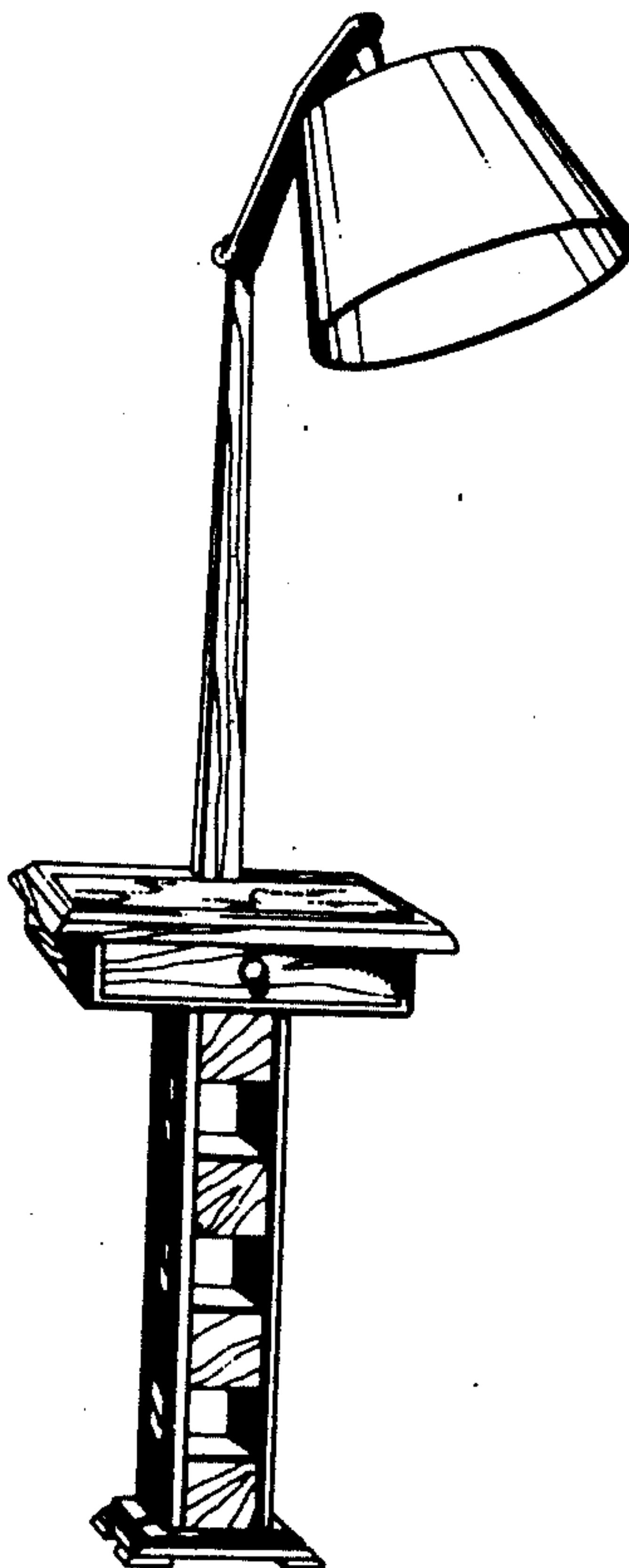
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a combined table

front in FIG. 1 and toward the side in FIG. 2.



