[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a self-watering flower pot, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a self-watering flower pot showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view taken from the left of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a sectional view taken on line 6-6 of FIG. 4.

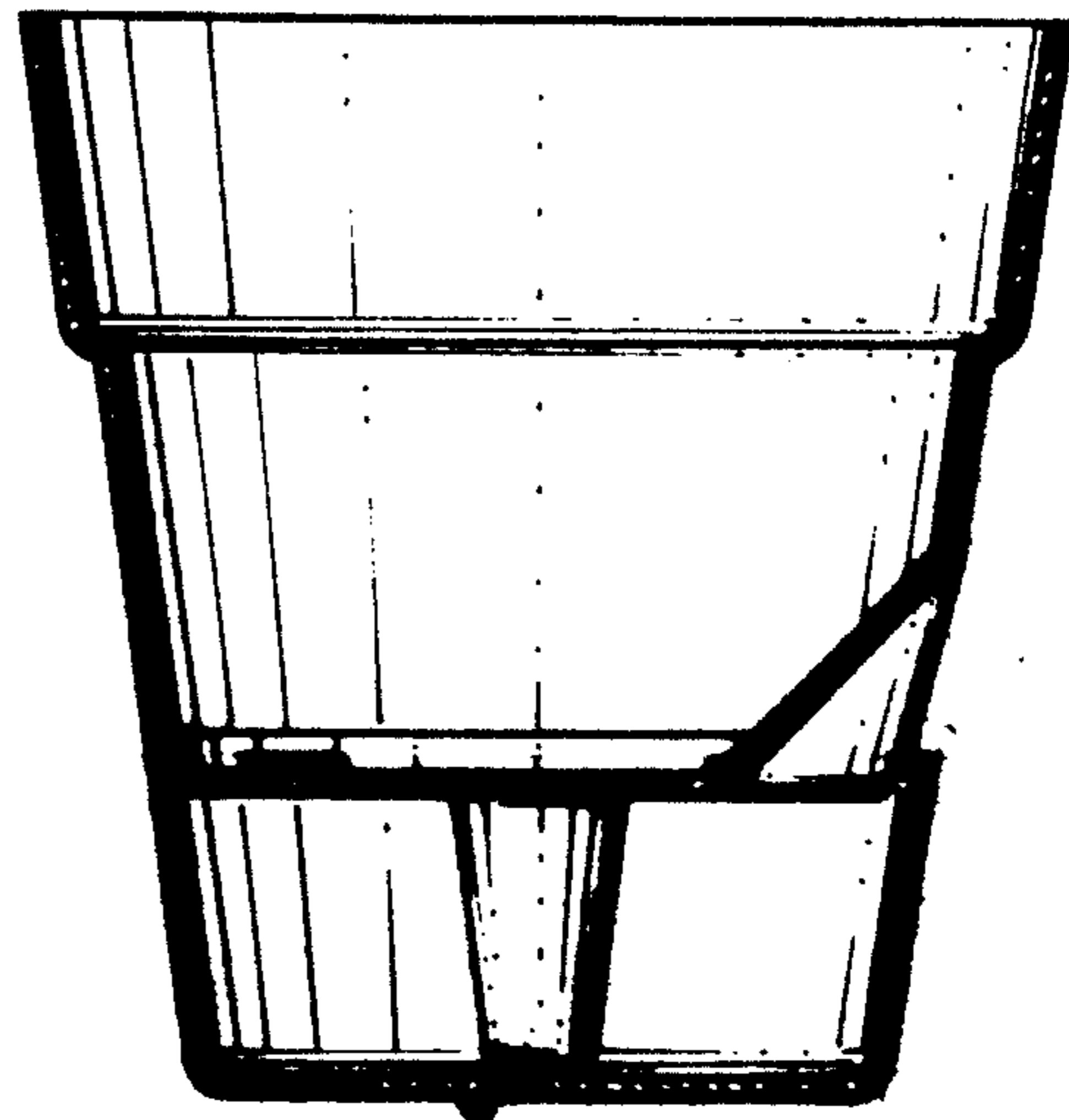
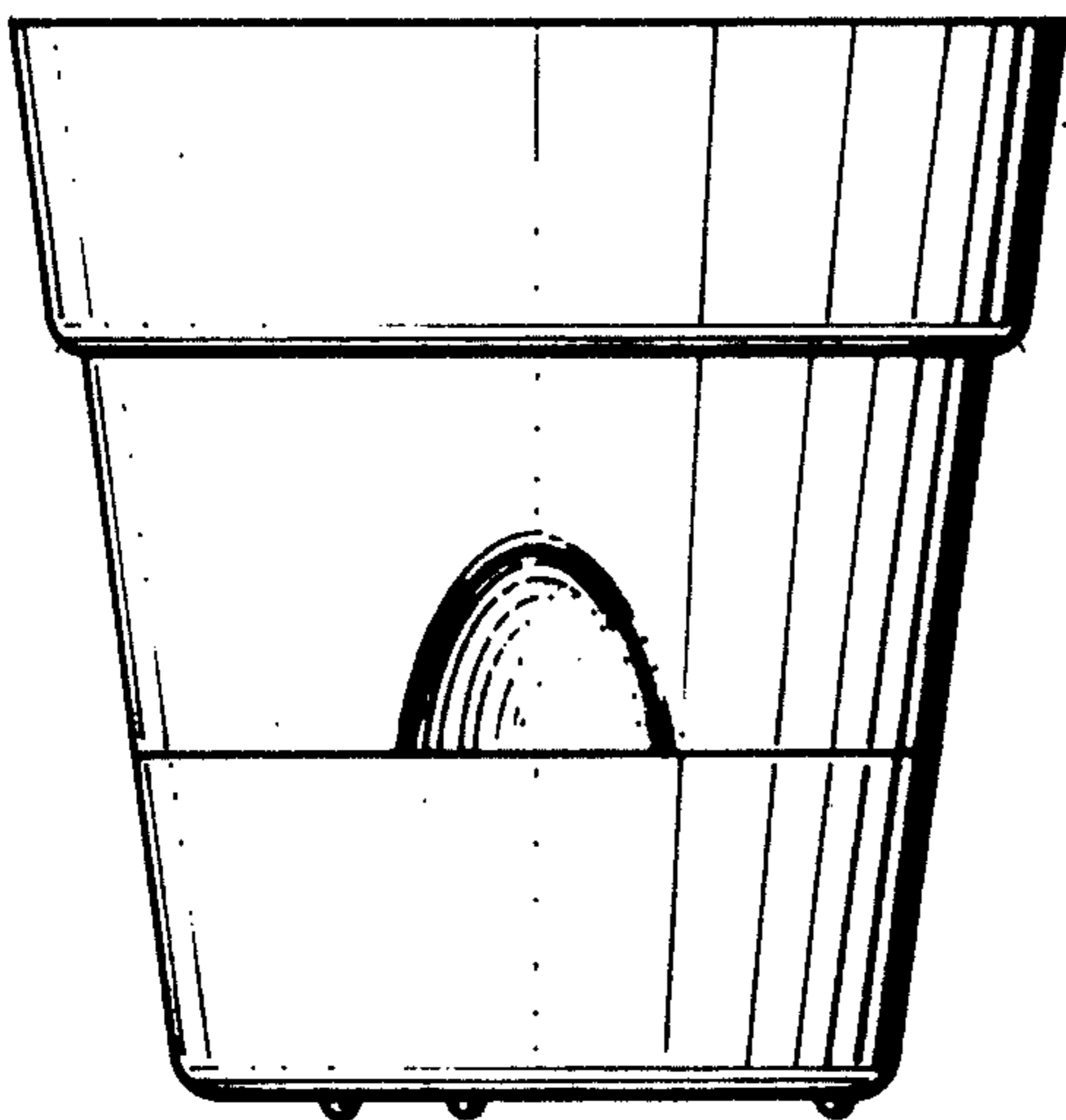

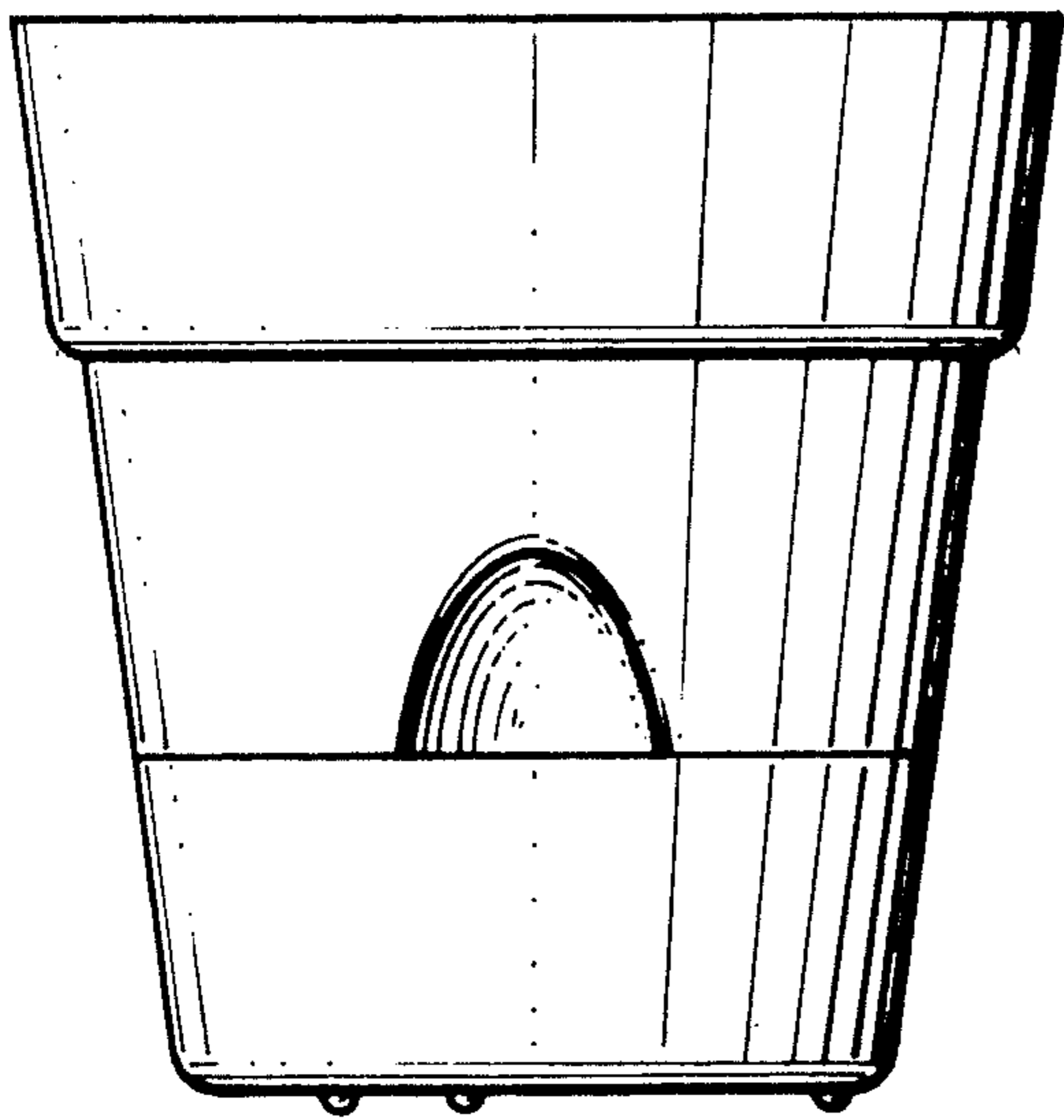

