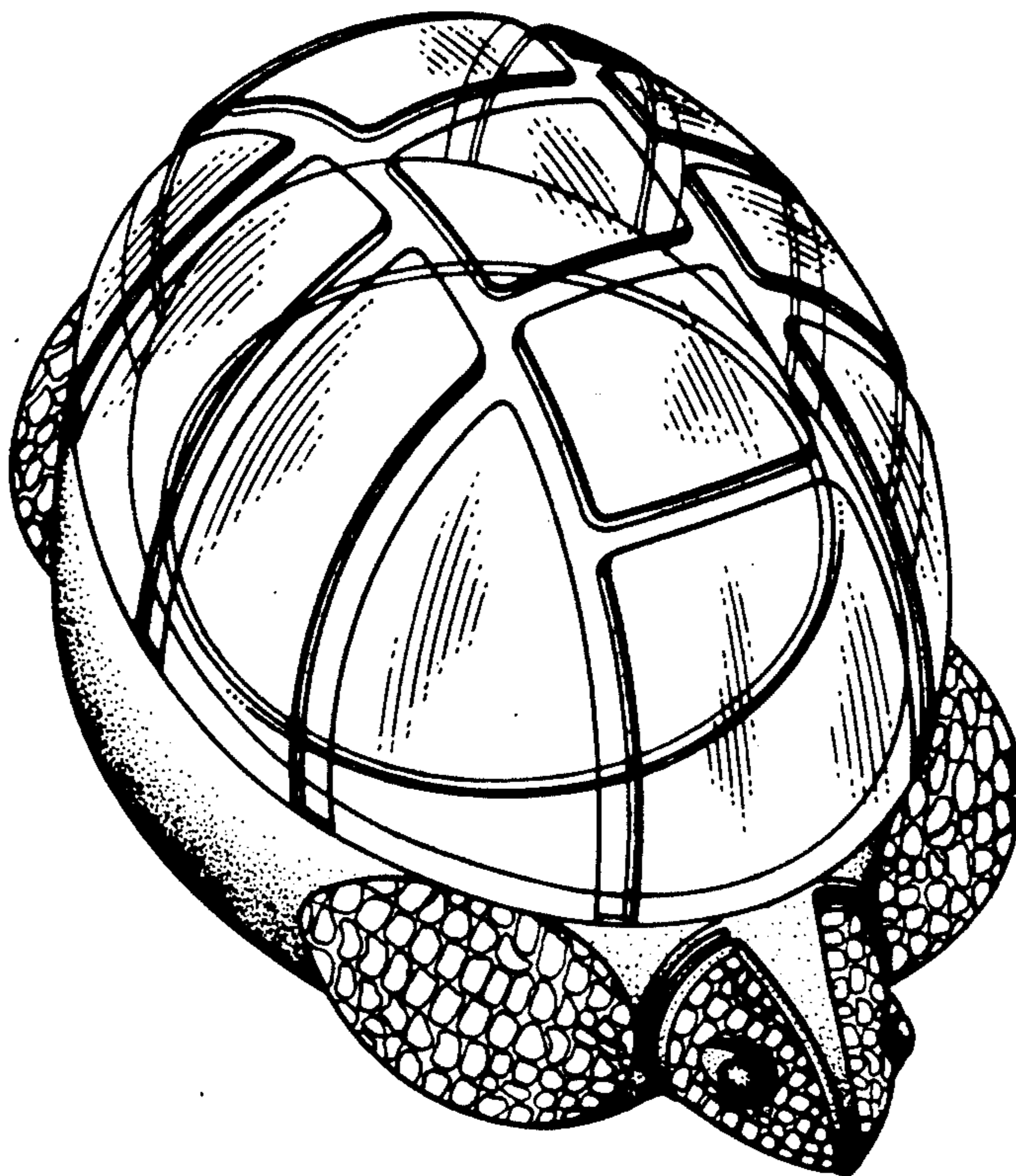

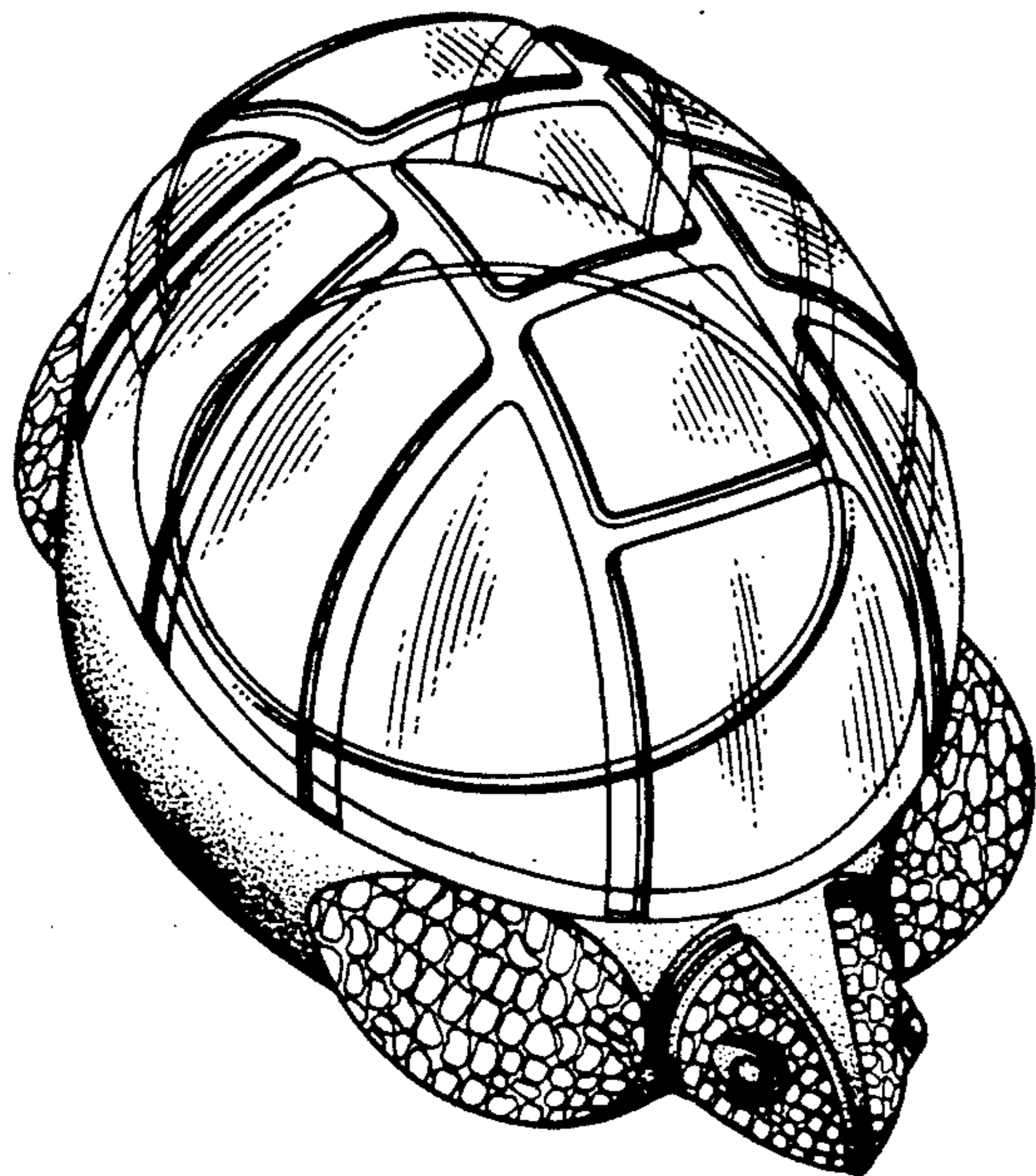
CLAIM

