[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a jewelry medallion or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a plan view of a jewelry medallion or similar article showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;
The rear is plain and unadorned.

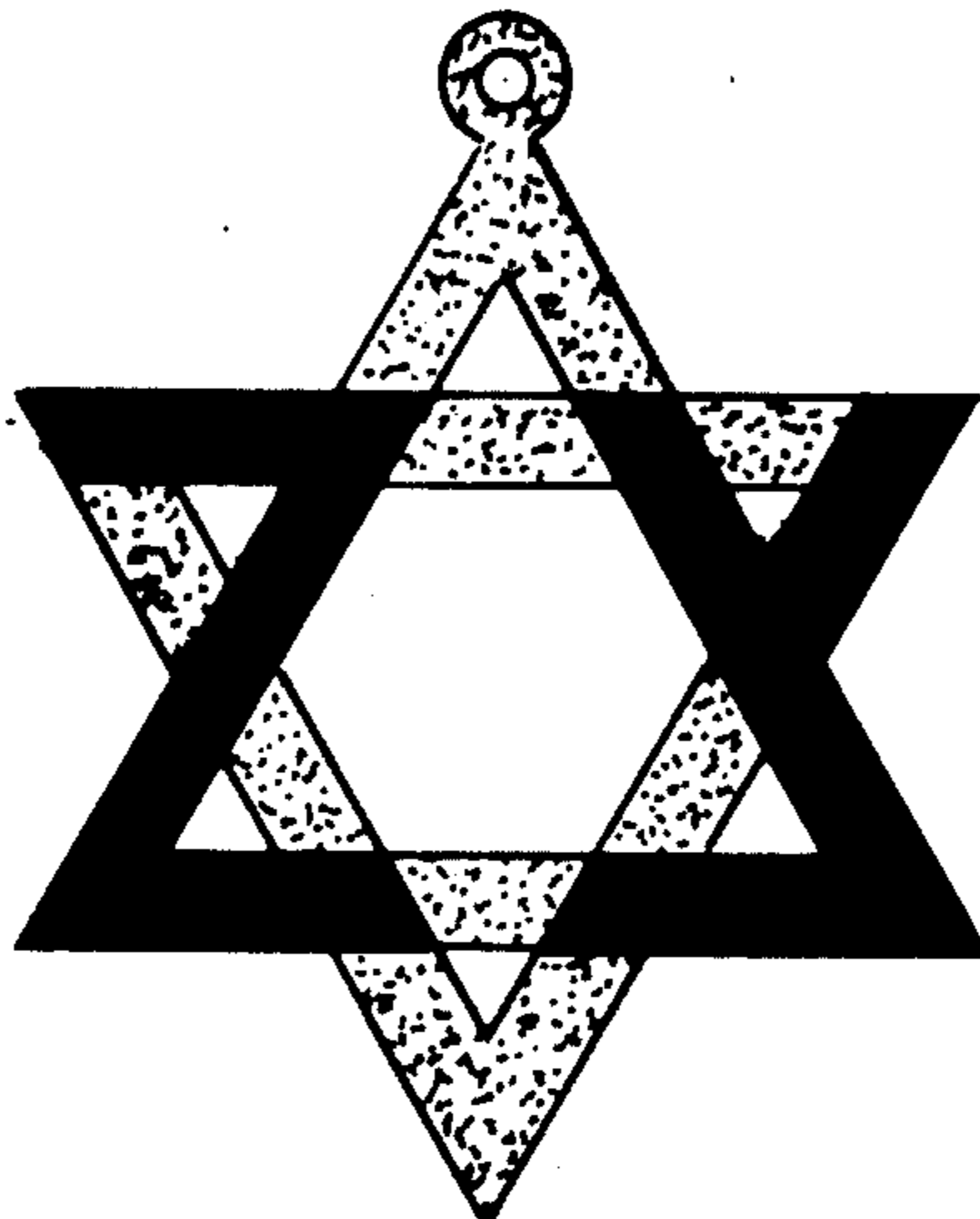

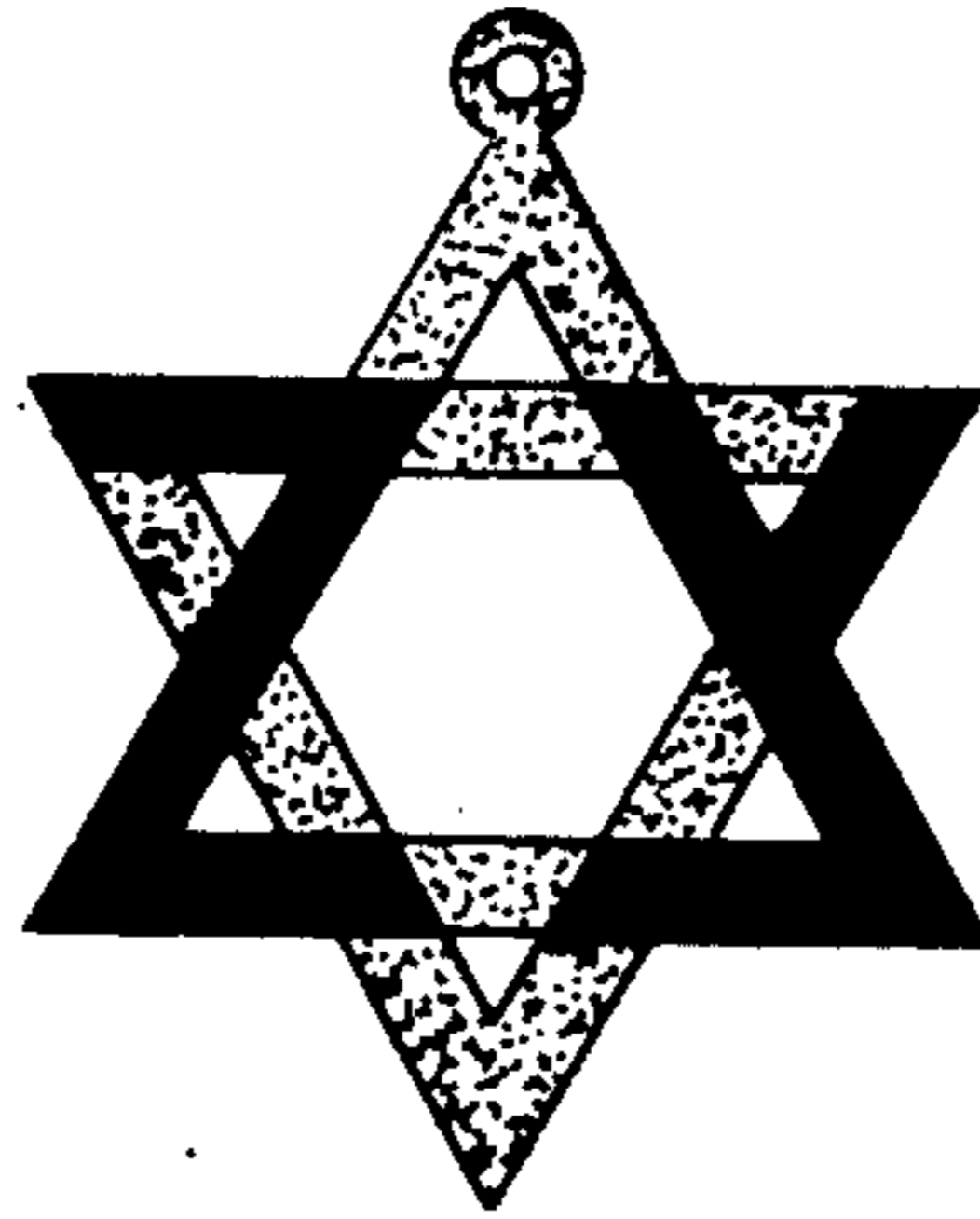
