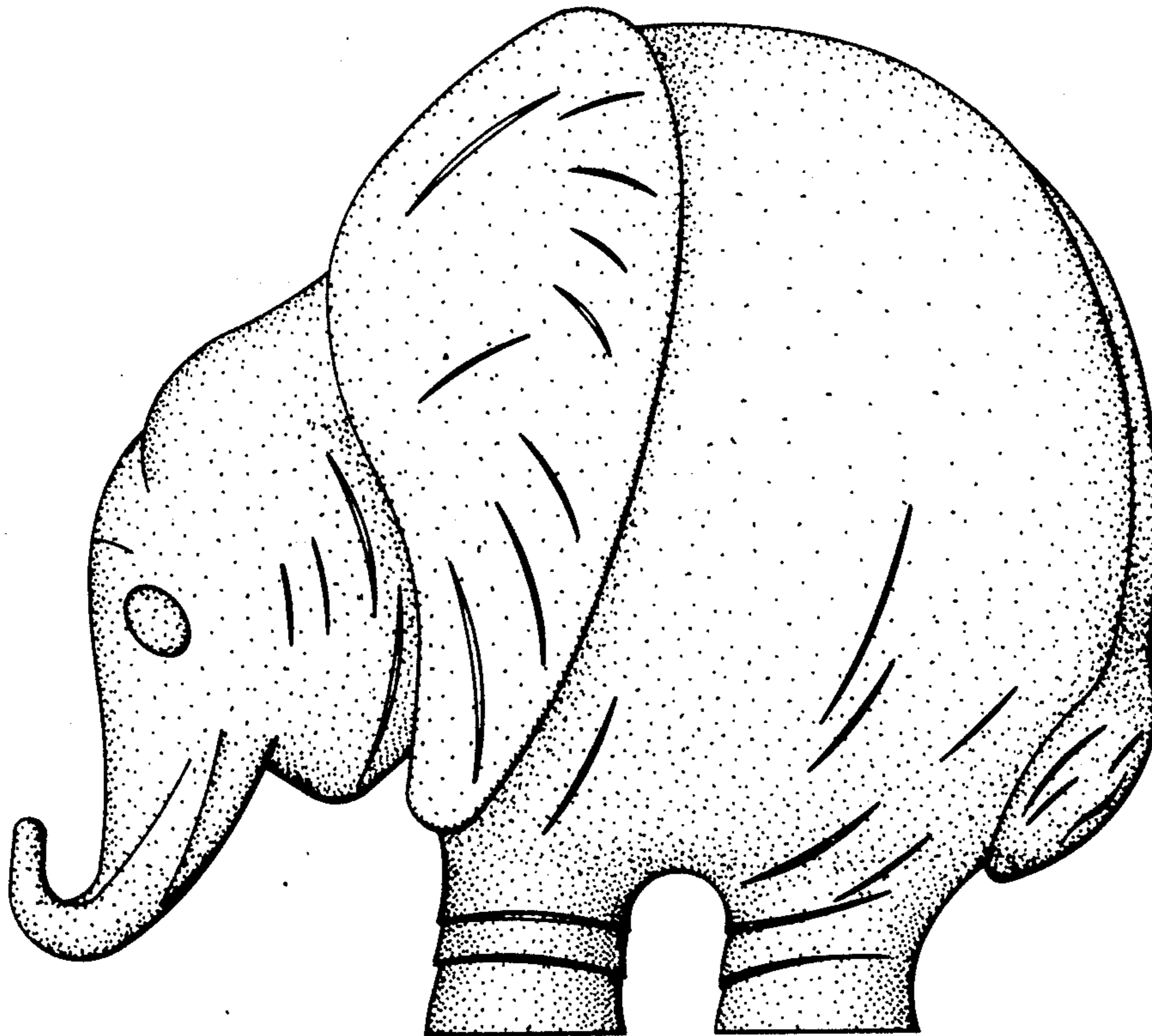

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a jewelry charm showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view, the left side being substantially a mirror image with the exception of the tail; and
FIG. 3 is a rear view.



