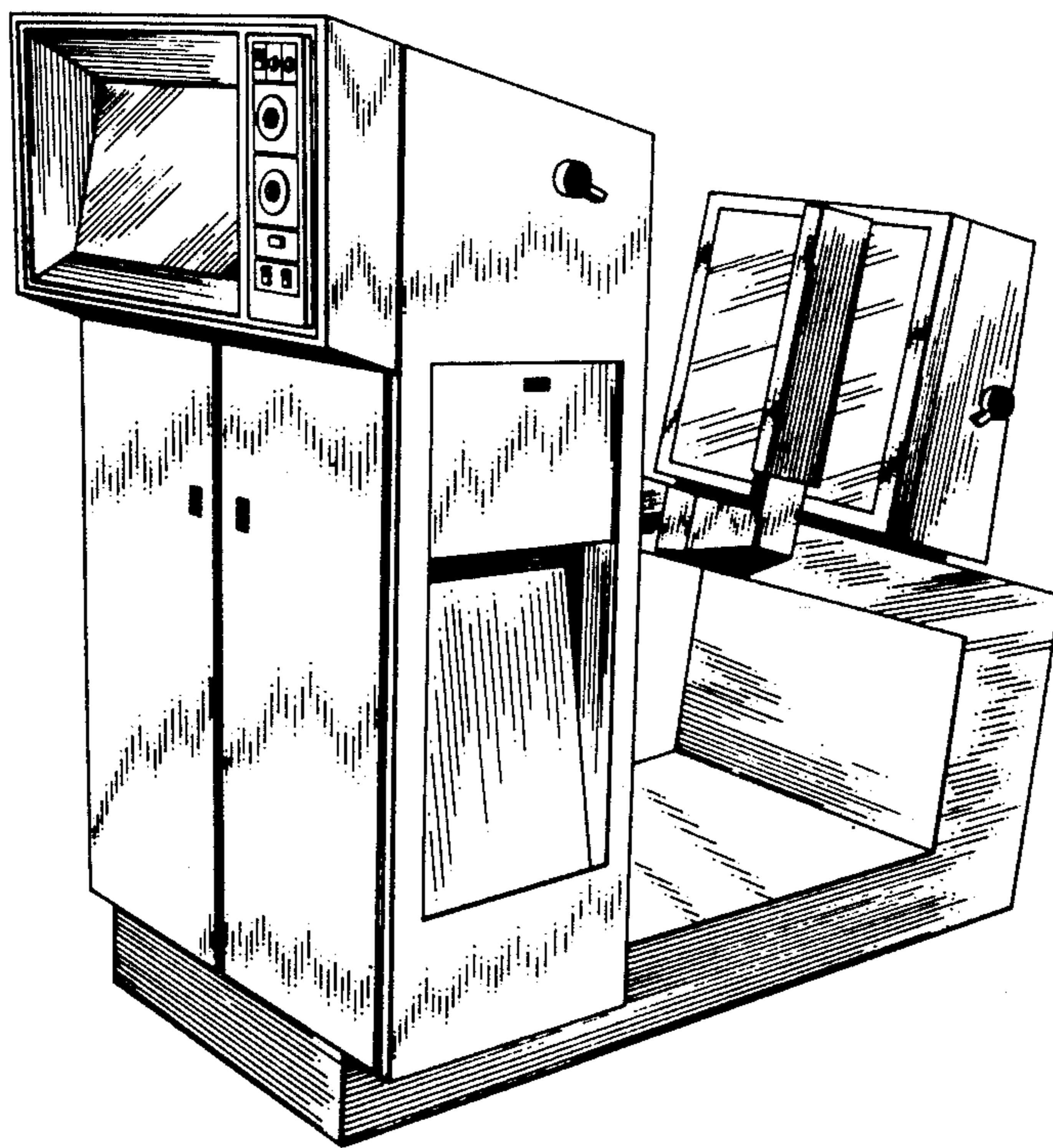

FIG. 2 is a back and left side perspective view.