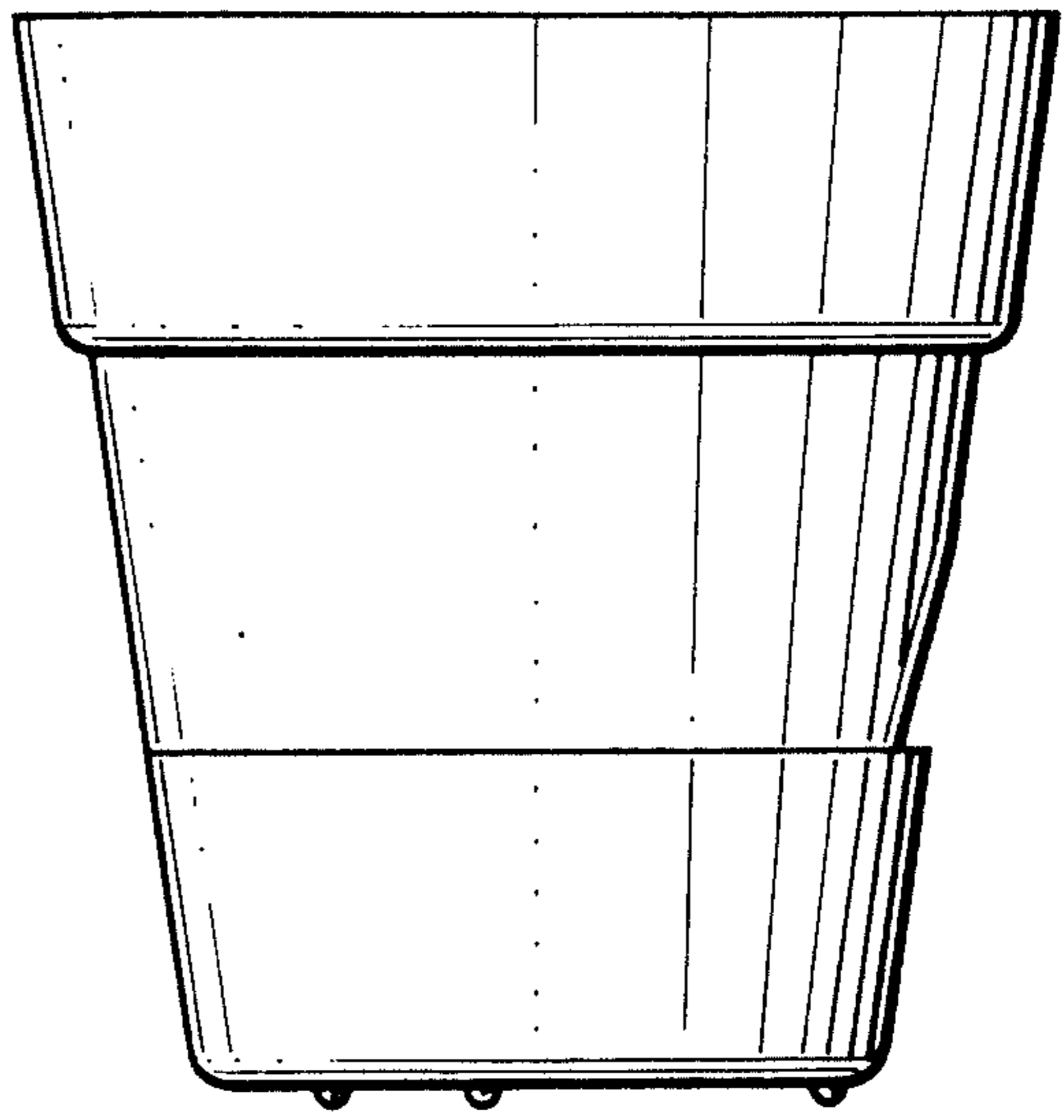

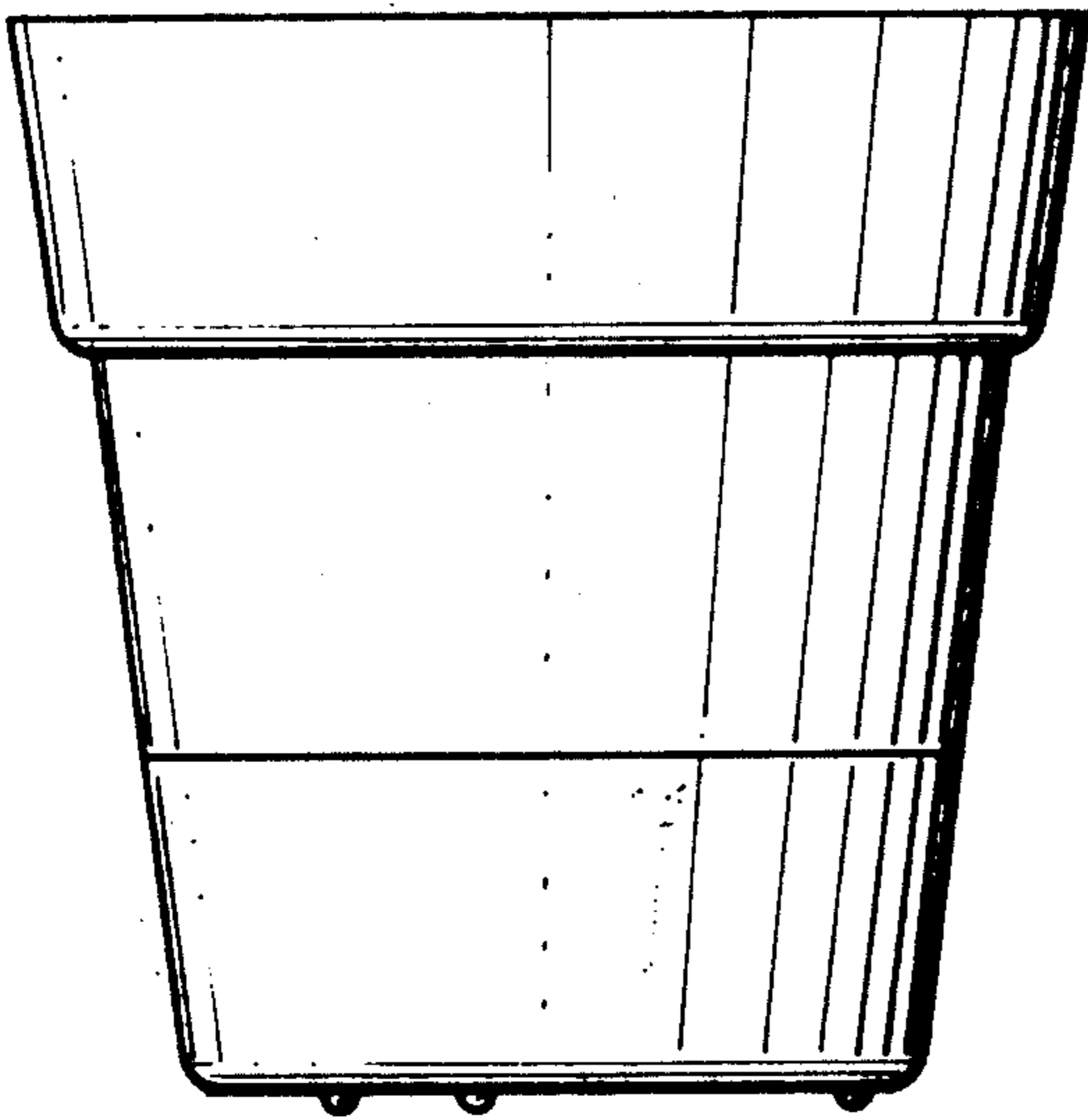