DESCRIPTION

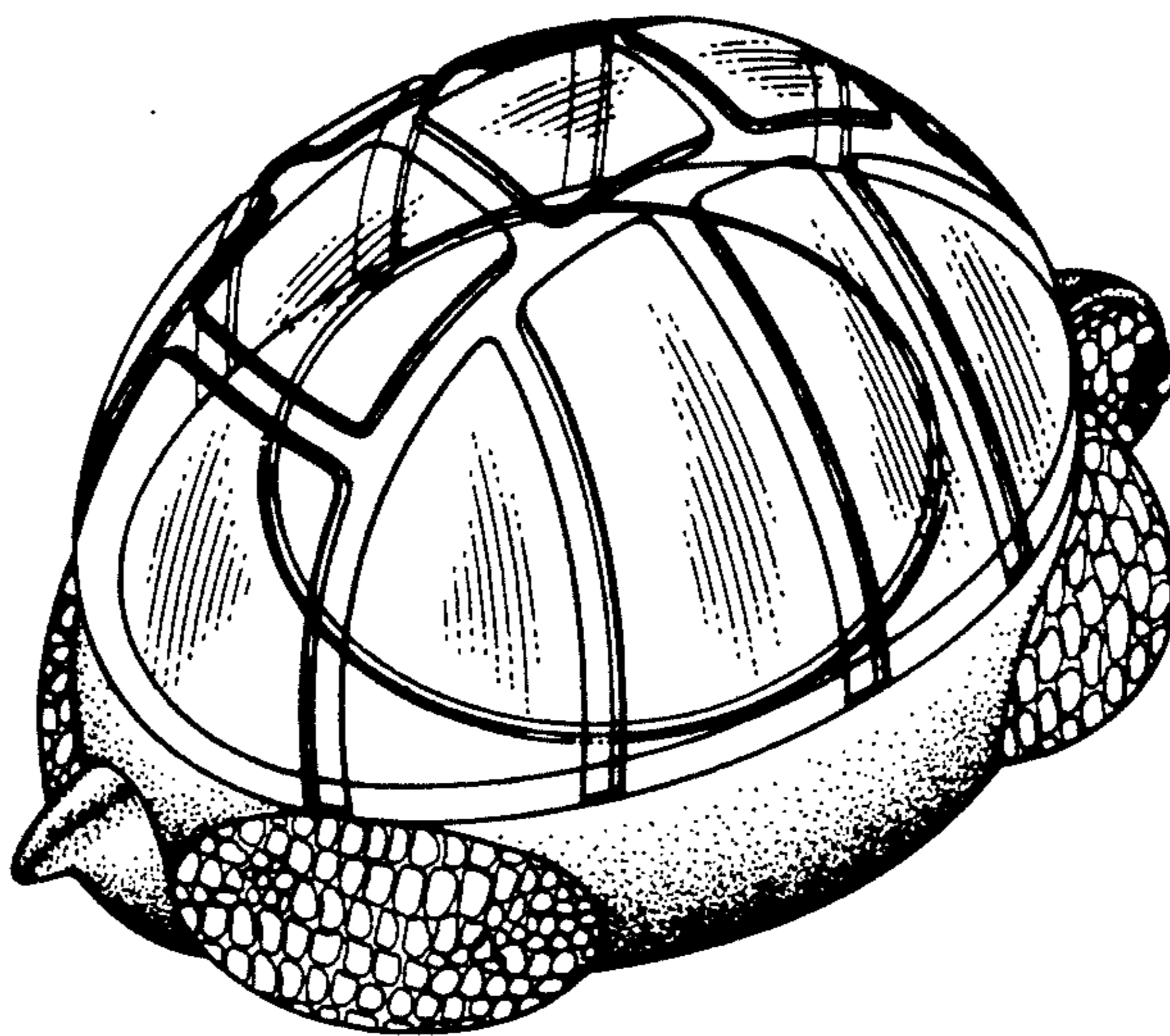
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a dusting powder

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.



