DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a plan view of an article holder mountable on an automobile visor in the unfolded condition showing my new design;

FIG. 3 is a perspective view thereof, in folded condition;

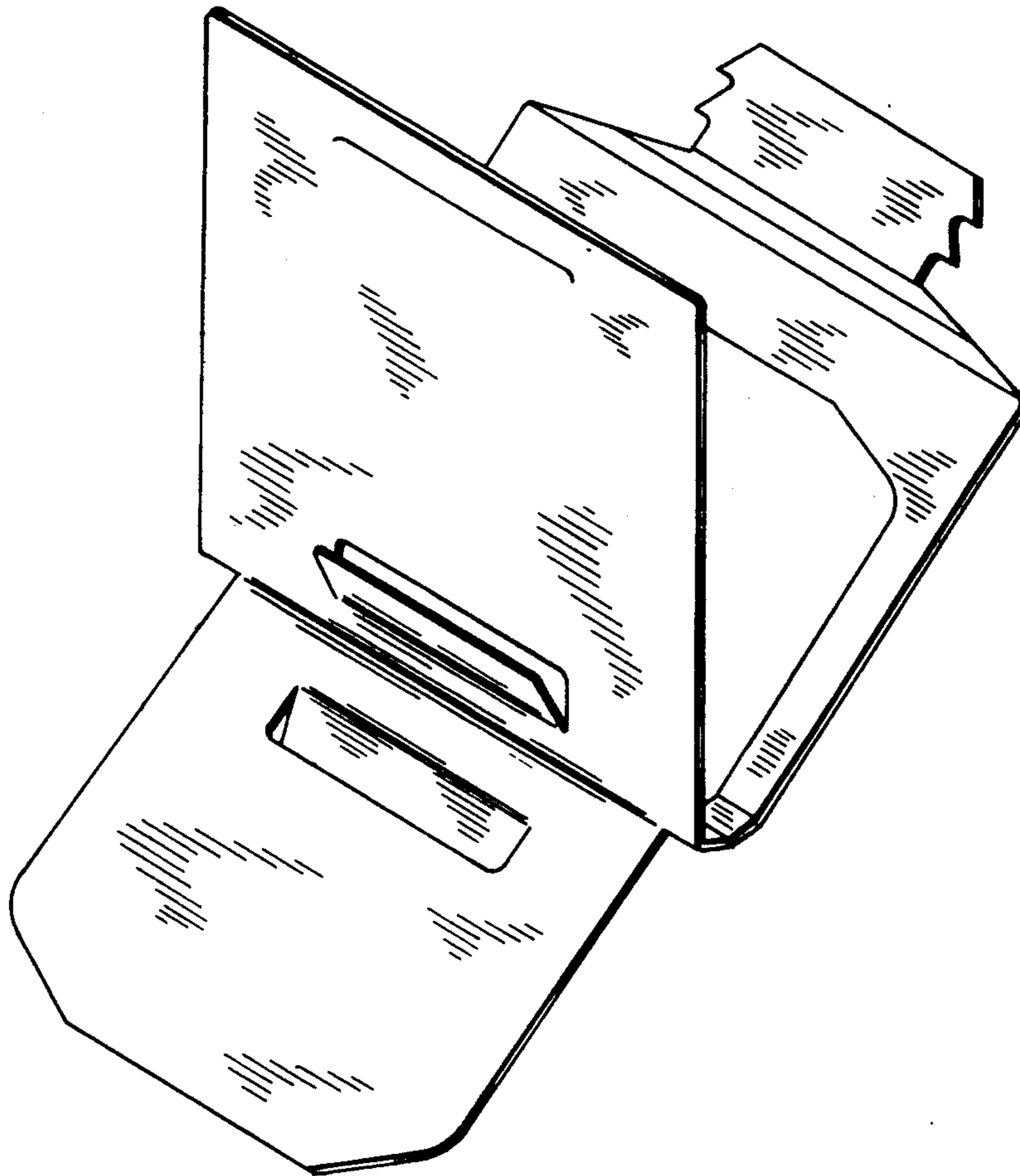
FIG. 4 is a front elevation view of FIG. 3;

FIG. 8 is a rear elevation view of FIG. 3.



