central opening.

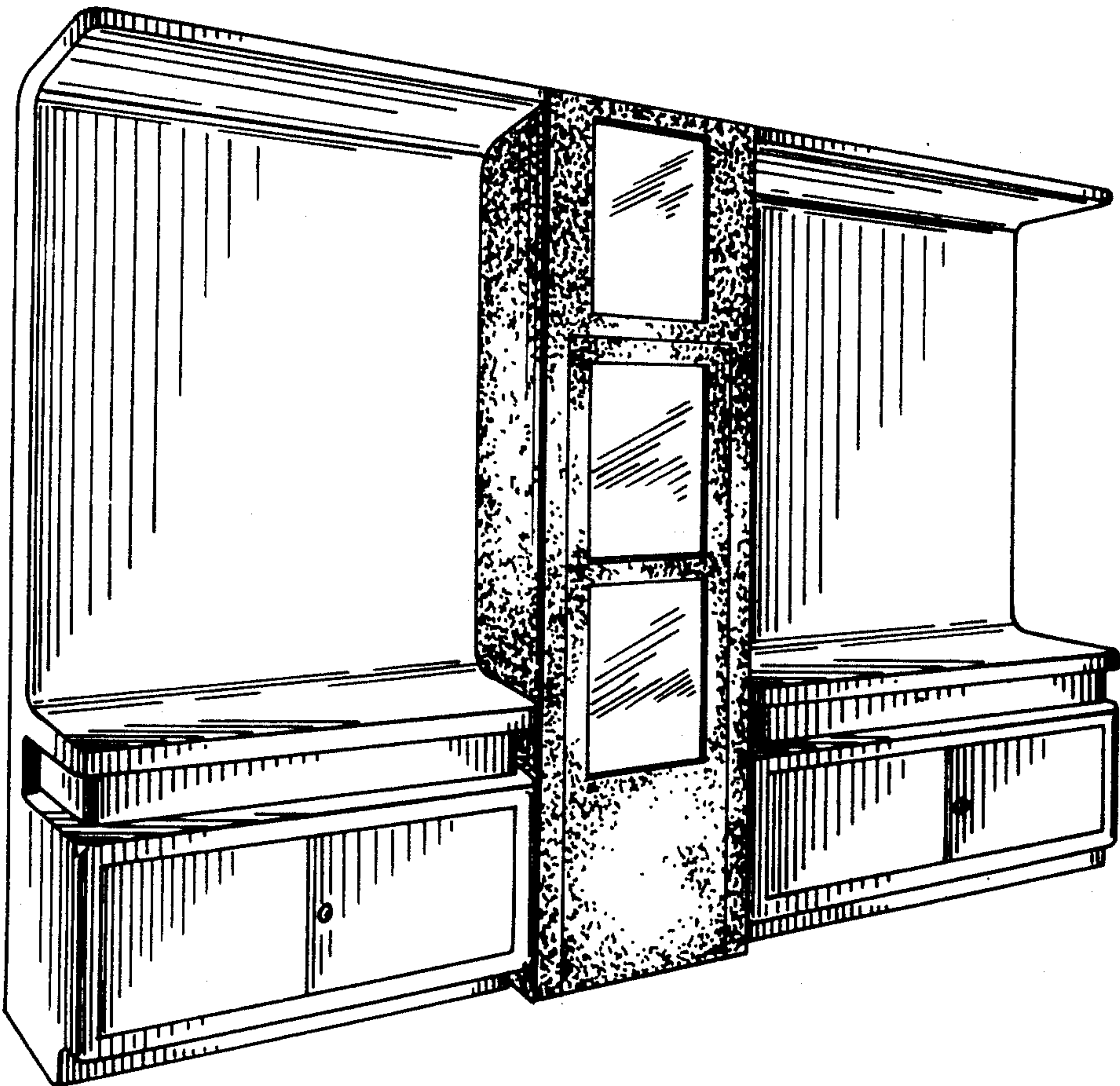

