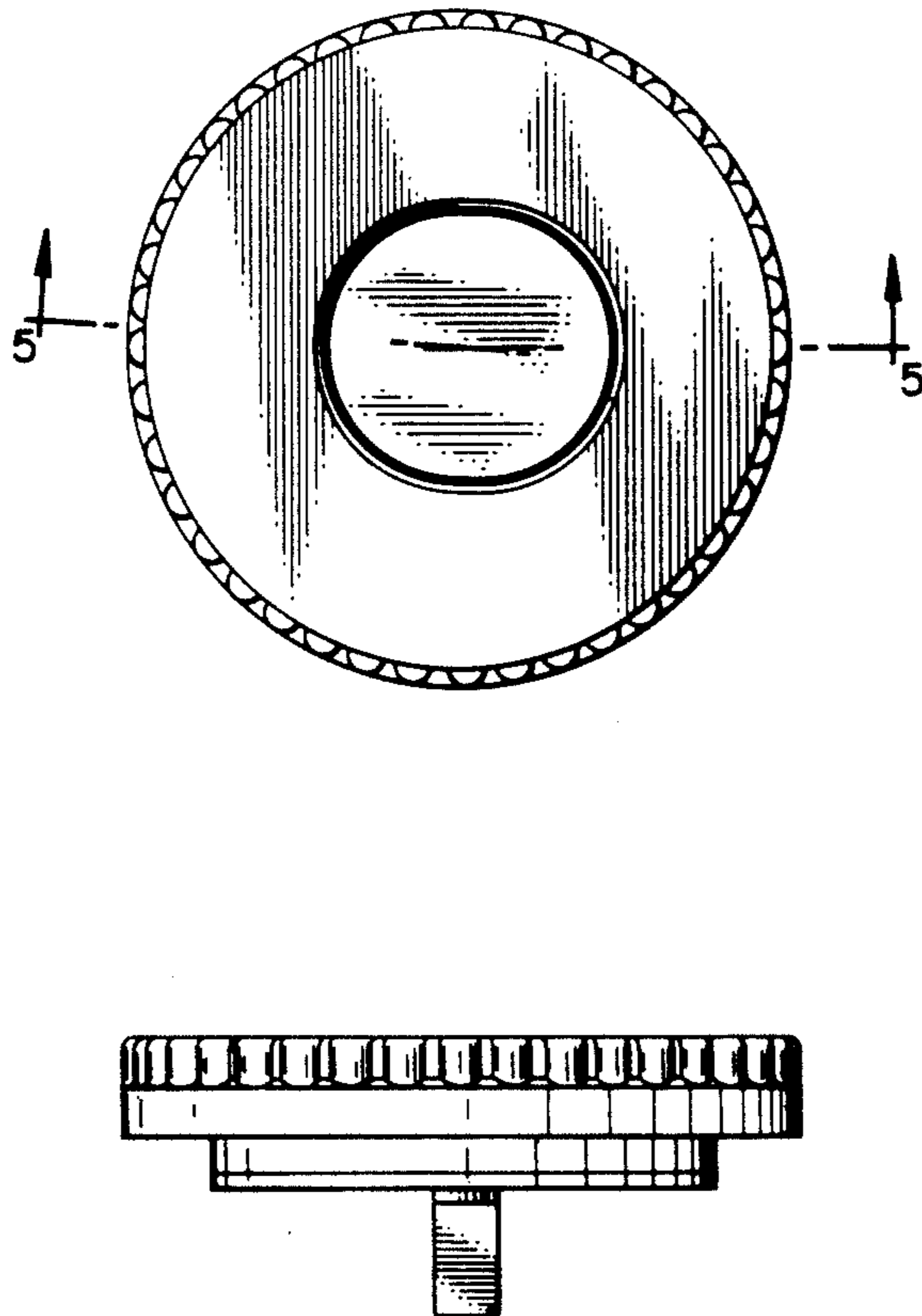
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a tank cap, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a tank cap showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear being a mirror image of the front shown herein;
 FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being substantially a mirror image of the right side shown herein; and
 FIG. 5 is an enlarged cross-sectional view thereof taken along line 5—5 of FIG. 1.