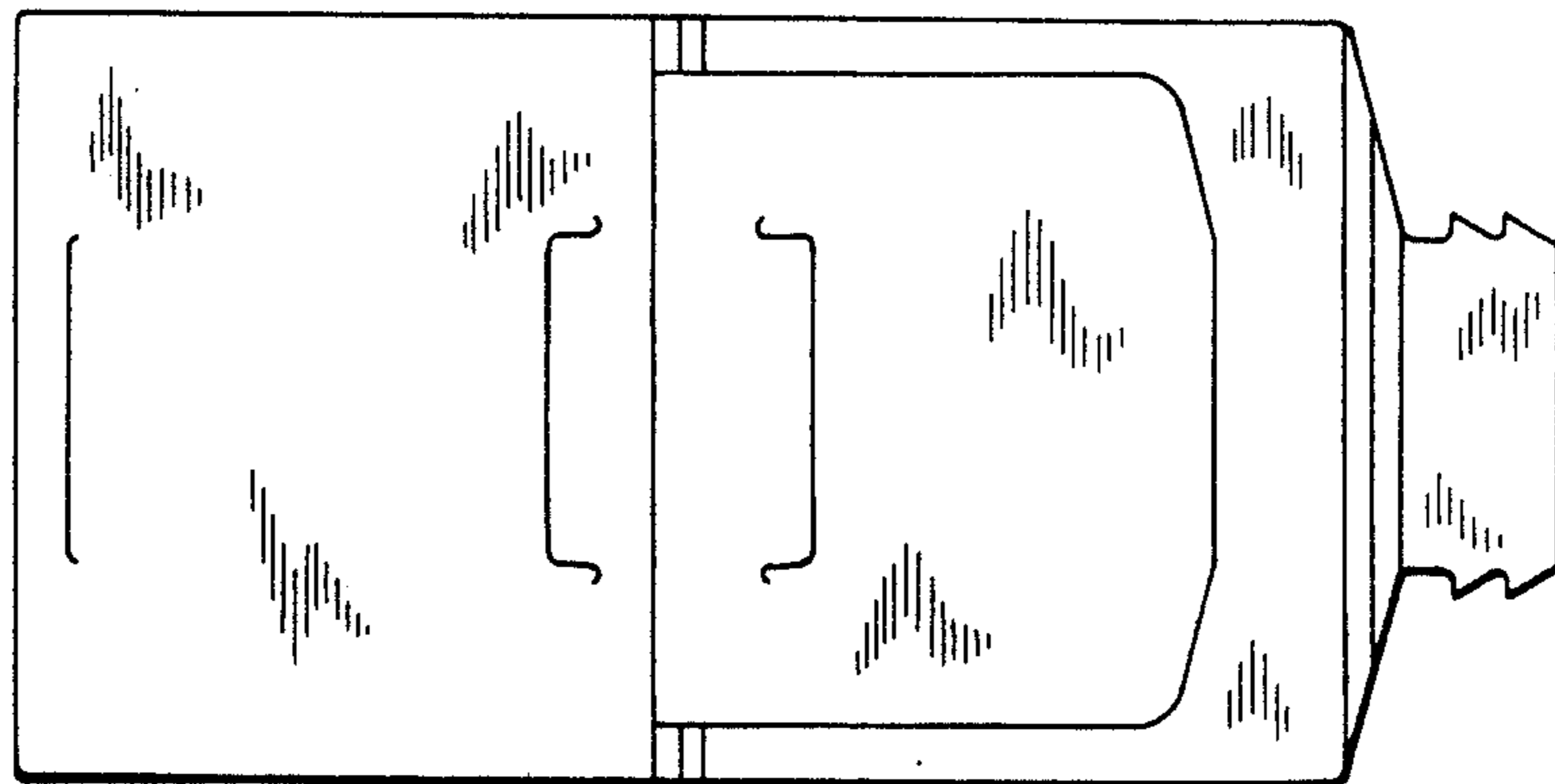