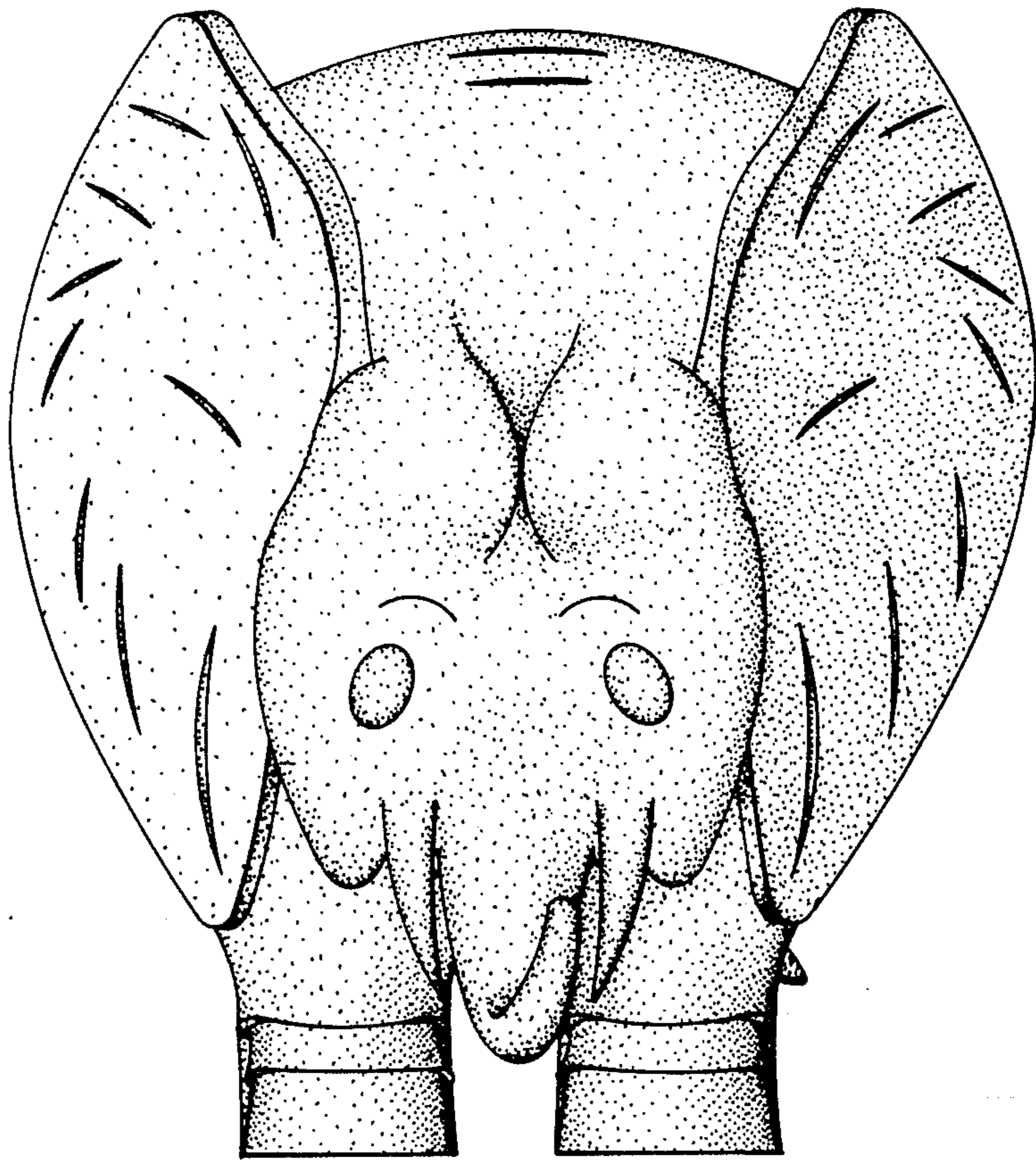