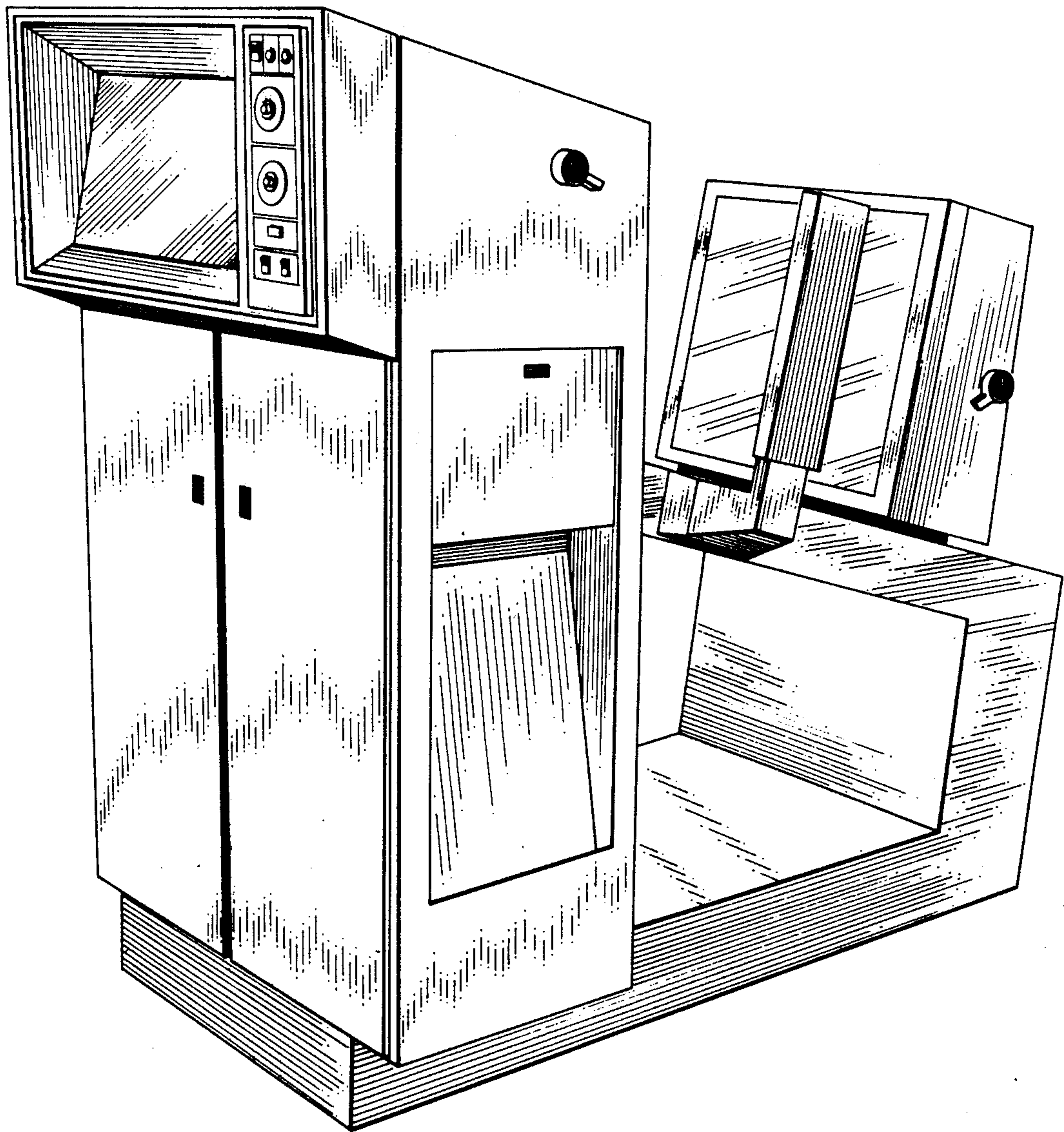