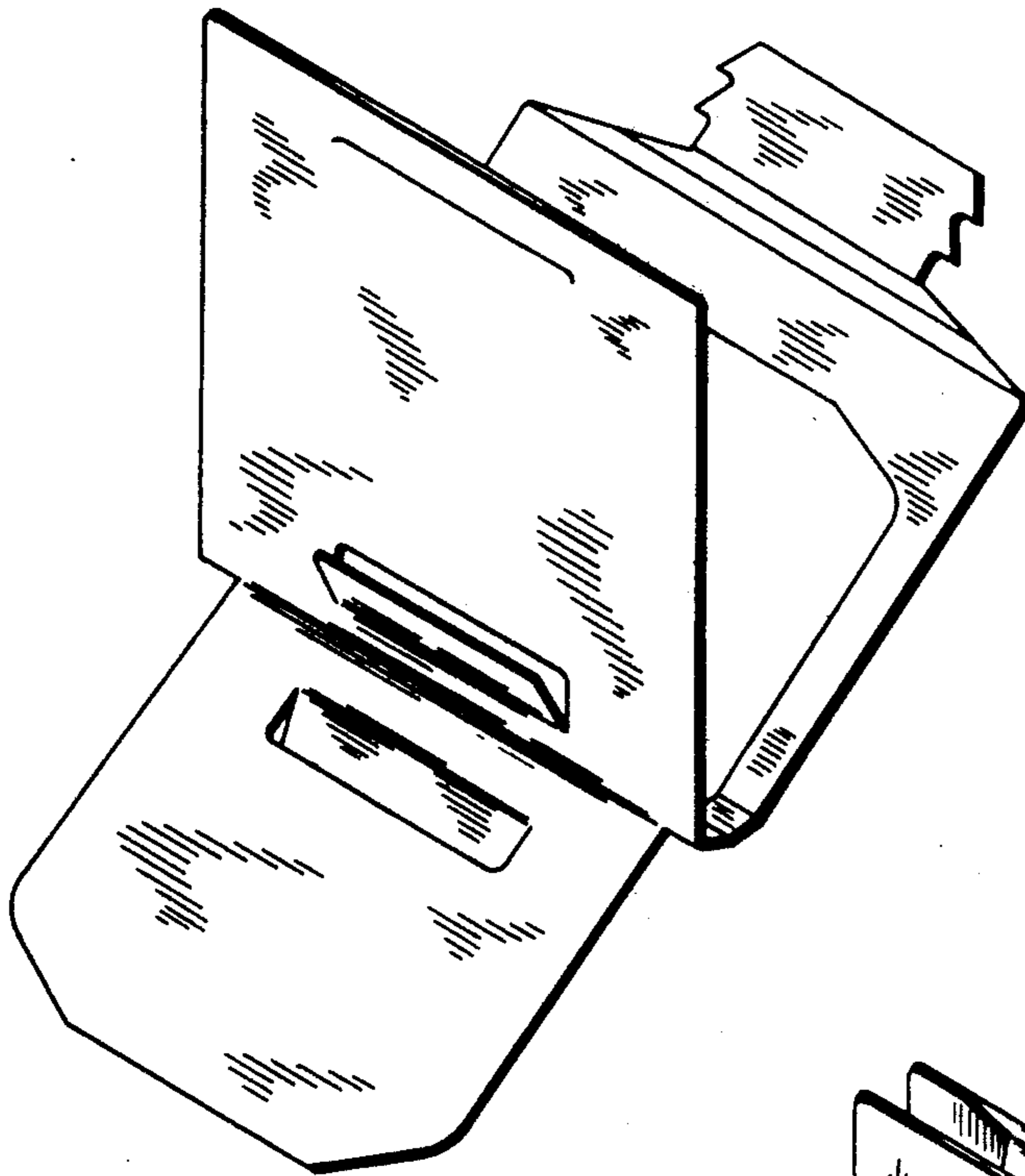

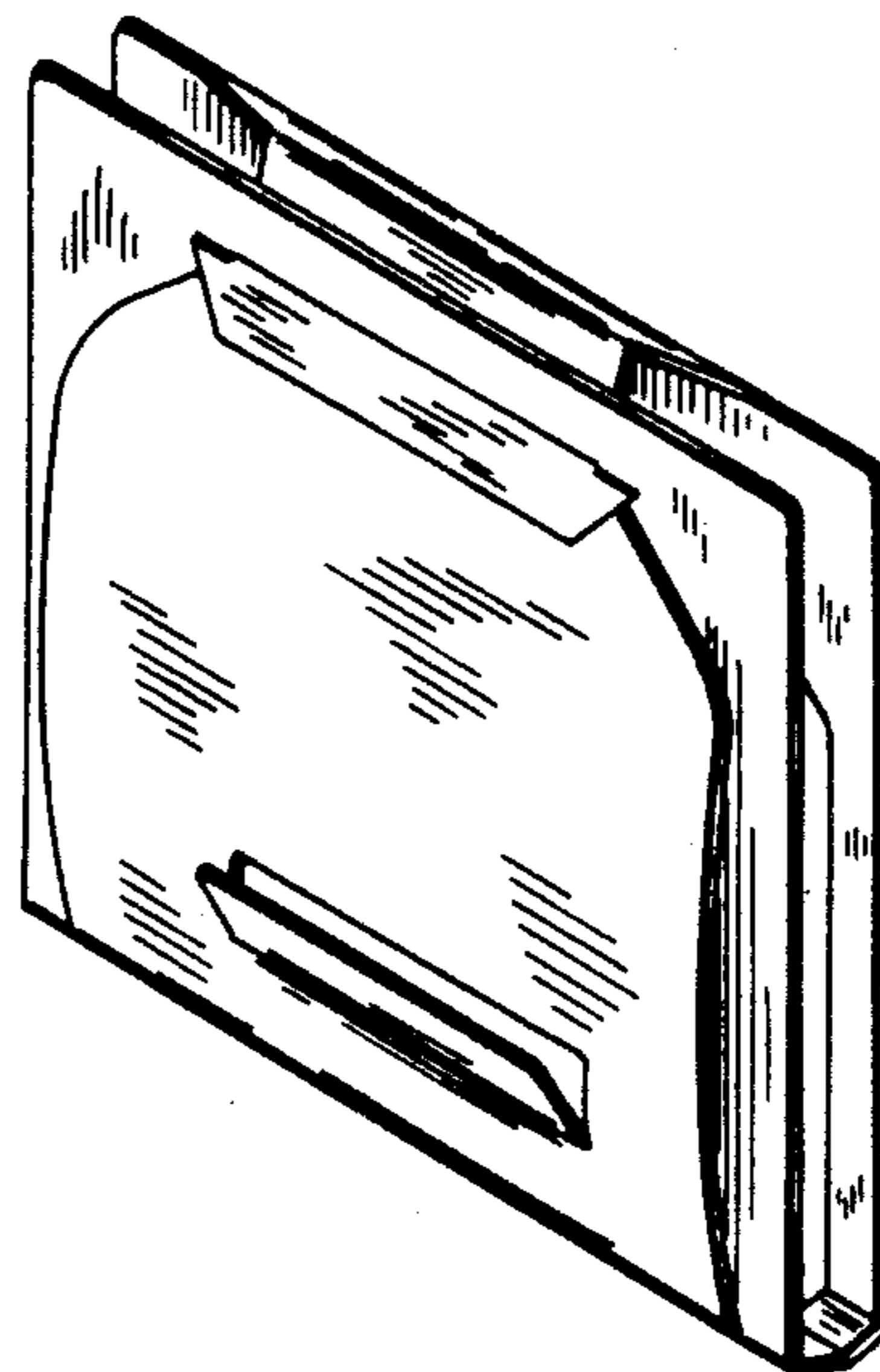