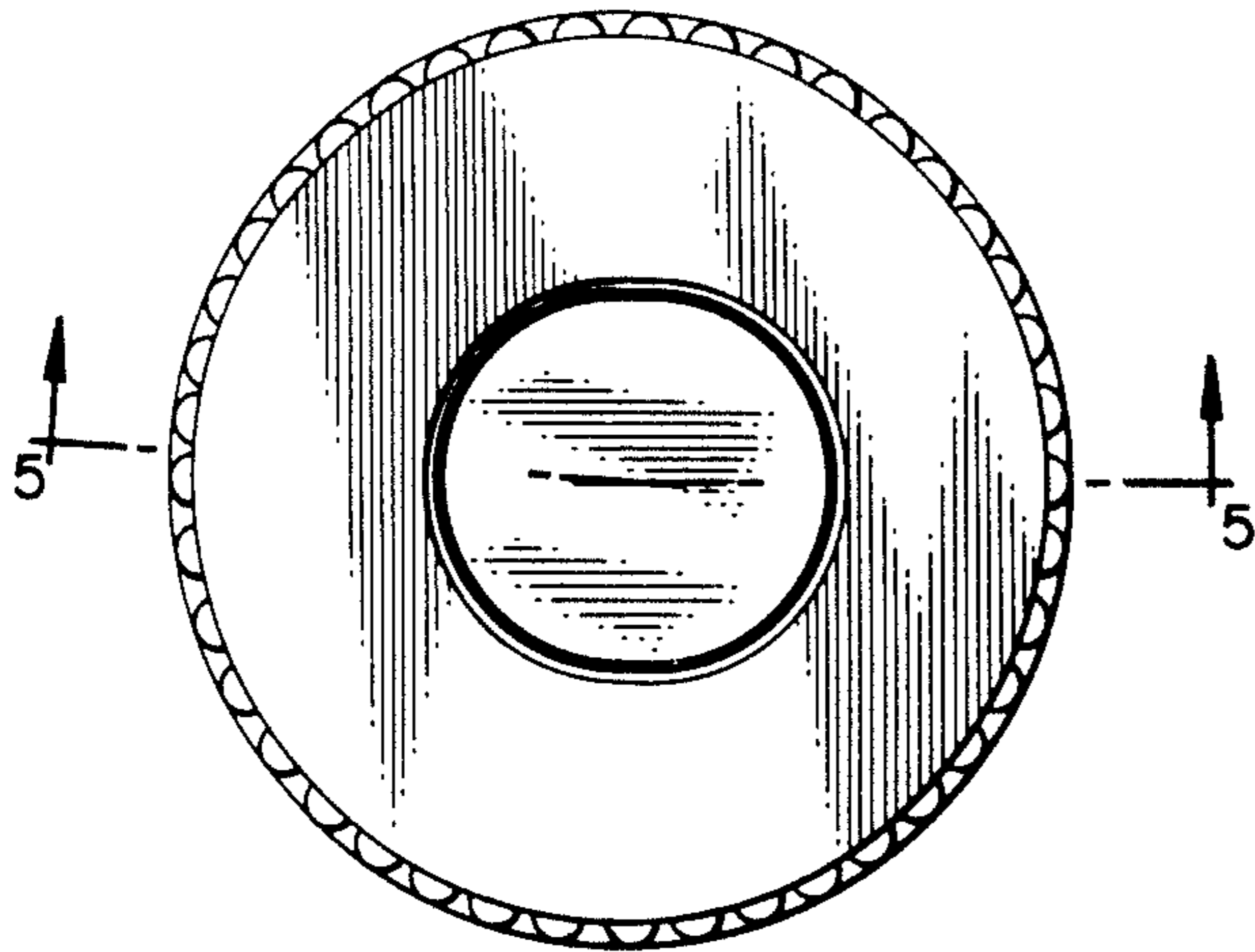