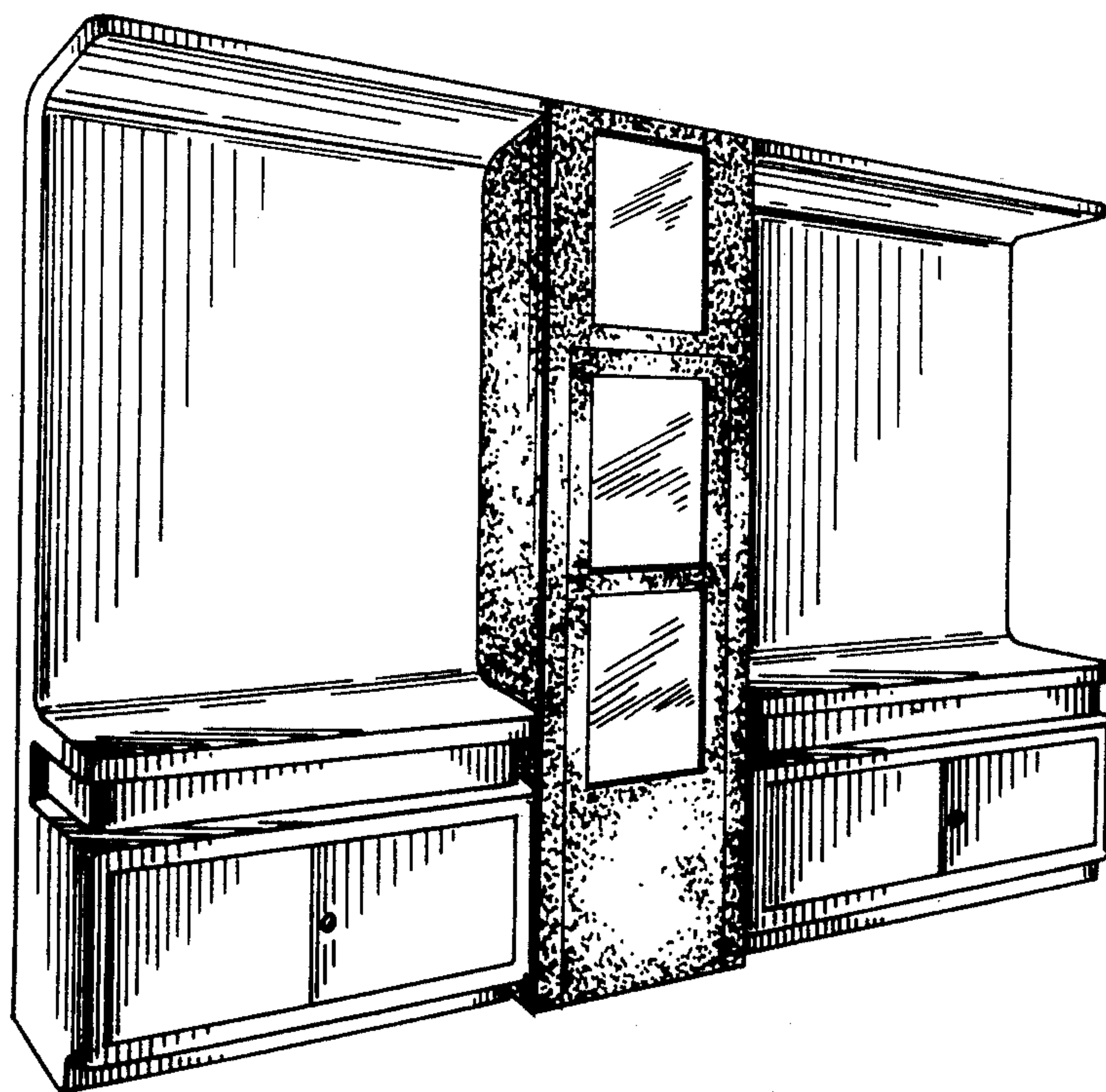