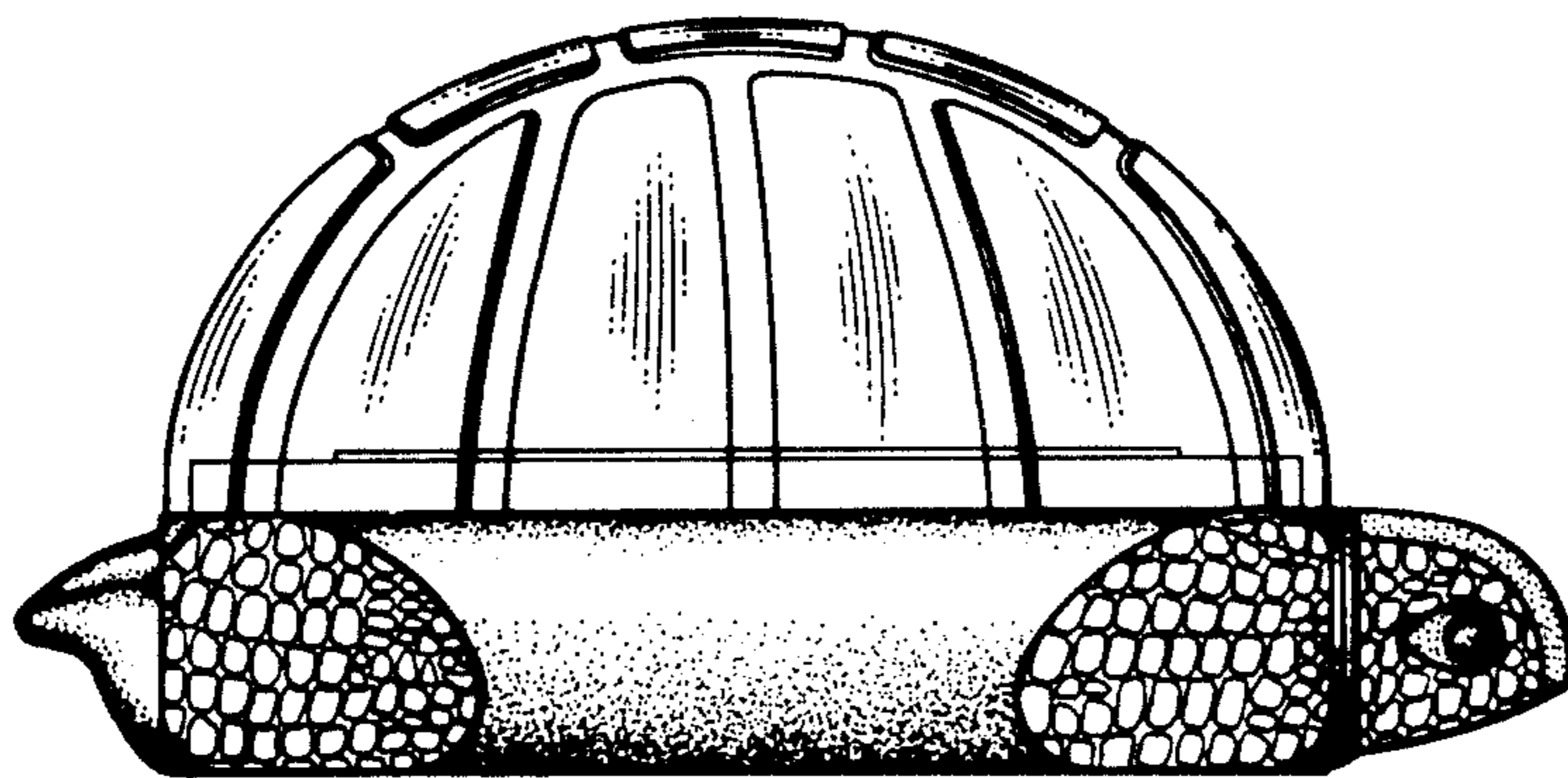