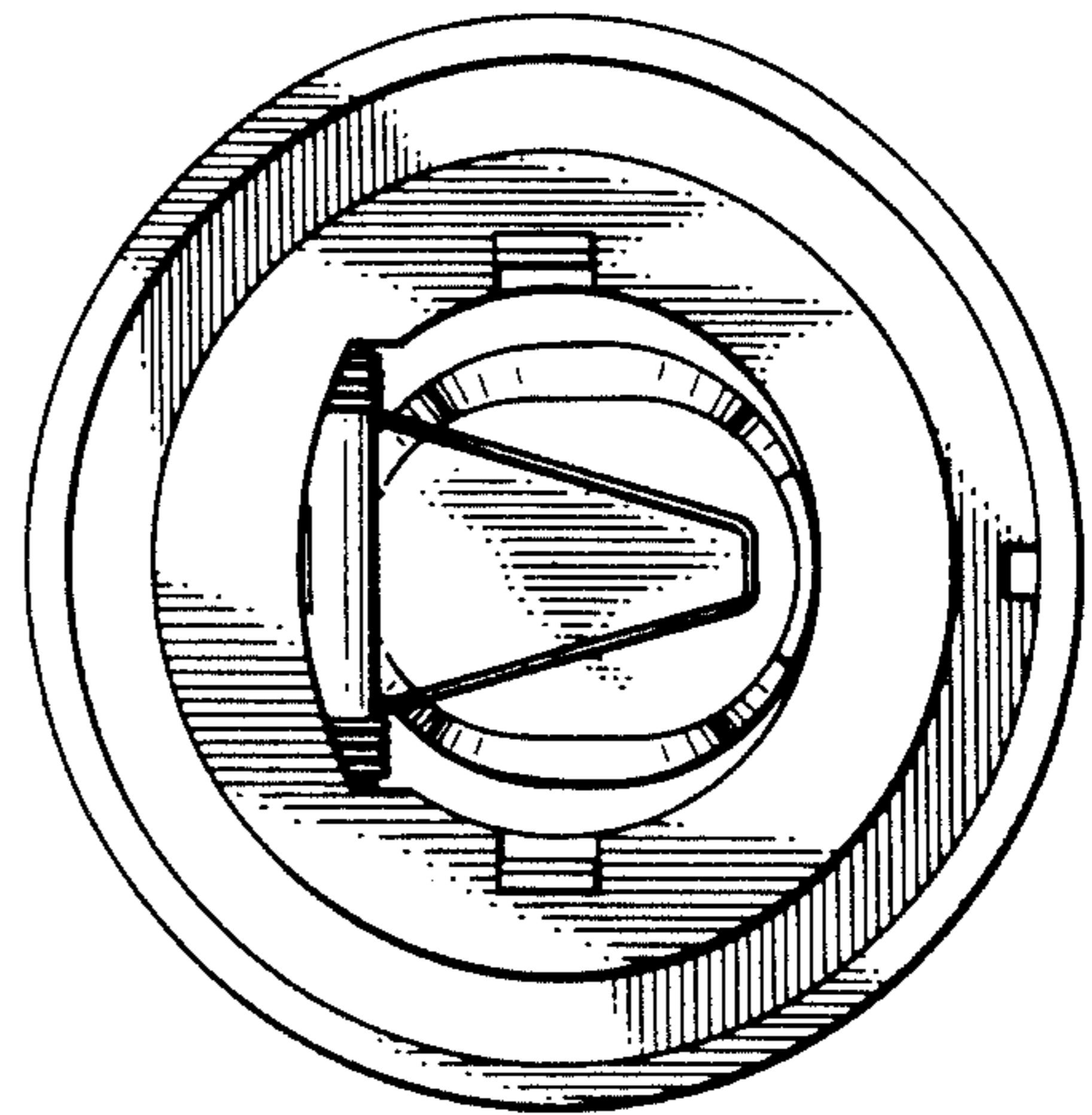