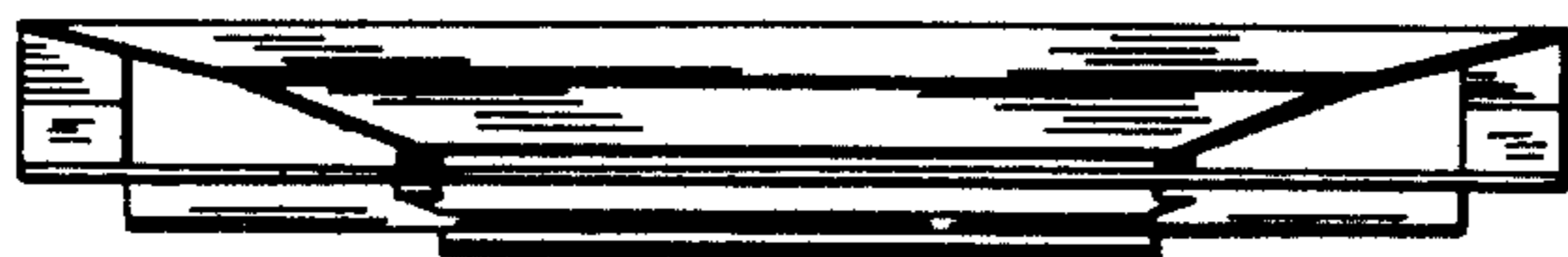

