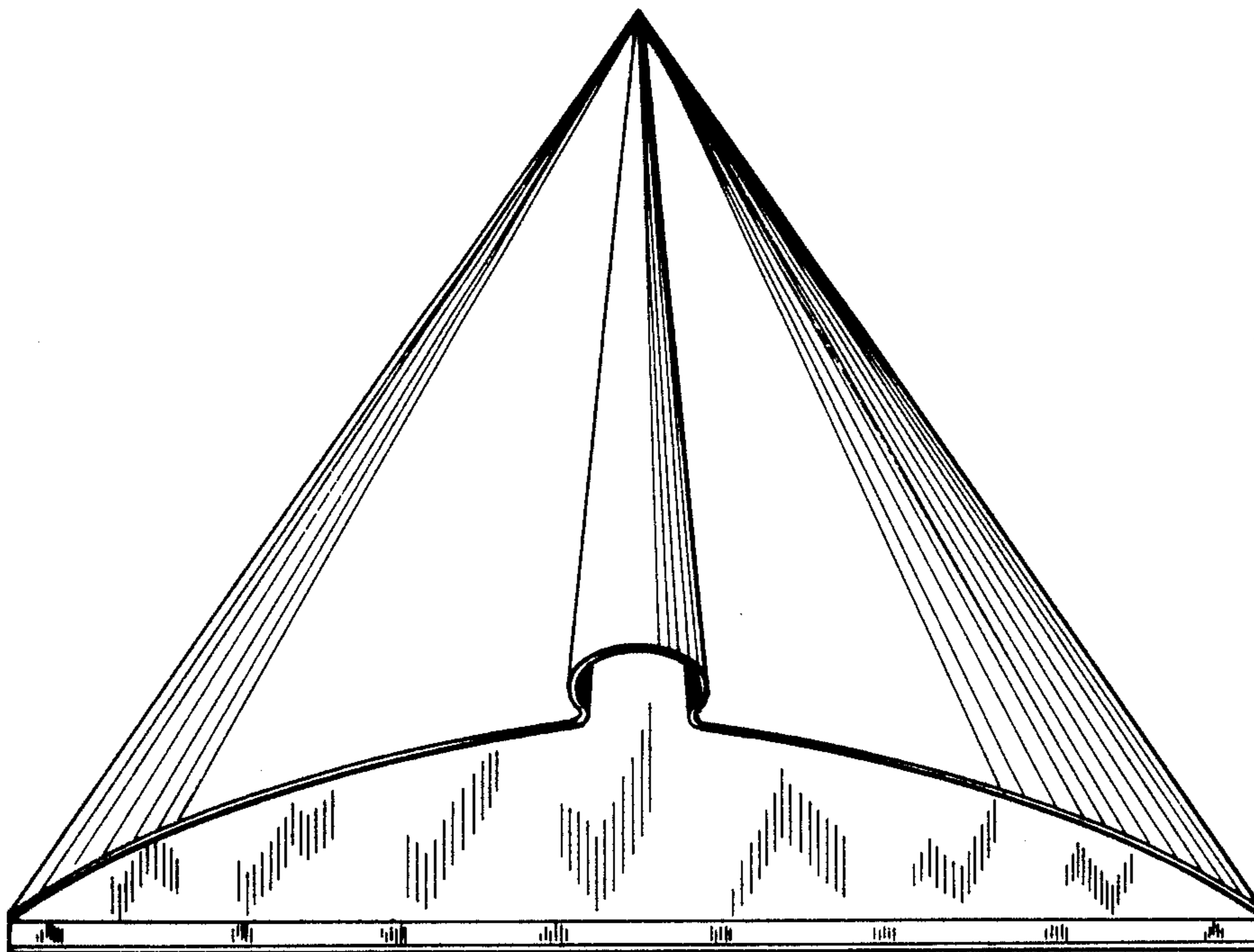

FIG. 4 is an elevational view thereof looking from the right side of FIG. 2.