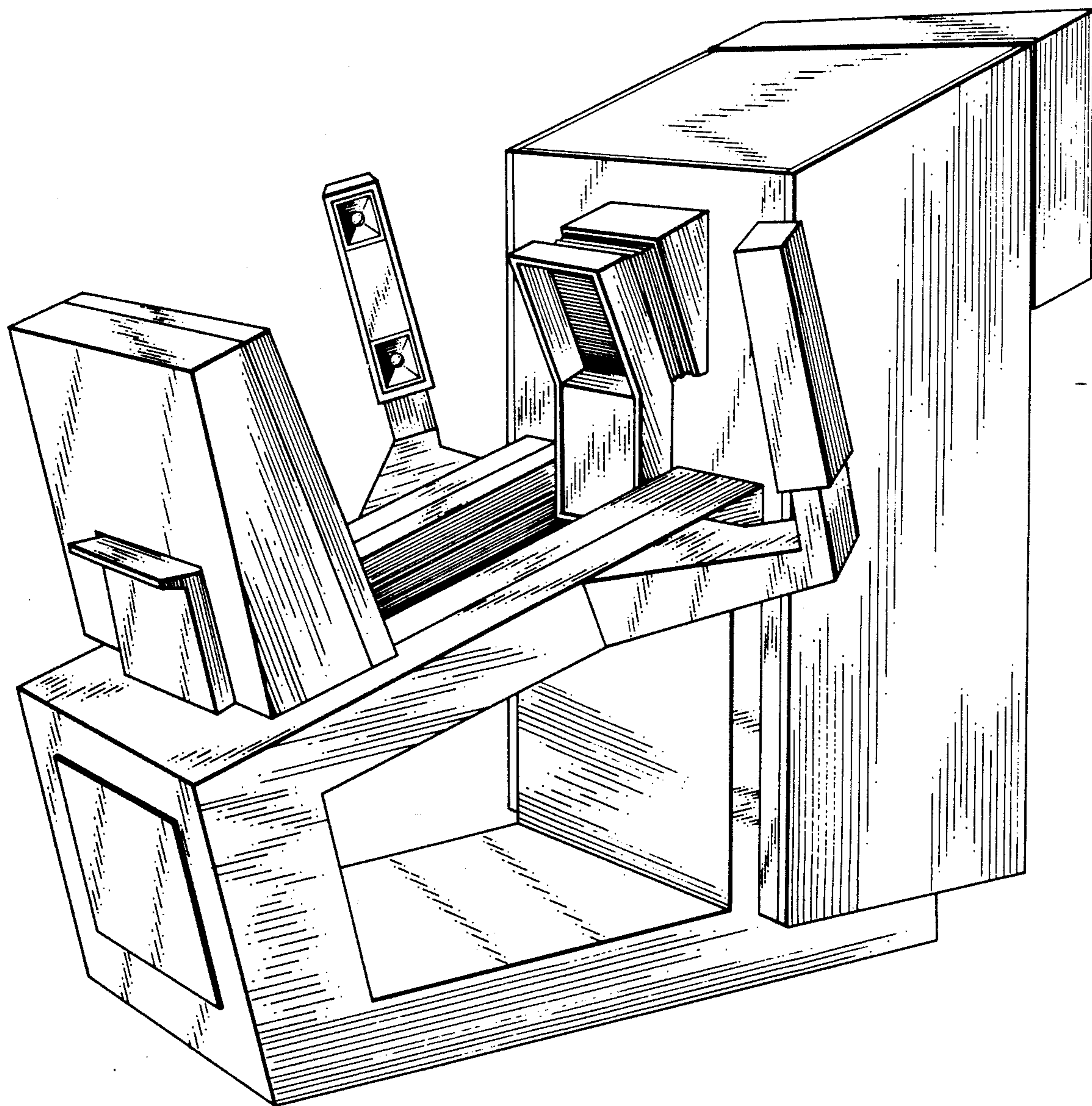
