CLAIM

The ornamental design for an insulated cover for a food tray or the like, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an insulated cover for a food tray or the like showing my new design; FIG. 2 is an enlarged top plan view; FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is an end elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and FIG. 6 is an enlarged perspective view taken from the underside thereof.

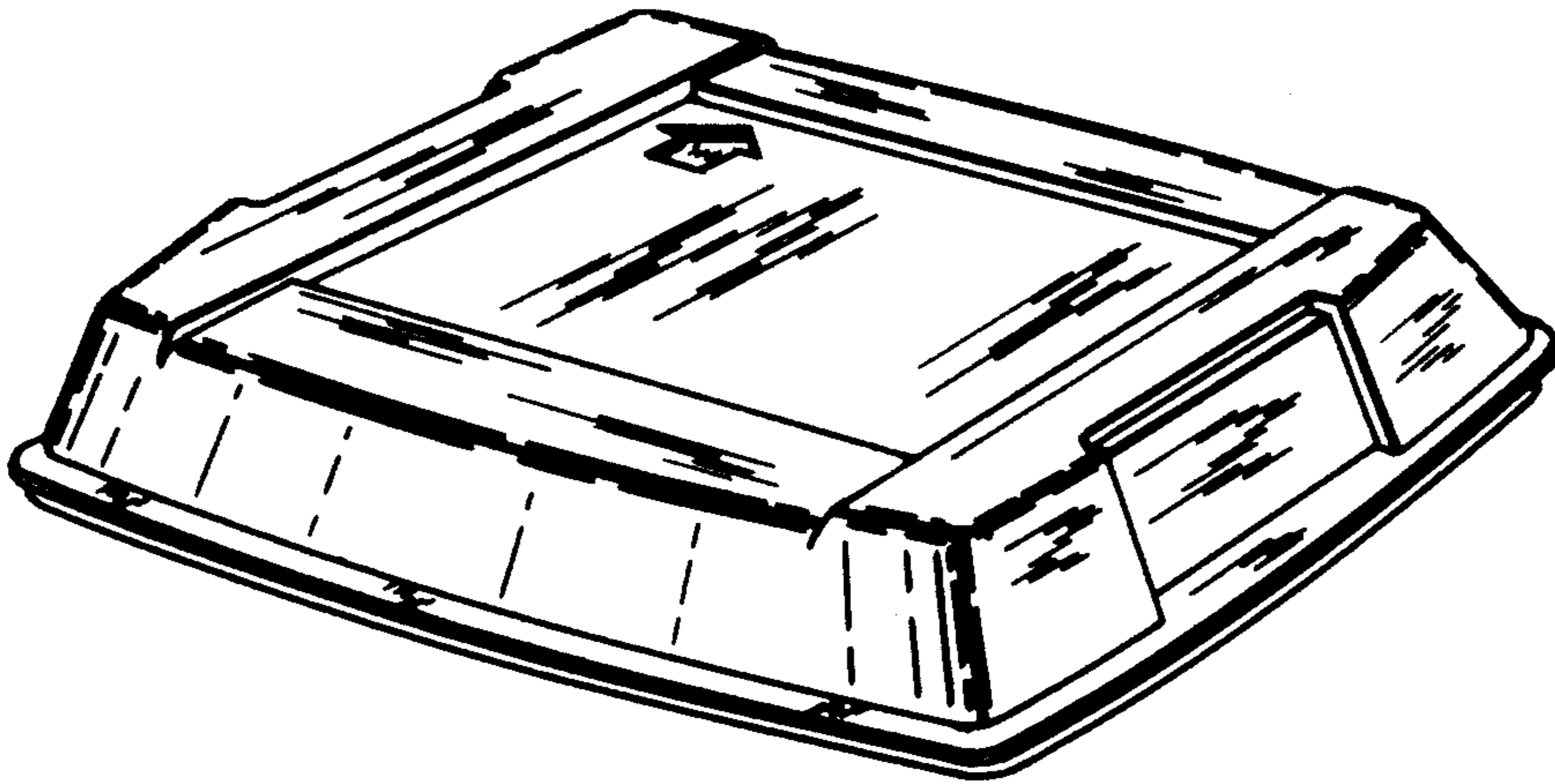

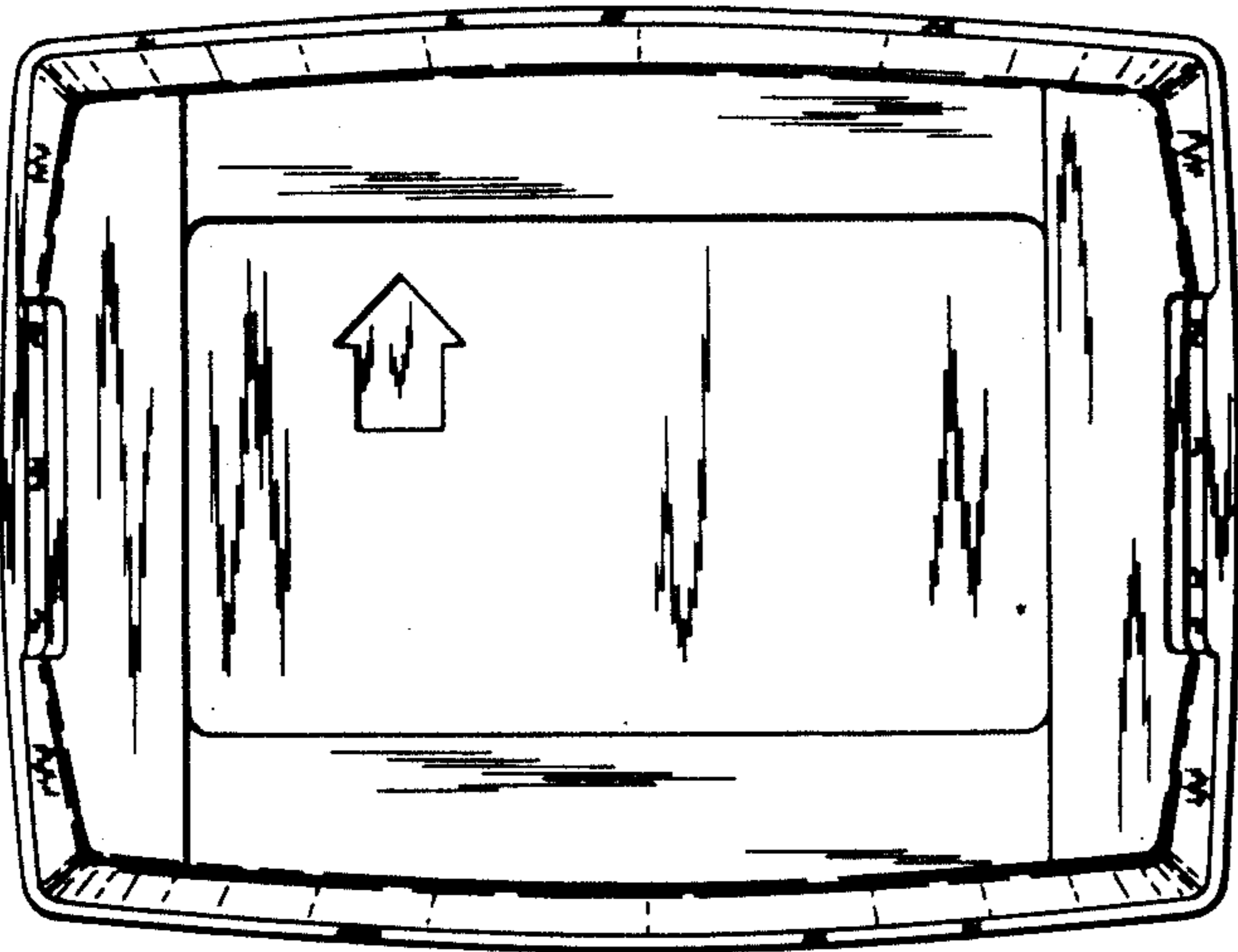
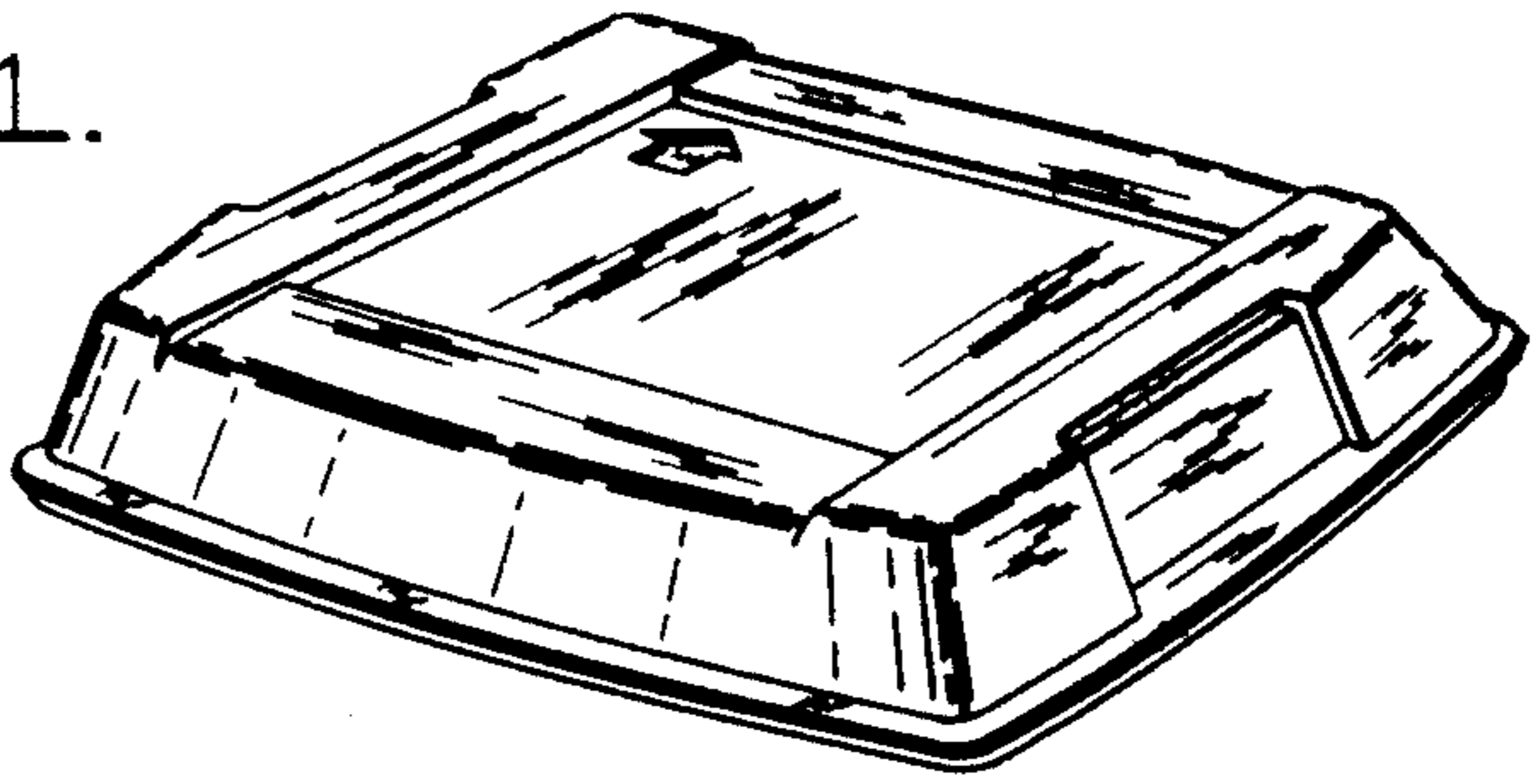