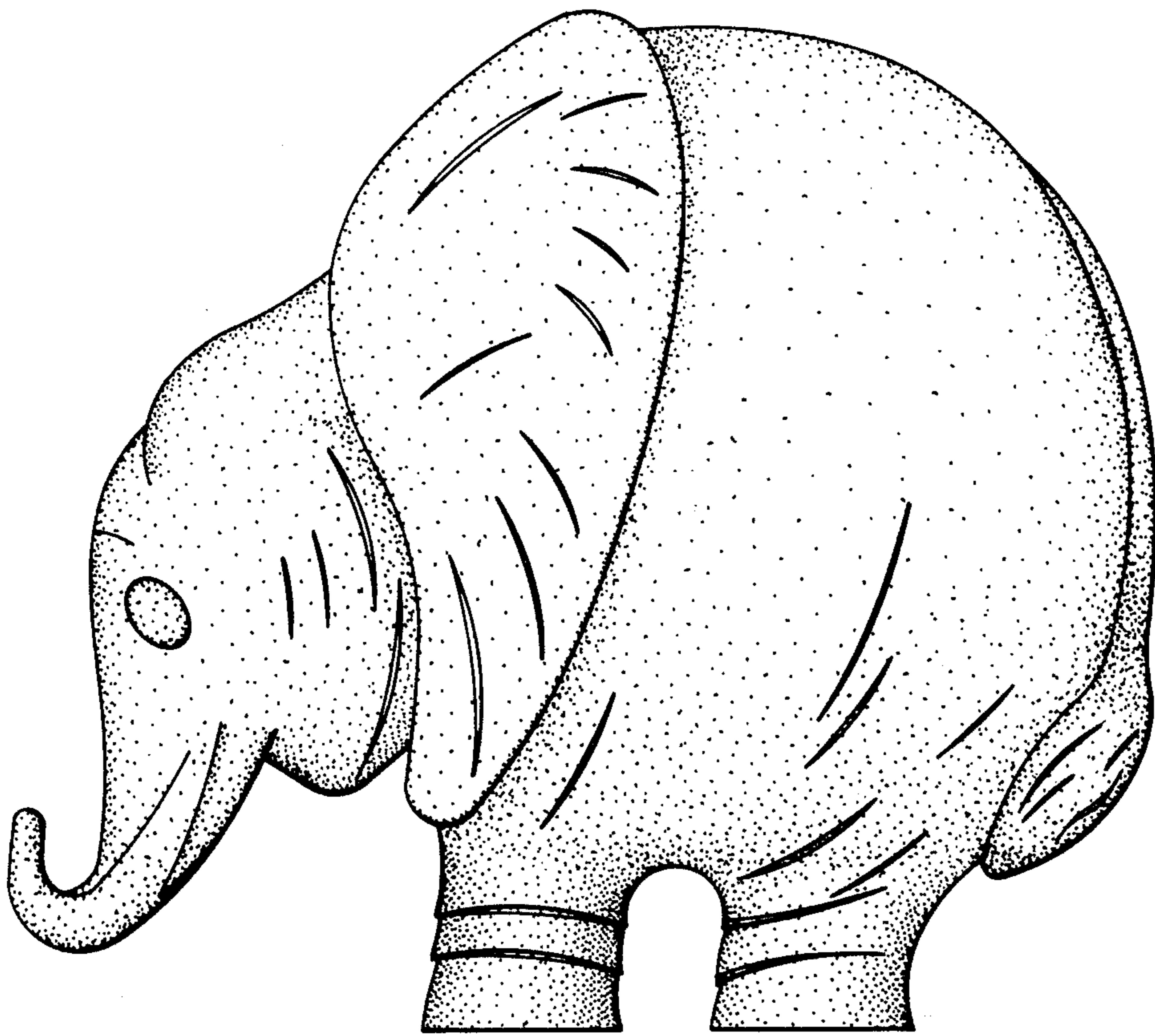