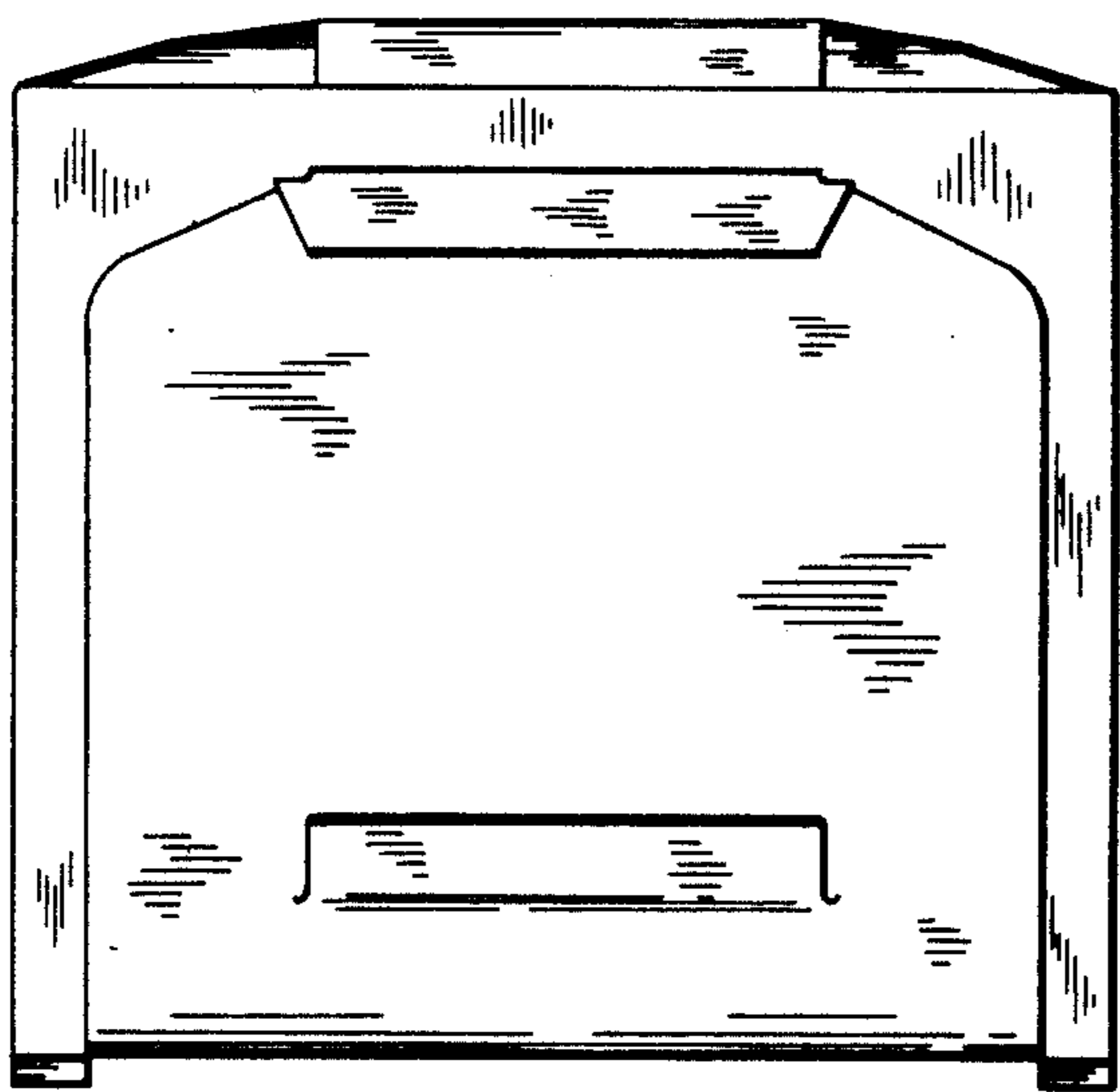