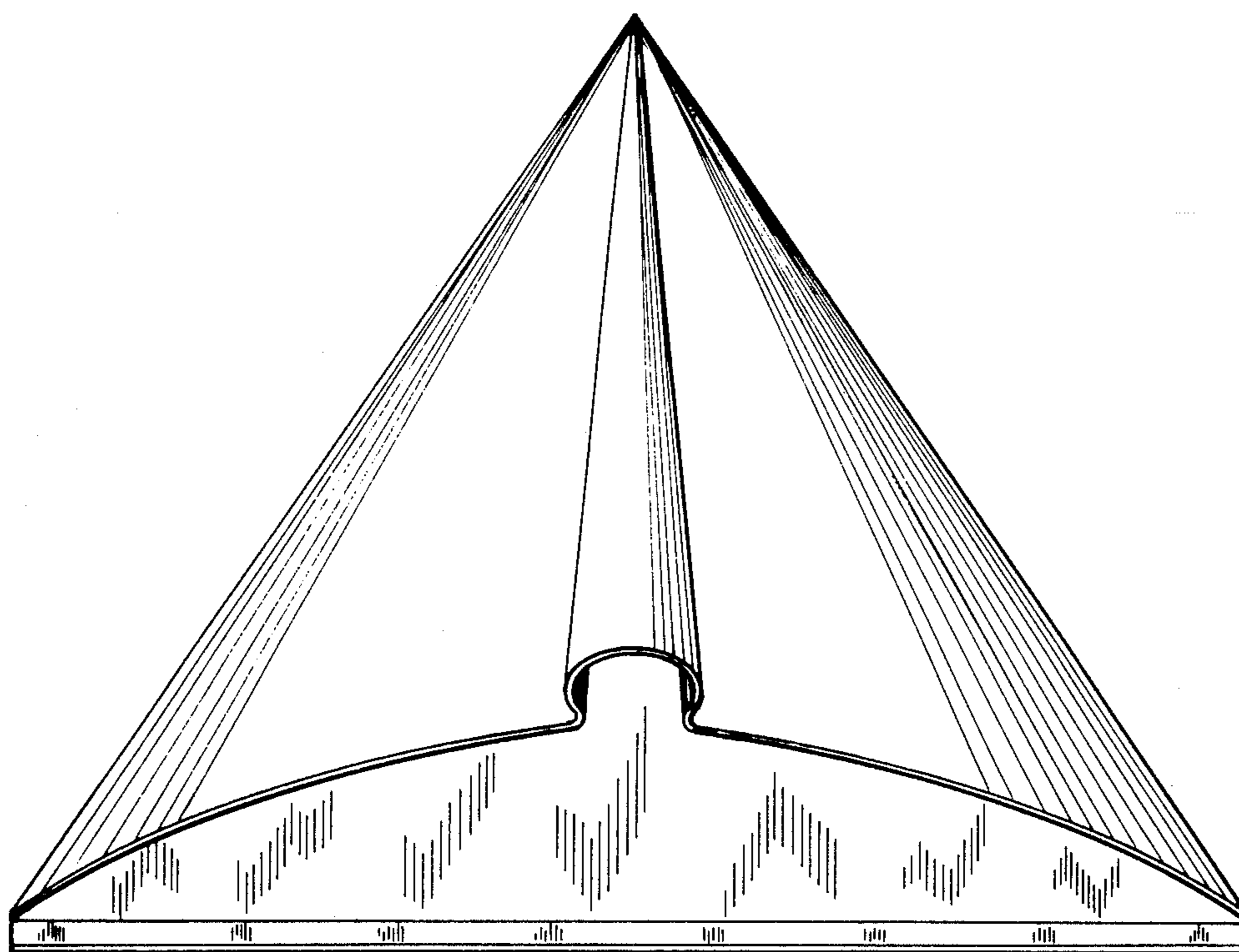

