FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a flag showing my new design.

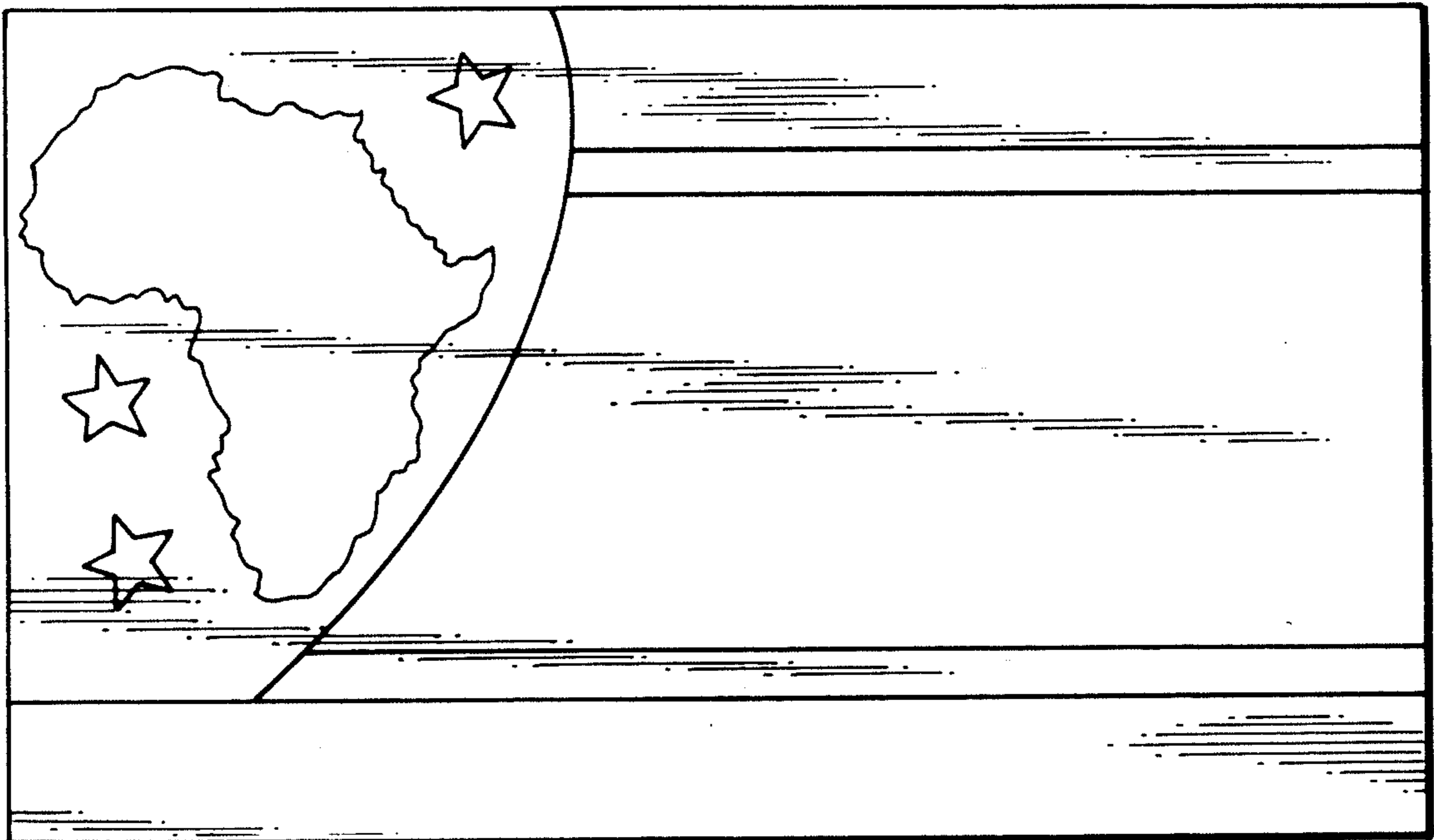
FIG. 2 is an edge view thereof; and

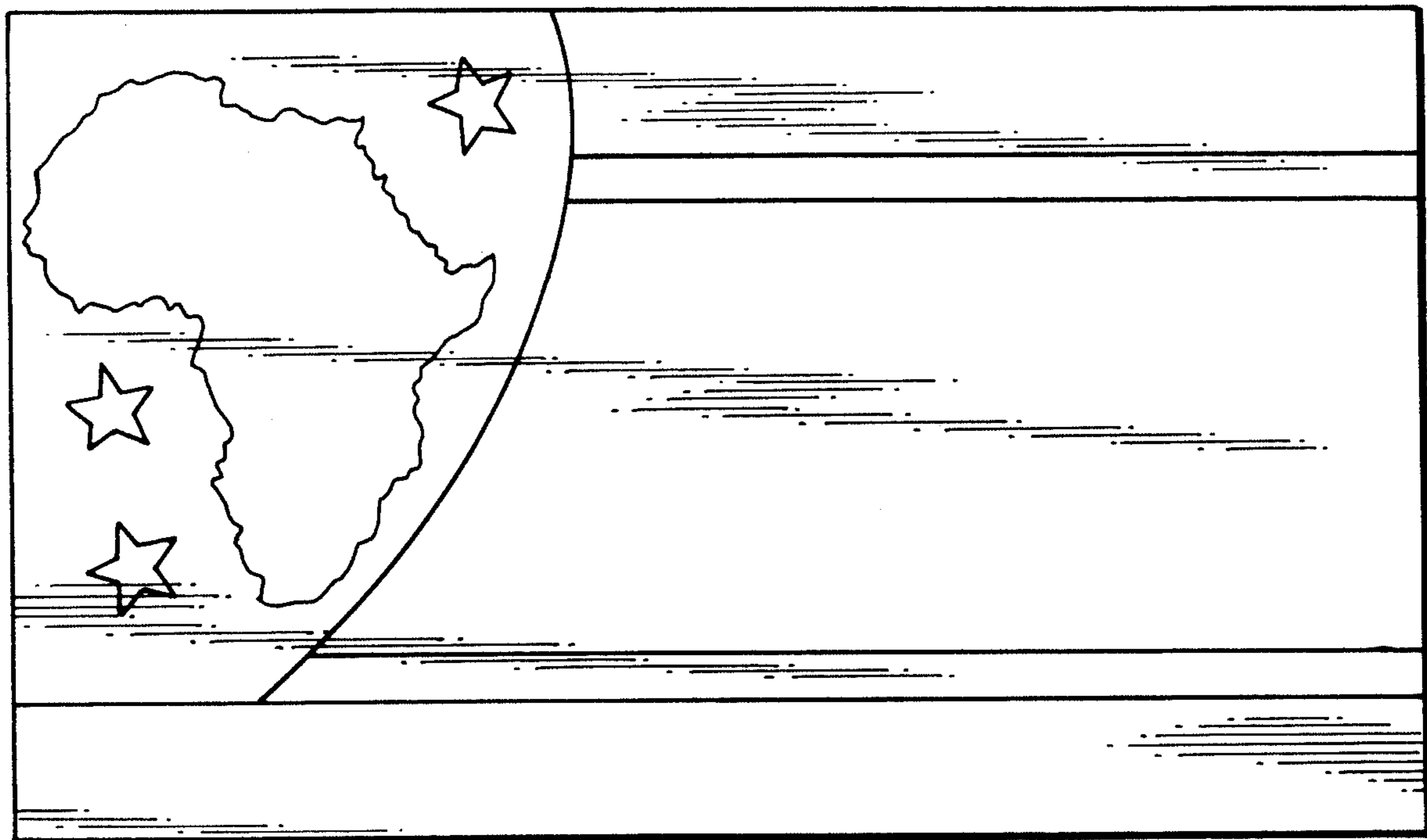