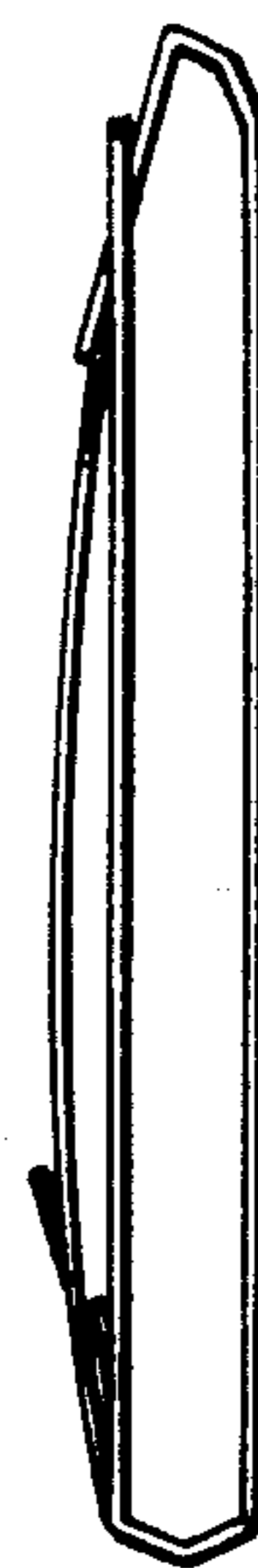

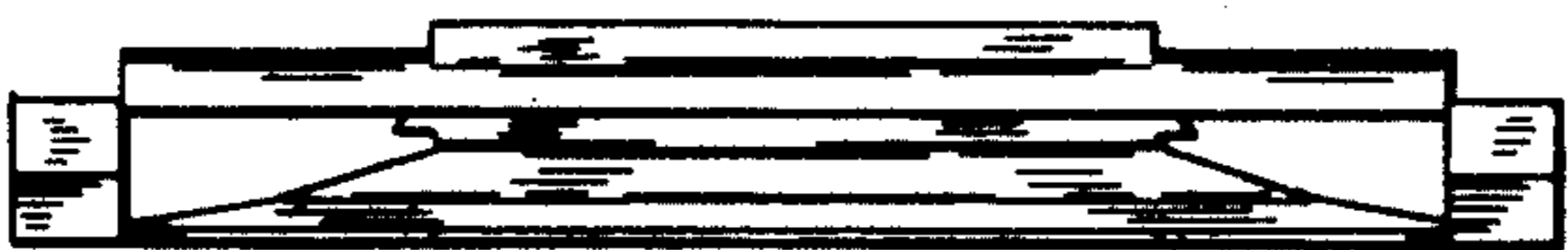

