DESCRIPTION

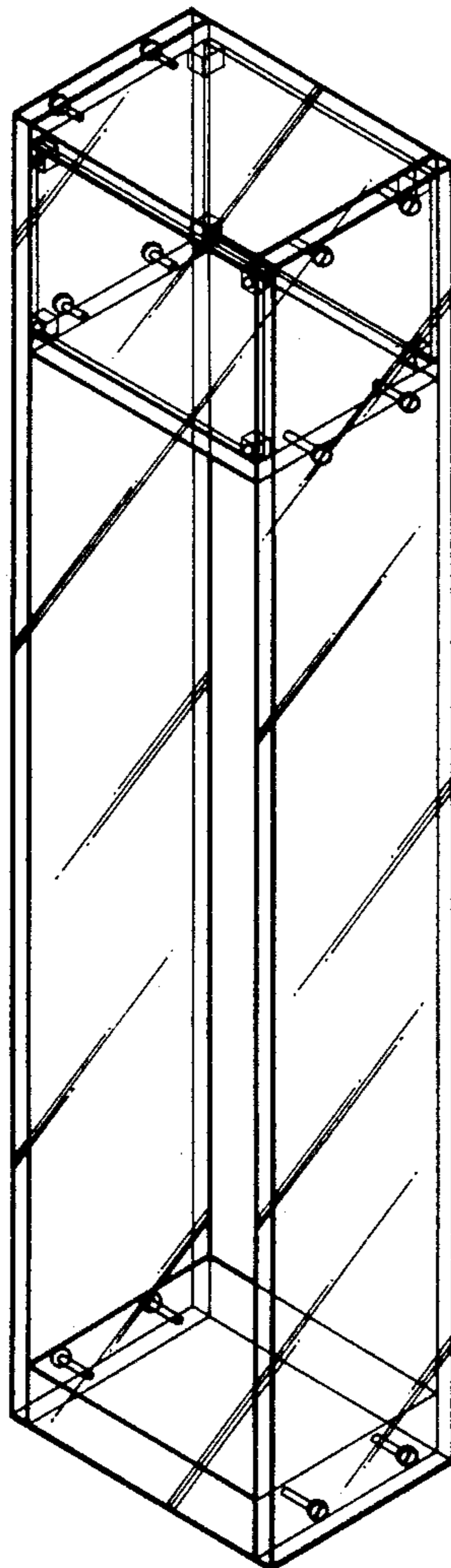
FIG. 1 is a front isometric view of a clock