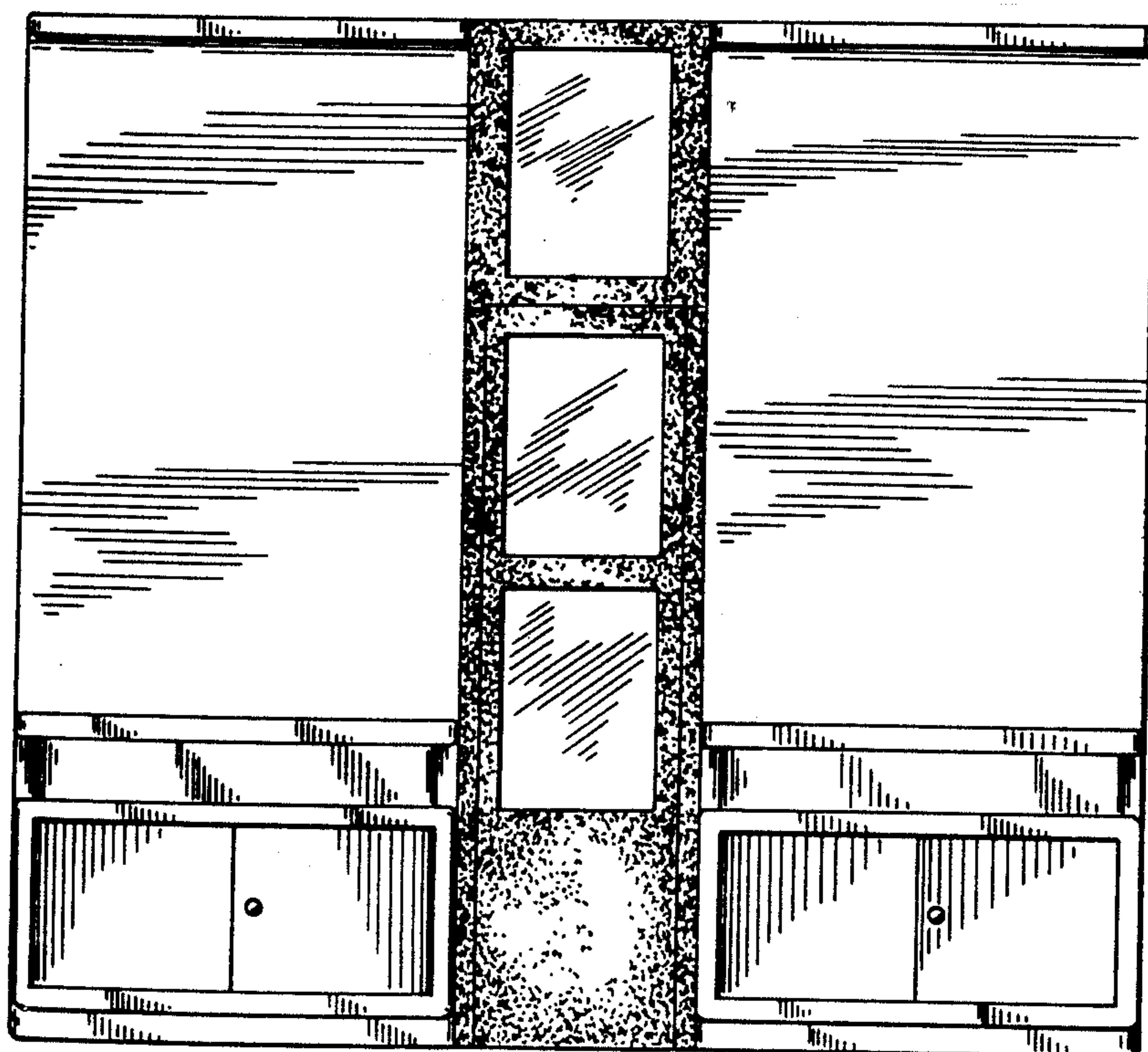

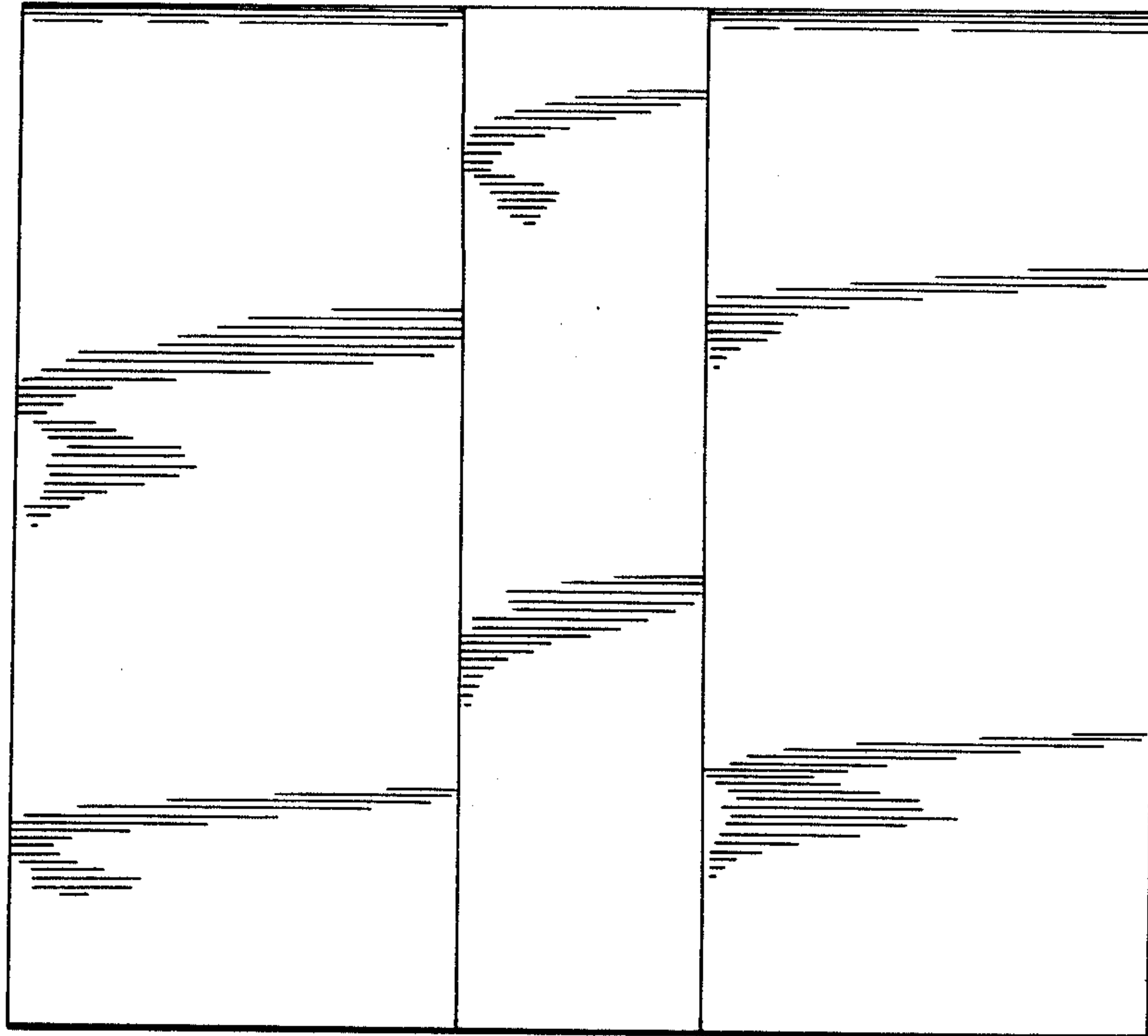