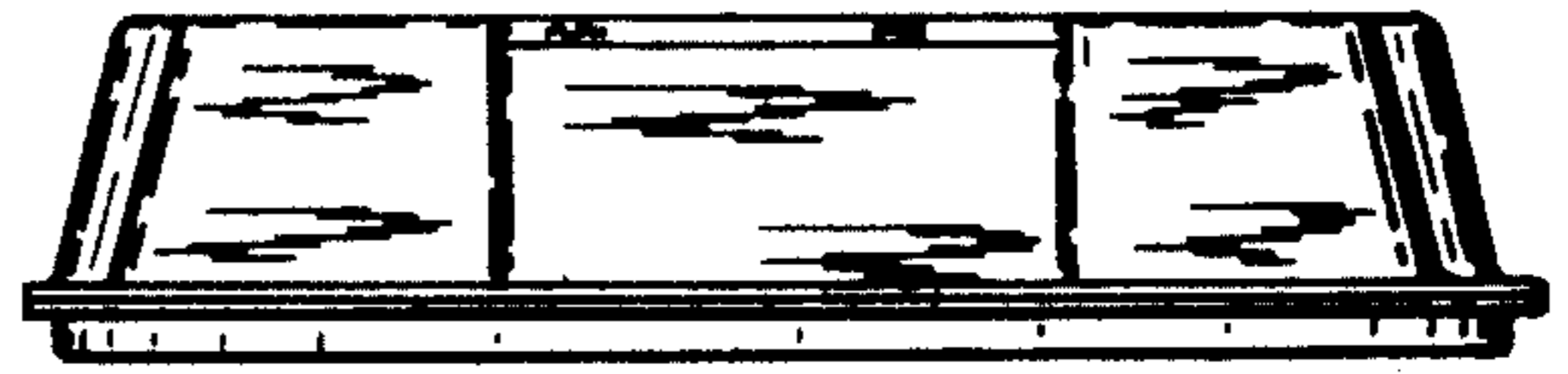
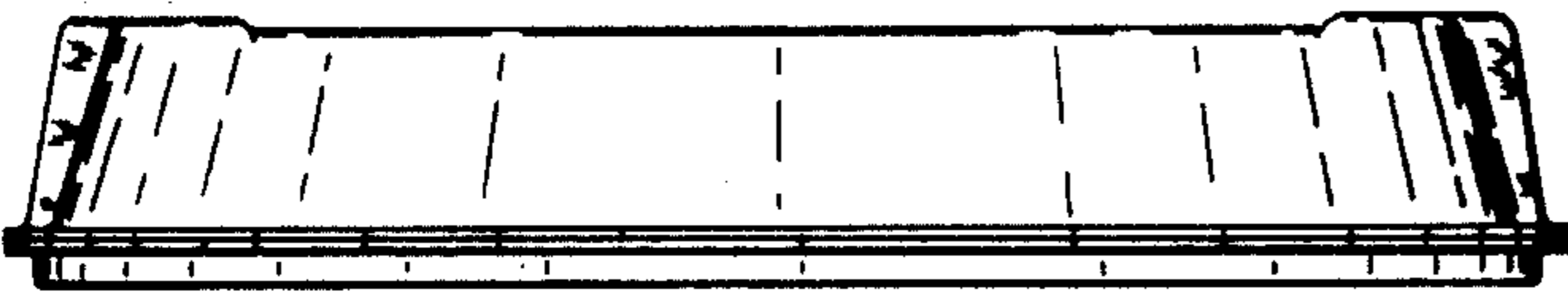

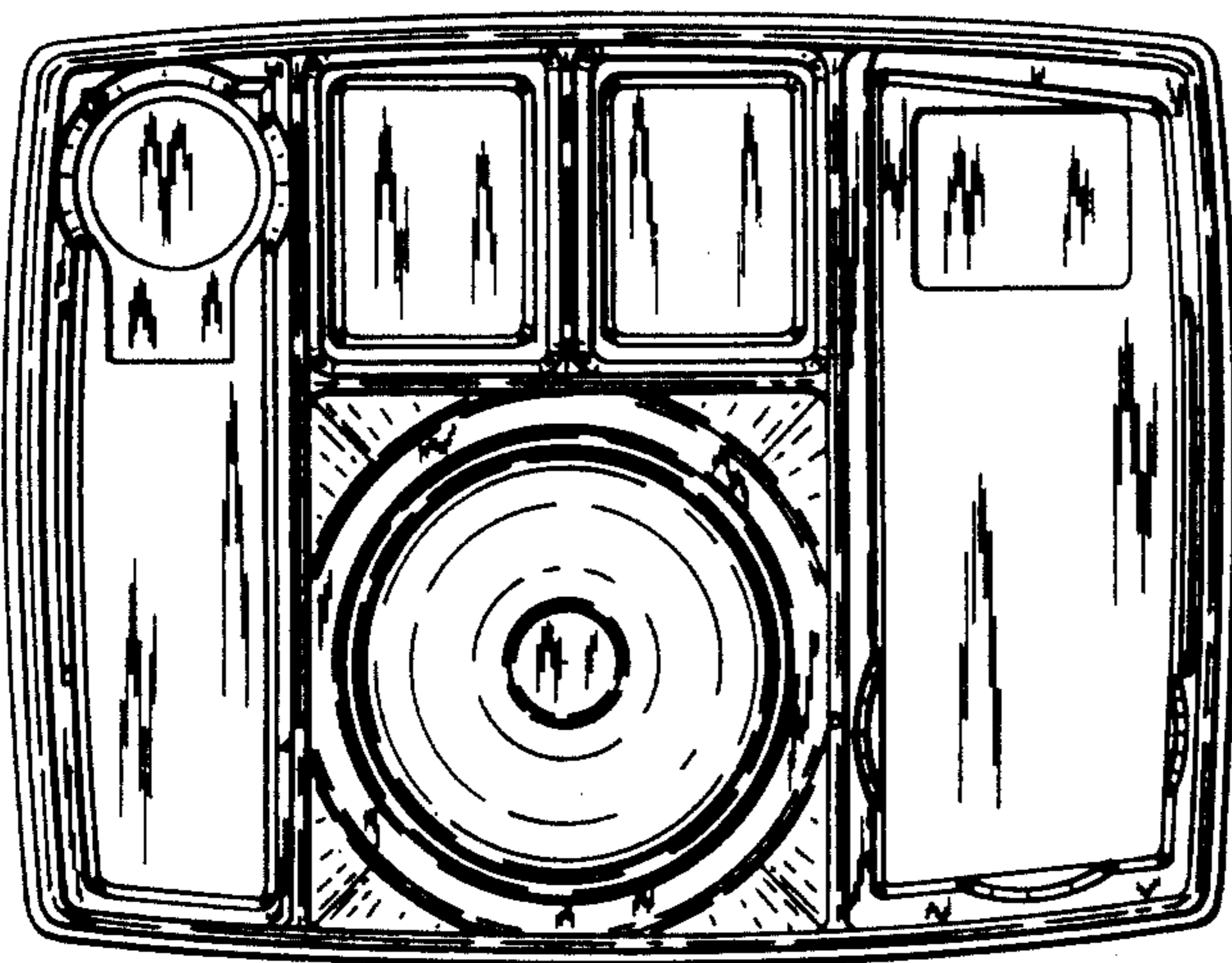

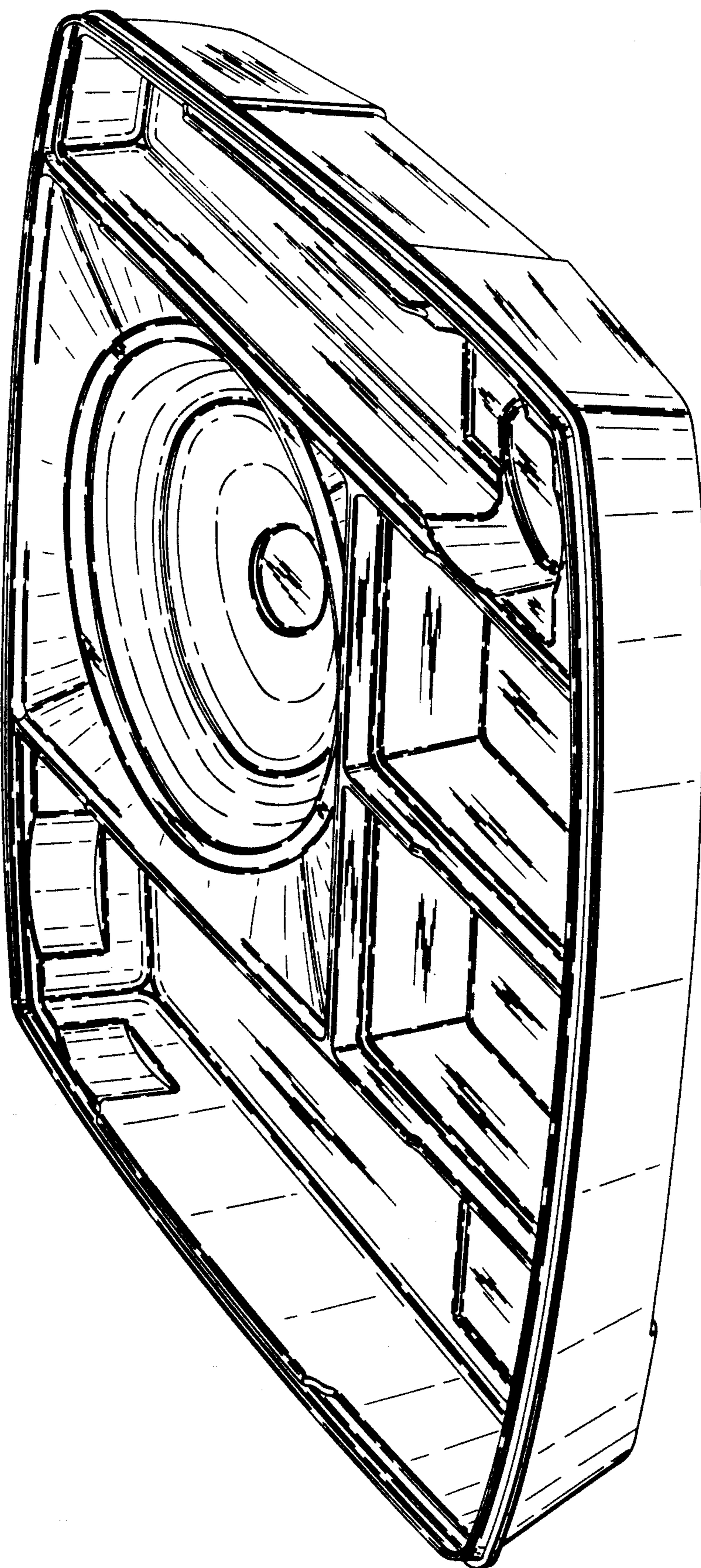