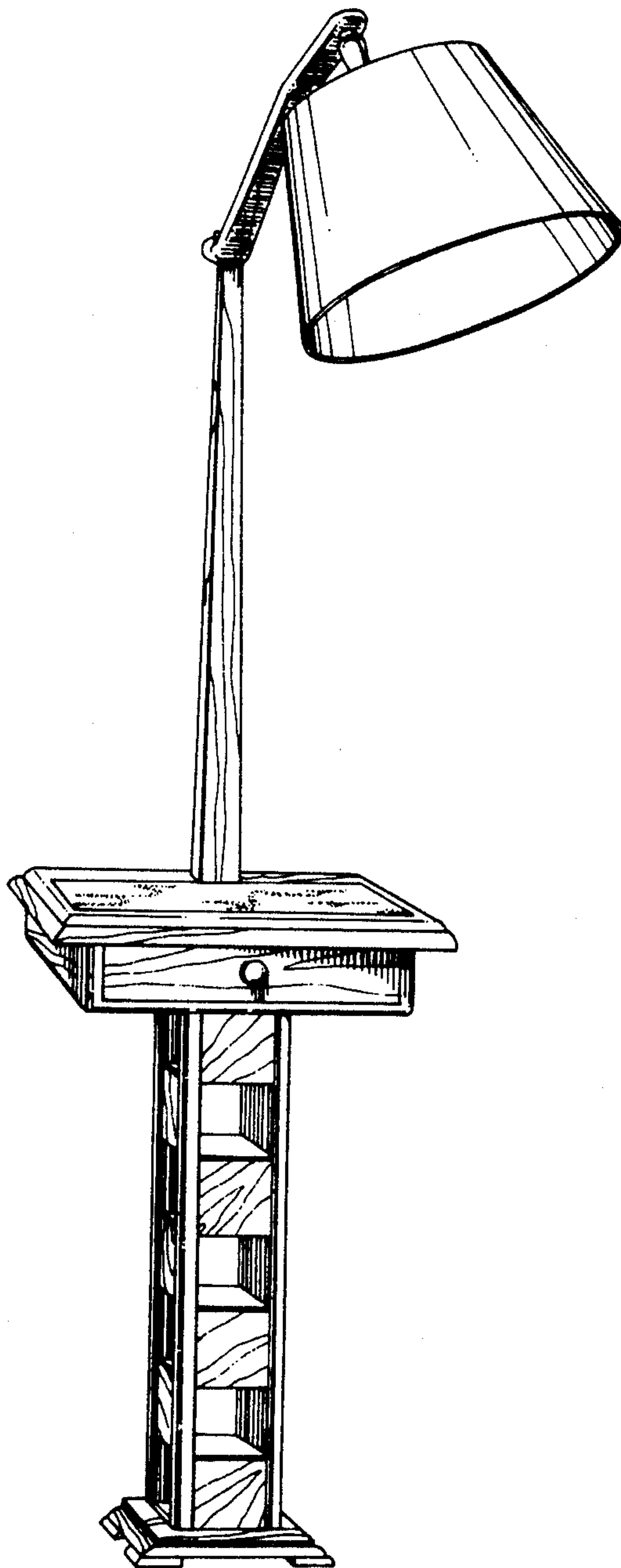

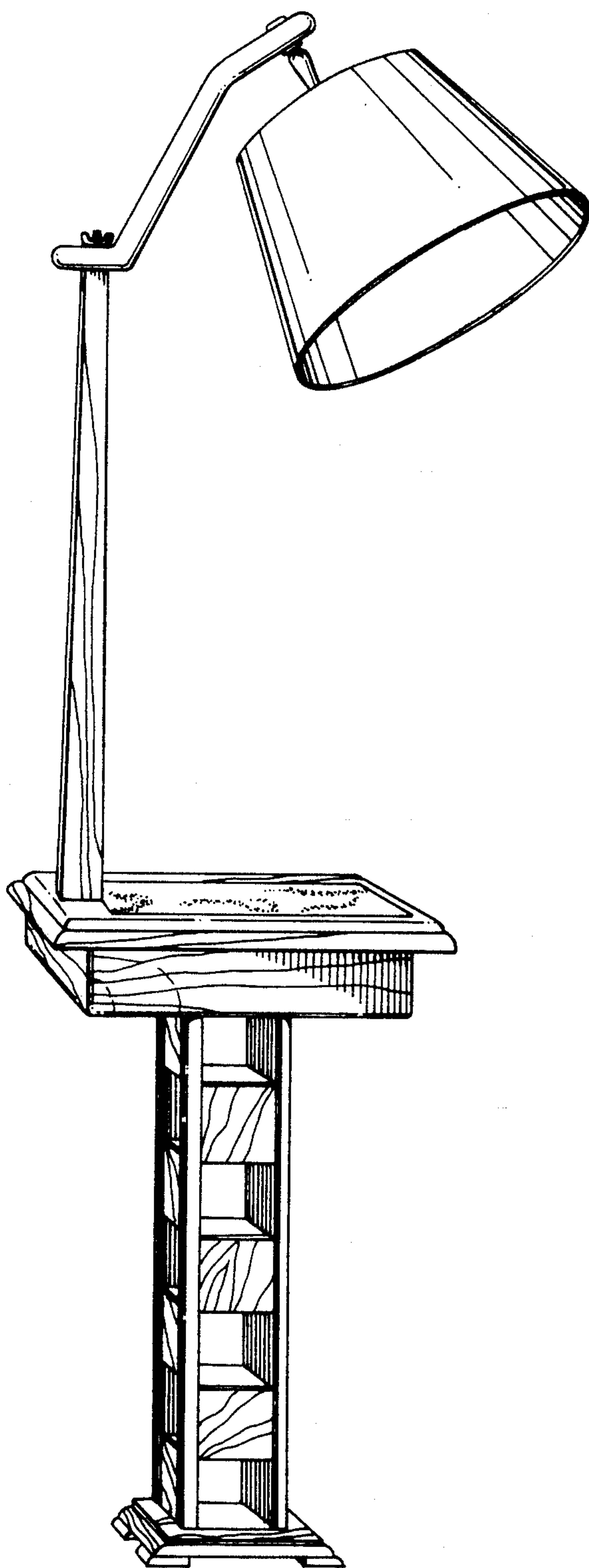