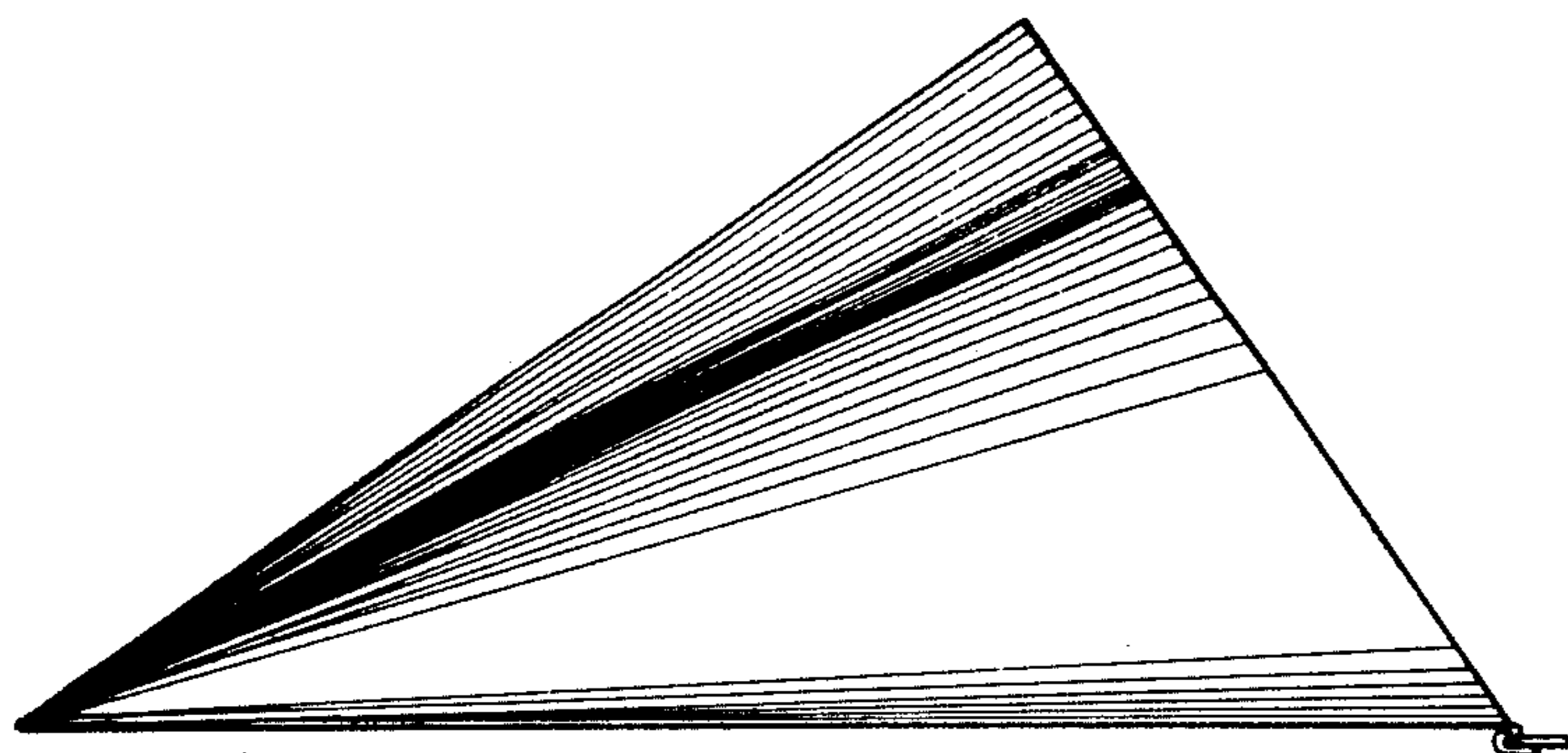

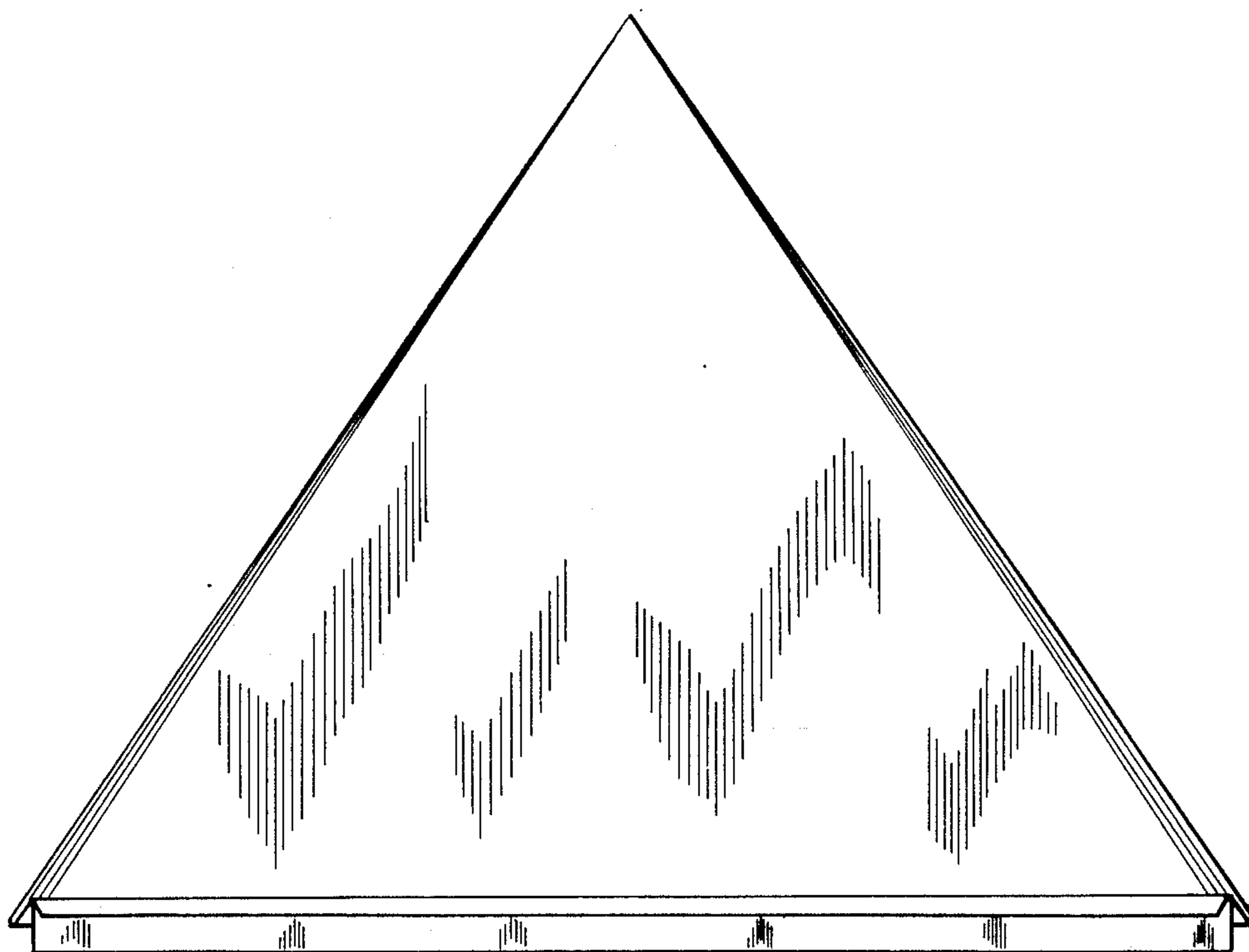