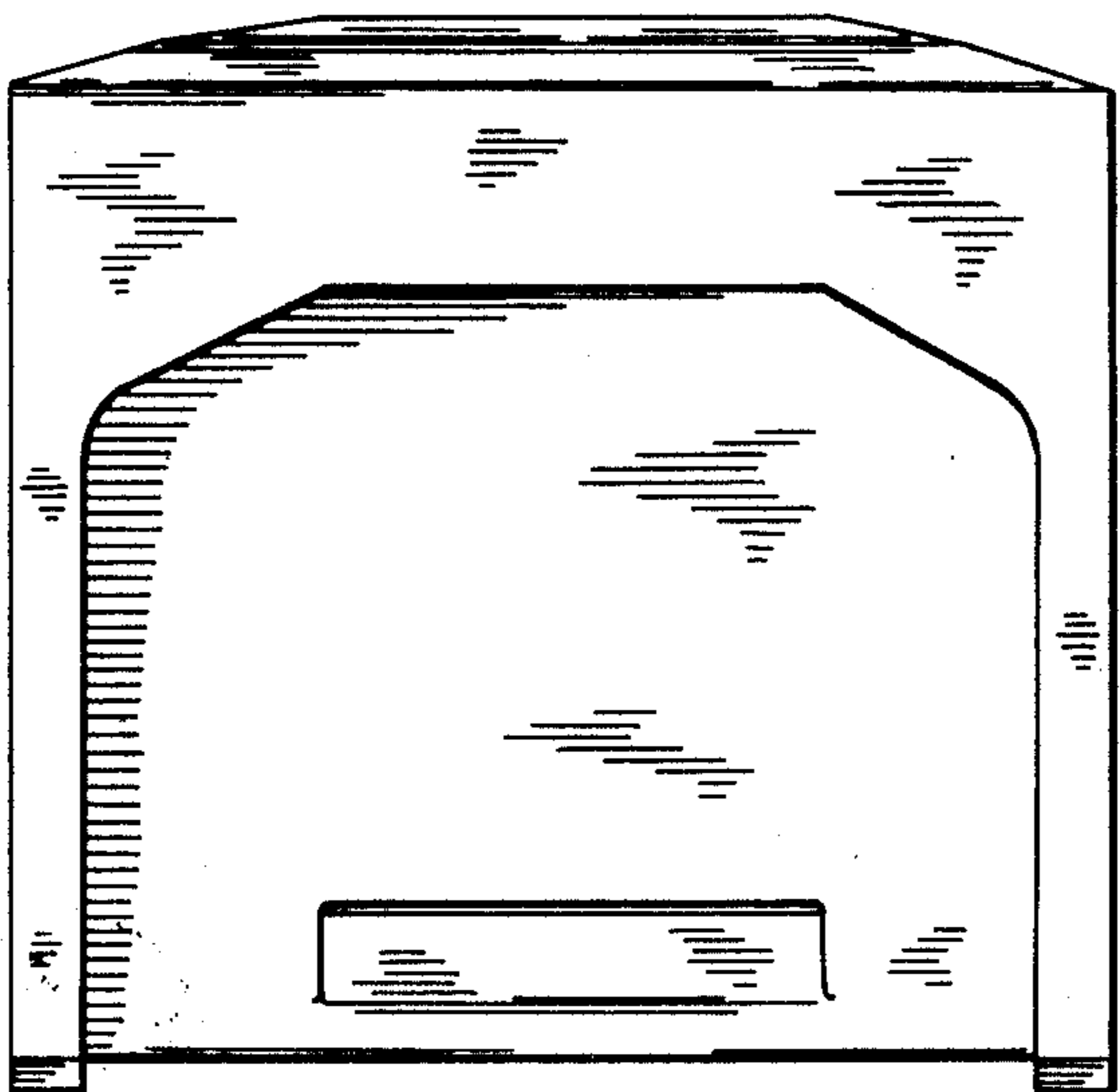