casing showing our new design;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



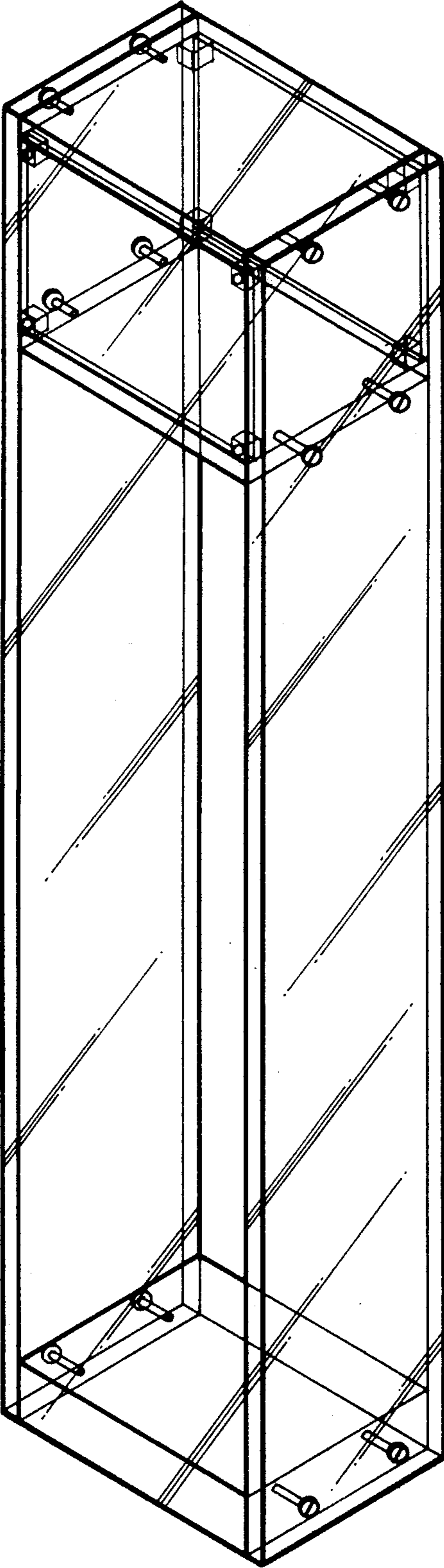

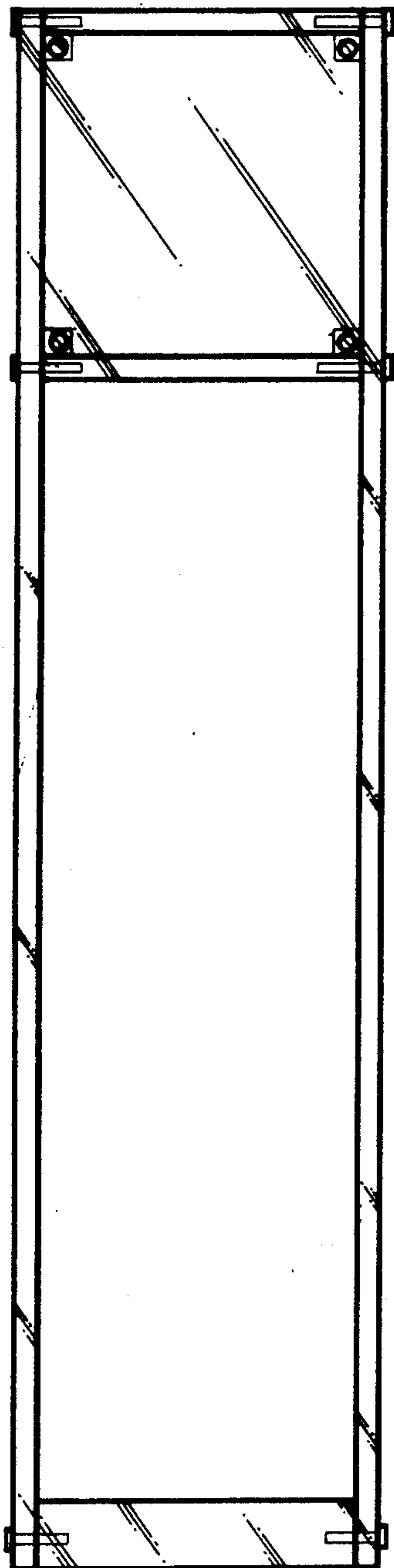

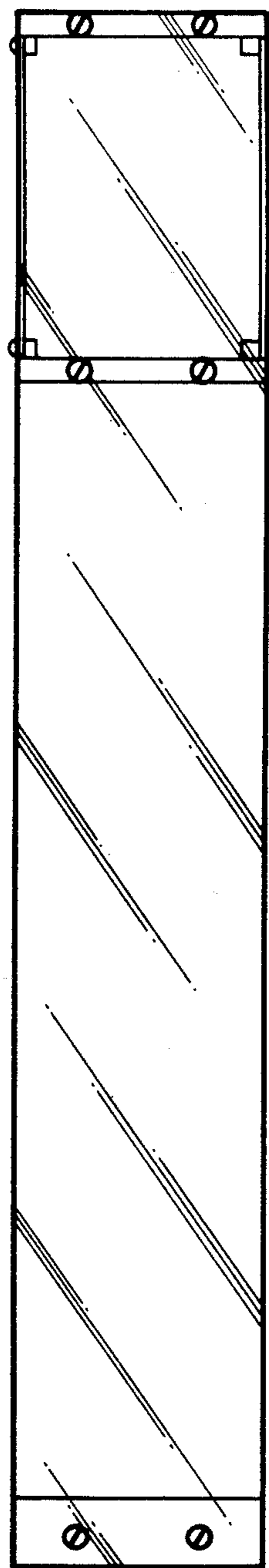