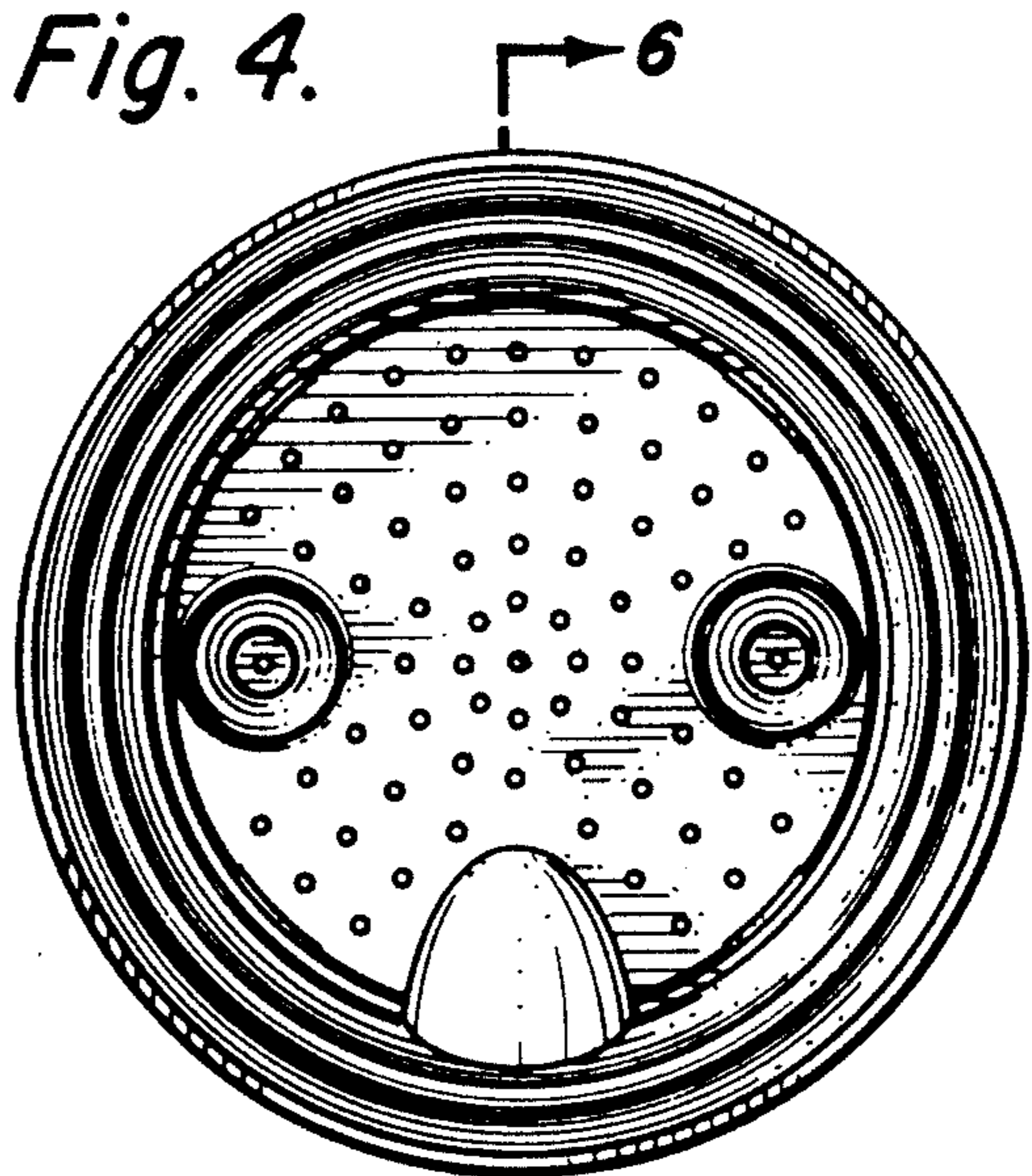

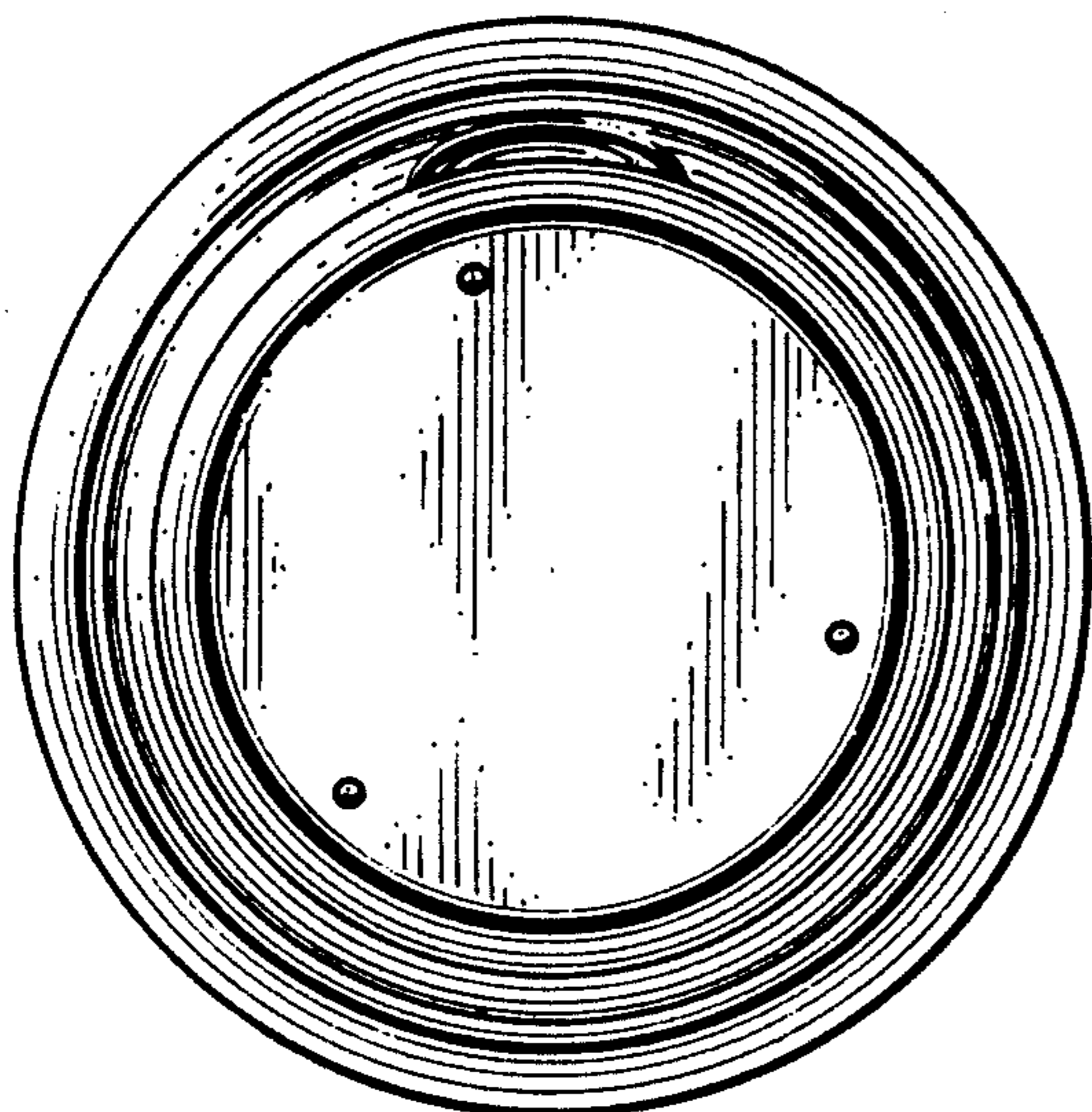
