CLAIM

The ornamental design for a concrete table, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view, in perspective, showing my new design for a concrete table, the corresponding rear view being a mirror image thereof.


FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof.

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear elevational view being a mirror image thereof.

FIG. 4 is a bottom view thereof.

FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view taken on line 5—5 of FIG. 2.

The characteristic features of my design reside in the relatively wide legs and the specific angularity of the top portions thereof and the inset appearance of the table top.