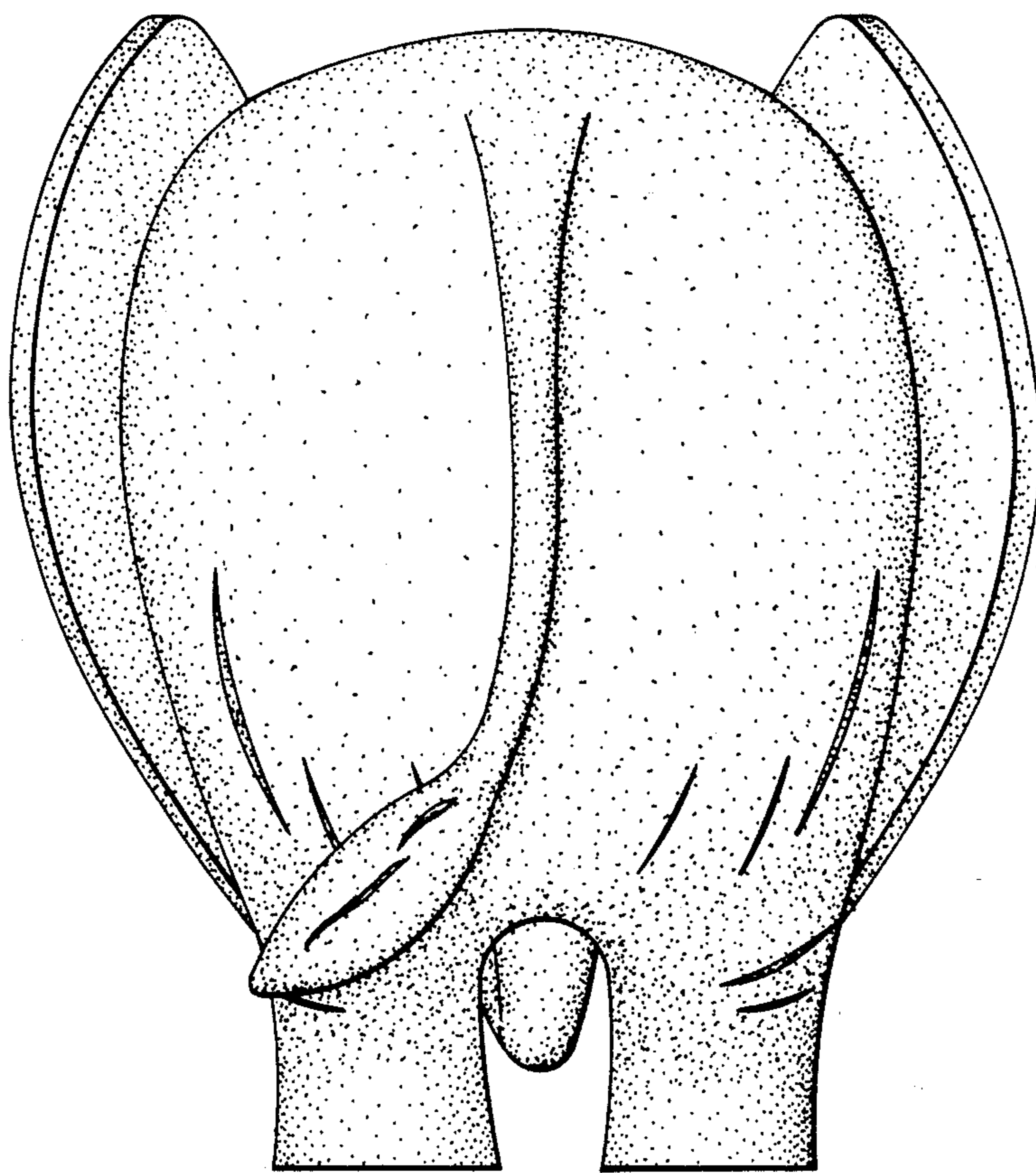