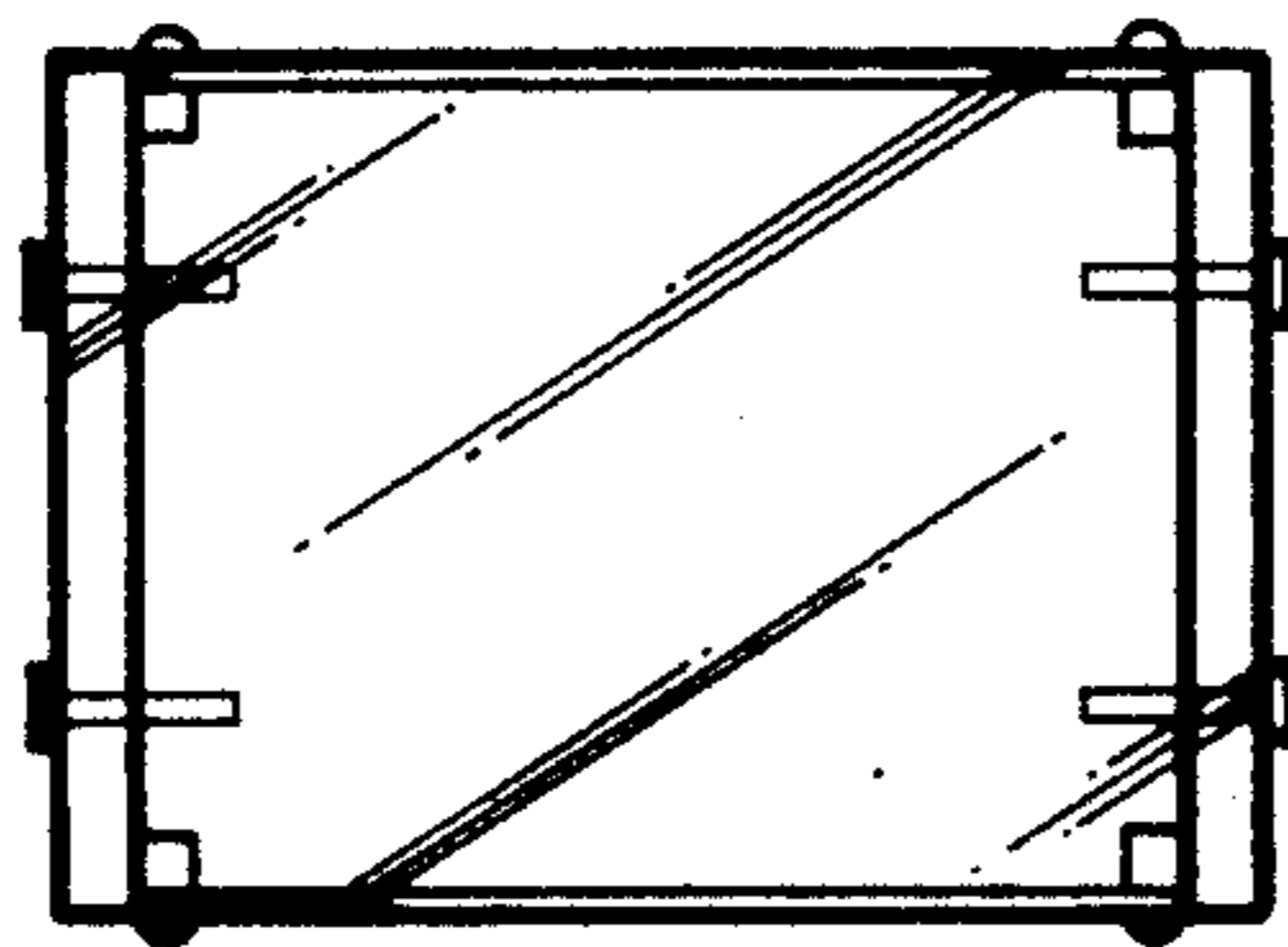

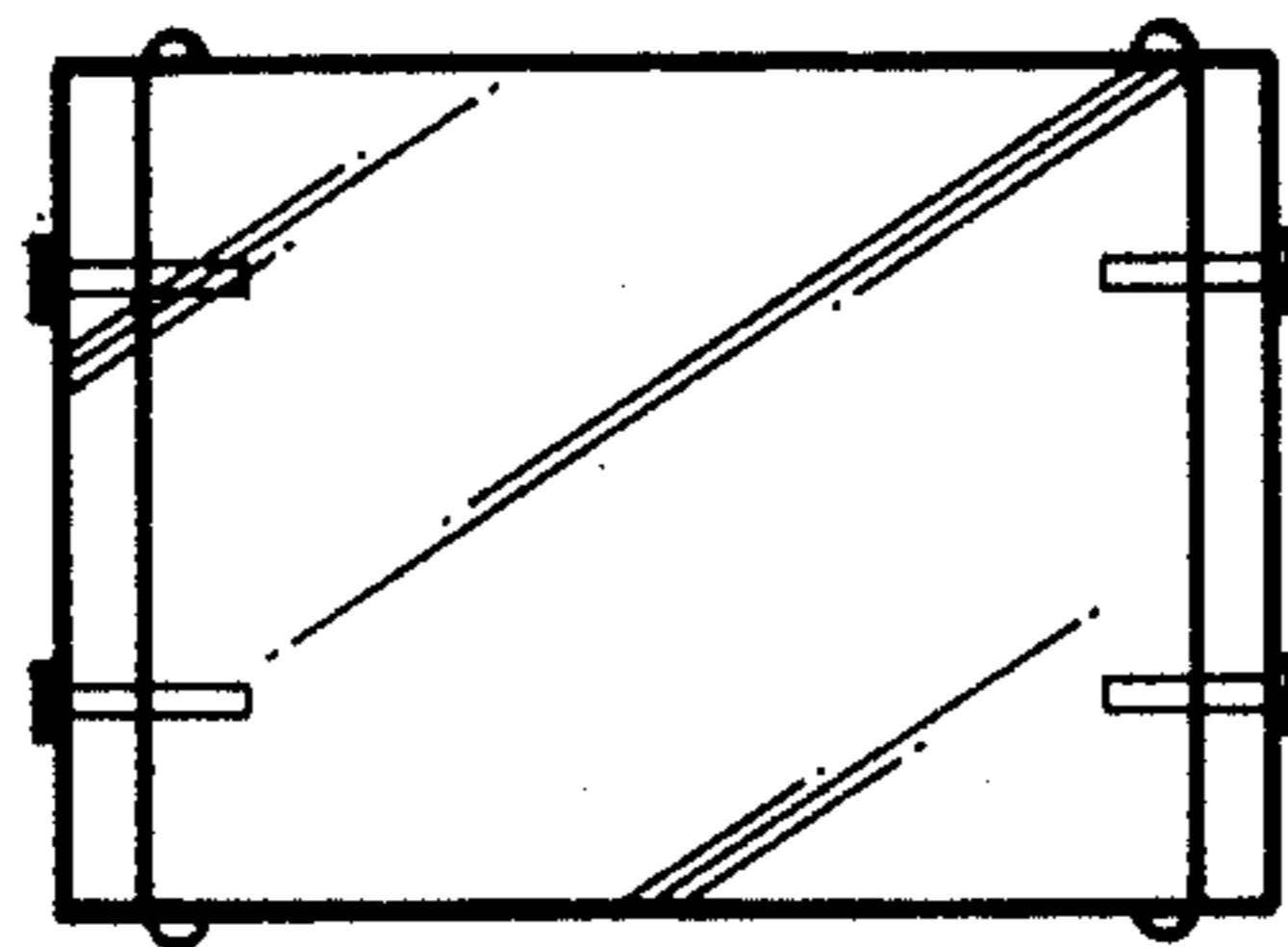