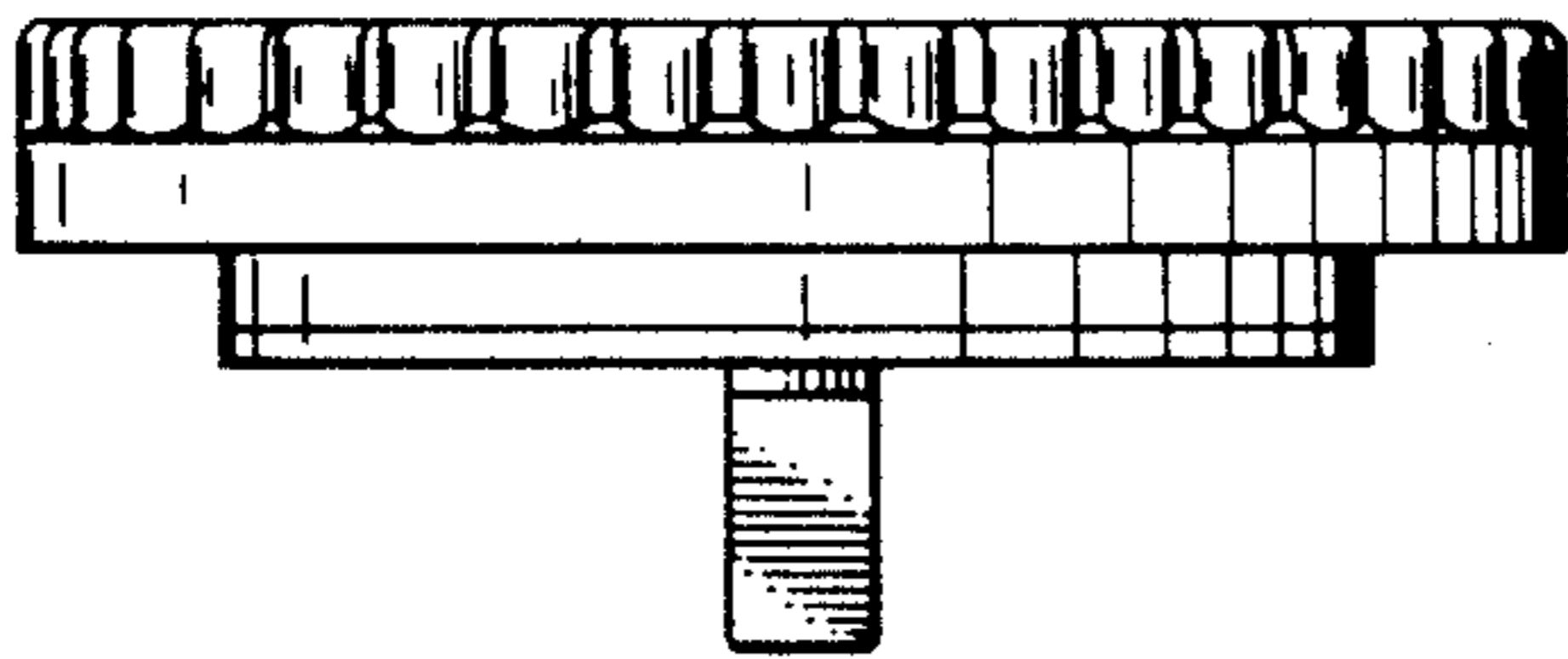

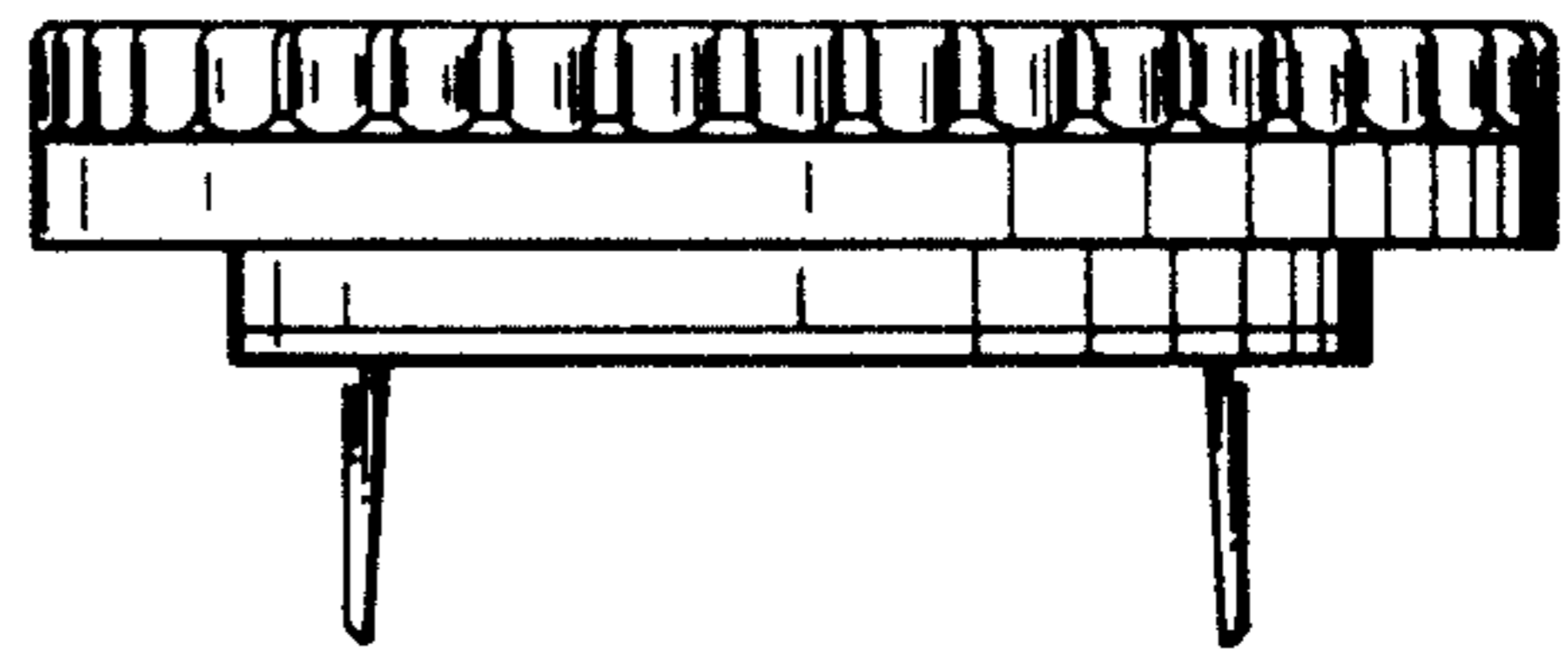