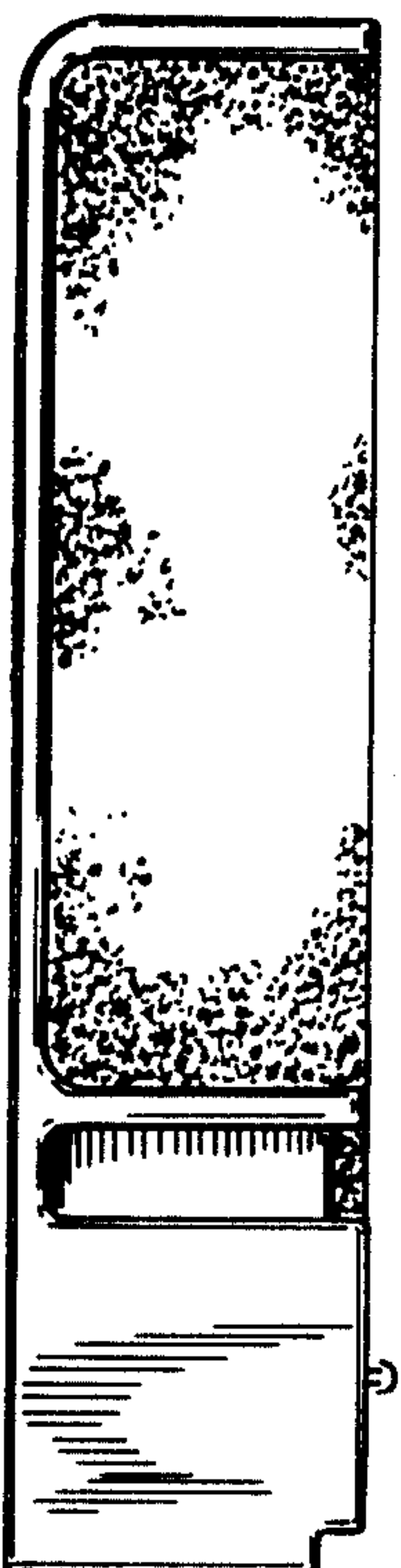