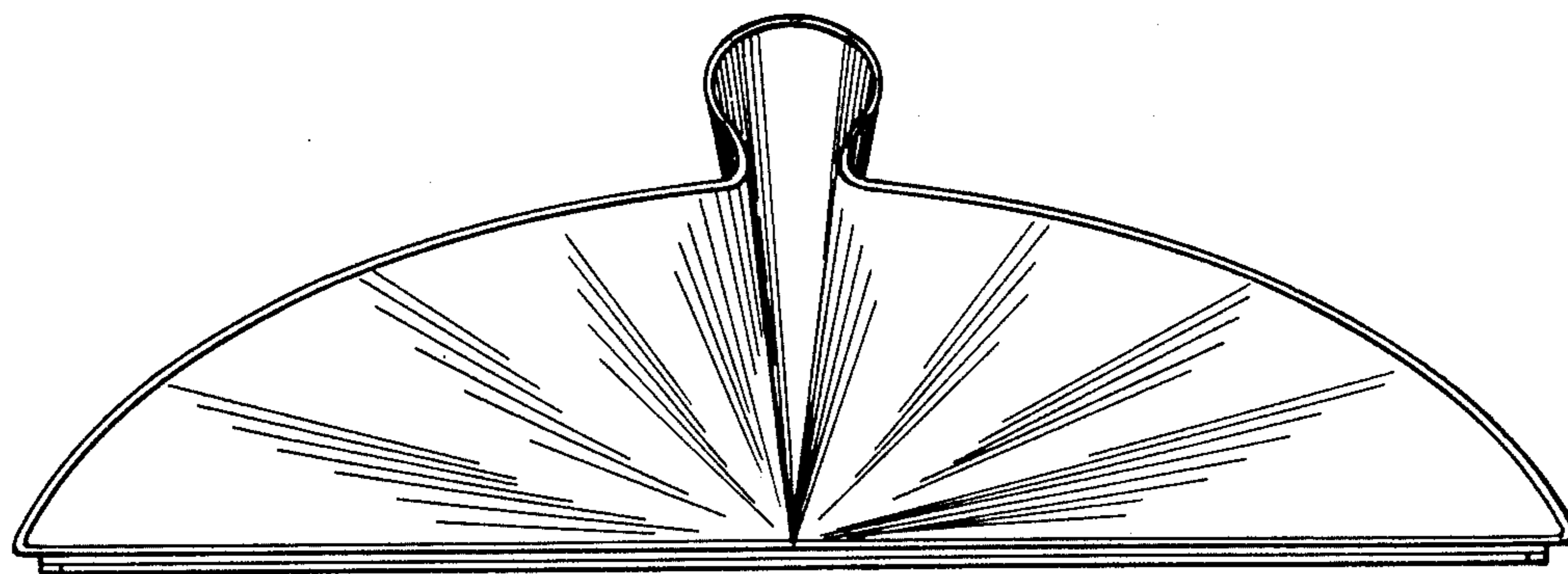