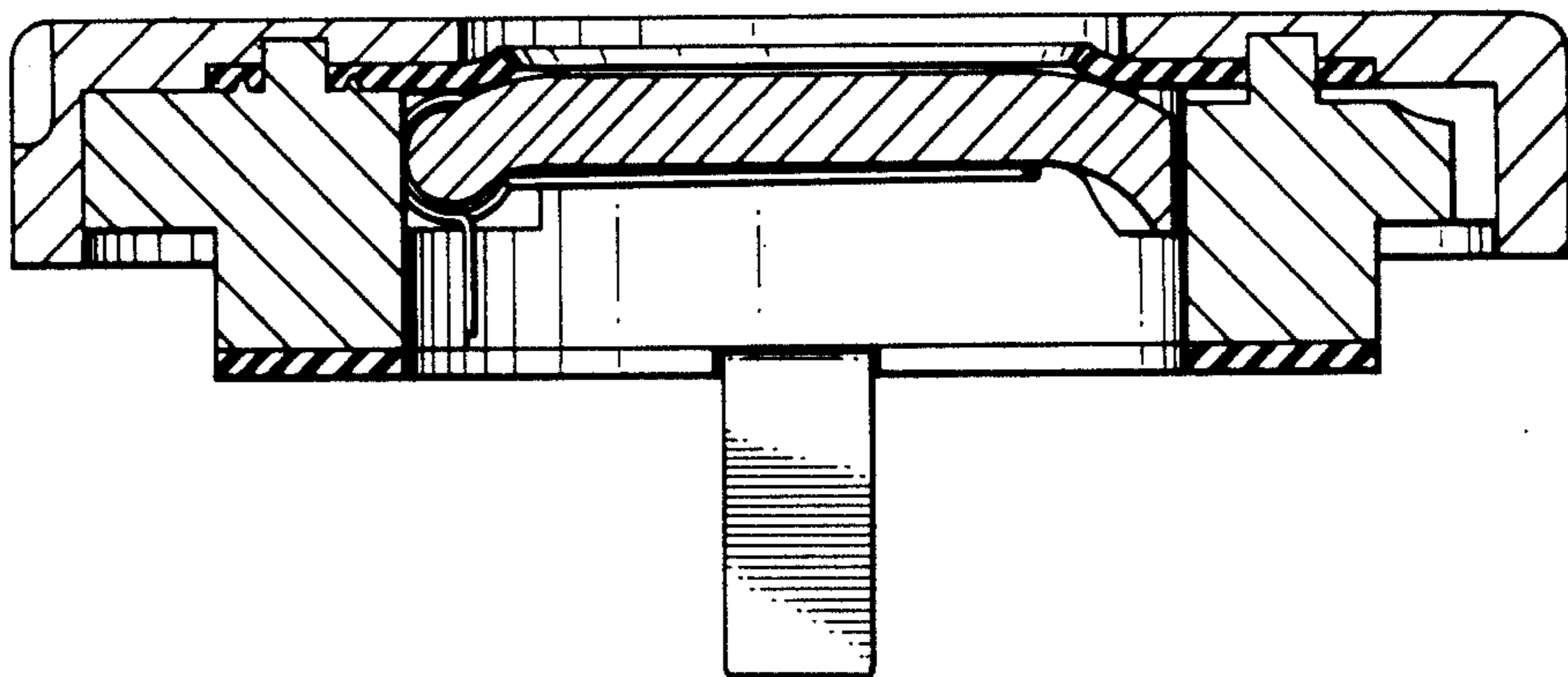
